All LSU Soccer regular season matches are free admission. Capacity will be limited to 450 fans this season. Visiting Teams can submit a Pass List of 50 individuals. All seating is general admission. Guests are subject to stadium and athletic department polices. Gates will open to the public beginning an hour prior to the match beginning.

Handicap accessible seating is available. Please inform the Landmark Event Staff member in your area of any special needs at the time of your arrival.

LSU Game/Event Management reserves the right to hold sections of the bleacher seating. These areas will be marked prior to the start of the match.

SPORTS MEDICINE

Dear Visiting Women's Soccer Athletic Trainer:

On behalf of the Louisiana State University Athletic Training Department, I would like to welcome you and your student-athletes to Baton Rouge and LSU for our upcoming soccer match. This letter is to inform you of the sports medicine services that will be provided for you during your stay. If you require additional services, please feel free to contact me at any time.

The athletic training room that will be available to you while at LSU is located at the soccer complex. Supplies that are available in this athletic training room include a hydro-collator, electrical stimulation unit, ultrasound, ice and first aid supplies. Additional supplies and services will be available to you in the Martin J. Broussard Center for Athletic Training located in Tiger Stadium. Please notify me before your arrival if you will be requiring additional supplies or services, including rehabilitation equipment or various other modalities at the Center for Athletic Training.

The following services will be provided to you and your student-athletes during competition at LSU:

- A Certified Athletic Trainer will be present at all times
- A host Athletic Training Student
- Access to an athletic training room with various therapeutic modalities
- Water, PowerAde, cups, injury ice and ice bags
- Biohazard kits
- A team physician will be on-call

Emergency equipment including crutches, splints, spine board, AED, etc. will be on site.

If your team will not be traveling with a Certified Athletic Trainer, please send a signed letter with written instructions for each athlete, so that the proper accommodations can be made.

FACILITY INFORMATION

The LSU Soccer Complex is the site of all LSU Women's Soccer home events. This facility was opened on September 13, 1996. The lighted facility has a state of the art scoreboard, sound system and covered press box. The bleachers and the press box were remodeled prior to the 2011 season. The LSU Soccer Complex is located just a half mile from the Mississippi River and provides seating for 2,200 spectators.

Soccer Facility Diagram

Please note: A representative of LSU Game/Event Management will meet you upon arrival. This individual will be positioned near the large gate marked Team Entrance on the diagram.

Visiting Team Arrival Parking (See #1)

Team Bus/Vans—The visiting team bus and/or vans will be allowed to load and unload at the team entrance gate. Players and coaches will be directed through a field gate to their team bench area and/or locker room.

Game Parking (See #1)

Team Bus/Vans—After unloading, the visiting team bus and/or vans will be directed to park outside the gate of the parking lot.

Visiting Team Locker Room (See #2)

The visiting team locker room will be adjacent to the LSU locker room.

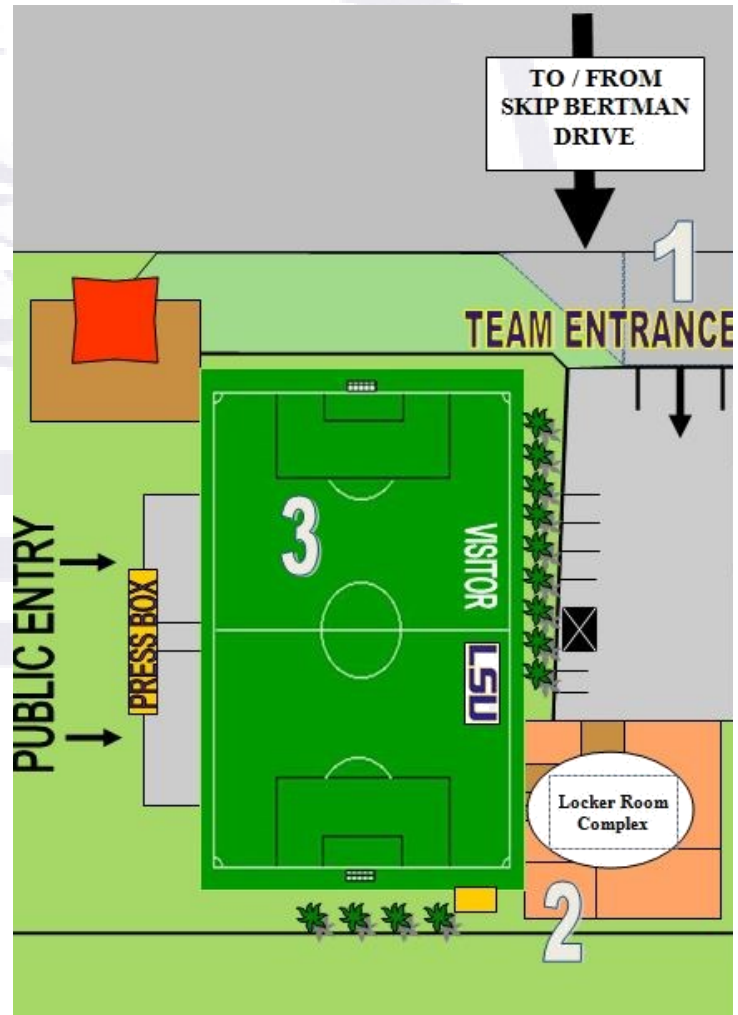
Training Room (located near locker room)

Bench Area

The team bench area is located on the east side of the field (opposite stadium seating). The visiting team will be allocated the space along the northern half of the sideline for their team bench area.

Pregame Warmup Area (See #3)

The visiting team will be allocated the north half of the playing surface for stretching and warming-up prior to competition.



FACILITY ACCOMODATIONS

Guest Parking—Located in Lot 406, the large lot north & west of the LSU Soccer Complex

Concessions—Hot food items, packaged items and cold drinks are available for purchase at the LSU Soccer Complex

Rest Rooms—Located throughout the complex

Locker Rooms & Shower Facilities—Available at the LSU Soccer Complex; Please indicate on the travel information form on page 18 of this guide if you need towels for your locker room; Be advised—only two shower stalls are available

Videotaping—Permitted from the TOP of the press box; Teams must provide their own video equipment and extension cords; Address any questions regarding videotaping to the Soccer office at 225-578-2539

Inclement Weather—LSU follows SEC protocol for all severe weather situations; LSU Game/Event Management will communicate with officials and teams regarding any weather concerns

PRACTICE

If you would like to request a practice time other than the 60 minute warmup period allotted before the game, please contact Seb Furness the week prior to the scheduled game to confirm practice times. Practice times/location on weekends that coincide with LSU Football home games will have certain restrictions. Any practice prior to the allotted game warmup will be held at the LSU Soccer practice field, located perpendicular to the Soccer Stadium.

On gameday, the field will be available for warmup 60 minutes before kick-off.

UNIFORMS

Please contact Seb Furness prior to your arrival in Baton Rouge to communicate what colors your team will be wearing. Seb will be able to provide LSU's uniform colors to help avoid any potential conflicts.

Coming from the East on Interstate 10:

- Take I-10 to College Dr. (Exit 158).
- Take a left onto College Dr. and proceed straight ahead.
- Proceed straight through intersection with Perkins Rd. (notice College Dr. becomes Lee Dr.)
- Proceed straight through intersections with Highland Rd., and Burbank Dr.
- Continue straight on Lee Dr. until reaching Nicholson Dr. (LA Hwy. 30). Turn right at intersection with Nicholson Dr.
- Proceed straight on Nicholson Dr. until reaching Skip Bertman Dr. Turn left onto Skip Bertman Dr.
- Proceed 0.2 miles past the railroad tracks and the Charles McClendon Football Practice Facility. Turn left into the gravel lot at the LSU Soccer Complex. Please see page 9 of this manual for team bus parking.

Coming from the West on Interstate 10:

- Take I-10 to Nicholson Dr./Highland Rd. (Exit 155A).
- Keep right and turn onto Terrace Street.
- Turn left onto Nicholson Dr. and proceed forward until reaching Skip Bertman Dr.
- Turn right onto Skip Bertman Dr.
- Proceed 0.2 miles past the railroad tracks and the Charles McClendon Football Practice Facility. Turn left into the gravel lot at the LSU Soccer Complex. Please see page 9 of this manual for team bus parking.

LSU Soccer Complex to Interstate 10 East:

- From Skip Bertman Dr. take a right onto Nicholson Dr.
- Proceed on Nicholson until reaching Lee Dr.
- Turn left onto Lee Dr.
- Proceed on Lee Dr. (notice Lee Dr. becomes College Dr.)
- Proceed on College Dr. until reaching Interstate 10.
- Turn right to merge onto Interstate 10 towards New Orleans or Interstate 12 towards Hammond.

LSU Soccer Complex to Interstate 10 West:

- From Skip Bertman Dr. take a left onto Nicholson Dr.
- Proceed on Nicholson Dr. until reaching Interstate 10
- Turn right to merge onto Interstate 10 West toward Lafayette / Port Allen

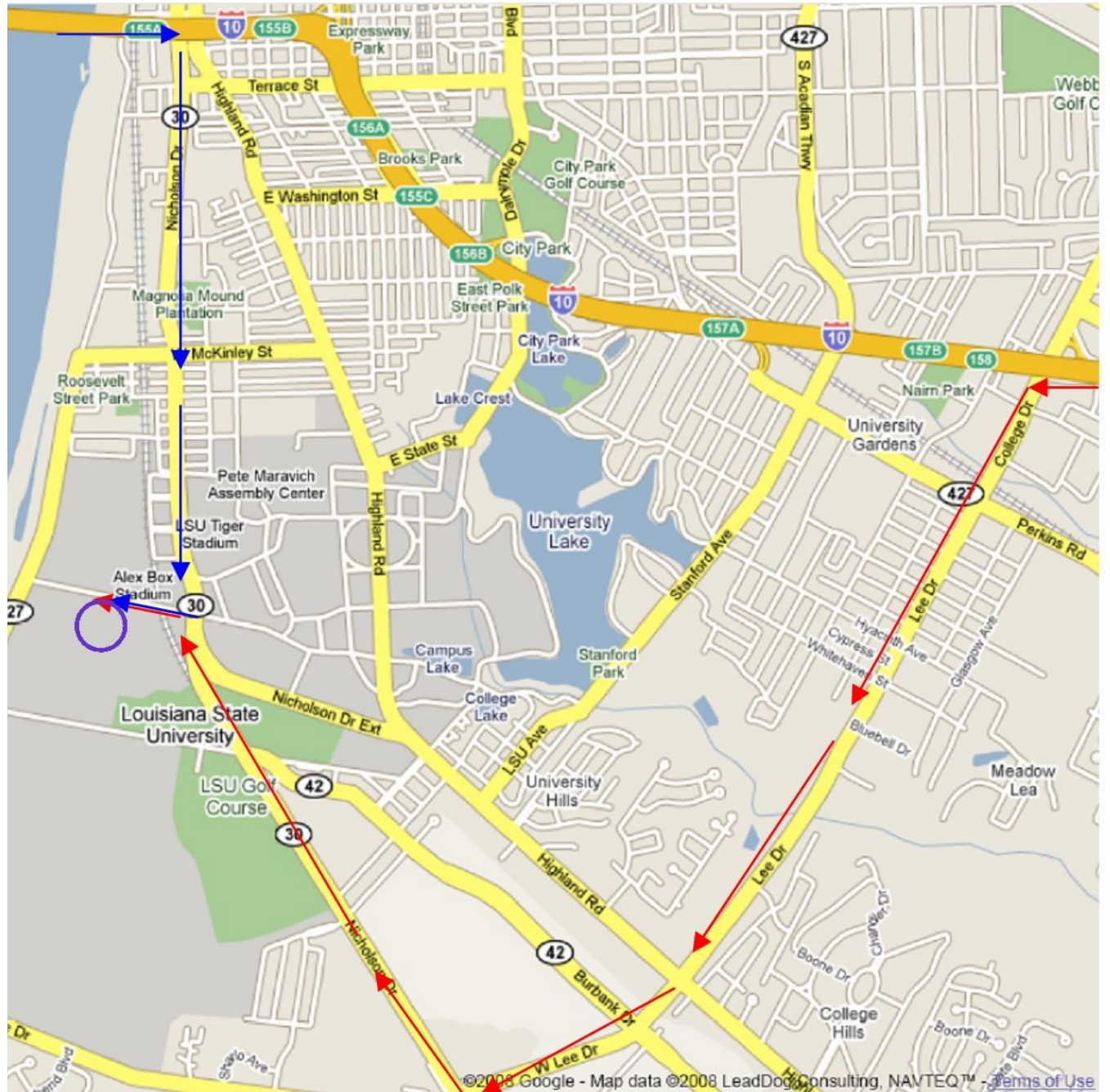
LSU Soccer Complex to the Baton Rouge Metropolitan Airport:

- From Skip Bertman Dr. take a left onto Nicholson Dr.
- Proceed on Nicholson Dr. until reaching Government St. Take a right onto Government St.
- Proceed on Government St. until reaching I-110. Turn left onto I-110 towards N. Baton Rouge
- Take I-110 to Exit 6 for LA 408W toward Metro Airport / Southern University.
- Turn right at Veterans Memorial Blvd.
- Turn right at Captain Ryan Dr. (signs for Rental Car Return / Terminal Bldg. / Terminal Parking).

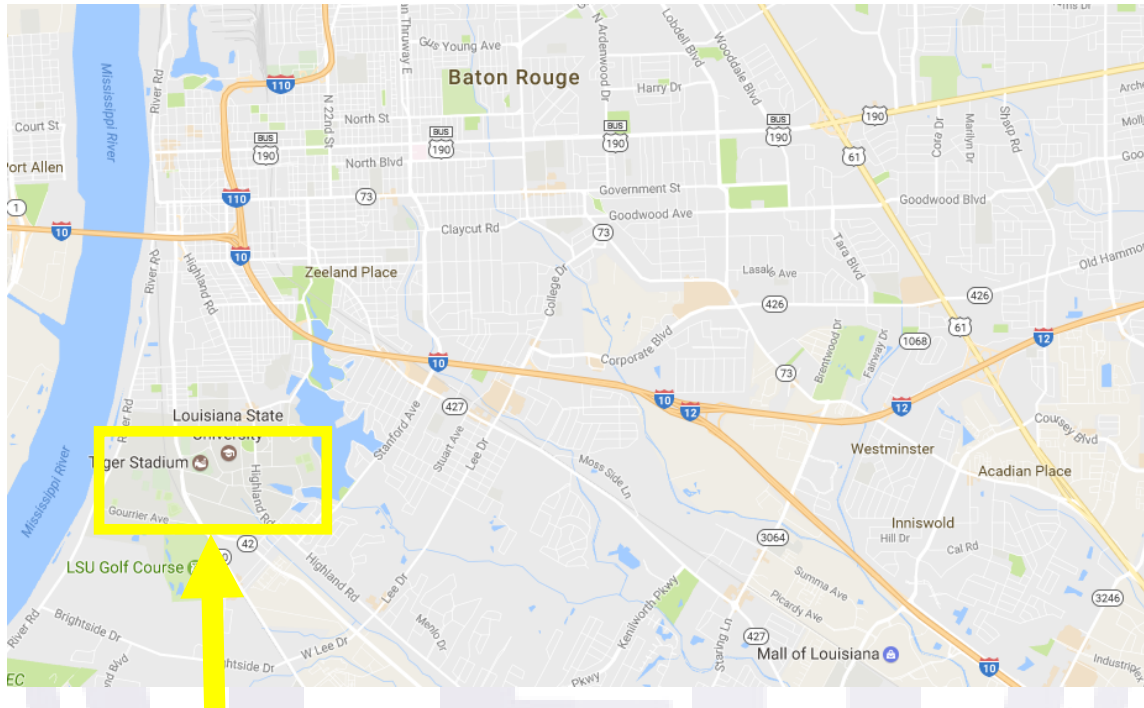

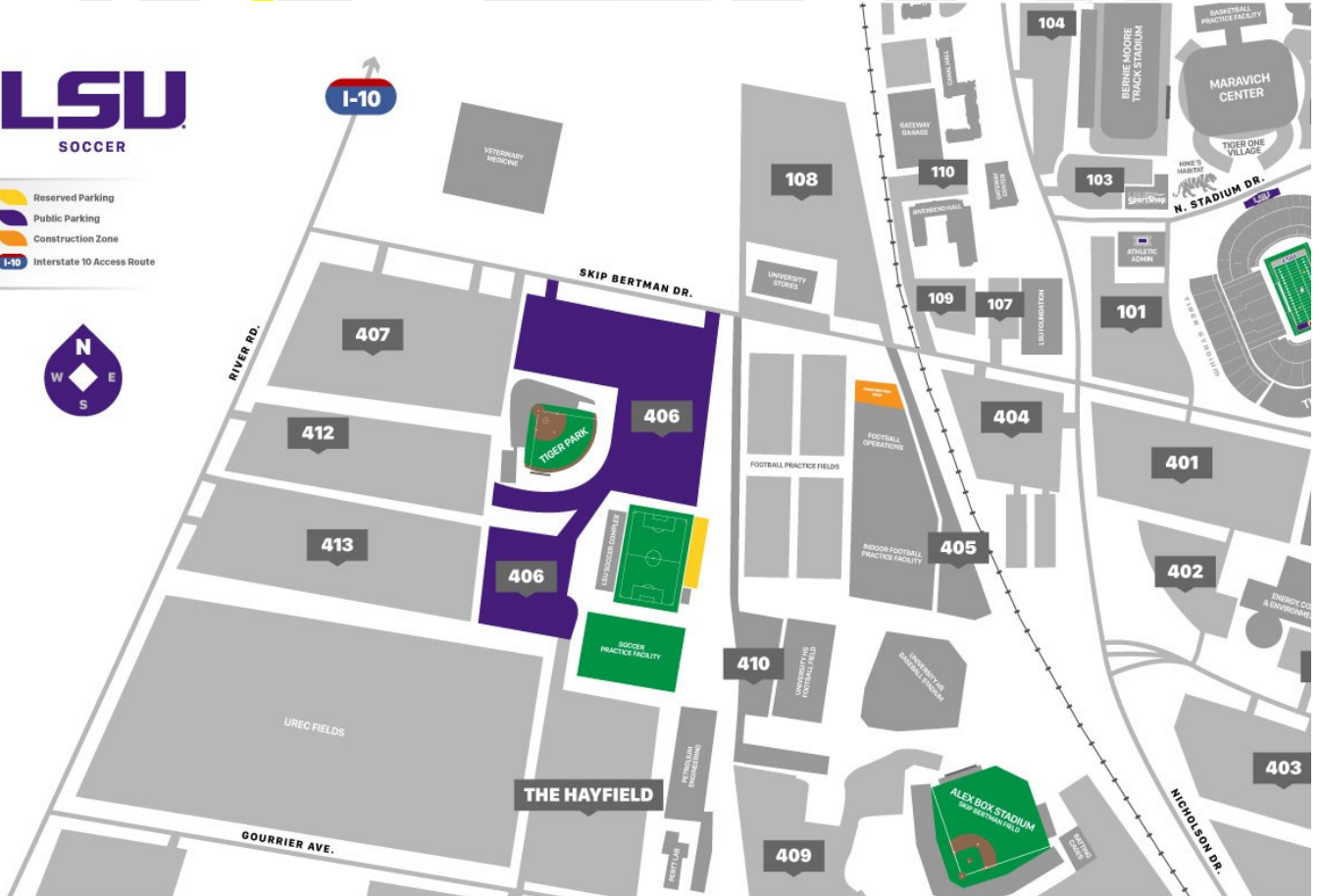


BATON ROUGE AREA & CAMPUS MAPS
