SEC TELECONFERENCE

MEDIA SESSIONS

Coach Wade meets, when travel schedules permit, usually one or two days prior to games in non-conference play and usually on Mondays and Thursdays during the SEC season. The sessions take place in the practice facility meeting room. Times are announced based on practice plans with players usually one day a week. Some travel and scheduling issues may change the time and day so media should contact the Communications Office to confirm start time ... Player requests need to be in to Kent Lowe at clowe@lsu.edu no later than 24 hours in advance.

POST GAME

During the current season, post-game video sessions will be done remotely on zoom links that will be distributed to the media during the course of the game. There will be separate video zooms for each team and both will be conducted after the game when coaches and players are available the 10-minute cooling off period. Both home and away, Coach Wade will conduct his radio post-game show before beginning his zoom session with media on hand for the game and admitted remotely.

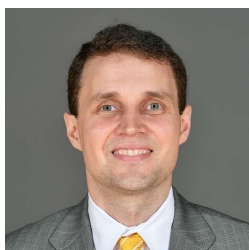

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

PRIOR TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

LAST GAME: LSU 86, LOUISIANA TECH 55 (12/6/20, BATON ROUGE)

For the second straight game the Tigers played solid defensively and was able to put the Bulldogs away early in the game and cut off any chance of a comeback in the second half.

Darius Days hit back-to-back-to-back three-pointers to help the Tigers sprint to an early lead that would amount to a 43-24 halftime advantage. In the second half, when Tech was able to cut the deficit to 14 points, the Tigers quickly ran off eight points to increase the lead back over 20. LSU led by 33 in the final minutes of the game.

Five players scored in double figures for the Tigers with Trendon Watford scoring 18 with Javonte Smart and Cam Thomas each getting 16. Days had 12 and Jalen Cook had 10.

For the fourth straight game, LSU shot over 50 percent from the floor, 54.2 percent (28-48) with eight treys. LSU was 26-of-34 from the free throw line. Tech was held to just 28.8 percent from the floor (19-of-66) and 12-of-25 from the line. LSU out rebounded Tech, 46-33.

DEFENSE STEPS UP IN LAST TWO GAMES

After allowing 80- plus points and over 50 percent shooting in each of the first two games, the Tigers began to get their defense going along with the continued success of their offense.

Against Southeastern (11/30), the Lions were held to just 22 percent from the floor (13-59) and just five treys in scoring 43 points in a 96-43 LSU win. The Lions shot just 17.2 percent in the first half (5-29) as LSU raced to a 50-18 lead.

Versus Louisiana Tech on Dec. 6, the Tigers held the Bulldogs to 28.8 percent (19-66) and five treys. LSU outscored the Bulldogs, 43-24, in the first half.

Over the last two games, LSU has held opponents to 32-of-125 (25.6%) from the field (and 10 combined treys).

LOTS OF REBOUNDS, BUT COACH WANTS MORE IN ONE CATEGORY

The Tigers have been able to pull down 53 rebounds against Southeastern and 46 against Louisiana Tech but the numbers for the opponents on the offensive side have caused some consternation for the LSU coach staff.

Southeastern pulled down 14 offensive rebounds to 13 for the Tigers, but in the LA Tech game, the difference was more pronounced with a 14-4 advantage for the Bulldogs that led to a 13-5 second chance points advantage.

SO, FOR THE SECOND TIME A HOME GAME ADDED

The Southeastern game was a late addition after LSU's original planned MTE appearance in Lincoln, Nebraska of three games was shuttled to two games in Saint Louis. Now this game with Sam Houston State follows LSU being unable to go to the Holiday Hoopsgiving event in Atlanta this past Saturday to play South Florida because of contact tracing issues within the LSU program.

ONE OF 13 PLAYERS

Cam Thomas became the 13th player at LSU since the 1976-77 season to score at least 21 points in his first varsity game when he scored 27 in the contest. The freshman hit 10-of-21 shots, including 4-of-9 from the arc. Freshman Tremont Waters scored 27 in his debut on Nov. 10, 2017 against Alcorn State and junior college transfer Marcus Thornton hit for 27 against Southeastern on Nov. 12, 2007.

Others who had 21 or more in their first LSU game are: Lester Earl, Duop Reath, Antonio Blakeney, Randy Livingston, Jose Vargas, Ralston Turner, Andre Stringer, Ronald Dupree, Ronnie Henderson and John Williams.

For the record, in his first game in 1967, Pete Maravich scored 49 points.

THREE STRAIGHT 20 POINT GAMES TO START AN LSU CAREER

Cam Thomas became the first LSU player to have three 20 or more in his first three varsity LSU games since JC transfer Marcus Thornton did in Nov. 2007 – games of 27, 24 and 20.

As freshmen go in recent times – Tremont Waters as a freshman had 20-plus in his first and third games in 2017-18; In 2015-16, Ben Simmons, who went on to be national freshman of the year, had 20-plus in his second and third games; and, high school All-America Randy Livingston, returned after knee surgery for his redshirt freshman season and had 20-plus in his 1st and 3rd games in 1994-95.

In another example, Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf opened his two-time All-American campaign at LSU with 13, 25 and 48. Pete Maravich, who played at a time freshman weren't eligible, had 48, 42 and 51 in his first three sophomore games as a Tiger. It should be said he topped 20 plus in his first three games on the LSU freshman team.

THOMAS NUMBERS VERY CONSISTENT

Cam Thomas' numbers of 27 points against SIUE (1/26) and 25 against Saint Louis (1/28) ended up very similar when you look at the line scores for those two games:

SIUE – 10-of-21 FGs, 4-9 3FGs, 3-4 FT, 2 assists

SLU – 10-of-18 FGs, 4-10 3FGs, 1-1 FT, 2 assists

Thomas' line against Saint Louis also included a four-point play as he was fouled on a second half three-pointer and added the free throw.

Those two games earned him the SEC Freshman of the Week honor.

In the Southeastern game (11/30), Thomas had four field goals all treys and stepped inside the arc to make 9-of-10 free throws. He posted 16 points against Louisiana Tech.

In four games, he is averaging 22.3 points per game, 2.8 rebounds and 1.75 assists. Thomas is shooting 48.3 percent overall (29-of-60) and 40 percent (12-30) from the arc ... He is at 82.6 percent (19-23) from the line.

WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

Trendon Watford has scored well in the early going, averaging 18.8 points in the first four games with 6.3 rebounds and a team best 4.5 assists per game. Watford early on also has a 2.57 assist-to-turnover ratio of 18 assists and seven turnovers. 1He has made 21-of-34 from the field (61.8%) with three treys.

Dating back to the final two games of the 2019-20 season, Watford has been in double figures for six straight games.

WATFORD LOOKING GOOD AT THE LINE

It is well documented the improvement that Trendon Watford made at the free throw line in his freshman season.

In non-conference games last season (with all but one in November and December 2019), Watford was 33-of-58 at the line, 56.9 percent. After the Christmas holidays, Coach Wade and Trendon would go to the free throw line after every practice and shootaround and begin free throw drills with him having to make a certain amount or the drill would start over.

In the 18 conference games, Watford would make 56-of-74 or 75.7 percent. That gave him a season mark of 67.4 percent.

Watford, first of all has been getting fouled and to the line a good bit in the first four games, drawing 22 fouls. That has led to a strong 30-of-36 free throw effort (83.3%). Watford is first in the SEC and fourth in the NCAA in free throws made.

DARIUS DAYS ON THE BOARDS

The junior from Raleigh, Florida pulled down his 10th double figure rebound game against Saint Louis (11/28) with 11 and in four games is averaging a team best 8.0 a game.

Speaking of rebounds, the Tigers pulled down 50 boards for the third time in the Will Wade era at LSU with 53 against Southeastern on Monday. The others came against UNF in Nov. 2017 and Arkansas in January 2020.

TEAM SHOOTING

LSU has opened well from the field and more importantly from the line in the first four games:

SIUE – 30-58 FG (51.7%), 12 treys, 22-26 FT (84.6%)

at Saint Louis – 28-52 (53.8%), 9 treys, 16-21 FT (76.2%)

Southeastern – 30-60 (50.0%), 13 treys, 23-29 FT (79.3%)

LA Tech – 26-48 (54.2%), 8 treys, 26-34 FT (76.5%)

Through four games, LSU is 114-of-218 or 52.3 percent with 42 treys and 87-of-110 (79.1%) at the line. That's compared with opponents shooting 38.7 percent (92-of-238) with 33 treys and 47-of-75 at the line (62.7%). LSU has made 22 more field goals, nine more three-pointers and more interestingly 40 more free throws. LSU has made 12 more free throws than opponents have attempted in four games.

LSU'S OFFENSIVE POWER NUMBERS

Kenpom.com has LSU fifth in the list of top 10 offenses so far in the early part of the year. Gonzaga is tops followed by Iowa, Baylor, Villanova and LSU. The remaining top 10 are Creighton, Ohio State, Michigan, Arizona State and Illinois.

LSU returns three starters from a season ago and each started 30-of-the-31 games:

Sophomore Trendon Watford – 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds
Junior Javonte Smart – 12.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 4.2 assists
Junior Darius Days – 11.1 points and 6.8 rebounds

LSU returns 45.7 percent of its offensive production (45.1 points of an 80.5 season average); 20.7 rebounds of a 39.7 team rebound average (53.1%) and 57.0 percent of assists (227 of 398 total).

Offensively, LSU had one of the most efficient offenses in February and March at 1.13 points per possession. According to NCAA.com, only Gonzaga (1.19) and Creighton (1.15) had higher points per possession levels during February/March.

FATHERS AND SONS

UCLA transfer Shareef O'Neal brings an addition to the list of Fathers and Sons who have been a part of the LSU men's basketball program over the years.

O'Neal will wear 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice – 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

Shareef and father Shaquille O'Neal will become the latest in a line of father-son combinations that have played for the LSU Purple and Gold:

So far in four games, O'Neal has averaged 16 minutes a game, 3.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and just under one block a game. He has made two three-pointers which is two more than his dad made in his three years at LSU. He has been first sub in the game in three-of-the-four contests.

EARLY SEASON WATCH LISTS

Two Tigers were named to two of the watch lists as put out by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and for the Wooden Award – Javonte Smart and Trendon Watford.

Smart was named to the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award for point guards and Watford is on the watch list for the Karl Malone Award for forwards.

The two were also on the first team All-SEC coaches' preseason squad.

TIGERS PICKED THIRD IN MEDIA PRESEASON POLL

SERIES AGAINST SAM HOUSTON STATE

LSU has won all three previous meetings with Sam Houston State, including the last meeting in the first year of Coach Will Wade at LSU, 80-58 (12-19-17). The Tigers also won contests in December of 1999 and December of 2014.

Sam Houston State is 3-3 on the season after a 107-65 win over LeTourneau on Thursday. The Bearcats have scored over 100 points in each of the last three games including a 117-42 win over Dallas Christian and a 117-54 win over Howard Payne. Games against Arlington Baptist and at Houston have been canceled.

Through the first six games, Zach Nutall leads Sam Houston with a 22.5 points per game average with Demarkus Lampley averaging 11.2 points.

Jason Hooten is in his 11th year as the head coach of Sam Houston State with four CIT and one NIT post-season appearances during his first 10 years. His teams have won 20 games or more on five occasions.

JAVONTE SMART

Smart started 30-of-31 games a year ago and has played in 69-of-a-possible-70 games over his two plus years at LSU with 52 starts over that time ... Last year he averaged 12.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and had 129 assists.

He is on the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award and the Jersey Mike's Naismith Player of the Year list as well as the Wooden list. He was a second team selection on the media All-SEC team (two five-man teams) and is on the first team of the coaches' All-SEC selection (eight players).

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 26 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league. Smart has had no turnovers in three-of-the-last-four SEC games.

So far this season, he is averaging 13.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game. He rides a seven-game double figure scoring streak dating back to the final three games of last season.

Entering the weekend, Smart was fourth in the league among active players in career scoring:

ONE TREY FOR 100 FOR SMART

Javonte Smart enters the game Monday with 99 career three-point field goals and will be looking to become the 23rd LSU player with 100 career three-pointers. Darrel Mitchel, who played for the 2006 Final Four team, is the team's all-time leader in three-pointers at 258, while Tremont Waters (2017-19) is the last to cross the 100 threshold, finishing at 128.

DARIUS DAYS

Days also was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

Days averaged 11.1 points last year for the Tigers, hitting 48.6 percent of his field goal attempts (125-of-257) with 39 three-pointers.

Days also started 30-of-31 games and has played 67 games. After averaging 5.3 points as a freshman, Days more than doubled his scoring average and increased his rebound average from 4.0 to 6.8.

So far this season, he is third behind Thomas and Watford, averaging 14.0 points and team best eight boards. He has hit 8 treys and is shooting 20-of-34 from the field (58.8%)

MANNING RETURNS

After a season in which he broke the fifth metatarsal bone in both feet at various times in SEC play last year, the team's long senior, Charles Manning Jr., finally was able to make his season debut against Louisiana Tech (12/6).

Manning played 13.5 minutes in the Tech game, scoring 2 points with two rebounds in his opening game while playing on a minutes restriction after coming back to practice.

WILKINSON GETS FIRST START

Freshman Mwani Wilkinson from Las Vegas got his first start of his LSU career on Dec. 6 against Louisiana Tech. Although he didn't score in the game, he played 17 minutes and had one block and two steals. His best game was against Southeastern Louisiana (11/30), scoring 12 points on 5-of-8 field goal attempts.

For the year, Wilkinson is averaging 4.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game.

JALEN COOK

The Walker, Louisiana product missed the Southeastern game with a minor injury but came back against Louisiana Tech (12/6) and played 13 minutes, scoring 10 points with two assists. Cook in three games is averaging 5.0 points per game and 1.3 rebounds for the year.

NEW FACES FOR 2020-21

Of the 15 players on this year's LSU Basketball team, only six were actually on the roster last year -- Smart, Watford, Days, Edwards, Hyatt, Manning.

The Tiger coaching staff brought in the sixth ranked recruiting class with five-star Cameron Thomas, four stars Mwani Wilkinson and Eric Gaines and three stars Jalen Cook and Josh Gray.

LSU also has three transfers -- center Bryan Penn-Johnson from Washington, Shareef O'Neal from UCLA and Josh LeBlanc from Georgetown. Penn-Johnson and O'Neal have already received their waivers, while LeBlanc (who arrived at LSU between semesters last season) will be eligible at the end of the first semester.

HOW YOUNG AND NEW IS THIS TEAM?

The Tigers are a bit on the new and young side based on research by Tom Gilbert of Kansas State prior to the season. LSU's five returning letterman makes LSU one of 25 teams that will return five letter winners or less for the 20-21 season.

LSU's eight new players (three transfers, three signees) make it one of 37 teams to have at least eight players in their first year in Baton Rouge.

LSU is one of 23 basketball teams to have at least 10 underclassmen on the roster (freshmen, sophomores).

The Tigers are one of 17 teams to have four or less upperclassmen on the roster (junior, seniors).

Finally, LSU is one of just 12 teams to have one senior (Charles Manning Jr.) on the roster.

MONDAY'S GAME IS THE FIRST OF FOUR GAMES IN NINE DAYS

When the Tigers tip off against Sam Houston on Monday morning, it will be the start of four games before Christmas for LSU.

The Tigers will also host on UNO on Dec. 16 at 8 p.m.; against North Texas on Dec. 19 at a time TBD and VCU on Dec. 22 at 8 p.m.
