### SEC TELECONFERENCE

The 14 SEC coaches are featured on a teleconference three times beginning in January. Coach Wade is on at 10:28 a.m. CT. The teleconferences are still to be determined. To access the media only number contact SEC Media Relations Office (205-458-3010).

### MEDIA SESSIONS

Coach Wade meets, when travel schedules permit, usually one or two days prior to games in non-conference play and usually on Mondays and Thursdays during the SEC season. The sessions take place in the practice facility meeting room. Times are announced based on practice plans with players usually one day a week. Some travel and scheduling issues may change the time and day so media should contact the Communications Office to confirm start time ... Player requests need to be in to Kent Lowe at [clowe@lsu.edu](mailto:clowe@lsu.edu) no later than 24 hours in advance.

### POST GAME

During the current season, post-game video sessions will be done remotely on zoom links that will be distributed to the media during the course of the game. There will be separate video zooms for each team and both will be conducted after the game when coaches and players are available the 10-minute cooling off period. Both home and away, Coach Wade will conduct his radio post-game show before beginning his zoom session with media on hand for the game and admitted remotely.

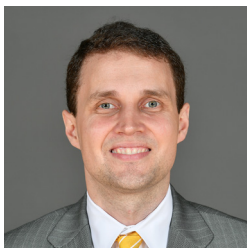

# Will Wade

## Head Coach

@wwadelsu

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

### PRIOR TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

### LAST GAME: FLORIDA 83, LSU 79 (Gainesville, Jan. 2, 2021)

A nine-minute stretch in the middle of the 40-minute game may have been what ultimately sunk LSU as the Tigers entered the final minute of the first half up five, 40-35. In the final minute, Florida was able to tie the game and adding in the first eight minutes of the second half, the Gators had outscored LSU, 27-12, to take a 10-point advantage that LSU was unable to overcome.

The Tigers tried to get back in the game but was only able to get as close as two in the final 10 seconds but Florida made its free throws to ice the game.

Three LSU players had 20 points in the game, in fact, scoring 69-of-the-79 points that LSU scored in the game -- Cam Thomas 28, Trendon Watford 21 and Javonte Smart 20. But Watford and Smart returned to form having had games below scoring average in the conference opener against A&M (12/29).

LSU had its worst game shooting overall from the field, hitting just 25-of-61 from the field (41.0%). The Tigers did hit seven treys and 22-of-25 at the line. The Tigers were out rebounded, 35-31. The game had nine ties and 11 lead changes and the specialty stats were very similar in the game.

There have been several times since then with two 20-point scorers, but also later in the 2015-16 season that also featured prolific scorers Antonio Blakeney and Keith Hornsby, the Tigers had two games with two players over 20 points and one at 18.

## SO HOW WE FINALLY GOT TO SEC PLAY

With the SEC schedule now underway, a refresher course on how the schedule looked at the start and all the changes that got us to where we are now:

1 -- LSU was scheduled to play San Fran, Western Kentucky and Saint Louis in Lincoln, Nebraska in the Golden Window Classic, Nov. 25, 26 and 28.

2 -- Saint Louis elected to stay in Saint Louis and invited LSU to join them for the Billiken Classic where LSU played SIUE and Saint Louis, Nov. 26 and 28.

3 -- To replace the third game that would have been played in Nebraska, LSU scheduled Southeastern for a game played, Nov. 30.

4 -- LSU plays a scheduled game on Dec. 6 in Baton Rouge against Louisiana Tech. The two teams were originally supposed to meet in Bossier City, Nov. 24, but the promoter and the teams elected to move the game in Bossier City to December of 2021. Tech and LSU signed a new contract for this game.

5 -- LSU pulls out of a game with South Florida in Atlanta at Holiday Hoopsgiving Dec. 12 because of SEC and NCAA Covid protocols involving the LSU team.

6 -- LSU quickly schedules Sam Houston State for an 11 a.m. game on Dec. 14. Associate Head Coach Bill Armstrong coaches the game solo as Coach Will Wade announced earlier in the day he had tested positive for Covid-19.

7 -- LSU announces postponements against UNO (Dec. 16), North Texas (Dec. 19) and VCU (Dec. 22) because of SEC and NCAA protocols regarding Covid.

8 -- LSU on Dec. 21 schedules Texas Southern for a Dec. 26, 4 p.m. game.

9 -- On Dec. 24, Texas Southern has to withdraw because of NCAA Covid-19 protocols. That evening, Nicholls signs a contract to come to Baton Rouge for a 1 p.m. game on Dec. 26.

10 -- LSU opens SEC play as scheduled on Dec. 29 playing Texas A&M.

## 13 GAMES OF 20 OR MORE POINTS FOR TIGERS

Through eight games, LSU has had players record 13 games of 20 points or more this season -- 6 by Cam Thomas, 4 by Trendon Watford and 2 by Javonte Smart and one by Darius Days.

The breakdown:

**Thomas -- 27 vs. SIUE, 25 at Saint Louis, 21 vs. Southeastern, 29 vs Nicholls, 32 vs. A&M, 28 at UF**

Last year, in 31 LSU games there were 22 games of 20 points or more by the Tigers.

## A 99-POINT THREE-GAME STRETCH

Since LSU returned to play on Dec. 26, Cam Thomas has certainly continued to play well and score well, including 99 points total in the last three games which is a 33-point average. It is the second time this season he has posted three consecutive games of 20-points or more.

Cam Thomas had back-to-back games of 29 versus Nicholls on Dec. 26, 32 on Dec. 29 against Texas A&M and 28 at Florida. For the three games, he is 29-of-61 from the field (47.5%), 10-of-29 from three-point range (34.4%) and 21-of-21 at the free throw line. He has a combined nine rebounds, four assists and five steals.

If Thomas is able to get a fourth consecutive 20-point game he will be the first LSU player to have four consecutive games over 20 since Antonio Blakeney had six consecutive 20-point games in the month of February 2017.

## THOMAS FOUR GAMES 10 OR MORE FIELD GOALS

Ten or more field goals for Thomas has led to big nights for the freshman:

In eight games, Thomas is averaging 24.6 points per game. Officially as of Monday he is seventh in the NCAA in scoring but third among players who have played at least five games.

The games against SIUE and Saint Louis to open the season earned him the SEC Freshman of the Week honor and the Nicholls game earned him on this past Monday his second SEC Freshman of the Week honor.

Besides the scoring, Thomas is averaging 2.9 rebounds and 1.6 assists. He is shooting 49.9 percent overall and made 24 three pointers. Thomas has drawn 31 fouls in the eight games and is 47-of-52 at the line for 90.4 percent. He has not missed a free throw since the 15:45 mark of the first half against Sam Houston game on Dec. 14. He missed the first half of a two-shot foul and since then has made 28 straight free throws. The school record is 35 straight made by Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf during the 1989-90 season.

## SOMETHING ABOUT SEC OPENERS

Cam Thomas hit five treys in the win over A&M in the league opener. The last player to hit five treys for LSU was Javonte Smart which happened to be in the opening win last season at Tennessee.

Thomas is the first player to take 11 threes in a game (A&M, 12/29) for LSU since Tremont Waters took 13 at UGA on Feb. 24, 2018.

### TIGERS SHOOTING WELL DESPITE UF STUMBLE

The Tigers, after shooting just 41 percent at Florida (1/2) has fallen one field goal make under 50 percent overall for the first time this season.

The Tigers are second in the league in field goal percent at 49.9 percent (233-of-467).

LSU has shot better than 50 percent in five games. The 50 percent shooting percentages this season:

#### SIUE – 30-of-58 (51.7%)

#### Saint Louis – 28-of-52 (53.8%)

#### Southeastern – 30-of-60 (50.0%)

#### Louisiana Tech – 26-of-48 (54.2%)

#### Nicholls – 31-of-56 (55.4%)

LSU is 95-9 since the start of the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or more in a game. Opponents are shooting 40.7 percent. LSU has made 36 more field goals than opponents on 17 less attempts.

### LOTS OF REBOUNDS, BUT STOPPING OPPONENTS OFFENSIVE REBOUNDS KEY

The Tigers were able to pull down 53 rebounds against Southeastern and 46 against Louisiana Tech but the numbers for the opponents on the offensive side have caused some consternation for the LSU coach staff.

Southeastern pulled down 14 offensive rebounds to 13 for the Tigers, but in the LA Tech game, the difference was more pronounced with a 14-4 advantage for the Bulldogs that led to a 13-5 second chance points advantage.

The inability to clear the boards again caused problems for LSU against Nicholls as the Tigers were not only rebounded by the Colonels, but Nicholls had a 17-10 advantage on the offensive boards. That resulted in an 18-12 advantage for Nicholls in second chance points.

LSU turned that around in the conference opener against A&M, with a 40-31 margin overall on the boards and 15-11 on the offensive boards. That was part of a 21-8 advantage for LSU in second chance points.

Florida had a four-board advantage but LSU had a 14-13 advantage in offensive boards. Florida, however, was an 18-14 leader in second chance points.

### THREE STRAIGHT 20 POINT GAMES TO START AN LSU CAREER; SEC OPENERS

Cam Thomas became the first LSU player to have three games of 20 or more in his first three varsity LSU games since JC transfer Marcus Thornton did in Nov. 2007 – games of 27, 24 and 20.

Thomas' 32-point opening league game is the most by an LSU freshman since the opening game of conference play for LSU in the 2015-16 season when on Jan. 2, 2016, Ben Simmons opened his national freshman of the year campaign with 36 points at Vanderbilt in a Tiger win.

LSU's last 30-point game by any player was in the regular season finale last year when senior Marlon Taylor had 30 points against Georgia. The last LSU player to score more points than Thomas in a game was former point guard Tremont Waters, who scored 39 also against A&M in January 2019.

### COACH WADE PASSES 100

### WILL WADE IN CONFERENCE GAMES

Coach Will Wade in his eighth season as a head coach has had good success in conference games in all three of his

head coaching stops, winning double figure games every year except his first year at LSU.

Wade won 27 league games in two years at Chattanooga, 28 in two years at VCU and now 36 SEC games in his fourth year at LSU. Wade is presently 91-34 in league games including 36-19 at LSU. Wade was 8-10 his first season in the league, 15-2 in a conference championship team in 2019 (He did not coach the final game of the 2019 season.) and, 12-6 and tying for second in 2020.

#### WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

After a strong freshman campaign in which he averaged 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds, Trendon Watford's sophomore campaign has started well, although he missed the Sam Houston game (12/14) with a minor ankle injury.

After struggling to score against A&M, Watford posted 21 points to go with eight rebounds (six offensive). He is second on the team in scoring at 17.4 points a game and second in rebounds at 6.7 a game. He is also the team leader in assists at 4.29 with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.14.

Watford is all over the SEC statistics leaders showing fourth in scoring, 13th in rebounds, third in field goal percentage (52.7%), fourth in assists, third in assist-to-turnover ratio, ninth in free throw percentage (78.0%) and third in minutes played average (32.9).

Watford has four games of 20 points or more this year and that gives him seven for his LSU career:

#### WATFORD LOOKING GOOD AT THE LINE

It is well documented the improvement that Trendon Watford made at the free throw line in his freshman season.

In non-conference games last season (with all but one in November and December 2019), Watford was 33-of-58 at the line, 56.9 percent. After the Christmas holidays, Coach Wade and Trendon would go to the free throw line after every practice and shootaround and begin free throw drills with him having to make a certain amount or the drill would start over.

In the 18 conference games, Watford would make 56-of-74 or 75.7 percent. That gave him a season mark of 67.4 percent.

Watford, first of all has been getting fouled and to the line a good bit in the early part of the season. He leads the team with 38 fouls drawn. That has led to a strong 39-of-50 free throw effort (78.0%).

#### TIGERS INSIDE THE ARC

LSU has been good the last few years shooting inside the arc but this year the Tigers again have posted one of the nation's top percentages inside the arc for two points. LSU prior to the Florida game was seventh in the nation in two-point shooting at 62.0 percent. The Florida game, however, may have been one of the Tigers poorer efforts inside the arc, shooting just 41.9 percent.

But for the season, LSU is still at 58.8 percent for the year, 14th in the NCAA.

Last season, LSU was 54.7 percent inside the arc, which was 17th in the nation. In 2018-19, LSU was 52.9 percent inside the arc.

#### LSU BETTER THIS YEAR OUTSIDE THE ARC

The Nicholls game (12/26) was the first game, LSU's outside shooting numbers tumbled, hitting only 4-of-15 attempts (26.7%). However, LSU has hit double figures twice and no less than seven in any of the other seven games to post 70-of-190 or 36.8 percent. That is 4.1 points better than last season when LSU was just 32.7 percent for the season.

LSU is actually second in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage.

LSU's 70 makes are 11 more than the opponents which have taken 33 more three-point attempts than LSU.

#### FREE THROWS COUNTING WELL

LSU is first in the league at the line at 79.5 percent after making 22-of-25 against Florida (1/2). For the season, LSU is 151-of-190, not shooting below 71 percent this season.

The Tigers have made 57 more free throws than opponents and have attempted 50 more free throws than opponents early in the season.

Only one game, the A&M game has LSU attempted less than 18 free throws in a game.

#### LSU'S OFFENSIVE POWER NUMBERS

Kenpom.com has LSU fifth entering the week in the list of top 10 offenses so far in the early part of the year. Iowa is tops followed by Gonzaga, Baylor and Villanova in front of LSU. After LSU comes Illinois, Michigan, Ohio State, Wisconsin and Creighton.

#### SOME OF THE NUMBERS

LSU returned three starters from a season ago and each started 30-of-the-31 games:

**Sophomore Trendon Watford – 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds**  
**Junior Javonte Smart – 12.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 4.2 assists**  
**Junior Darius Days – 11.1 points and 6.8 rebounds**

LSU returned 45.7 percent of its offensive production (45.1 points of an 80.5 season average); 20.7 rebounds of a 39.7 team rebound average (53.1%) and 57.0 percent of assists (227 of 398 total).

Offensively, LSU had one of the most efficient offenses in February and March of last season at 1.13 points per possession. According to NCAA.com, only Gonzaga (1.19) and Creighton (1.15) had higher points per possession levels during February/March when the season was called.

For the first eight games, LSU is at 1.193 points per possession which is sixth in the country.

#### FATHERS AND SONS

UCLA transfer Shareef O'Neal brings an addition to the list of Fathers and Sons who have been a part of the LSU men's basketball program over the years.

O'Neal is wearing 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice – 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

Shareef and father Shaquille O'Neal will become the latest in a line of father-son combinations that have played for the LSU Purple and Gold:

The two were also on the first team All-SEC coaches' preseason squad.

### SERIES AGAINST GEORGIA

The teams have split the last six games with Georgia winning three and then LSU winning the last three games, including last year here in Baton Rouge, 94-64, in the season finale. LSU also won both games in 2019, the last year the teams played home and home like this year. Like Florida, Georgia has been an opponent that has been a popular home and home opponent as this will be the third time in the last four years the teams have met twice.

LSU leads the overall series, 66-47, with LSU leading, 37-15, in games in Baton Rouge. The teams first played over 100 years ago in 1920 in Athens.

The teams have split the last six games and LSU has won 8-of-the-last-15.

Georgia last played on Dec. 30, losing to Mississippi State, 83-73. This will actually be Georgia's first road game of the season. Six Bulldogs are presently averaging in double figures with Toumani Camara averaging 14.3 points, Sahvir Wheeler 12.8, Tye Fagan and Justin Kier 10.9 each, P. J. Horne 10.5 and Andrew Garcia 10.3. The Bulldogs are averaging 80.1 points a game and giving up 67.0 point a contest.

Tom Crean is in his third year as the head coach at Georgia.

### JAVONTE SMART

Coach Will Wade saluted Javonte Smart after the opening SEC game when he struggled to score but still kept LSU moving forward running the offense and posting six assists in the win.

Against Florida, Smart had a strong game, hitting 7-of-12 field goal attempts, including two treys and four-of-four at the line for 20 points with two assists and six rebounds.

After averaged 12.5 points a year ago to go with 3.5 rebounds and his 129 assists, Smart is averaging 14.4 points, 4.4 rebounds and 3.86 assists with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.80.

He is on the watch list for the Bob Cousy Award and the Jersey Mike's Naismith Player of the Year list as well as the Wooden list. He was a second team selection on the media All-SEC team (two five-man teams) and is on the first team of the coaches' All-SEC selection (eight players).

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play last year. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 26 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league. Smart has had no turnovers in three-of-the-last-four SEC games.

SMART TOPS 100 THREE-POINTERS

It was at the 6:01 mark of the first half against Sam Houston (12/14) when Javonte Smart made his first three-pointer of the game and that gave him 100 for his LSU career. He became the 23rd player in LSU history with 100 career treys. Darrel Mitchell, who played for the 2006 Final Four team, is the team's all-time leader in three-pointers at 258, while Tremont Waters (2017-19) was the one prior to Smart to cross the 100 threshold, finishing at 128.

DARIUS DAYS

Days was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

Days averaged 11.1 points last year for the Tigers, hitting 48.6 percent of his field goal attempts (125-of-257) with 39 three-pointers.

After averaging 5.3 points as a freshman, Days more than doubled his scoring average and increased his rebound average from 4.0 to 6.8.

So far this season, the junior from Raleigh, Florida is fourth on the team in scoring at 13.4 points and 7.9 boards. He is fifth in rebound average. He has hit 15 treys and is shooting 39-of-71 from the field (54.9%). He is 15-of-39 from long range (38.5%).

DARIUS DAYS ON THE BOARDS

For the third time this year, Darius Days pulled down double figure rebounds as he grabbed 10 against Texas A&M (12/29) after 11 at Saint Louis (11/28) and Sam Houston State (12/14).

Two of those were part of double doubles as Days scored 16 points in the Sam Houston State game and 18 against A&M.

Days with his two double doubles this year, giving him a total of 10 for his three years at LSU.

MANNING RETURNS

After a season in which he broke the fifth metatarsal bone in both feet at various times in SEC play last year, the team's long senior, Charles Manning Jr., finally was able to make his season debut against Louisiana Tech (12/6).

Manning played 13.5 minutes in the Tech game, scoring 2 points with two rebounds in his opening game while playing on a minutes restriction after coming back to practice.

With the Trendon Watford injury, he was elevated to the starting lineup against Sam Houston (12/14), playing 32 minutes and scoring four points with seven rebounds, two assists and three steals.

Manning had a good game against Texas A&M (12/29), in which he played 19 minutes, hitting four field goals with four rebounds and nine points.

In five games, Manning is averaging 19.6 minutes, 4.6 points, and 3.6 rebounds.

JOSH LEBLANC FINALLY PLAYS

He's been at LSU since last January chomping at the bit for the chance to play college basketball again. Finally, against Sam Houston State (12/14), Josh LeBlanc got that chance again, this time in his hometown.

The Baton Rouge native spent a season and a half at Georgetown playing for the Hoyas before returning to Baton Rouge and enrolling at LSU in time for the second semester of the 2019-20 school year.

LeBlanc practiced with the Tigers during the conference part of the 2019-20 season and early on this year before becoming eligible for LSU at the end of the fall semester.

He played 14 minutes against the Bearkats, making both field goal attempts, one free throw for five points to go with eight rebounds, including four offensive boards.

He is averaging 14.6 minutes a game, 3.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.

WILKINSON IN STARTING ROLE

Freshman Mwani Wilkinson from Las Vegas got his first start of his LSU career on Dec. 6 against Louisiana Tech. Although he didn't score in the game, he played 17 minutes and had one block and two steals. His best game was against Southeastern Louisiana (11/30), scoring 12 points on 5-of-8 field goal attempts.

He scored six against Sam Houston hitting all three field goal attempts. For the year, Wilkinson is averaging 4.4 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game.

Against Nicholls he played 20 minutes with a rebound and two steals, but a +/- number of +14. After five starts, he is averaging 18.6 minutes, hitting 4.1 points and 3.4 rebounds. Of his 27 rebounds, 22 have been offense boards. He had seven points and seven rebounds in the win over Texas A&M (12/29) to open SEC play.

JALEN COOK

The Walker, Louisiana product missed the Southeastern game with a minor injury but came back against Louisiana Tech (12/6) and played 13 minutes, scoring 10 points with two assists. Cook had nine in 11 minutes against Sam Houston.

Cook is fifth on the team in scoring at 5.0 points with 1.1 rebounds and 1.4 assists. Cook played 25 minutes off the bench against Nicholls getting two field goals and 4-of-6 at the line to score eight points with four assists and two steals.

He is averaging 10.5 minutes a game.

ERIC GAINES

Eric Gaines, the freshman from Lithonia, Georgia, got his first start against Nicholls (12/6) with Javonte Smart out and played 15 minutes. While he scored just one point, Gaines had two rebounds two assists, a block and a steal.

Gaines has struggled a bit from the field at 4-of-18, but he has been able to get fouled and get to the line, making 10-of-15. He is averaging 2.4 points and 1.6 rebounds.

BPJ AWAY FROM TEAM

Coach Wade announced in the Nicholls post-game that transfer center Bryan Penn-Johnson has returned home to California.

"This is the farthest he's ever been away from home," Wade said. "He was a little homesick and has some family issues he's working through. So, we gave him some time. He won't be with us for the foreseeable future as he kind of works through those issues back home."

HOW YOUNG AND NEW IS THIS TEAM?

The Tigers are a bit on the new and young side based on research by Tom Gilbert of Kansas State prior to the season. LSU's five returning letterman makes LSU one of 25 teams that will return five letter winners or less for the 20-21 season.
