MEDIA SESSIONS

Coach Wade meets, when travel schedules permit, usually one or two days prior to games in non-conference play and usually on Mondays and Thursdays during the SEC season. The sessions take place in the practice facility meeting room. Times are announced based on practice plans with players usually one day a week. Some travel and scheduling issues may change the time and day so media should contact the Communications Office to confirm start time ... Player requests need to be in to Kent Lowe at clowe@lsu.edu no later than 24 hours in advance.

POST GAME

During the current season, post-game video sessions will be done remotely on zoom links that will be distributed to the media during the course of the game. There will be separate video zooms for each team and both will be conducted after the game when coaches and players are available the 10-minute cooling off period.

Both home and away, Coach Wade will conduct his radio post-game show before beginning his zoom session with media on hand for the game and admitted remotely.

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

PRIOR TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

LAST GAMES: THE SEASON TO DATE

GAME 1 -- LSU 94, SIUE 81 (11/26/20)

The Tigers got off to a 26-4 start on SIU Edwardsville and despite a streak when the Cougars got hot from the three-point arc, LSU went on to win their opening contest in the Billiken Classic at Chaifetz Arena on the Saint Louis University Campus.

It was LSU's first game of the 2020-21 season and the first game the Tigers played since the regular season finale back in early March when LSU defeated Georgia. Ironically, LSU also scored 94 points in that game as well.

Freshman Cam Thomas led the Tigers with 27 points with 10 field goals and four treys, while junior Darius Days had a career high of 24 points (9-11 FG, 4 treys). Trendon Watford had 13 points, seven rebounds and nine assists while Javonte Smart had 10 points and five assists.

Both teams shot over 50 percent with LSU hitting 30-of-58 (51.7 percent) with 12 treys (46.2%) and a very good 22-of-26 at the free throw line. SIUE made 29-of-57 overall with 13 treys. LSU out rebounded SIUE, 32-30, and the Tigers committed just nine turnovers. LSU was able to record a +11 difference in points off turnovers.

GAME 2 -- SAINT LOUIS 85, LSU 81 (11/28/20)

The host Billikens used a 13-2 run in the final 10 minutes of the first half to get a 38-28 halftime advantage and the tried to match LSU with make-after-make in the second half. Both teams shot 61 percent plus in the second half, LSU 19-31 with five treys while Saint Louis was 16-26 with 8 treys.

The Tigers cut the game to three with under five minutes to play and had a three-pointer in the air to tie. LSU got as close as one in the final minute but could not get closer.

Cam Thomas for the second straight game hit 10 field goals and four treys in a 25-points night, while Trendon Watford just missed his career high with 24 points. Javonte Smart had 18 points as the trip combined for 67 of LSU's 81 points going 24-of-38 from the field with nine treys.

GAME 3 – LSU 96, SOUTHEASTERN 43 (11/30/20)

The third game in a five-day period put LSU in front of fans for the first time and friendly fans of 2,008 at the Maravich Center. The Tigers dominated the first half, 50-18, and Coach Wade wanted to see a matching effort in the second half as he used many different combinations as all 12 players played and nine scored.

Cam Thomas led LSU with 21 points but Trendon Watford joined him again at 20 or more with 20 points. Darius Days had 11 and Javonte Smart 10. Mwani Wilkinson played just under 14 minutes but had 12 points and more importantly a Coach Wade-approved five offensive rebounds.

LSU shot 50 percent for the game (30-60) with 13 treys and 23-of-29 (73.3%) at the line. Smart and Eric Gaines were a +46 in the game and Watford a +41.

ONE OF 13 PLAYERS

Cam Thomas became the 13th player at LSU since the 1976-77 season to score at least 21 points in his first varsity game when he scored 27 in the contest. The freshman hit 10-of-21 shots, including 4-of-9 from the arc. Freshman Tremont Waters scored 27 in his debut on Nov. 10, 2017 against Alcorn State and junior college transfer Marcus Thornton hit for 27 against Southeastern on Nov. 12, 2007.

Others who had 21 or more in their first LSU game are: Lester Earl, Duop Reath, Antonio Blakeney, Randy Livingston, Jose Vargas, Ralston Turner, Andre Stringer, Ronald Dupree, Ronnie Henderson and John Williams.

For the record, in his first game in 1967, Pete Maravich scored 49 points.

THREE STRAIGHT 20 POINT GAMES TO START AN LSU CAREER

Cam Thomas became the first LSU player to have three 20 or more in his first three varsity LSU games since JC transfer Marcus Thornton did in Nov. 2007 – games of 27, 24 and 20.

As freshman go in recent times – Tremont Waters as a freshman had 20-plus in his first and third games in 2017-18; In 2015-16, Ben Simmons, who went on to be national freshman of the year, had 20-plus in his second and third games; and, high school All-America Randy Livingston, returned after knee surgery for his redshirt freshman season and had 20-plus in his 1st and 3rd games in 1994-95.

In another example, Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf opened his two-time All-American campaign at LSU with 13, 25 and 48. Pete Maravich, who played at a time freshman weren't eligible, had 48, 42 and 51 in his first three sophomore games as a Tiger. It should be said he topped 20 plus in his first three games on the LSU freshman team.

The last player at anytime for LSU to have three straight 20-point games was last year by senior Skylar Mays. The last LSU player have more than three straight 20 points games was Antonio Blakeney, who had six straight against SEC competition in Feb. 2017 -- 31 at Kentucky (2/7/17), 21 vs. Arkansas (2/11/17); 29 at Ole Miss (2/14/17); 28 at Alabama (2/18/17), 29 vs. Auburn; (2/21/17); 20 at UGA (2/25/17).

THOMAS NUMBERS VERY CONSISTENT

Cam Thomas' numbers of 27 points against SIUE and 25 against Saint Louis end up very similar when you look at the line scores for those two games:

SIUE – 10-of-21 FGs, 4-9 3FGs, 3-4 FT, 2 assists

SLU – 10-of-18 FGs, 4-10 3FGs, 1-1 FT, 2 assists

Thomas' line against Saint Louis also included a four-point play as he was fouled on a second half three-pointer and added the free throw.

Those two games earned him the SEC Freshman of the Week honor.

In the Southeastern game this past Monday, Thomas had four field goals all treys and stepped inside the arc to make 9-of-10 free throws.

In three games, he is averaging 24.3 points, 2.3 rebounds, 2.0 assists and shooting 49 percent overall, 44.4 percent outside the arc and 86.7 percent at the stripe.

WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

Trendon Watford has scored well in the early going, averaging 19.0 points in the first three games with 5.7 rebounds and 6.0 assists. He has made 17-of-27 from the field (63.0%) with three treys.

But more importantly, Watford is dishing the ball to his teammates for scores to the tune of 6.0 a game. Watford had nine in the opener against SIUE and then six more against Saint Louis.

WATFORD LOOKING GOOD AT THE LINE

It is well documented the improvement that Trendon Watford made at the free throw line in his freshman season.

In non-conference games last season (with all but one in November and December 2019), Watford was 33-of-58 at the line, 56.9 percent. After the Christmas holidays, Coach Wade and Trendon would go to the free throw line after every practice and shootaround and begin free throw drills with him having to make a certain amount or the drill would start over.

In the 18 conference games, Watford would make 56-of-74 or 75.7 percent. That gave him a season mark of 67.4 percent.

So far in three games, Watford has drawn 16 fouls and has gone to the line for 24 attempts, making 20 or 83.3 percent. Those free points add up as the season goes on.

DARIUS DAYS ON THE BOARDS

The junior from Raleigh, Florida pulled down his 10th double figure rebound game on Saturday against Saint Louis with 11 and in three games is averaging 8.0 a game.

Speaking of rebounds, the Tigers pulled down 50 boards for the third time in the Will Wade era at LSU with 53 against Southeastern on Monday. The others came against UNF in Nov. 2017 and Arkansas in January 2020.

SOME OF THE NUMBERS

LSU returns three starters from a season ago and each started 30-of-the-31 games:

- Sophomore Trendon Watford – 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds**
- Junior Javonte Smart – 12.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 4.2 assists**
- Junior Darius Days – 11.1 points and 6.8 rebounds**

LSU returns 45.7 percent of its offensive production (45.1 points of an 80.5 season average); 20.7 rebounds of a 39.7 team rebound average (53.1%) and 57.0 percent of assists (227 of 398 total).

Offensively, LSU had one of the most efficient offenses in February and March at 1.13 points per possession. According to NCAA.com, only Gonzaga (1.19) and Creighton (1.15) had higher points per possession levels during February/March.

O'Neal will wear 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice -- 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

Shareef and father Shaquille O'Neal will become the latest in a line of father-son combinations that have played for the LSU Purple and Gold:

So far in three games, O'Neal is averaging 14.8 minutes off the bench and has made 3-of-6 field goals, including 2-of-4 from the arc (two more than his dad made in his three years at LSU). Shareef is averaging 2.7 points and 5.7 rebounds.

EARLY SEASON WATCH LISTS

Two Tigers were named to two of the watch lists as put out by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and for the Wooden Award -- Javonte Smart and Trendon Watford.

Smart was named to the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award for point guards and Watford is on the watch list for the Karl Malone Award for forwards.

The two were also on the first team All-SEC coaches' preseason squad.

SERIES AGAINST LOUISIANA TECH

This game was originally set for Nov. 24 at the CenturyLink Center in Bossier City, Louisiana, but promoter Russ Potts in consultation with the schools has elected to put off that game until the early part of the 2020-21 season.

So, the teams came to a new agreement to play in Baton Rouge on this Sunday afternoon. This will be the 13th official meeting between the two schools with LSU leading 11-1. The teams last met officially on Nov. 16, 2018 with LSU winning at the Maravich Center, 74-67.

The teams met in a charity exhibition game in Ruston at the Thomas Assembly Center prior to the 2019-20 season to help tornado victims in the Ruston area and on the Tech campus, with LSU winning 83-70.

Seven-of-the-last-eight years, the Bulldogs have won at least 20 games and five of those years they won at least 23 games.

The Bulldogs ran their record to 3-0 with a 78-62 win over ULM Thursday night in Ruston. The Bulldogs used a 45-31 first half lead to comfortably get the win. LA Tech led by as much as 23 in the final eight minutes of the game. Kalob Ledoux had 15 to lead the Bulldogs while Cobe Williams added 14. Jacoby Pemberton 12 points and 11 rebounds. Kenneth Lofton, Jr., also had a double with 10 points and 10 rebounds. LA Tech shot 48.3 percent from the field (29-60) with 9 treys and 11-19 at the free throw line.

Eric Konkol is in his sixth year as the Louisiana Tech coach after serving as assistant at George Mason and Miami with a year as a GA at Tennessee in 2001-02.

JAVONTE SMART

Smart started 30-of-31 games a year ago and has played in 68-of-a-possible-69 games over his two plus years at LSU with 51 starts over that time ... Last year he averaged 12.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and had 129 assists.

He is on the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award and the Jersey Mike's Naismith Player of the Year list as well as the Wooden list. He was a second team selection on the media All-SEC team (two five-man teams) and is on the first team of the coaches' All-SEC selection (eight players).

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 26 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league. Smart has had no turnovers in three-of-the-last-four SEC games.

So far this season, he is averaging 12.7 points 3.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

DARIUS DAYS

Days also was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

Days averaged 11.1 points last year for the Tigers, hitting 48.6 percent of his field goal attempts (125-of-257) with 39 three-pointers.

Days also started 30-of-31 games and has played 66 games. After averaging 5.3 points as a freshman, Days more than doubled his scoring average and increased his rebound average from 4.0 to 6.8.

So far this season, he is third behind Thomas and Watford, averaging 14.7 points and team best eight boards.

NOT SURE WHAT IT IS ABOUT MISSOURI

Last year, Darius Days had his career highs of 20 against Missouri State and Mizzou. In the opener, played in the state of Missouri, the junior upped his career high to 24 points which included an 11-point flurry that included back-to-back-to-back three-pointers and a tip-in. Days hit 9-of-11 for the game from the field and 4-of-5 from the arc to go with two free throws.

NEW FACES FOR 2020-21

Of the 15 players on this year's LSU Basketball team, only six were actually on the roster last year – Smart, Watford, Days, Edwards, Hyatt, Manning.

The Tiger coaching staff brought in the sixth ranked recruiting class with five-star Cameron Thomas, four stars Mwani Wilkinson and Eric Gaines and three stars Jalen Cook and Josh Gray.

LSU also has three transfers – center Bryan Penn-Johnson from Washington, Shareef O'Neal from UCLA and Josh LeBlanc from Georgetown. Penn-Johnson and O'Neal have already received their waivers, while LeBlanc (who arrived at LSU between semesters last season) will be eligible at the end of the first semester.

HOW YOUNG AND NEW IS THIS TEAM?

The Tigers are a bit on the new and young side based on research by Tom Gilbert of Kansas State prior to the season. LSU's five returning letterman makes LSU one of 25 teams that will return five letter winners or less for the 20-21 season.

LSU's eight new players (three transfers, three signees) make it one of 37 teams to have at least eight players in their first year in Baton Rouge.

LSU is one of 23 basketball teams to have at least 10 underclassmen on the roster (freshmen, sophomores).

The Tigers are one of 17 teams to have four or less upperclassmen on the roster (junior, seniors).

Finally, LSU is one of just 12 teams to have one senior (Charles Manning Jr.) on the roster.

EXAM WEEK AND THEN TO ATLANTA FOR HOLIDAY HOOPSGIVING

While the semester is being finished virtually, this would be the exam week for Students so some of that will be taking place and LSU will return to action on Saturday, Dec. 12, at 1:30 p.m. CT as part of the Holiday Hoopsgiving quadruple header at State Farm Arena in Atlanta. LSU will meet South Florida in the second game of the day.

After that, LSU will have three games prior to Christmas at the Maravich Center – Nov. 16 against UNO (8 p.m., SECN), Dec. 19 vs. North Texas (TBA, SECN+) and Dec. 22 VCU (8 p.m., SECN).
