Some travel and scheduling issues may change the time and day so media should contact the Communications Office to confirm start time ... Player requests need to be in to Kent Lowe at clowe@lsu.edu no later than 24 hours in advance.

POST GAME

During the current season, post-game video sessions will be done remotely on zoom links that will be distributed to the media during the course of the game. There will be separate video zooms for each team and both will be conducted after the game when coaches and players are available the 10-minute cooling off period. Both home and away, Coach Wade will conduct his radio post-game show before beginning his zoom session with media on hand for the game and admitted remotely.

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

PRIOR TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

LAST GAME: LSU 92, ARKANSAS 76 (BATON ROUGE, Jan. 13, 2021)

For the second straight game, the Tigers came out offensively and defensively and put themselves in position early to get another SEC win.

After Arkansas took a 7-4 lead, the Tigers ran off 18 straight points to go up 22-7 eight minutes in. Arkansas scored and then LSU ran off another eight to make it a 26-2 run over 6:47 of playing time. LSU would lead in the first half by as much as 31 points and go into the dressing room with a 51-31 halftime advantage.

LSU would give away some offensive rebounds opportunities by Arkansas and LSU turned the ball over 12 times in the second half, losing focus at the end of the game, but the outcome was really never in doubt after the first 30 minutes.

The Tigers shot 52.3 percent (34-of-65) with seven treys and 17-of-24 at the line. Arkansas was held to just 34.2 percent (26-of-76) with eight treys and 16-of-20 at the line.

All five Tigers were in double figures with Trendon Watford and Darius Days both getting double doubles. Watford scored 23 points and 10 rebounds for his first double of the year and Days got 18 points and 13 boards for his fourth double up of the season. Cam Thomas, who was listed as questionable after an ankle injury Saturday at Ole Miss, played 32 minutes and

scored 17 points. Mwani Wilkinson also scored in double figures for the first time in SEC play with 11 points.

LSU out rebounded Arkansas 48-39.

Thomas was a +29 in the game, Days +25 and Watford +20. The starting five played 21:22 of the game and outscored Arkansas 59-31 with 31 rebounds and a points per possession of 1.3361. In the first part of the game from the tip to the 12:14 mark, the fivesome outscored Arkansas 22-7 with a points per possession of 1.5493.

50 POINT HALVES

The 51 points scored against Arkansas on Wednesday marked the ninth time in the Will Wade era that LSU has scored 50 points in the first half of a game. The Tigers are 9-0 when that happens and it marked the third time the Tigers have scored 50 in a half:

SO HOW WE FINALLY GOT TO SEC PLAY

With the SEC schedule now underway, a refresher course on how the schedule looked at the start and all the changes that got us to where we are now:

1 – LSU was scheduled to play San Fran, Western Kentucky and Saint Louis in Lincoln, Nebraska in the Golden Window Classic, Nov. 25, 26 and 28.

2 – Saint Louis elected to stay in Saint Louis and invited LSU to join them for the Billiken Classic where LSU played SIUE and Saint Louis, Nov. 26 and 28.

3 – To replace the third game that would have been played in Nebraska, LSU scheduled Southeastern for a game played, Nov. 30.

4 – LSU plays a scheduled game on Dec. 6 in Baton Rouge against Louisiana Tech. The two teams were originally supposed to meet in Bossier City, Nov. 24, but the promoter and the teams elected to move the game in Bossier City to December of 2021. Tech and LSU signed a new contract for this game.

5 – LSU pulls out of a game with South Florida in Atlanta at Holiday Hoopsgiving Dec. 12 because of SEC and NCAA Covid protocols involving the LSU team.

6 – LSU quickly schedules Sam Houston State for an 11 a.m. game on Dec. 14. Associate Head Coach Bill Armstrong coaches the game solo as Coach Will Wade announced earlier in the day he had tested positive for Covid-19.

7 – LSU announces postponements against UNO (Dec. 16), North Texas (Dec. 19) and VCU (Dec. 22) because of SEC and NCAA protocols regarding Covid.

8 – LSU on Dec. 21 schedules Texas Southern for a Dec. 26, 4 p.m. game.

9 – On Dec. 24, Texas Southern has to withdraw because of NCAA Covid-19 protocols. That evening, Nicholls signs a contract to come to Baton Rouge for a 1 p.m. game on Dec. 26.

10 – LSU opens SEC play as scheduled on Dec. 29 playing Texas A&M.

THE SEC PIVOT ...

1 – LSU is scheduled to play Missouri, Jan. 9; Conference announces at 1 p.m. on Jan. 8 that the LSU game at Missouri is postponed; LSU travels to Oxford for a Jan. 9 game at Ole Miss instead of as scheduled on Feb. 17.

AN 86-POINT OPENING SEC RUN

Cam Thomas posted 86 points in the first three SEC games to average 28.7 points after scoring 32 points against Texas A&M, 28 points at Florida and 26 versus Georgia.

Prior to that Thomas had 29 versus Nicholls which made him the first LSU player to have four consecutive games over 20 since Antonio Blakeney had six consecutive 20-point games in the month of February 2017.

THOMAS FOUR GAMES 10 OR MORE FIELD GOALS

Ten or more field goals for Thomas has led to big nights for the freshman:

At 21.8 points per game, Thomas is 11th in the NCAA in scoring.

The games against SIUE and Saint Louis to open the season earned him the SEC Freshman of the Week honor and the Nicholls game earned him on Dec. 28 his second SEC Freshman of the Week honor.

Besides the scoring, Thomas is averaging 2.7 rebounds and 1.5 assists. He is shooting 42.7 percent overall and made 26 three pointers.

GETTING TO THE LINE

Cam Thomas has done a good job of drawing fouls and getting to the line. Wednesday against Arkansas, Thomas was fouled eight times and finished the game 6-of-8 at the stripe.

So far this season, he is first in the league in free throws made at 68 (9th in NCAA) and 1st in the league in percentage at 89.5 percent. He is 35-of-38 in SEC play or 92.1 percent.

Thomas has drawn 49 fouls in the 11 games, just behind the and is 62-of-68 at the line for 91.2 percent. He is second on the team in fouls drawn, just behind the 51 drawn by Trendon Watford.

FIVE TIMES THREE

Cam Thomas hit five treys in the win over A&M in the league opener. The last player to hit five treys for LSU was Javonte Smart which happened to be in the opening win last season at Tennessee. Smart has again now become the latest to hit five treys in the win over Georgia (1/6).

MORE NUMBERS

Thomas's 26-point game versus Georgia (1/6) was his seventh game of 20 points or more this season and as of Jan. 14, that was the most by any freshman in Division I:

Cam Thomas – LSU – 7 (Next game Saturday vs. South Carolina)

- Cade Cunningham – Oklahoma State – 5 (vs. Oklahoma Saturday)
- Marcus Williams – Wyoming – 4 (at. Air Force Saturday)

The 32 points remains the most points in a game by a D1 freshman this season.

Thomas scored at least 15 points or more in his first seven career games. It is the longest career-opening streak of 15-point games by an SEC player over the last 25 seasons, according to ESPN Stats & Info.

ESPN Stats & Info also reports that Thomas' four consecutive 25-point games makes him the only SEC freshman with a four-game 25-point streak in the last 25 seasons and also the only to surpass 200 points in nine career games during that span as well.

TIGERS SHOOTING WELL

The Tigers lead the league at this point in the season in shooting percentage at 49.4 percent (325-of-658). Opponents are shooting 40.4 percent (274-of-679), with LSU ranking fourth in field goal percentage defense.

LSU has shot better than 50 percent in six games including Wednesday's Arkansas game. The 50 percent shooting percentages this season:

- SIUE – 30-of-58 (51.7%)
- Saint Louis – 28-of-52 (53.8%)
- Southeastern – 30-of-60 (50.0%)
- Louisiana Tech – 26-of-48 (54.2%)

LSU is 96-9 since the start of the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or more in a game. So far this season, LSU has made 51 more field goals than opponents on 21 less attempts.

THREE IN TOP FIVE IN LEAGUE IN FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE

Speaking of shooting it well, the Tigers have three players in the top five in league field goal percentage:

LOTS OF REBOUNDS, BUT STOPPING OPPONENTS OFFENSIVE REBOUNDS KEY

The Tigers have pulled down 53, 48 and 46 rebounds this season but Coach Will Wade is still looking to prevent opponents from getting offensive boards that turn into second chance points.

LSU pulled down 48 rebounds against Arkansas on Wednesday, but the Razorbacks had a 17-14 advantage in offensive boards and that led to 21 second chance points.

The 53 boards came against Southeastern and 46 against Louisiana Tech but both teams pulled down 14 offensive rebounds and that led to a 13-5 advantage in second chance points.

The inability to clear the boards again caused problems for LSU against Nicholls as the Tigers were not only rebounded by the Colonels, but Nicholls had a 17-10 advantage on the offensive boards. That resulted in an 18-12 advantage for Nicholls in second chance points.

LSU turned that around in the conference opener against A&M, with a 40-31 margin overall on the boards and 15-11 on the offensive boards. That was part of a 21-8 advantage for LSU in second chance points.

LSU is averaging 38.9 rebounds a game to 34.2 for opponents. LSU is fifth in rebounding offense and seventh in rebounding defense.

THREE STRAIGHT 20 POINT GAMES TO START AN LSU CAREER

Cam Thomas became the first LSU player to have three games of 20 or more in his first three varsity LSU games since JC transfer Marcus Thornton did in Nov. 2007 – games of 27, 24 and 20.

Thomas' 32-point opening league game is the most by an LSU freshman since the opening game of conference play for LSU in the 2015-16 season when on Jan. 2, 2016, Ben Simmons opened his national freshman of the year campaign with 36 points at Vanderbilt in a Tiger win.

LSU's last 30-point game by any player was in the regular season finale last year when senior Marlon Taylor had 30 points against Georgia. The last LSU player to score more points than Thomas in a game was former point guard Tremont Waters, who scored 39 also against A&M in January 2019.

COACH WADE PASSES 100

Coach Wade reached 100 games as the LSU head coach in the Nicholls game on Dec. 26. Here's where he ranked in wins among LSU coaches in their first 100 games as the head coach (years in parenthesis represent length to get to 100 games):

WILL WADE IN CONFERENCE GAMES

Coach Will Wade in his eighth season as a head coach has had good success in conference games in all three of his head coaching stops, winning double figure games every year except his first year at LSU.

Wade won 27 league games in two years at Chattanooga, 28 in two years at VCU and now 39 SEC games in his fourth year at LSU. Wade is presently 94-34 in league games including 39-19 at LSU. Wade was 8-10 his first season in the league, 15-2 in a conference championship team in 2019 (He did not coach the final game of the 2019 season.) and, 12-6 and tying for second in 2020. This season the Tigers are 4-1.

WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

Trendon Watford continued his strong sophomore season with his first double double of the campaign and the eighth of his LSU career. Watford had 23 points (his second consecutive game over 20 points for the second time this year) and 10 rebounds.

Watford, from Birmingham, averaged 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds as a freshman and for the season is averaging 18.3 points and 7.0 rebounds to go with a good 3.6 assists average.

After struggling to score against A&M, Watford has scored 82 points in the next four SEC games – 21 at Florida, 17 vs. Georgia, 21 at Ole Miss and 23 vs. Arkansas. He is second on the team in scoring, rebounding and assists.

Watford is all over the SEC statistics leaders showing fourth in scoring, 10th in rebounds, third in field goal percentage (53.0%), T9 in assists, third in defensive rebound average at 5.3 a game and third in minutes played average (33.4).

Watford has six games of 20 points or more this year and that gives him nine for his LSU career (The 23 against Arkansas was the most he has scored in the Maravich Center):

A LITTLE FREE THROW TOUCH

Trendon Watford, whose free throw shooting percentage improved from the 50s during non-conference play as a freshman through the 70 percent range in league play and early this year, stumbled against Georgia (1/6) missing his first six free throw attempts. Late in overtime, obviously fouled in the late stretch, Watford hit 3-of-4 to help ice the game. But afterwards, he was back on the floor in uniform still, shooting free throws working on his form.

After the shootaround last Saturday in Oxford, there was a familiar site as Watford and Coach Wade walked to a basket for some free throw shooting. In the game Saturday, Watford was 5-of-5 at the stripe, which he followed up by going 4-of-4 against Arkansas. So technically that makes him 12-of-his-last 13 in SEC play. For the season, Watford is 51-of-69 or 73.9 percent.

TIGERS INSIDE THE ARC

LSU has been good the last few years shooting inside the arc but this year the Tigers again have posted one of the nation's better percentages inside the arc for two points. LSU prior to the Florida game was seventh in the nation in two-point shooting at 62.0 percent. The Florida game, however, may have been one of the Tigers poorer efforts inside the arc, shooting just 41.9 percent.

For the season, LSU is 17th nationally in two-point percentage at 57.8 percent.

Last season, LSU was 54.7 percent inside the arc, which was 17th in the nation. In 2018-19, LSU was 52.9 percent inside the arc.

LSU's Darius Days is 11th in the country inside the arc at 72.9% after going 6-of-6 inside the arc versus Arkansas.

LSU BETTER THIS YEAR OUTSIDE THE ARC

LSU has hit for double figures outside the arc three times:

- Vs. SIUE (Nov. 26) – 12 three-pointers**
- Vs. Southeastern (Nov. 30) – 13 three-pointers**
- Vs. Georgia (Dec 6) – 10 three-pointers**

Other than the Nicholls game, LSU has had no less than seven three-pointers in any of the other games this season. So far LSU is 95-of-260 or 36.5 percent. That is 3.8 percentage points better than last season when LSU was just 32.7 percent for the season.

LSU is third in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage and second in 3-point field goal percentage defense at 27.6 percent (87-of-315).

LSU's 95 makes are eight more than the opponents which have taken 55 more three-point attempts than LSU.

Smart and Thomas are at 2.4 three-point makes a game. With addition numbers outside the decimal point, Smart is in a four-way tie in the league standings with Thomas fifth.

FREE THROWS COUNTING WELL

LSU remains on top of the league in free throw shooting percentage at 77.2 percent (203-of-263). Only Arkansas in two more games has made more free throws in the league than LSU (212).

The Tigers have made 62 more free throws than opponents and have attempted 57 more free throws than opponents early in the season (141-of-206).

The Ole Miss (1/9) was the second game this season that LSU has attempted less than 18 free throws in a game.

LSU'S OFFENSIVE POWER NUMBERS

Kenpom.com has LSU fifth entering Thursday in the list of top 10 offenses so far in the early part of the year. Gonzaga is tops followed by Iowa, Baylor and Villanova in front of LSU. After LSU comes Michigan, Creighton, Ohio State, Illinois and UCLA and Wisconsin.

LSU is seventh in the NCAA in Team Offensive Efficiency at 1.155. Last year LSU finished at 1,104.

FATHERS AND SONS

UCLA transfer Shareef O'Neal brings an addition to the list of Fathers and Sons who have been a part of the LSU men's basketball program over the years.

O'Neal is wearing 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice – 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

Shareef and father Shaquille O'Neal will become the latest in a line of father-son combinations that have played for the LSU Purple and Gold:

So far this season, O'Neal has averaged 15 minutes a game, 3.0 points and 5.0 rebounds a game. O'Neal had nine rebounds in the win over Southeastern.

The younger O'Neal has made two three-pointers which is two more than his dad made in his three years at LSU. He has been first sub or co-sub in the game in all five of the games he has played in.

It is hoped that O'Neal can return to the court during next week during one of LSU's games.

TIGERS PICKED THIRD IN MEDIA PRESEASON POLL

SERIES AGAINST SOUTH CAROLINA

South Carolina leads the series that was first played in 1974 by an 18-17 count. The teams have obviously played every year since 1992 when the Gamecocks joined the league. In the last 10 years, the teams have met 11 times with LSU winning six times. LSU leads the series, 8-6, in games played in Baton Rouge.

The Gamecocks are 1-0 in the league with their only win coming at home, 78-54, over Texas A&M on Jan. 6. AJ Lawson scored a career-high 30 points in the game. Jermaine Couisnard had 15 points and Wildens Leveque added 10.

South Carolina has had three conference games postponed so far.

Frank Martin is the head coach at Carolina.

AT THE HOME PLACE

This is the 50th year of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center and LSU at present has won nine straight at home, dating back to the final two home games of the 2019-20 season.

All time, LSU is 586-197 (75.3%) and 271-154 (63.7%) in conference games. LSU needs three more wins to win 10 games or more in a season in the Maravich Center for the fourth straight year and nine-of-the-last-10 years.

JAVONTE SMART

Coach Will Wade saluted Javonte Smart after the opening SEC game against Texas A&M (12/29) when he struggled to score but still kept LSU moving forward running the offense and posting six assists in the win.

In the last four conference games, the junior point guard has had several good performances both in the scoring end (i.e. two threes in the last two minutes to force overtime against UGA (1/6) and the Ole Miss and Arkansas where he scored in double figures in both games and had six assists versus the Rebels and five against Arkansas.

After averaging 12.5 points a year ago to go with 3.5 rebounds and his 129 assists last year, Smart is averaging 15.2 points, 3.9 rebounds and 4.2 assists.

He is on the preseason watch list for the Bob Cousy Award and the Jersey Mike's Naismith Player of the Year list as well as the Wooden list. He was a second team selection on the media All-SEC team (two five-man teams) and is on the first team of the coaches' All-SEC selection (eight players).

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play last year. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 26 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league.

SMART'S EIGHTH GAME OVER 20; THIRD THIS SEASON

Against Sam Houston on Dec. 14, Smart had 25 points in that game, four points away from his 29 points against Tennessee (Feb. 23, 2019) he had as a freshman. The 21 against Georgia was his eighth games of 20 points or more this season:

SMART TOPS 100 THREE-POINTERS

It was at the 6:01 mark of the first half against Sam Houston (12/14) when Javonte Smart made his first three-pointer of the game and that gave him 100 for his LSU career (now 111 total). He became the 23rd player in LSU history with 100 career treys. Darrel Mitchell, who played for the 2006 Final Four team, is the team's all-time leader in three-pointers at 258, while Tremont Waters (2017-19) was the one prior to Smart to cross the 100 threshold, finishing at 128.

DARIUS DAYS

Days was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

Days averaged 11.1 points last year for the Tigers, hitting 48.6 percent of his field goal attempts (125-of-257) with 39 three-pointers.

After averaging 5.3 points as a freshman, Days more than doubled his scoring average and increased his rebound average from 4.0 to 6.8.

So far this season, the junior from Raleigh, Florida is fourth on the team in scoring at 13.9 points and 8.5 boards. He is second in rebound average, one of three players averaging over eight rebounds a game in the SEC. Days is averaging 8.8 rebounds a game in league play which is also second in the SEC.

After hitting two treys versus Arkansas, Days is 22-of-54 from the arc or 40.7 percent.

Days is second in the league in defensive rebound average at 5.9 a game and T5 in offensive rebound average at 2.6 a game.

DARIUS DAYS DOUBLES

For the fifth time this year, Darius Days pulled down double figure rebounds as he grabbed a season high 13 rebounds against Arkansas (1/13).

It was part of his fourth double double of the season as Days scored 18 points. His other doubles came against Sam Houston State, A&M and 13 against Georgia.

Days with his four double doubles this year, gives him a total of 12 for his three years at LSU.

Keyontae Johnson of Florida leads "active" SEC players with 13 career double doubles with Days the only other player with double figure doubles at 12.

JOSH LEBLANC

He's been at LSU since last January 2020 chomping at the bit for the chance to play college basketball again. Finally, against Sam Houston State (12/14), Josh LeBlanc got that chance again, this time in his hometown.

The Baton Rouge native spent a season and a half at Georgetown playing for the Hoyas before returning to Baton Rouge and enrolling at LSU in time for the second semester of the 2019-20 school year.

LeBlanc practiced with the Tigers during the conference part of the 2019-20 season and early on this year before becoming eligible for LSU at the end of the fall semester.

He played 14 minutes against the Bearkats, making both field goal attempts, one free throw for five points to go with eight rebounds, including four offensive boards.

Against Georgia, LeBlanc scored two points in 16 minutes but had a block and five steals in the contest.

In the win at Ole Miss (1/9), LeBlanc hit his one field goal attempted but contributed in other ways with five rebounds, an assist and three blocks in 21 minutes.

He is averaging 15.9 minutes a game through his first seven LSU appearances, 1.9 points and 3.9 rebounds.

WILKINSON IN STARTING ROLE

Freshman Mwani Wilkinson from Las Vegas got his first start of his LSU career on Dec. 6 against Louisiana Tech. Although he didn't score in the game, he played 17 minutes and had one block and two steals. His best game was against Southeastern Louisiana (11/30), scoring 12 points on 5-of-8 field goal attempts.

Wilkinson had his first double figure game in the SEC against Arkansas (1/13) hitting 4-of-4 field goals his first three-pointer and two free throws to finish with 11 points to go with six rebounds and two steals.

Wilkinson is averaging 4.8 points, 3.7 rebounds and 1.4 assists. In SEC play, Wilkinson is averaging 6.2 points and 5.2 rebounds. Of his 41 rebounds, 25 are offensive boards (second on the team).

JALEN COOK

The Walker, Louisiana product missed the Southeastern game with a minor injury but came back against Louisiana Tech (12/6) and played 13 minutes, scoring 10 points with two assists. Cook had nine in 11 minutes against Sam Houston.

Cook is averaging 3.9 points with 1.0 rebounds and 1.1 assists. Cook played 25 minutes off the bench against Nicholls getting two field goals and 4-of-6 at the line to score eight points with four assists and two steals. He is averaging 9.1 minutes a game.

ERIC GAINES

When it came time for someone to move in and keep the offensive flow going when Cam Thomas went out against Ole Miss (1/9), Lithonia, Georgia freshman Eric Gaines moved in and played 28 minutes in the game. He scored a season high 10 points with two rebounds, two assists and four steals.

Gaines played 14 minutes against Arkansas with three points and an assist.

Gaines, who is averaging 2.9 points, 1.5 rebounds and 1.1 assists a game, also had one of his best shooting nights from the field hitting 3-of-7 field goals and 2-of-3 long-range attempts against the Rebels. That gives him three makes for the season from distance.

AUNDRE HYATT

The sophomore has kind of emerged from the shadows after not playing the first two conference games. Against Georgia (1/6), Hyatt played seven minutes, hitting 3-of-5 shots to score six points with three offensive rebounds and an assist. He followed that up at Ole Miss (1/9) with a 2-of-4 shooting night with five rebounds in 17 minutes. Hyatt played 10 minutes against Arkansas (1/13) with two field goals including a trey to total 5 points.

For the season, he is averaging 3.8 points in eight games and 2.3 rebounds.

LSU will be on the road after the Alabama game against Kentucky and Texas A&M.
