>>> SOUTH CAROLINA NOTES

• LSU had 542 yards of total offense and put up 31 points in the first half in a 52-24 win over South Carolina Oct. 24 in Baton Rouge.

• LSU leads the all-time series with the Gamecocks, 19-2-1. This was the first meeting between the two teams since the 2015.

• Coach Muschamp is 1-4 all-time against LSU in his coaching career.

• South Carolina's captains for the LSU game were Jaycee Horn, Sadarius Hutcherson, Adam Prentice and Keir Thomas

• Attendance at Tiger Stadium was 21,855.

• WR Jalen Brooks and RB Rashad Amos made their first appearance in a Carolina uniform in the LSU game.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA OFFENSE NOTES

• Collin Hill was 12-for-22 for 234 yards, a touchdown and an interception in the LSU game.

- Shi Smith moved into a tie for seventh place on Carolina's all-time receptions list. Smith now has 153 receptions, tying him with Jermale Kelly (1997-2000) after his two catches for 68 yards.
- Keveon Mullins led the Gamecocks with 126 receiving yards on two catches in the win. Both were career highs.

• Kevin Harris opened the scoring for the Gamecocks with a 45-yard touchdown run with 6:40 left in the first quarter. It was Harris' seventh rushing touchdown of the season. He added his eighth score with 11:17 left in the third quarter on a 1-yard scamper. Harris now has a rushing touchdown in all five Gamecock games this season.

• Harris had 126 yards on 12 carries in the LSU game. Harris now has three 100-yard plus game this season.

• Jalen Brooks had his first reception as a Gamecock, a 3-yard completion in the third quarter.

• Hill connected with Josh Vann for a five-yard touchdown reception. It is Vann's second career touchdown reception. He had one vs. Ole Miss in 2018.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA DEFENSE NOTES

• Ernest Jones had a career high 19 tackles in the loss. Jones' previous high was 13 on two occasions, including this season vs. Vanderbilt. Eight of Jones' 19 tackles were solos.

• The last Gamecock to have at least 18 tackles in a game was Aubrey Brooks vs. Arkansas in 1995.

• Israel Mukuamu intercepted TJ Finlay and returned the pick 56 yards in the second quarter. It was Mukuamu's second interception of the season and seventh in his career.

• Jammie Robinson was Carolina's second defender with double-digit tackles as he had 12 with four solos.

>>> SOUTH CAROLINA SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

• Parker White's 45-yard field goal in the second quarter tied a season high for yards. It also was his seventh field goal of the season and 52nd of his career.
