SEC TELECONFERENCE

The 14 SEC coaches are featured on a teleconference three times beginning in January. Coach Wade is on at 10:28 a.m. CT. The teleconferences are still to be determined. To access the media only number contact SEC Media Relations Office (205-458-3010).

MEDIA SESSIONS

Coach Wade meets, when travel schedules permit, usually one or two days prior to games in non-conference play and usually on Mondays and Thursdays during the SEC season. The sessions take place in the practice facility meeting room. Times are announced based on practice plans with players usually one day a week. Some travel and scheduling issues may change the time and day so media should contact the Communications Office to confirm start time ... Player requests need to be in to Kent Lowe at clowe@lsu.edu no later than 24 hours in advance.

POST GAME

During the current season, post-game video sessions will be done remotely on zoom links that will be distributed to the media during the course of the game. There will be separate video zooms for each team and both will be conducted after the game when coaches and players are available the 10-minute cooling off period. Both home and away, Coach Wade will conduct his radio post-game show before beginning his zoom session with media on hand for the game and admitted remotely.

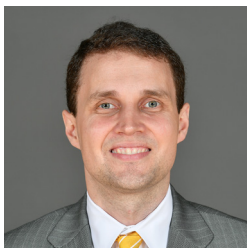

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

PROTIO TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

LAST GAME: LSU 75, OLE MISS 61 (Oxford, Mississippi)

In a pivot of game scheduling by the SEC that was officially announced at 1 p.m. on Friday, the LSU Tigers quickly learned about a new opponent, took an early evening flight to a new location, and promptly played an SEC winning game in Oxford against the Rebels of Ole Miss.

LSU's defense responded to the challenge and its offense responded early to take Ole Miss completely off its game and force three called time outs in the first half. All this despite freshman star Cam Thomas missing the majority of the game after coming down awkwardly on his first three-point attempt of the game.

LSU held the Rebels to 6-of-23 from the floor in the first half including 1-of-10 from the arc. The Tigers on the other hand were 15-of-30 with six treys en route to a 39-21 halftime advantage.

LSU forced 20 Ole Miss turnovers in the game, getting 29 points off the turnovers. LSU would finish at 48.2 percent overall from the field (27-of-56) with eight treys.

Trendon Watford had 21 points, six boards and three assists to lead LSU, with Javonte Smart having 17 points and six assists along with Darius Days getting 15 points and seven boards. Freshman Eric Gaines, who played 28 minutes primarily in place of Cam Thomas, had 10 points on 3-of-7 shooting, including two treys, two assists and four steals.

Mwani Wilkinson was +14 in the game and Days was +22. The lineup of Wilkinson, Smart, Watford, Days and Gaines

played 9:34 together during the game and outscored Ole Miss 27-15 with a 1.4151 points per possession with six steals and five assists.

That same rotation was on court from the 18:20 mark of the first half to the 14:39 mark, outscoring Ole Miss, 12-0, with a 1.7143 points per possession.

SO HOW WE FINALLY GOT TO SEC PLAY

With the SEC schedule now underway, a refresher course on how the schedule looked at the start and all the changes that got us to where we are now:

1 -- LSU was scheduled to play San Fran, Western Kentucky and Saint Louis in Lincoln, Nebraska in the Golden Window Classic, Nov. 25, 26 and 28.

2 -- Saint Louis elected to stay in Saint Louis and invited LSU to join them for the Billiken Classic where LSU played SIUE and Saint Louis, Nov. 26 and 28.

3 -- To replace the third game that would have been played in Nebraska, LSU scheduled Southeastern for a game played, Nov. 30.

4 -- LSU plays a scheduled game on Dec. 6 in Baton Rouge against Louisiana Tech. The two teams were originally supposed to meet in Bossier City, Nov. 24, but the promoter and the teams elected to move the game in Bossier City to December of 2021. Tech and LSU signed a new contract for this game.

5 -- LSU pulls out of a game with South Florida in Atlanta at Holiday Hoopsgiving Dec. 12 because of SEC and NCAA Covid protocols involving the LSU team.

6 -- LSU quickly schedules Sam Houston State for an 11 a.m. game on Dec. 14. Associate Head Coach Bill Armstrong coaches the game solo as Coach Will Wade announced earlier in the day he had tested positive for Covid-19.

7 -- LSU announces postponements against UNO (Dec. 16), North Texas (Dec. 19) and VCU (Dec. 22) because of SEC and NCAA protocols regarding Covid.

8 -- LSU on Dec. 21 schedules Texas Southern for a Dec. 26, 4 p.m. game.

9 -- On Dec. 24, Texas Southern has to withdraw because of NCAA Covid-19 protocols. That evening, Nicholls signs a contract to come to Baton Rouge for a 1 p.m. game on Dec. 26.

10 -- LSU opens SEC play as scheduled on Dec. 29 playing Texas A&M.

1 -- LSU is scheduled to play Missouri, Jan. 9; Conference announces at 1 p.m. on Jan. 8 that the LSU game at Missouri postponed; LSU travels to Oxford for a Jan. 9 game at Ole Miss instead of as scheduled on Feb. 17.

16 GAMES OF 20 OR MORE POINTS FOR TIGERS

Through 10 games, LSU has had players record 16 games of 20 points or more this season -- 7 by Cam Thomas, 5 by Trendon Watford, 3 by Javonte Smart and one by Darius Days.

Thomas -- 27 vs. SIUE, 25 at Saint Louis, 21 vs. Southeastern, 29 vs Nicholls, 32 vs. A&M, 28 at UF, 26 vs. UGA

Smart -- 25 vs. Sam Houston State, 20 at UF, 21 vs. UGA

Last year, in 31 LSU games there were 22 games of 20 points or more by the Tigers.

AN 86-POINT OPENING SEC RUN

Already scoring well, Cam Thomas has stepped it up even a little bit more with 86 points in the first three SEC games to average 28.7 points after scoring 32 points against Texas A&M, 28 points at Florida and 26 versus Georgia.

Prior to that Thomas had 29 versus Nicholls which made him the first LSU player to have four consecutive games over 20 since Antonio Blakeney had six consecutive 20-point games in the month of February 2017.

INJURY KNOCKS AVERAGE DOWN

Playing just 3:54 at Ole Miss and going down with a right ankle injury on his first shot of the game, put a hit on Thomas' scoring average understandably. His averaged dropped 2.5 points but anyone in the Southeastern Conference would still be happy to have a 22.3 scoring average after 10 games.

Thomas still remains the leading scorer in the SEC by 0.7 points over Scotty Pippen Jr., of Vanderbilt, the only other player averaging 20 or more in league play.

THOMAS FOUR GAMES 10 OR MORE FIELD GOALS

Ten or more field goals for Thomas has led to big nights for the freshman:

SIUE -- 10-of-21 FGs, 4-9 3FGs, 3-4 FT, 2 assists (27 points)

SAINT LOUIS -- 10-of-18 FGs, 4-10 3FGs, 1-1 FT, 2 assists (25 points)

NICHOLLS -- 10-of-21 FGs, 2-8 3FGs, 7-7 FT, 2 assists (29 points)

TEXAS A&M -- 12-of-21 FGs, 5-11 3FGs, 3-3 FT, 1 assist (32 points)

At 22.3 points per game, Thomas is 10th in the NCAA in scoring but seventh among players who have played at least five games.

The games against SIUE and Saint Louis to open the season earned him the SEC Freshman of the Week honor and the Nicholls game earned him on Dec. 28 his second SEC Freshman of the Week honor.

Besides the scoring, Thomas is averaging 2.6 rebounds and 1.4 assists. He is shooting 43.6 percent overall and made 25 three pointers.

LET'S TALK FREE THROWS, MANY IN SUCCESSION

After missing his first free throw against Sam Houston State on Dec. 14, Cam Thomas made his last seven of that game. That started what would be a record-breaking streak of 42 consecutive made free tosses:

Sam Houston State (Dec. 14) -- last 7

Nicholls (Dec. 26) -- 7

Texas A&M (Dec. 29) -- 3

At Florida (Jan. 2) -- 11

Georgia (Jan. 6) -- first 14 (before a miss in the first of a two-shot to finish 15-16 for the game)

It was at the 7:04 mark of the second half against UGA when Thomas made free throws No. 35 and No. 36 that he broke the LSU record for consecutive free throws made set originally by Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf during the 1989-90 season of 35.

FIVE TIMES THREE

Cam Thomas hit five treys in the win over A&M in the league opener. The last player to hit five treys for LSU was Javonte Smart which happened to be in the opening win last season at Tennessee. Smart has again now become the latest to hit five treys in the win over Georgia (1/6).

MORE NUMBERS

Thomas's 26-point game versus Georgia was his seventh game of 20 points or more this season and as of Jan. 8, that was the most by any freshman in Division I:

The 32 points remains the most points in a game by a D1 freshman this season.

Thomas scored at least 15 points or more in his first seven career games. It is the longest career-opening streak of 15-point games by an SEC player over the last 25 seasons, according to ESPN Stats & Info.

ESPN Stats & Info also reports that Thomas' four consecutive 25-point games makes him the only SEC freshman with a four-game 25-point streak in the last 25 seasons and also the only to surpass 200 points in nine career games during that span as well.

For the record, outside the 25-season range, LSU freshman Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf (Chris Jackson) scored 210 points in his first seven games (although that included a 48 and 53-point efforts) and 253 in his first nine games.

TIGERS SHOOTING WELL

The Tigers lead the league at this point in the season in shooting percentage at 49.1 percent (291-of-593). Opponents are shooting 41.1 percent (248-of-603), with LSU ranks seventh in field goal percentage defense.

LSU has shot better than 50 percent in five games. The 50 percent shooting percentages this season:

SIUE – 30-of-58 (51.7%)
Saint Louis – 28-of-52 (53.8%)
Southeastern – 30-of-60 (50.0%)

LSU is 95-9 since the start of the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or more in a game. So far this season, LSU has made 43 more field goals than opponents on 10 less attempts.

LOTS OF REBOUNDS, BUT STOPPING OPPONENTS OFFENSIVE REBOUNDS KEY

The Tigers were able to pull down 53 rebounds against Southeastern and 46 against Louisiana Tech earlier this season but the numbers for the opponents on the offensive side have caused some consternation for the LSU coach staff.

Southeastern pulled down 14 offensive rebounds to 13 for the Tigers, but in the LA Tech game, the difference was more pronounced with a 14-4 advantage for the Bulldogs that led to a 13-5 second chance points advantage.

The inability to clear the boards again caused problems for LSU against Nicholls as the Tigers were not only rebounded by the Colonels, but Nicholls had a 17-10 advantage on the offensive boards. That resulted in an 18-12 advantage for Nicholls in second chance points.

LSU turned that around in the conference opener against A&M, with a 40-31 margin overall on the boards and 15-11 on the offensive boards. That was part of a 21-8 advantage for LSU in second chance points.

Florida had a four-board advantage but LSU had a 14-13 advantage in offensive boards. Florida, however, was an 18-14 leader in second chance points. Against Georgia, the Bulldogs out rebounded LSU, 43-40, but LSU had a 21-13 advantage in second chance points

THREE STRAIGHT 20 POINT GAMES TO START AN LSU CAREER

Cam Thomas became the first LSU player to have three games of 20 or more in his first three varsity LSU games since JC transfer Marcus Thornton did in Nov. 2007 – games of 27, 24 and 20.

Thomas' 32-point opening league game is the most by an LSU freshman since the opening game of conference play for LSU in the 2015-16 season when on Jan. 2, 2016, Ben Simmons opened his national freshman of the year campaign with 36 points at Vanderbilt in a Tiger win.

LSU's last 30-point game by any player was in the regular season finale last year when senior Marlon Taylor had 30 points against Georgia. The last LSU player to score more points than Thomas in a game was former point guard Tremont Waters, who scored 39 also against A&M in January 2019.

COACH WADE PASSES 100

Coach Wade reached 100 games as the LSU head coach in the Nicholls game on Dec. 24. Here's where he ranked in wins among LSU coaches in their first 100 games as the head coach (years in parenthesis represent length to get to 100

WILL WADE IN CONFERENCE GAMES

Coach Will Wade in his eighth season as a head coach has had good success in conference games in all three of his head coaching stops, winning double figure games every year except his first year at LSU.

Wade won 27 league games in two years at Chattanooga, 28 in two years at VCU and now 38 SEC games in his fourth year at LSU. Wade is presently 93-34 in league games including 38-19 at LSU. Wade was 8-10 his first season in the league, 15-2 in a conference championship team in 2019 (He did not coach the final game of the 2019 season.) and, 12-6 and tying for second in 2020 to go with 3-1 this season.

WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

Despite missing a game against Sam Houston State in December, Trendon Watford has done well in the sophomore season continuing the good numbers he set as a freshman.

Watford, from Birmingham, averaged 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds as a freshman and for the season is averaging 17.8 points and 6.7 rebounds to go with 4.0 assists. He is certainly one of the small list of players in the SEC to average over 15 points, five rebounds and four assists this season.

After struggling to score against A&M, Watford has scored 59 points in the next three SEC games – 21 at Florida, 17 vs. Georgia and 21 at Ole Miss. He is second on the team in scoring and second in rebounds as well as second in assists.

Watford is all over the SEC statistics leaders showing sixth in scoring, 12th in rebounds, third in field goal percentage (52.5%), eighth in assists, ninth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.4) and third in minutes played average (33.4).

Watford has five games of 20 points or more this year and that gives him eight for his LSU career:

A LITTLE FREE THROW TOUCH

Trendon Watford, whose free throw shooting percentage improved from the 50s during non-conference play as a freshman through the 70 percent range in league play and early this year, stumbled against Georgia (1/6) missing his first six free throw attempts. Late in overtime, obviously fouled in the late stretch, Watford hit 3-of-4 to help ice the game. But afterwards, he was back on the floor in uniform still, shooting free throws working on his form.

After the shootaround on Saturday in Oxford, there was a familiar site as Watford and Coach Wade walked to a basket for some free throw shooting. In the game Saturday, Watford was 5-of-5 at the stripe, technically making 8-of-his-last-9 in SEC play. For the season, Watford is 47-of-65 or 72.3 percent.

TIGERS INSIDE THE ARC

LSU has been good the last few years shooting inside the arc but this year the Tigers again have posted one of the nation's better percentages inside the arc for two points. LSU prior to the Florida game was seventh in the nation in two-point shooting at 62.0 percent. The Florida game, however, may have been one of the Tigers poorer efforts inside the arc, shooting just 41.9 percent.

For the season, LSU is 18th nationally in two-point percentage at 57.7 percent.

Last season, LSU was 54.7 percent inside the arc, which was 17th in the nation. In 2018-19, LSU was 52.9 percent inside the arc.

LSU BETTER THIS YEAR OUTSIDE THE ARC

LSU has hit for double figures outside the arc three times:

- Vs. SIUE (Nov. 26) – 12 three-pointers**
- Vs. Southeastern (Nov. 30) – 13 three-pointers**
- Vs. Georgia (Dec 6) – 10 three-pointers**

Other than the Nicholls game, LSU has had no less than seven three-pointers in any of the other games this season. So far LSU is 88-of-241 or 36.5 percent. That is 3.8 percentage points better than last season when LSU was just 32.7 percent for the season.

LSU is third in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage and second in 3-point field goal percentage defense at 27.8 percent (79-of-284).

LSU's 88 makes are nine more than the opponents which have taken 43 more three-point attempts than LSU.

Javonte Smart and Cam Thomas are the only two listed for three-point percentage in the SEC with Smart at 44.2 percent and Thomas at 32.9 percent. The two are also 1-2 in three-point field goals made with Smart at 2.6 and Thomas at 2.5. Smart is 36th in the nation in three-point percentage.

FREE THROWS COUNTING WELL

LSU remains on top of the league in free throw shooting percentage at 77.8 percent (186-of-239). Only Arkansas in two more games has made more free throws in the league than LSU (196).

The Georgia game was the first that LSU had shot below 71 percent in a game this season.

The Tigers have made 61 more free throws than opponents and have attempted 53 more free throws than opponents early in the season.

The Ole Miss was the second game this season that LSU has attempted less than 18 free throws in a game.

LSU'S OFFENSIVE POWER NUMBERS

Kenpom.com has LSU fifth entering Thursday in the list of top 10 offenses so far in the early part of the year. Gonzaga is tops followed by Iowa, Villanova and Baylor in front of LSU. After LSU comes Michigan, Creighton, Illinois, Ohio State and Wisconsin.

LSU is eighth in the NCAA in Team Offensive Efficiency at 1.161. Last year LSU finished at 1,104.

O'Neal is wearing 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice – 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

So far this season, O'Neal has averaged 15 minutes a game, 3.0 points and 5.0 rebounds a game. O'Neal had nine rebounds in the win over Southeastern.

The younger O'Neal has made two three-pointers which is two more than his dad made in his three years at LSU. He has been first sub or co-sub in the game in all five of the games he has played in.

It is hoped that O'Neal can return to the court during LSU's three-game homestand.

SERIES AGAINST ARKANSAS

Arkansas leads the overall series, 37-32, which first began in 1949. The teams split games the last two seasons with teams winning on their home court in 2020 and teams winning on the road court in 2019.

LSU leads the series, 18-12, in games played in Baton Rouge and that is despite Arkansas winning 9-of-the-first-11 meetings in Baton Rouge after the Razorbacks joined the league.

Arkansas comes in off a strong, 99-69, performance against Georgia in Fayetteville on Saturday. Moses Moody had 25 points, Davonte Davis 20, Vance Jackson and Jalen Tate 15 each (Tate 10 assists) and JD Notae 12.

Moody leads Arkansas at 16.7 points a game while Notae is at 15.4 points, Desi Sills checks in at 11.8, Tate 11.8 and Justin Smith 11.6 (out since Jan. 1 with right ankle surgery).

Eric Musselman is the head coach of the Arkansas Razorbacks in his second season. He is a former assistant coach at LSU.

AT THE HOME PLACE

This is the 50th year of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center and LSU at present has won eight straight at home, dating back to the final two home games of the 2019-20 season.

All time, LSU is 585-197 (75.3%) and 270-154 (63.7%) in conference games. LSU needs four more wins to win 10 games or more in a season in the Maravich Center for the fourth straight year and nine-of-the-last-10 years.

JAVONTE SMART

Coach Will Wade saluted Javonte Smart after the opening SEC game against Texas A&M (12/29) when he struggled to score but still kept LSU moving forward running the offense and posting six assists in the win.

In the last three games, Smart has had three strong performances highlighted by the two treys he made in the last two minutes to force overtime against Georgia (1/6). The numbers:

After averaging 12.5 points a year ago to go with 3.5 rebounds and his 129 assists last year, Smart is averaging 15.4 points, 4.0 rebounds and 4.11 assists with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.8.

He is on the preseason watch list for the Bob Cousy Award and the Jersey Mike's Naismith Player of the Year list as well as the Wooden list. He was a second team selection on the media All-SEC team (two five-man teams) and is on the first team of the coaches' All-SEC selection (eight players).

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play last year. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 26 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league.

SMART'S EIGHTH GAME OVER 20; THIRD THIS SEASON

SMART TOPS 100 THREE-POINTERS

It was at the 6:01 mark of the first half against Sam Houston (12/14) when Javonte Smart made his first three-pointer of the game and that gave him 100 for his LSU career (now 110 total). He became the 23rd player in LSU history with 100 career treys. Darrel Mitchell, who played for the 2006 Final Four team, is the team's all-time leader in three-pointers at 258, while Tremont Waters (2017-19) was the one prior to Smart to cross the 100 threshold, finishing at 128.

DARIUS DAYS

Days was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

Days averaged 11.1 points last year for the Tigers, hitting 48.6 percent of his field goal attempts (125-of-257) with 39 three-pointers.

After averaging 5.3 points as a freshman, Days more than doubled his scoring average and increased his rebound average from 4.0 to 6.8.

So far this season, the junior from Raleigh, Florida is fourth on the team in scoring at 13.5 points and 8.1 boards. He is third in rebound average, one of three players averaging over eight rebounds a game.

After hitting three treys at Ole Miss, Days is 20-of-50 from the arc or 40 percent. He is tied for ninth in the league at 2.0 threes a game.

Days is second in the league in defensive rebound average at 5.7 a game and ninth at 2.4 offensive rebounds a game.

DARIUS DAYS DOUBLES

For the fourth time this year, Darius Days pulled down double figure rebounds as he grabbed 11 against Georgia (1/6) after 10 against Texas A&M (12/29). He also pulled down 11 at Saint Louis (11/28) and Sam Houston State (12/14).

Three of those were part of double doubles as Days scored 16 points in the Sam Houston State game, 18 against A&M and 13 against Georgia.

Days with his three double doubles this year, gives him a total of 11 for his three years at LSU.

Keyontae Johnson of Florida leads "active" SEC players with 13 career double doubles with Days the only other player with double figure doubles at 11.

JOSH LEBLANC

He's been at LSU since last January 2020 chomping at the bit for the chance to play college basketball again. Finally, against Sam Houston State (12/14), Josh LeBlanc got that chance again, this time in his hometown.

The Baton Rouge native spent a season and a half at Georgetown playing for the Hoyas before returning to Baton Rouge and enrolling at LSU in time for the second semester of the 2019-20 school year.

LeBlanc practiced with the Tigers during the conference part of the 2019-20 season and early on this year before becoming eligible for LSU at the end of the fall semester.

He played 14 minutes against the Bearkats, making both field goal attempts, one free throw for five points to go with eight rebounds, including four offensive boards.

Against Georgia, LeBlanc scored two points in 16 minutes but had a block and five steals in the contest.

In the win at Ole Miss (1/9), LeBlanc hit his one field goal attempted but contributed in other ways with five rebounds,

He is averaging 16 minutes a game through his first six LSU appearances, 1.8 points and 4.0 rebounds.

WILKINSON IN STARTING ROLE

Freshman Mwani Wilkinson from Las Vegas got his first start of his LSU career on Dec. 6 against Louisiana Tech. Although he didn't score in the game, he played 17 minutes and had one block and two steals. His best game was against Southeastern Louisiana (11/30), scoring 12 points on 5-of-8 field goal attempts.

He scored six against Sam Houston hitting all three field goal attempts. For the year, Wilkinson is averaging 4.4 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game.

Against Nicholls he played 20 minutes with a rebound and two steals, but a +/- number of +14.

Wilkinson has continued to contribute in the SEC games with 20 total points in the four games and 20 rebounds. He had four points on 2-2 shooting against Ole Miss (1/9) with three rebounds, two assists and two steals. He had a plus-minus of +14.

He is averaging 4.3 points, 3.5 rebounds (with 23 of his 35 total boards being offensive grabs). He is averaging 20.8 minutes a game, fifth most on the team.

JALEN COOK

The Walker, Louisiana product missed the Southeastern game with a minor injury but came back against Louisiana Tech (12/6) and played 13 minutes, scoring 10 points with two assists. Cook had nine in 11 minutes against Sam Houston.

Cook is fifth on the team in scoring at 4.3 points with 1.0 rebounds and 1.2 assists. Cook played 25 minutes off the bench against Nicholls getting two field goals and 4-of-6 at the line to score eight points with four assists and two steals. He is averaging 9.7 minutes a game.

ERIC GAINES

When it came time for someone to move in and keep the offensive flow going when Cam Thomas went out against Ole Miss (1/9), Lithonia, Georgia freshman Eric Gaines moved in and played 28 minutes in the game. He scored a season high 10 points with two rebounds, two assists and four steals.

Gaines, who is averaging 2.9 points, 1.5 rebounds and 1.1 assists a game, also had one of his best shooting nights from the field hitting 3-of-7 field goals and 2-of-3 long-range attempts. That gives him three makes for the season from distance.

Gaines got his first start against Nicholls (12/6) with Javonte Smart out and played 15 minutes. While he scored just one point, Gaines had two rebounds two assists, a block and a steal.

AUNDRE HYATT

The sophomore has kind of emerged from the shadows after not playing the first two conference games. Against Georgia (1/6), Hyatt played seven minutes, hitting 3-of-5 shots to score six points with three offensive rebounds and an assist. He followed that up at Ole Miss (1/9) with a 2-of-4 shooting night with five rebounds in 17 minutes.

In the last two games, he has played almost 25 minutes, hitting 5-of-9 shots with eight boards and 10 points. For the season, he is averaging 3.8 points in eight games and 2.3 rebounds.

The Gamecocks last played on Jan. 6, winning over Texas A&M. But games on Dec. 29 against Kentucky and Jan. 9 at Ole Miss and Tuesday against Tennessee have been postponed. Word is that the Gamecocks should be ready to go again on Saturday so plans are moving forward for what will be the second of three straight home games for the Tigers.
