FAST FACTS

- Head coach Beth Torina is in her ninth season at the helm of LSU softball and has coached the Tigers to four Women's College World Series appearances, including three-straight, one of two teams (UCLA) in the nation to accomplish that feat from 2015-17.
- Under Torina, the Tigers are averaging 45
 wins per season. Torina currently has a
 total of 376 wins at LSU. She earned her
 500th victory February 21 with a no-hitter
 against Sam Houston State, thrown by
 Shelby Wickersham.
- The Tigers have a 0.95 ERA which is first in the nation and the SEC. This season the pitching staff has a total of three no-hitters, including a perfect game, and three onehitters. Shelby Wickersham leads the country with a 0.25 ERA.
- Maribeth Gorsuch earned SEC Pitcher of the Week, NFCA Pitcher of the Week and DI Softball Pitcher of the Week after throwing the first seven-inning perfect game in program history on February 22. She pitched 21 first-pitch strikes and struck out a career-high 16 batters. Gorsuch also threw a one-hitter on Wednesday against LA Tech
- Wickersham's no-hitter on February 21 was her second career no-hitter. Her first came in her freshman debut in 2019. She struck out a career-high six batters on Friday.
- The Tigers scored 20 runs against Sam Houston State on February 22 which was the most runs scored in the new Tiger Park.
- In that game against Sam Houston State, the Tigers walked a program record of 14 times. Taylor Pleasants had five of those which is the most in a game by a Tiger.
- The Tigers had a total of 7 run-rule games in the first 14 games of the season.
- This Tigers earned an SEC weekly honor three out of the four weeks since season started.

- Seniors Aliyah Andrews and Amanda
 Doyle both rank in the top 15 across active
 Division I players in two career categories
 each. Andrews is ranked seventh in the
 nation with 206 games played in her career,
 while Doyle is ranked eighth with 205
 games played. Andrews is sixth in career
 stolen bases with 110, while they both rank
 14th in the nation in at-bats with 601.
- Andrews led the Tigers at the plate with a .529 average. She had at least one hit in every game on the weekend and had a stolen base in four of the five games. Went 2-for-4 against No. 25 Texas Tech with a run and an RBI. Finished the weekend with an on-base percentage of .529. Had zero errors in centerfield and a total of 11 putouts.
- Sunseri went 2-0 in the circle for the Tigers, including coming in relief and getting the win against No. 25 Texas Tech. Allowed four runs in 11.2 innings of work and struck out a total of 11 batters on the weekend. Went the distance for the Tigers in the win over Cal. Allowed just the one run and struck out five. Also hit .333 at the plate with five hits, four RBI and a triple.
- In the last 10 games, Georgia Clark has led the team with a .444 average. She had 12 hits with four doubles, a home run, eight RBI and nine runs scored.
- Andrews has hit .438 in the last 10 games after hitting .182 in the first nine games of the season. She had 14 hits in the last 10 games to go along with two triples, five RBI and 10 runs scored. She was 7-for-7 in stolen bases.
- Sunseri has also done well in the last 10 games, hitting .400 with 10 hits, two doubles, a triple, a home run, 11 RBI and nine runs scored. In the first nine games of the season, she hit .136.

Against the Field

- Campbell The Tigers lead the all-time series 2-0, facing the Camels in a doubleheader on March 6, 2010. The Tigers took game one 8-0 in five innings and claimed game two 2-1 in eight innings. This will be the first time Beth Torina will face the Camels.
- Illinois State The Tigers lead the all-time series 5-0 against the Red Birds, all games coming under Torina. The Tigers faced them last season, coming out on top 6-2.

Wheels on the Bases

Andrews was also named to the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 Watch List. She was one of six SEC players on the list. Andrews broke the single-season stolen base record with 47 last year and passed her sister A.J. on the career list with 100. With 10 stolen bases on the year, she now has 110. She is 46 away from breaking the all-time record set by Dee Douglas (1998-2001). Dee Dee Henderson (2005-08) is second with 113.

Coming in for the Save

Ali Kilponen was stellar in the circle in the Tiger Classic, coming in for the save on two occasions. In the season opener against Central Arkansas, she came in at the top of the seventh inning and closed out the game on back-to-back strikeouts for her first career save.

The Highlands Ranch, Colorado native earned her second save the next day, coming into the game in the seventh with runners at first and second and no outs. She got out of the jam with a sac bunt, strike out and a pop up to first.

Kilponen got the start on Sunday against Florida A&M and pitched three perfect innings before letting two freshmen get some work in the circle. The three ended up combining for a no-hitter, the 41st in program history. It was the first combined no-hitter with three pitchers.

On the weekend, Kilponen struck out eight batters in five innings. She did not give up a run, hit or walk.

The Freshmen Came To Play

Taylor Pleasants - SEC Freshman of the Week (Feb. 10)

- Led the entire SEC in batting average in the first weekend of action at .692. She hit her first career home run to walk off No. 13 Oklahoma State. In her second career at-bat, she hit a double. She went 9-for-13 at the plate with five runs scored, two doubles, a home run, four RBI and four walks. She finished the weekend with a 1.077 slugging percentage and a .765 on-base percentage. She picked up seven putouts and three assists, and had a diving play against Florida A&M on Saturday.
- She tallied tree hits, three RBI and three runs scored last weekend in the LSU Invitational. She hit her second home run of the season to take a 2-0 lead against No. 13 ULL.
- In the Purple & Gold Challenge, Pleasants recorded an LSU softball record of five walks in the win over Sam Houston State. She is second in the SEC in batting average at .500

Ciara Briggs

- Briggs had a big highlight in the Tiger Classic as she brought in the tying run in the 3-2 win over No. 13 Oklahoma State. She hit a double in the sixth inning to bring in Taylor Tidwell from first, evening the score at 2-2. Briggs recorded her first career hit in the 8-0 win over Florida A&M earlier on Saturday. She also had a hit, an RBI, two runs scored, two walks and a stolen base against Florida A&M on Sunday.
- Briggs had a big second weekend in the LSU Invitational as she hit .364 with four hits, two runs scored and and RBI. She also had a diving catch in left field to hold off No. 13 ULL on Sunday.
- In the Purple & Gold Challenge, she had the top freshmen average on the team at .500 with five hits, six runs, a double, two walks and two stolen bases. Had a .615 on-base percentage. Scored the first run of the game against Belmont on Saturday. Had and RBI against Sam Houston State on Saturday and against Belmont on Friday. Had one putout and did not have an error on the weekend.

Raeleen Gutierrez

- Gutierrez got her first career start in the season opener against Central Arkansas, starting at first base. She recorded her first career hit against Florida A&M on Saturday. She recorded two hits in that game with a run scored.

15-Run Inning

Against Florida A&M, the Tigers scored 15 runs in the second inning, which is the most runs scored in an inning at the new Tiger Park. It is tied for most runs scored in an inning. The Tigers scored 15 runs in the 6th inning at LA Tech in 2016 and against Nicholls St. in the 4th inning in 2004.

Preseason All-SEC

Aliyah Andrews and Shelbi Sunseri were both named to the Preseason All–SEC team. The two earned Second Team All–SEC last year with Andrews also on the SEC All–Defensive Team for the second time.

LSU Picked Third in Preseason SEC Poll

The 2020 SEC Softball Preseason Coaches' Poll was released in January, and the league's coaches have predicted the LSU softball team to finish third in the conference.

The Tigers are coming off a 43-19 overall mark and 14-10 SEC record in 2019. They return 16 players from last year's squad and add seven newcomers. Of the returners, All-American Shelbi Sunseri is back for her junior season, while two-time All-SEC and SEC All-Defensive performer Aliyah Andrews returns to the outfield.

LSU opened the 2020 season with their first practice last Thursday. The season opener is set for February 6 in Tiger Park, taking on Central Arkansas at $6\,\mathrm{n}$ m

The Crimson Tide, who received 11 first-place votes, returns 13 letterwinners from last year's program that finished the 2019 season with an overall record of 60-10 and a 18-6 mark in league play. Tennessee earned two first-place votes and was tabbed to finish second in the SEC. Kentucky came in fourth, and Florida rounded out the top five.



- The facility was named after the late Mike Moore, a longtime supporter of LSU softball. During his life, Mr. Moore was an avid and very active fan of LSU Athletics. Mr. Moore and his family were season ticket holders for multiple sports and often traveled across the country to watch the Tigers play.
- Mr. Moore tragically passed away while traveling with his wife supporting the LSU Softball team in Palm Springs, California in February of 2015. Before his passing, Mr. Moore and his family made a financial commitment to the LSU softball program for the performance center.
- This state-of-the-art facility features a fullsized infield, multiple hitting lanes and a team weight room, believed to be the first-ever exclusive weight room for a softball team in the nation.
- With a space of 14,500 square feet, 1,279 square feet is dedicated to the weight room to go along with 770 square feet on the second floor specifically for cardio equipment.
- Each hitting lane will has wired electricity which provides the staff and student-ath-letes the capability to set up multiple hitting machines throughout the facility. The facility is wired with a custom multi-camera system that provides a chance to immediately review film during practice.
- The building is also equipped with 517 square feet of storage space and a 240 square foot locker room area. Lighting is energy efficient with impact-resistant LED fixtures.
- A custom turf, that mirrors real grass in terms of playability and performance, was installed with LSU branding through the entire indoor. Graphics are placed throughout the interior of the facility that honors the history of LSU softball.


