SEC TELECONFERENCE

MEDIA SESSIONS

Coach Wade meets, when travel schedules permit, usually one or two days prior to games in non-conference play and usually on Mondays and Thursdays during the SEC season. The sessions take place in the practice facility meeting room. Times are announced based on practice plans with players usually one day a week. Some travel and scheduling issues may change the time and day so media should contact the Communications Office to confirm start time ... Player requests need to be in to Kent Lowe at clowe@lsu.edu no later than 24 hours in advance.

POST GAME

During the current season, post-game video sessions will be done remotely on zoom links that will be distributed to the media during the course of the game. There will be separate video zooms for each team and both will be conducted after the game when coaches and players are available the 10-minute cooling off period.

Both home and away, Coach Wade will conduct his radio post-game show before beginning his zoom session with media on hand for the game and admitted remotely.

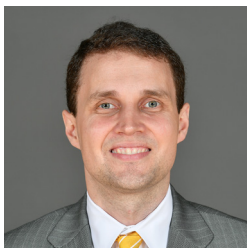

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

PROF TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

LAST GAME: LSU 94, GEORIGIA 92 (OT) (Baton Rouge, Jan. 6, 2021)

For the second straight game the Tigers found themselves down 10 points in the second half but LSU was able to get the game back to even to force overtime. LSU was able to win its second home game in SEC play as Javonte Smart hit two three pointers in the final two minutes of regulation to force the extra five minutes.

In the overtime, Cam Thomas and Darius Days both hit key three-pointers and Trendon Watford, in a struggling night at the line, made 3-of-4 free throws to help secure the win.

Thomas, who hit 15-of-16 free throws that pushed his school record free throw streak to 42 before it was stopped late in overtime, had 26 to lead LSU. It was his fourth consecutive game over 20 points and his seventh of the season.

Javonte Smart had his second straight game over 20 points with 21 points, five rebounds, four assists and six steals. Trendon Watford had 17 points and seven rebounds and Darius Days had his 11th career double double with 13 points and 11 rebounds.

LSU shot 44.3 percent for the game (31-of-70) with 10 treys. The Tigers had its lowest percentage of the season at the free throw line, hitting 22-of-33. UGA was 34-of-71 (47.9%) with 12 treys and 12-of-18 at the line.

After a tied first half, Georgia would get a 68-58 lead with 9:07 to play. Two minutes later the Tigers tied the game, but still was behind by six with 1:57 left. Smart hit a three on the next possession for LSU to cut the UGA lead to three, 80-77, and off a steal, Smart would hit the game-tying trey with 1:10 to go.

It was the ninth time in 35 games in the Will Wade era LSU has won after trailing after 30 minutes of play and the ninth time in 31 games that the Tigers have won after trailing entering the final five minutes. LSU is now 13-12 in games decided by 3 points or less in the Wil Wade era.

GAME HAS SIMILAR FINISH TO ALMOST A YEAR AGO

Down six entering the final two minutes, Javonte Smart hit two three-pointers Wednesday to tie the game with 1:10 to go against Georgia and send the contest to overtime and an LSU win.

The script was very similar to almost a year ago (1/14/20) at Texas A&M when LSU trailed Texas A&M, 79-73, entering the final couple of minutes. First Marshall Graves and then Javonte Smart hit three-pointers to tie the game with 1:03 to play. At the start of the overtime, Smart would hit a three that would give the Tigers the lead for good en route to an 89-85 victory over the Aggies.

In the overtime Wednesday, it would be a Darius Days three-pointer with 50 seconds to play and free throws that would cinch the home-court win for the Tigers.

LAST TIME THREE LSU PLAYERS SCORING 20

LSU had three players top 20 in the loss at Florida on Jan. 2. It was a wild game the last time three LSU players topped 20 points in a game:

There have been several times since then with two 20-point scorers (including Wednesday night), but also later in the 2015-16 season that also featured prolific scorers Antonio Blakeney and Keith Hornsby, the Tigers had two games with two players over 20 points and one at 18.

SO HOW WE FINALLY GOT TO SEC PLAY

With the SEC schedule now underway, a refresher course on how the schedule looked at the start and all the changes that got us to where we are now:

- 1 -- LSU was scheduled to play San Fran, Western Kentucky and Saint Louis in Lincoln, Nebraska in the Golden Window Classic, Nov. 25, 26 and 28.
- 2 -- Saint Louis elected to stay in Saint Louis and invited LSU to join them for the Billiken Classic where LSU played SIUE and Saint Louis, Nov. 26 and 28.
- 3 -- To replace the third game that would have been played in Nebraska, LSU scheduled Southeastern for a game played, Nov. 30.
- 4 -- LSU plays a scheduled game on Dec. 6 in Baton Rouge against Louisiana Tech. The two teams were originally supposed to meet in Bossier City, Nov. 24, but the promoter and the teams elected to move the game in Bossier City to December of 2021. Tech and LSU signed a new contract for this game.
- 5 -- LSU pulls out of a game with South Florida in Atlanta at Holiday Hoopsgiving Dec. 12 because of SEC and NCAA Covid protocols involving the LSU team.
- 6 -- LSU quickly schedules Sam Houston State for an 11 a.m. game on Dec. 14. Associate Head Coach Bill Armstrong coaches the game solo as Coach Will Wade announced earlier in the day he had tested positive for Covid-19.
- 7 -- LSU announces postponements against UNO (Dec. 16), North Texas (Dec. 19) and VCU (Dec. 22) because of SEC and NCAA protocols regarding Covid.
- 8 -- LSU on Dec. 21 schedules Texas Southern for a Dec. 26, 4 p.m. game.
- 9 -- On Dec. 24, Texas Southern has to withdraw because of NCAA Covid-19 protocols. That evening, Nicholls signs a contract to come to Baton Rouge for a 1 p.m. game on Dec. 26.
- 10 -- LSU opens SEC play as scheduled on Dec. 29 playing Texas A&M.

15 GAMES OF 20 OR MORE POINTS FOR TIGERS

Through nine games, LSU has had players record 15 games of 20 points or more this season -- 7 by Cam Thomas, 4 by Trendon Watford, 3 by Javonte Smart and one by Darius Days. The breakdown:

AN 86-POINT OPENING SEC RUN

Already scoring well, Cam Thomas has stepped it up even a little bit more with 86 points in the first three SEC games to average 28.7 points after scoring 32 points against Texas A&M, 28 points at Florida and 26 versus Georgia. Prior to that Thomas had 29 versus Nicholls which made him the first LSU player to have four consecutive games over 20 since Antonio Blakeney had six consecutive 20-point games in the month of February 2017.

THOMAS FOUR GAMES 10 OR MORE FIELD GOALS

Ten or more field goals for Thomas has led to big nights for the freshman:

SIUE -- 10-of-21 FGs, 4-9 3FGs, 3-4 FT, 2 assists (27 points)
SAINT LOUIS -- 10-of-18 FGs, 4-10 3FGs, 1-1 FT, 2 assists (25 points)
NICHOLLS -- 10-of-21 FGs, 2-8 3FGs, 7-7 FT, 2 assists (29 points)
TEXAS A&M -- 12-of-21 FGs, 5-11 3FGs, 3-3 FT, 1 assist (32 points)

In nine games, Thomas is averaging 24.8 points per game. Officially as of Thursday, he is fifth in the NCAA in scoring but third among players who have played at least five games. The games against SIUE and Saint Louis to open the season earned him the SEC Freshman of the Week honor and the Nicholls game earned him on Dec. 28 his second SEC Freshman of the Week honor. Besides the scoring, Thomas is averaging 2.9 rebounds and 1.6 assists. He is shooting 43.9 percent overall and made 25 three pointers.

It was at the 7:04 mark of the second half when Thomas made free throws No. 35 and No. 36 that he broke the LSU record for consecutive free throws made set originally by Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf during the 1989-90 season of 35.

Thomas has drawn 41 fouls in the nine games and is 62-of-68 at the line for 91.2 percent.

FIVE TIMES THREE

Cam Thomas hit five treys in the win over A&M in the league opener. The last player to hit five treys for LSU was Javonte Smart which happened to be in the opening win last season at Tennessee. Smart has again now become the latest to hit five treys in the win over Georgia (1/6).

MORE NUMBERS

Thomas's 26-point game versus Georgia was his seventh game of 20 points or more this season and as of Jan. 8, that was the most by any freshman in Division I:

Cam Thomas – LSU – 7 (Next game at Missouri Saturday)

Cade Cunningham – Oklahoma State – 5 (at Kansas State, Saturday)

Marcus Williams – Wyoming – 4 (vs. Boise State, Monday)

The 32 points remains the most points in a game by a D1 freshman this season ... 32 points ranked T41 in single game points scored in D1 this year.

Thomas scored at least 15 points or more in his first seven career games. It is the longest career-opening streak of 15-point games by an SEC player over the last 25 seasons, according to ESPN Stats & Info.

ESPN Stats & Info also reports that Thomas' four consecutive 25-point games makes him the only SEC freshman with a four-game 25-point streak in the last 25 seasons and also the only to surpass 200 points in nine career games during that span as well.

For the record, outside the 25-season range, LSU freshman Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf (Chris Jackson) scored 210 points in his first seven games (although that included a 48 and 53-point efforts) and 253 in his first nine games.

DUOS

Okay, can't take credit for this but Matt Dunaway at Mississippi State came up with the top duos and trios in the league when it comes to scoring and LSU is on top of both groups.

TIGERS SHOOTING WELL

The Tigers lead the league at this point in the season in shooting percentage at 49.2 percent (264-of-537). Opponents are shooting 41.6 percent (231-555).

LSU has shot better than 50 percent in five games. The 50 percent shooting percentages this season:

- SIUE – 30-of-58 (51.7%)**
- Saint Louis – 28-of-52 (53.8%)**
- Southeastern – 30-of-60 (50.0%)**
- Louisiana Tech – 26-of-48 (54.2%)**
- Nicholls – 31-of-56 (55.4%)**

LSU is 95-9 since the start of the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or more in a game. So far this season, LSU has made 33 more field goals than opponents on 18 less attempts.

LOTS OF REBOUNDS, BUT STOPPING OPPONENTS OFFENSIVE REBOUNDS KEY

The Tigers were able to pull down 53 rebounds against Southeastern and 46 against Louisiana Tech but the numbers for the opponents on the offensive side have caused some consternation for the LSU coach staff.

Southeastern pulled down 14 offensive rebounds to 13 for the Tigers, but in the LA Tech game, the difference was more pronounced with a 14-4 advantage for the Bulldogs that led to a 13-5 second chance points advantage.

The inability to clear the boards again caused problems for LSU against Nicholls as the Tigers were not only rebound-

ed by the Colonels, but Nicholls had a 17-10 advantage on the offensive boards. That resulted in an 18-12 advantage for Nicholls in second chance points.

LSU turned that around in the conference opener against A&M, with a 40-31 margin overall on the boards and 15-11 on the offensive boards. That was part of a 21-8 advantage for LSU in second chance points.

Florida had a four-board advantage but LSU had a 14-13 advantage in offensive boards. Florida, however, was an 18-14 leader in second chance points. Against Georgia, the Bulldogs out rebounded LSU, 43-40, but LSU had a 21-13 advantage in second chance points

THREE STRAIGHT 20 POINT GAMES TO START AN LSU CAREER

Cam Thomas became the first LSU player to have three games of 20 or more in his first three varsity LSU games since JC transfer Marcus Thornton did in Nov. 2007 – games of 27, 24 and 20.

Thomas' 32-point opening league game is the most by an LSU freshman since the opening game of conference play for LSU in the 2015-16 season when on Jan. 2, 2016, Ben Simmons opened his national freshman of the year campaign with 36 points at Vanderbilt in a Tiger win.

LSU's last 30-point game by any player was in the regular season finale last year when senior Marlon Taylor had 30 points against Georgia. The last LSU player to score more points than Thomas in a game was former point guard Tremont Waters, who scored 39 also against A&M in January 2019.

COACH WADE PASSES 100

Coach Wade reached 100 games as the LSU head coach in the Nicholls game on Dec. 24. Here's where he ranked in wins among LSU coaches in their first 100 games as the head coach (years in parenthesis represent length to get to 100 games):

WILL WADE IN CONFERENCE GAMES

Coach Will Wade in his eighth season as a head coach has had good success in conference games in all three of his head coaching stops, winning double figure games every year except his first year at LSU.

Wade won 27 league games in two years at Chattanooga, 28 in two years at VCU and now 37 SEC games in his fourth year at LSU. Wade is presently 92-34 in league games including 37-19 at LSU. Wade was 8-10 his first season in the league, 15-2 in a conference championship team in 2019 (He did not coach the final game of the 2019 season.) and, 12-6 and tying for second in 2020.

WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

After a strong freshman campaign in which he averaged 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds, Trendon Watford's sophomore campaign has started well, although he missed the Sam Houston game (12/14) with a minor ankle injury.

After struggling to score against A&M, Watford posted 21 points to go with eight rebounds (six offensive) at Florida and 17 points versus Georgia. He is second on the team in scoring at 17.4 points a game and second in rebounds at 6.8 a game. He is also the team leader in assists at 4.13.

Watford is all over the SEC statistics leaders showing sixth in scoring, 13th in rebounds, third in field goal percentage (54.2%), sixth in assists, ninth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.4) and third in minutes played average (33.8).

Watford has four games of 20 points or more this year and that gives him seven for his LSU career:

26 – at Vanderbilt, 2/5/20

24 – at Saint Louis, 11/28/20

22 – vs. Nicholls, 12/26/20

22 – at Texas, 1/25/20

21 – at Florida, 1/2/21

21 – vs. Arkansas, 1/8/20

20 – vs. Southeastern, 11/30/20

TIGERS INSIDE THE ARC

LSU has been good the last few years shooting inside the arc but this year the Tigers again have posted one of the nation's better percentages inside the arc for two points. LSU prior to the Florida game was seventh in the nation in two-point shooting at 62.0 percent. The Florida game, however, may have been one of the Tigers poorer efforts inside the arc, shooting just 41.9 percent.

For the season, LSU is 17th nationally in two-point percentage at 58.0 percent.

Last season, LSU was 54.7 percent inside the arc, which was 17th in the nation. In 2018-19, LSU was 52.9 percent inside the arc.

LSU BETTER THIS YEAR OUTSIDE THE ARC

The Nicholls game (12/26) was the first game, LSU's outside shooting numbers tumbled, hitting only 4-of-15 attempts (26.7%). However, LSU has hit double figures three times:

Vs. SIUE (Nov. 26) – 12 three-pointers

Vs. Southeastern (Nov. 30) – 13 three-pointers

Vs. Georgia (Dec 6) – 10 three-pointers

Other than the Nicholls game, LSU has had no less than seven three-pointers in any of the other games this season. So far LSU is 80-of-220 or 36.4 percent. That is 3.7 percentage points better than last season when LSU was just 32.7 percent for the season.

LSU is third in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage.

LSU's 80 makes are nine more than the opponents which have taken 38 more three-point attempts than LSU.

FREE THROWS COUNTING WELL

Despite what was its lowest free throw percentage of the season against Georgia (66.7 percent), LSU remains on top of the league in free throw shooting percentage at 77.6 percent (173-of-223). Only Arkansas in 11 games has made more free throws in the league than LSU (181).

The Georgia game was the first that LSU had shot below 71 percent in a game this season.

The Tigers have made 67 more free throws than opponents and have attempted 65 more free throws than opponents early in the season.

Only one game, the A&M game (9 attempts), has LSU attempted less than 18 free throws in a game.

LSU'S OFFENSIVE POWER NUMBERS

Kenpom.com has LSU fifth entering Thursday in the list of top 10 offenses so far in the early part of the year. Iowa is tops followed by Gonzaga, Baylor and Villanova in front of LSU. After LSU comes Michigan, Illinois, Creighton, Wisconsin and Ohio State.

SOME OF THE NUMBERS

LSU returned 45.7 percent of its offensive production (45.1 points of an 80.5 season average); 20.7 rebounds of a 39.7 team rebound average (53.1%) and 57.0 percent of assists (227 of 398 total).

Offensively, LSU had one of the most efficient offenses in February and March of 2020 at 1.13 points per possession. According to NCAA.com, only Gonzaga (1.19) and Creighton (1.15) had higher points per possession levels during February/March when the season was called.

For the first eight games, LSU is at 1.175 points per possession which is fifth in the country.

FATHERS AND SONS

UCLA transfer Shareef O'Neal brings an addition to the list of Fathers and Sons who have been a part of the LSU men's basketball program over the years.

O'Neal is wearing 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice – 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

Shareef and father Shaquille O'Neal will become the latest in a line of father-son combinations that have played for the LSU Purple and Gold:

So far this season, O'Neal has averaged 15 minutes a game, 3.0 points and 5.0 rebounds a game. O'Neal had nine rebounds in the win over Southeastern.

The younger O'Neal has made two three-pointers which is two more than his dad made in his three years at LSU. He has been first sub or co-sub in the game in all five of the games he has played in.

It is hoped that O'Neal can return to the court during LSU's three-game homestand.

EARLY SEASON WATCH LISTS

Two Tigers were named to two of the watch lists as put out by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and for the Wooden Award – Javonte Smart and Trendon Watford.

Smart was named to the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award for point guards and Watford is on the watch list for the Karl Malone Award for forwards.

The two were also on the first team All-SEC coaches' preseason squad.

TIGERS PICKED THIRD IN MEDIA PRESEASON POLL

LSU was picked third in the SEC Media poll behind Tennessee and Kentucky in the voting by a group of SEC and national writers.

SERIES AGAINST OLE MISS

This game was originally scheduled for mid-February on a Wednesday night but will now be played on a Saturday night as the late game on the SEC Network.

LSU and Ole Miss have been playing hoops since 1910 and LSU leads the overall series at 124-88. Ole Miss leads, 55-40 in Oxford.

LSU has won four straight in the series and seven-of-the-last-eight games. LSU won in The Pavilion in both 2019 and 2020.

Kermit Davis, Jr., who was on Coach John Brady's first staff at LSU in between his coaching stints and Idaho, Texas A&M and then after LSU back to Idaho, is in his third year as the Ole Miss head coach.

ON THE ROAD

LSU was 5-6 on the road a year ago and starting with the 2017-18 season through present, LSU is 17-17 in road games, highlighted by 11 straight league road wins during the entire 2019 season and the first two leagues game of 2020.

JAVONTE SMART

Coach Will Wade saluted Javonte Smart after the opening SEC game when he struggled to score but still kept LSU moving forward running the offense and posting six assists in the win.

In the last two games, Smart has had two good performances, scoring 20 in each contest, and against UGA (1/6) hitting two key treys in the final two minutes to force overtime. The numbers:

After averaging 12.5 points a year ago to go with 3.5 rebounds and his 129 assists last year, Smart is averaging 15.3 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.88 assists with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.4.

He is on the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award and the Jersey Mike's Naismith Player of the Year list as well as the Wooden list. He was a second team selection on the media All-SEC team (two five-man teams) and is on the first team of the coaches' All-SEC selection (eight players).

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play last year. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 26 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league.

SMART'S EIGHTH GAME OVER 20; THIRD THIS SEASON

Against Sam Houston on Dec. 14, Smart had 25 points in that game, four points away from his 29 points against Tennessee (Feb. 23, 2019) he had as a freshman. The 21 against Georgia was his eighth games of 20 points or more this season:

SMART TOPS 100 THREE-POINTERS

It was at the 6:01 mark of the first half against Sam Houston (12/14) when Javonte Smart made his first three-pointer of the game and that gave him 100 for his LSU career (now 109 total). He became the 23rd player in LSU history with 100 career treys. Darrel Mitchell, who played for the 2006 Final Four team, is the team's all-time leader in three-pointers at 258, while Tremont Waters (2017-19) was the one prior to Smart to cross the 100 threshold, finishing at 128.

DARIUS DAYS

Days was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

Days averaged 11.1 points last year for the Tigers, hitting 48.6 percent of his field goal attempts (125-of-257) with 39 three-pointers.

After averaging 5.3 points as a freshman, Days more than doubled his scoring average and increased his rebound average from 4.0 to 6.8.

So far this season, the junior from Raleigh, Florida is fourth on the team in scoring at 13.3 points and 8.2 boards. He is fifth in rebound average. He has hit 17 treys and is shooting 44-of-83 from the field (53.0%). He is 17-of-44 from long range (38.6%). Days is 10th in the league in offensive rebound average at 2.4 a game and third in defensive rebound average at 5.8.

DARIUS DAYS ON THE BOARDS

For the fourth time this year, Darius Days pulled down double figure rebounds as he grabbed 11 against Georgia (1/6) after 10 against Texas A&M (12/29) and 11 at Saint Louis (11/28) and Sam Houston State (12/14).

Three of those were part of double doubles as Days scored 16 points in the Sam Houston State game, 18 against A&M and 13 against Georgia.

Days with his three double doubles this year, gives him a total of 11 for his three years at LSU.

MANNING RETURNS

After a season in which he broke the fifth metatarsal bone in both feet at various times in SEC play last year, the team's long senior, Charles Manning Jr., finally was able to make his season debut against Louisiana Tech (12/6).

Manning played 13.5 minutes in the Tech game, scoring 2 points with two rebounds in his opening game while playing on a minutes restriction after coming back to practice.

With the Trendon Watford injury, he was elevated to the starting lineup against Sam Houston (12/14), playing 32 minutes and scoring four points with seven rebounds, two assists and three steals.

Manning had a good game against Texas A&M (12/29), in which he played 19 minutes, hitting four field goals with four rebounds and nine points.

In six games, Manning is averaging 17.8 minutes, 4.2 points, and 3.0 rebounds.

JOSH LEBLANC

He's been at LSU since last January chomping at the bit for the chance to play college basketball again. Finally, against Sam Houston State (12/14), Josh LeBlanc got that chance again, this time in his hometown.

The Baton Rouge native spent a season and a half at Georgetown playing for the Hoyas before returning to Baton Rouge and enrolling at LSU in time for the second semester of the 2019-20 school year.

LeBlanc practiced with the Tigers during the conference part of the 2019-20 season and early on this year before becoming eligible for LSU at the end of the fall semester.

He played 14 minutes against the Bearkats, making both field goal attempts, one free throw for five points to go with eight rebounds, including four offensive boards.

Against Georgia, LeBlanc scored two points in 16 minutes but had a block and five steals in the contest.

He is averaging 14.9 minutes a game, 1.8 points and 3.8 rebounds.

WILKINSON IN STARTING ROLE

Freshman Mwani Wilkinson from Las Vegas got his first start of his LSU career on Dec. 6 against Louisiana Tech. Although he didn't score in the game, he played 17 minutes and had one block and two steals. His best game was against Southeastern Louisiana (11/30), scoring 12 points on 5-of-8 field goal attempts.

He scored six against Sam Houston hitting all three field goal attempts. For the year, Wilkinson is averaging 4.4 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game.

Against Nicholls he played 20 minutes with a rebound and two steals, but a +/- number of +14.

Wilkinson has contributed with 16 points in the three SEC games and 17 rebounds. He had five points and five rebounds to go with two steals.

He is averaging 20.0 minutes a game, averaging 4.2 points and 3.6 rebounds. Of his 32 rebounds, 21 have been offensive boards.

JALEN COOK

The Walker, Louisiana product missed the Southeastern game with a minor injury but came back against Louisiana Tech (12/6) and played 13 minutes, scoring 10 points with two assists. Cook had nine in 11 minutes against Sam Houston.

Cook is fifth on the team in scoring at 4.6 points with 1.0 rebounds and 1.2 assists. Cook played 25 minutes off the bench against Nicholls getting two field goals and 4-of-6 at the line to score eight points with four assists and two steals. He is averaging 9.9 minutes a game.

ERIC GAINES

Eric Gaines, the freshman from Lithonia, Georgia, got his first start against Nicholls (12/6) with Javonte Smart out and played 15 minutes. While he scored just one point, Gaines had two rebounds two assists, a block and a steal.

Gaines has struggled a bit from the field at 4-of-18, but he has been able to get fouled and get to the line, making 10-of-15. He is averaging 2.1 points and 1.4 rebounds.

HOW YOUNG AND NEW IS THIS TEAM?

The Tigers are a bit on the new and young side based on research by Tom Gilbert of Kansas State prior to the season. LSU's five returning letterman makes LSU one of 25 teams that will return five letter winners or less for the 20-21 season.

LSU's eight new players (three transfers, three signees) make it one of 37 teams to have at least eight players in their first year in Baton Rouge.

LSU is one of 23 basketball teams to have at least 10 underclassmen on the roster (freshmen, sophomores).

The Tigers are one of 17 teams to have four or less upperclassmen on the roster (junior, seniors).

Finally, LSU is one of just 12 teams to have one senior (Charles Manning Jr.) on the roster.

After the nine games, Kenpom.com has LSU's experience rated on the young side at No. 326 with only Kentucky and Auburn behind them in the SEC.

BACK TO BR FOR A THREE-GAME HOMESTAND

LSU returns to Baton Rouge for a three-game homestand at the Maravich Center hosting Arkansas on Wednesday on ESPN2, South Carolina on the SEC Network next Saturday and Alabama on Tuesday, Jan. 19 on ESPN2.

The Arkansas game time has been changed to 6 p.m. and the Alabama game will tip at 8 p.m. All three games will be broadcast on the affiliates of the LSU Sports Radio Network.
