### MEDIA SESSIONS

Coach Wade meets, when travel schedules permit, usually one or two days prior to games in non-conference play and usually on Mondays and Thursdays during the SEC season. The sessions take place in the practice facility meeting room. Times are announced based on practice plans with players usually one day a week. Some travel and scheduling issues may change the time and day so media should contact the Communications Office to confirm start time ... ### POST GAME

During the current season, post-game video sessions will be done remotely on zoom links that will be distributed to the media during the course of the game. There will be separate video zooms for each team and both will be conducted after the game when coaches and players are available the 10-minute cooling off period. 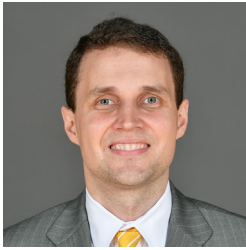

# Will Wade

Head Coach

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

## PROTIO TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

### LAST GAME: TEXAS TECH 76, LSU 71 (Baton Rouge, Jan. 30, 2021)

Just when it appeared the LSU Tigers would get a win over the 10th ranked Texas Tech Red Raiders Saturday at the Maravich Center, things turned on a dime or maybe things turned in a minute would be more accurate as Texas Tech scored 12 unanswered points in the final minutes to come from seven down to win.

LSU had a 71-64 lead on a Shareef O'Neal put back with 1:06 to play. At that point, Kenpom.com had LSU at a win percentage potential of 97.6.

Texas Tech hit a three to cut it to 71-67 with 59.6 left. LSU missed a front end of a one-and-one on its next possession and after a Tech miss, the Red Raiders on the offensive board scramble got another three to cut it to 71-70 with 31 seconds left.

After a timeout, LSU struggled to get the ball in bounds and turned it over right in front of the basket, allowing Tech to get an easy layup for a 72-71 lead with 23 seconds left.

LSU would miss two three-point attempts and Texas Tech added four free throws to end the game.

Javonte Smart for the second time in his career and first time since his freshman year posted 29 points against Texas Tech hitting 12-of-18 field goals with four treys and a free throw. Cam Thomas had 25 points and before he got hurt had 11 points and nine rebounds in 21 minutes.

LSU shot 43.1 percent (25-of-58) with nine treys and 12-of-18 free throws. Texas Tech out rebounded LSU, 41-29, and 16-10 on the offensive boards.

## TWO GAMES, TWO SHUTOUT FINISHES

The games of the final week of January for LSU brought two entirely different endings for LSU:

**At Texas A&M –** Down 66-60 with 8:20 left to play, LSU held the Aggies without a point as LSU scored the final 18 points of the game and won going away, 78-66.

**Vs. Texas Tech –** Up 71-64 with 1:06 to play, LSU did not score again as Texas Tech hit two treys and then got a turnover on a baseline inbound for an easy layup and made four free throws to win, 76-71.

## FAST STARTS FOR LSU; FAST STARTS FOR OPPONENTS

In four of last five LSU league games, the contest has been decided fairly early by fast starts – the Ole Miss and Arkansas games by LSU; the Alabama and Kentucky game by the opponents.

**LSU at Ole Miss – Jan. 9 –** Tigers jump out 11-2 with a couple of treys; LSU then gets up by a 26-7 margin with a lead of 39-21 at the half. LSU wins the game, 75-61.

**Arkansas at LSU – Jan. 13 –** LSU, down 4-0 and 7-4, goes on an 18-0 run to take a 22-7 lead and would outscore Arkansas 40-6 at one point in the half to lead 51-31 at halftime. LSU wins the game, 92-76.

**Alabama at LSU – Jan. 19 –** Alabama makes its first 8 three pointers to jump out 30-8 on LSU en route to a 60-32 halftime advantage as Tide makes 14-of-19 3s. Alabama wins the game, 105-75.

**LSU at Kentucky – Jan. 23 --** LSU got a 4-2 lead in the first 90 seconds, Kentucky went on a 15-3 run, hitting three treys to build a 17-7 advantage. UK led by 16 in the half and led 49-36 at the break.

## BUT ALSO, LATE CLOSES

The A&M game was the third time in SEC play, there was a strong finish to games by LSU that got them wins.

Vs. Georgia (Jan. 6) – Georgia lead, 80-74, with 1:57 to play ... Javonte Smart hit three-pointers with 1:44 and 1:10 to play to tie the game and force overtime ... LSU would win, 94-92.

Vs. South Carolina (Jan.16) – LSU trailed by seven with 7:47 to play, 72-64. The Tigers would outscore the Gamecocks, 21-8, to close the game to get an 85-80 victory.

Vs. A&M (Jan. 26) – The Tigers trailed 66-60 with 8:50 to go. A&M goes 0-for-15 from the field and scoreless as LSU scores 18 points in the process to win, 78-66.

## WATCH LIST UPDATES

The Basketball Hall of Fame announced last week that two LSU players were among their 10 candidates to watch for two of their starting five awards.

Cam Thomas was on their list of 10 for the Jerry West shooting guard of the year and Trendon Watford was on the list of 10 candidates for the Karl Malone Award, given to the top power forward in college basketball.

## JAVONTE SMART SET TO HIT TWO MILESTONES

After scoring 29 points and getting three steals against Texas Tech on Saturday, junior Javonte Smart is set to enter two exclusive LSU clubs possibly as early as Wednesday night.

Smart needs four points to become the 43rd LSU player to score 1,000 career points for the Tigers.

He also needs just two steals to become the 35th player in LSU history to record 100 career steals.

## SHALL WE START THE SECOND HALF

Thanks to an SEC pivot that sent LSU to Ole Miss on 24 hours notice in January instead of sitting out after road opponent Missouri couldn't play, LSU did last week complete its first half of SEC play.

As the second half officially begins, there is still no word as to what will be league's intentions for LSU's present open date on Feb. 17 when the Tigers were originally supposed to travel to Ole Miss. There is also the final Thursday-Saturday, March 4-6 when make-up games as necessary added to the schedule so LSU could possibly play Missouri then. Mizzou however has more than one make-up and that will have to be considered.

## FRESHMAN STARTS

Thanks to Tom Gilbert of Kansas State, there is a list of freshman starts and those teams starting at least two true freshmen in some games.

LSU has had 30 freshman starts in its 16 games this season and that ranks seventh in the country behind Kentucky (45), Washington State (40), Kansas State (39), North Carolina (35), Auburn (32), Duke (31) and 30.

Cam Thomas has started 16 games, Mwani Wilkinson 13 and Eric Gaines 1.

## DUOS

With Cam Thomas averaging 22.3 points and Trendon Watford 17.3, they combine to average 39.6 points per game for the Tigers. The last time LSU had a pair of players average over 17 points a game for a season was the 1988-89 season when Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf averaged 30.2 points and Ricky Blanton 20.3.

## TIGERS ADD TWO MORE 20-POINT GAMES TO LIST

After missing his first free throw against Sam Houston State on Dec. 14, Cam Thomas made his last seven of that game. That started what would be a record-breaking streak of 42 consecutive made free tosses:

It was at the 7:04 mark of the second half against UGA when Thomas made free throws No. 35 and No. 36 that he broke the LSU record for consecutive free throws made set originally by Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf during the 1989-90 season of 35.

### GETTING TO THE LINE

Both Trendon Watford and Cam Thomas continue to show the ability to draw fouls this season and it has resulted in both players picking up lots of free points at the line. Watford was fouled eight times and Thomas seven in the game against South Carolina (1/16) and both players were 9-of-10 at the free throw line. Against Alabama (1/19), both players were fouled six times and Thomas was 8-of-8 at the line.

Again, the fouls proved important in the Texas A&M game (1/26) as Watford was fouled eight times and was 5-of-7 at the line and Thomas fouled seven times and was 9-of-9 at the line. Against Texas Tech, Thomas was fouled five times, two on three-point attempts and was 10-of-11 at the line.

This season, Watford has drawn a team high 83 fouls, while Thomas has been fouled 78 times.

Thomas is first in the league in free throws made (109) and second in the NCAA (Jalen Moore of Oakland is the leader at 120). He is also first in the league in percentage at 89.3 percent (109-122). That is 26th in the nation. He is 66-of-73 in league games of 90.4 percent.

As far as best free throw percentage for a season, here are some of LSU's best to date (minimum 75 percent):

1 Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf, 1989-90 – 191-of-210 – 90.95

2 Kenny Drost, 1965-66 – 74-of-82 – 90.24

3 Eddie Palubinskas, 1972-73 – 137-of-153 – 89.54

In Watford's case, it has been a story of his LSU career as his free throw shooting percentage improved from the 50s during non-conference play as a freshman through the 70 percent range in league play. Early in SEC play, the sophomore stumbled against Georgia (1/6) missing his first six free throw attempts. Late in overtime, obviously fouled in the late stretch, Watford hit 3-of-4 to help ice the game. But afterwards, he was back on the floor still in uniform, shooting free throws working on his form.

After the shootaround on Jan. 9 in Oxford, there was a familiar site as Watford and Coach Wade walked to a basket for some free throw shooting, much like they did every game after league play a year ago. For the season, Watford is 72-of-98 or 73.5 percent.

As a team, LSU is first in the league in free throw makes at 286 and percentage at 75.9 (286-of-377). LSU is ninth in the country in makes (Ohio State first at 322) and 39th in percentage. LSU is averaging 17.9 makes a game. LSU has made 85 more free throws than opponents, 286-201, and LSU's 286 makes is 1 more than opponents have attempted in 16 games. Opponents are 201-of-285 (70.5%).

### FIVE TIMES THREE

Cam Thomas hit five treys in the win over A&M in the league opener (Dec. 29). The last player to hit five treys for LSU was Javonte Smart which happened to be in the opening win last season at Tennessee. Smart has again now become the latest to hit five treys in the win over Georgia (1/6).

### FOUR GOOD FOR SMART

Including the game against Georgia when he five, Smart has hit for at least four treys in a game seven times this season, including four of the last five games (4-of-6 vs. South Carolina, 4-of-8 vs. Alabama, 4-of-9 at Texas Tech and 4-of-7 vs. Texas Tech).

The 32 points that Thomas scored in the first meeting with A&M on Dec. 29 is tied for the most points in a game by a D1 freshman this season with Marcus Fitzgerald of Tennessee State who had 32 against SIUE on Jan. 21.

ESPN Stats & Info reported that Thomas' four consecutive 25-point games earlier in the year makes him the only SEC freshman with a four-game 25-point streak in the last 25 seasons and also the only to surpass 200 points in nine career games during that span as well.

Thomas is averaging 22.3 points a game which leads the conference and is second in the NCAA behind only Luka Garza of Iowa at 26.4 points a game heading into play on Monday. Thomas also averages 2.6 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game.

#### TIGERS SHOOTING WELL

The Tigers did not shoot well from the field in their two losses, making just 28-of-74 against Alabama (37.8%) and 25-of-65 at Kentucky (38.5%). The Tigers came back to shoot 47.2 percent in the win over Texas A&M (25-of-53). LSU is still second in the league in field goal percentage at 47.1 percent (455-of-967). Opponents are shooting 41.6 percent (420-of-1009).

LSU has shot better than 50 percent in six games:

LSU is 96-9 since the start of the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or more in a game.

Both Javonte Smart (5th, 49.1%) and Trendon Watford (6th, 48.6%) are in the top 10 of field goal percentage in the league.

#### THREE STRAIGHT 20 POINT GAMES TO START AN LSU CAREER

Cam Thomas became the first LSU player to have three games of 20 or more in his first three varsity LSU games since JC transfer Marcus Thornton did in Nov. 2007 – games of 27, 24 and 20.

Thomas' 32-point opening league game is the most by an LSU freshman since the opening game of conference play for LSU in the 2015-16 season when on Jan. 2, 2016, Ben Simmons opened his national freshman of the year campaign with 36 points at Vanderbilt in a Tiger win.

LSU's last 30-point game by any player was in the regular season finale last year when senior Marlon Taylor had 30 points against Georgia. The last LSU player to score more points than Thomas in a game was former point guard Tremont Waters, who scored 39 also against A&M in January 2019.

#### WILL WADE IN CONFERENCE GAMES

Coach Will Wade in his eighth season as a head coach has had good success in conference games in all three of his head coaching stops, winning double figure games every year except his first year at LSU.

Wade won 27 league games in two years at Chattanooga, 28 in two years at VCU and now 41 SEC games in his fourth year at LSU. Wade is presently 96-35 in league games including 41-21 at LSU. Wade was 8-10 his first season in the league, 15-2 in a conference championship team in 2019 (He did not coach the final game of the 2019 season,) and, 12-6 and tying for second in 2020. This season the Tigers are 6-3 halfway through the league season.

#### WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

Trendon Watford continued his strong sophomore season with his second double double of the campaign and the ninth of his LSU career at Kentucky (1/23). Watford equaled his career high with 26 points and 10 boards. His first double of the year came against Arkansas (1/13) when Watford went 23-10.

Watford has had eight 20-point games this season, including in four of the past six games:

24 – at St. Louis, 11/28/20

The sophomore struggled in the SEC/Big 12 challenge with just four points before fouling out, hitting just 2-of-11 shots.

Watford, from Birmingham, averaged 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds as a freshman and for the 2021 season is averaging 17.3 points and 7.1 rebounds to go with a good 3.5 assists average.

Watford is second on the team in scoring, rebounding and assists.

Watford is all over the SEC statistics leaders showing fifth in scoring, seventh in rebounds, sixth in field goal percentage (48.6%), eighth in assists, second in defensive rebound average at 5.5 a game and fourth in minutes played average (33.8).

#### JAVONTE SMART

We've talked about Javonte Smart's ability to shoot threes and it was his two threes in the final two minutes of the game against Georgia (Jan. 6) that allowed LSU to come from six down to force overtime in the eventual LSU win.

Smart is averaging 15.5 points, 3.4 rebounds and 4.1 assists per game. He leads the league at 44.6 percent from beyond the arc (41-of-92). He is second in the league in three-point field goals made 2.7 a contest.

Against A&M he posted nine assists, the second highest in his three-year career at LSU.

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play last year. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 20 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league.

Smart this season is at a 1.62 assist to turnover margin overall and that is fifth in the league. He is eighth in the league in scoring and fifth in field goal percentage.

#### SMART EQUALS CAREER HIGH VS. TEXAS TECH

Against Texas Tech on Saturday, Javonte Smart equaled the career high of 29 points he set against Tennessee his freshman campaign. It was his fourth game of 20 points or more this season:

### LSU BETTER THIS YEAR OUTSIDE THE ARC

Against Texas A&M in the second meeting (1/26), LSU hit for double figure three-pointers for the fourth time this year:

**Vs. SIUE (Nov. 26) – 12 three-pointers**

**Vs. Southeastern (Nov. 30) – 13 three-pointers**

**Vs. Georgia (Dec 6) – 10 three-pointers**

**At Texas A&M (Jan. 26) – 10 three-pointers**

LSU got 10 in the last games but in the previous two games combined (losses to Alabama and Kentucky), LSU was able to hit only nine three-pointers (9-of-49 combined). For the year, LSU is 130-of-379 or 34.3 percent.

LSU is sixth in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage and fifth in three-pointers made per game at 8.1. LSU is tied for third in 3-point field goal percentage defense at 30.4 percent (144-of-474).

LSU's 130 makes are 14 less than opponents that have taken 95 more attempts.

### SHAREEF O'NEAL

For the first time since league play began, Shareef O'Neal was able to return to play for LSU against Alabama (1/19). O'Neal had been out since the weekend before conference play began on Dec. 29 after suffering a right foot injury in practice.

O'Neal played 15 minutes against Alabama and was 2-of-4 from the field with two free throws to finish with 6 points, five rebounds and two steals. Against Kentucky, O'Neal played almost 10 minutes, hitting 1-of-2 shots to finish with two points, two rebounds and one steal.

He played 10 minutes against Texas A&M and was in on some of the defensive stops for the Tigers during the 18-0 run and made two free throws to help the final number. He had a season high 21 minutes against Texas Tech (1/30) with two points and six rebounds (offensive). He would be one of the two options to replace Darius Days in the starting lineup against Alabama Wednesday.

O'Neal has appeared in nine games this season and is averaging 3.0 points and 4.6 rebounds.

### FATHERS AND SONS

Shareef O'Neal brings an addition to the list of Fathers and Sons who have been a part of the LSU men's basketball program over the years.

O'Neal is wearing 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice – 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

### SERIES AGAINST ALABAMA

This will be the second meeting of the year against Alabama with the Tide winning, 105-75, in Baton Rouge two weeks ago after making a league record 23 three-pointers in the contest. Cam Thomas scored 21, Javonte Smart 12 and Trendon Watford 11 for LSU in the game.

Alabama also lost Saturday in its SEC/Big 12 Challenge, falling 66-61, at Oklahoma. Alabama is 14-4 and 9-0 in the SEC. John Petty Jr., leads the team along with Jaden Shackelford at 13.6 points per game. Herbert Jones is at 12.6 points and Jahvon Quinerly at 11.2 a contest.

Nate Oats is in his second year in Tuscaloosa.

### ON THE ROAD

The Tigers are 2-3 on the road this season, 2-2 in the SEC. Overall, LSU is 434-646 (.402). In Coach Wade's four years, the Tigers are 19-18 in true road games.

### AGAINST RANKED TEAMS

LSU stands at 83-264 against teams ranked in the AP poll, and 3-11 all-time against teams ranked No. 10 in the poll. LSU's last win against a team ranked 10th was on Dec. 19, 2011, when LSU defeated Marquette, 67-59, in the Maravich Center.

LSU's last win against a top-10 ranked team came in 2019 when LSU, ranked No. 13, down No. 5 Tennessee, 82-80, in overtime on Feb. 23, 2019.

### SMART TOPS 100 THREE-POINTERS

It was at the 6:01 mark of the first half against Sam Houston (12/14) when Javonte Smart made his first three-pointer of the game and that gave him 100 for his LSU career (now 128 total). He became the 23rd player in LSU history with 100 career treys. Darrel Mitchell, who played for the 2006 Final Four team, is the team's all-time leader in three-pointers at 258, while Tremont Waters (2017-19) was the one prior to Smart to cross the 100 threshold, finishing at 128.

Smart and Waters are tied at 128 career three-pointers at 14th on LSU's all-time list.

### DARIUS DAYS

Days was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

So far this season, the junior from Raleigh, Florida is fourth on the team in scoring at 12.1 points and 7.9 boards. He is fourth in rebound average in the league.

### DARIUS DAYS DOUBLES

Days was heading for another double double when he got hurt in the Texas Tech game halting his game at 11 points



and nine rebounds.

His last double figure rebound game had come against Arkansas (1/13) when he pulled down a season high 13 rebounds.

It was part of his fourth double double of the season as Days scored 18 points. His other doubles came against Sam Houston State, A&M and 13 against Georgia.

Days with his four double doubles this year, gives him a total of 12 for his three years at LSU.

Keyontae Johnson of Florida leads "active" SEC players with 13 career double doubles with Days with 12 for his career and Jeremiah Tilmon of Missouri the only other player in double figures at 11.

#### JOSH LEBLANC

The transfer from Georgetown could be in the starting lineup depending on how the Tigers want to go against Alabama if Darius Days cannot go.

LeBlanc has been at LSU since last January 2020 chomping at the bit for the chance to play college basketball again. He returned to play against Sam Houston State (12/14) back in his hometown.

The Baton Rouge native spent a season and a half at Georgetown playing for the Hoyas before returning to Baton Rouge and enrolling at LSU in time for the second semester of the 2019-20 school year.

And, after the Jan. 26 game, he has a No. 1 SportsCenter play to show for his efforts this season after his dunk in the first half against the Aggies.

He played 14 minutes against the Bearcats, making both field goal attempts, one free throw for five points to go with eight rebounds, including four offensive boards.

Against Georgia, LeBlanc scored two points in 16 minutes but had a block and five steals in the contest.

In the win at Ole Miss (1/9), LeBlanc hit his one field goal attempted but contributed in other ways with five rebounds, an assist and three blocks in 21 minutes. He had four points against South Carolina in 23 minutes, hitting both field goal attempts.

Against Alabama (1/19), LeBlanc played 18 minutes, hitting all three field goal attempts, scoring six points with a season high six rebounds.

He is averaging 16.8 minutes a game and his totals are 2.4 points and 3.8 rebounds a game. He is 13-of-19 from the field (68.4%).

#### MWANI WILKINSON

Freshman Mwani Wilkinson from Las Vegas got his first start of his LSU career on Dec. 6 against Louisiana Tech and has remained there since provided his own moments and helping on the offensive boards. His first big game was against Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 30, scoring 12 points on 5-of-8 field goal attempts.

Wilkinson had his first double figure game in the SEC against Arkansas (1/13) hitting 4-of-4 field goals his first three-pointer and two free throws to finish with 11 points to go with six rebounds and two steals. Against South Carolina (1/16), Wilkinson was again a perfect 2-of-2 from the field, scoring five points, with three rebounds and two assists.

Wilkinson was 3-of-4 against Alabama in the first meeting for six points to go with three rebounds.

Wilkinson is averaging 4.4 points and 3.4 rebounds.

#### JALEN COOK

The Walker, Louisiana product missed the Southeastern game with a minor injury but came back against Louisiana Tech (12/6) and played 13 minutes, scoring 10 points with two assists. Cook had nine in 11 minutes against Sam Houston.

Cook is averaging 3.5 points with 0.9 rebounds. Cook played 25 minutes off the bench against Nicholls (12/26) getting two field goals and 4-of-6 at the line to score eight points with four assists and two steals. He is averaging 8.8 minutes a game.

#### ERIC GAINES

When it came time for someone to move in and keep the offensive flow going when Cam Thomas went out against Ole Miss (1/9), Lithonia, Georgia freshman Eric Gaines moved in and played 28 minutes in the game. He scored a season high 10 points with two rebounds, two assists and four steals.

Gaines played 14 minutes against Arkansas (1/13) with three points and an assist.

Gaines, who is averaging 2.4 points, 1.3 rebounds and 1.2 assists a game, had one of his best shooting nights from the field hitting 3-of-7 field goals and 2-of-3 long-range attempts against the Rebels. That gives him three makes for the season from distance.

Gaines got his first start against Nicholls (12/6) with Javonte Smart out and played 15 minutes. While he scored just one point, Gaines had two rebounds two assists, a block and a steal.

#### AUNDRE HYATT

Against Georgia (1/6), Hyatt played seven minutes, hitting 3-of-5 shots to score six points with three offensive rebounds and an assist. He followed that up at Ole Miss (1/9) with a 2-of-4 shooting night with five rebounds in 17 minutes. Hyatt played 10 minutes against Arkansas (1/13) with two field goals including a trey to total 5 points. Hyatt played 11:30 against South Carolina (1/16).

For the season, he is averaging 3.9 points and 2.5 rebounds. He played 13 minutes vs. Alabama and hit 3-of-4 shots to score six points with six rebounds, four offensive.

#### ANNIVERSARY YEAR

In this strange COVID season, LSU has three anniversaries it will salute at halftime of its February games through videos. This is the 40th anniversary of the 1981 NCAA Final Four team which started the league 17-0 before losing on the final day of the regular season at Rupp Arena to Kentucky. This is the 35th anniversary of the 1986 NCAA Final Four team which at that time was the first 11 seed to ever qualify for the Final Four. It also was the last team to host and play on its home floor in the first two rounds of the NCAA Tournament when it defeated Purdue and Memphis at the then LSU Assembly Center.

It is also the 15th anniversary of the 2006 NCAA Final Four team which became Louisiana's team in the first basketball season after Hurricane Katrina. The Tigers comprised of kids all from the Baton Rouge area with the exception of point guard Darrel Mitchell, who hailed from just down I-10 in St. Martinville.

Coach Dale Brown was in charge of the 1981 and 1986 teams and John Brady was head coach of the team in 2006, which included now assistant coach Tasmin Mitchell. Coach Brady will be on the call, although remotely, in the LSU Athletics third floor radio broadcast location, with Chris Blair of today's game.

#### 50 POINT HALVES

The 51 points scored against Arkansas on Jan. 13 marked the ninth time in the Will Wade era that LSU has scored 50 points in the first half of a game. The Tigers are 9-0 when that happens and it marked the third time the Tigers have scored 50 in a half:

- Nov. 10, 2017 – Alcorn State (W, 99-59) – 51 first-half points
- Dec. 10, 2017 – UNC Wilmington (W, 97-84) – 52 first-half points
- Dec. 22, 2017 – North Florida (W, 104-52) – 54 first-half points

- Jan. 12, 2019 – at Arkansas (W, 94-88, ot) – 50 first-half points

5 -- LSU quickly schedules Sam Houston State for a game on Dec. 14. Associate Head Coach Bill Armstrong coaches the game solo as Coach Will Wade announced earlier in the day he had tested positive for Covid-19.

6 -- LSU announces postponements against UNO (Dec. 16), North Texas (Dec. 19) and VCU (Dec. 22) because of SEC and NCAA protocols regarding Covid.

7 -- LSU on Dec. 21 schedules Texas Southern for a Dec. 26 game.

8 -- On Dec. 24, Texas Southern has to withdraw because of NCAA Covid-19 protocols. That evening, Nicholls signs a contract to come to Baton Rouge for a game on Dec. 26.

9 -- LSU opens SEC play as scheduled on Dec. 29 playing Texas A&M.

10 -- LSU is scheduled to play Missouri, Jan. 9; Conference announces at 1 p.m. on Jan. 8 that the LSU game at Missouri postponed; LSU travels to Oxford for a Jan. 9 game at Ole Miss instead of as scheduled on Feb. 17 as Ole Miss' game with South Carolina is also postponed for that date.
