SEC TELECONFERENCE

MEDIA SESSIONS

Coach Wade meets, when travel schedules permit, usually one or two days prior to games in non-conference play and usually on Mondays and Thursdays during the SEC season. The sessions take place in the practice facility meeting room. Times are announced based on practice plans with players usually one day a week. Some travel and scheduling issues may change the time and day so media should contact the Communications Office to confirm start time ... Player requests need to be in to Kent Lowe at clowe@lsu.edu no later than 24 hours in advance.

POST GAME

During the current season, post-game video sessions will be done remotely on zoom links that will be distributed to the media during the course of the game. There will be separate video zooms for each team and both will be conducted after the game when coaches and players are available the 10-minute cooling off period. Both home and away, Coach Wade will conduct his radio post-game show before beginning his zoom session with media on hand for the game and admitted remotely.

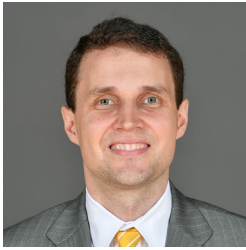

4th Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

The buzz word when Will Wade arrived at LSU was consistency.

He wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

A team with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

His players would represent the University in a positive way both on and off the court.

Completing his third season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tiger basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In three years, the Tigers have won 67 games with two post-season appearances (and what would have been a third before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019 and a tie for second in 2020. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018 and to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships.

In 2019, Coach Wade, his staff and players put together a team that posted a 16-2 record in the Southeastern Conference, winning the 11th regular season title in school history. In three seasons, the Tigers have won 36 games in league play.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first LSU mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first three seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

This past season that non-conference schedule helped LSU open with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

LSU was 8-1 in league play at the Maravich Center with a two-point win over Arkansas, a one-point win over Mississippi State (on a Skylar Mays buzzer beating jump shot) and a two-point win over Florida. LSU also won by four points at Texas A&M in overtime after rallying from six down in the final two minutes of regulation.

It was a season in which offense dominated the nights when LSU had success, averaging 80.5 points a game, marking the second straight year LSU averaged 80 points a game (80.4 in 2019) and the first time LSU has averaged over 80 points a game since the 1991 and 1992 seasons.

Four-year star Skylar Mays earned first-team All-SEC honors and showed his ability off the court earning his third College Sports Information Directors Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America honor in 2020. He

was a second-team Academic A-A in 2018 and a first-team Academic A-A in both 2019 and 2020. The Baton Rouge native was named the CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year for D1 men's basketball.

The highlight of Wade's three years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer.

As good as the players were in November when the season started, the team showed improvement from start to finish and that was all due to Coach Wade and his staff and the work that was put in on the court, in the video room, in scouting reports and so much more.

So far in three seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 18 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/now NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

In the first three years, the Tigers have drawn five crowds that are in the top 12 single game attendances in the present seating configuration of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

Three member of the 2019 championship team – Tremont Waters, Naz Reid and Kavell Bigby-Williams – played in the NBA and G-Leagues in 2020.

Waters was a first-team All-SEC selection and the co-SEC Defensive Player of the Year while Reid made the league all-freshman team.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 36, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded.

PROF TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016. In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years. The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the 2Atlantic 10 Conference regular season crown. The 2017 team won 26

games and finished second in the league.

Wade previously served at VCU as an assistant with the Rams under Shaka Smart from 2009-13. He was part of the staff in 2011 when VCU advanced from the NCAA "First Four" all the way to the Final Four in Houston.

Wade is credited with being a key figure in four top non-power five recruiting classes in his four seasons at VCU.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 (15-3 in league) as Wade guided UTC to its first 20-win season since 2004-05.

In his seven years as a head coach, he has a combined record of 155-75 and 90-33 in conference play with five post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

He served as an assistant to Tommy Amaker at Harvard in 2007-08 and 2008-09. Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05). There he worked for coaches Larry Shyatt (2002-03) and Oliver Purnell (2004-07).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (3).

Bryan-Penn Johnson and Shareef O'Neal received NCAA waivers to be eligible ... Josh LeBlanc became eligible and played in his first game on Dec. 14 against Sam Houston State ... Trendon Watford did not play with a minor ankle injury against Sam Houston (12/14) ... Javonte Smart did not play against Nicholls (12/26) because of Covid protocols ... Bryan Penn-Johnson left the team at Christmas break ... Charles Manning Jr., entered transfer portal (1/7) ... Shareef O'Neal out with boot on right foot since SEC play started ... Returned vs. Alabama (1/19) ... Darius Days injured left ankle 2nd half vs. Texas Tech (1/30), missed Alabama (2/3); returned at Miss. State (2/10) ... Mwani Wilkinson (non COVID-19 illness) and Shareef O'Neal (foot) did not travel to MSU (2/10) ... Wilkinson returned for Tennessee ... O'Neal return still questionable.

LAST GAME: LSU 104, AUBURN 80 (Baton Rouge, Feb. 20, 2021)

For the third straight game, the Tigers responded with a strong performance, scoring 50 in the first half, 54 in the second half to score over 100 for the first time in an SEC game since 1994.

The Tigers fell behind 5-0 but used a 13-0 run to get the lead five minutes in and never looked back. Cam Thomas led LSU with 27 points, making three treys and 10-of-11 free throws. LSU had balanced scoring with Trendon Watford getting 18 points (11 rebounds), Darius Days 17 points (4 treys) and Javonte Smart 16 points (4 treys, 6 assists).

Transfer Josh LeBlanc had his first LSU college double double making all six field goals with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

For the third straight game, LSU shot over 50 percent, 53.4 percent (39-73) with 11 treys (11-of-22) and 15-of-22 free throws. Auburn was 27-of-73 (37.0%) with seven treys (7-28) and 91-of-22 at the line. LSU out rebounded Auburn, 47-39.

It was the quintet of Smart, Watford, LeBlanc, Thomas and Aundre Hyatt that outscored Auburn, 24-9, from 18:45 to 12:37 in the first half that gave the Tigers the commanding advantage in the contest.

LSU scored on 47-of-76 possessions (1.368 points per possession), while Auburn was 37-of-76 (1.053 points per possession).

100 PT GAMES

While it was 1994 that LSU last scored 100 in an SEC game, it was a regulation loss in March 1994 to Arkansas, 108-105. To find the last time LSU scored 100 in regulation you have to go back to February 1992, in a 100-69 win over Ole Miss.

Since that loss to Arkansas in 1994, LSU has won 18 straight games when scoring 100 points in a game. LSU is 103-8 when it scores 100 or more all-time. LSU has won 41-of-the-last-42 games when scoring 100 or more. It was the fourth time in the Will Wade era that the Tigers have scored 100 points.

LOOKING BACK AT THE LAST THREE GAMES

Over the last three games, the Tigers won at Mississippi State, 94-80; No. 16 Tennessee, 78-65; and, Auburn, 104-80.

In the three games, the Tigers are 104-of-187 from the field (55.6%) including 28-of-65 from three-point range (43.1%). LSU was 40-of-51 from the line (78.4%).

Opponents similarly are 79-of-191 (41.3 percent), 24-of-79 from the arc (30.4 percent).

Some other numbers: Darius Days is 6-of-10 each of the last three games (18-of-30) ... He is also 10-of-19 for the three games from the arc ... Javonte Smart in the three games is 22-of-34 overall and 7-of-13 from the arc with 19 assists.

While Days is 6-of-10 each game, Trendon Watford shot 50 percent in each of the three games (7-14 vs. Miss. State, 4-8 vs. Tennessee, 8-16 vs. Auburn) ... Cam Thomas took 16 shots in each of the three games with 22 makes. He was 8-of-21 from distance and 25-of-27 at the line.

NUMBERS YOU HAVE TO LOOK FOR

It is the numbers of LSU's big four that stand out, but you have to look as well at the play of people like Aundre Hyatt, Josh LeBlanc and Eric Gaines.

Hyatt, in three starts in the last three games, has scored 21 points combined with 16 rebounds, including five offensive rebounds versus Auburn.

LeBlanc, had eight points against Mississippi State, going 4-of-4 from the field. Against Auburn, LeBlanc was 6-of-6 from the field for 12 points to go with 10 boards. LeBlanc has had 5 blocks in the three games.

Gaines has had eight assists off the bench in the three games with four steals.

SO HOW IT HAS BEEN SO FAR –

Here's how the season has rolled so far as far as scheduling as concerned itself:

1 -- LSU was scheduled to play San Fran, Western Kentucky and Saint Louis in Lincoln, Nebraska in the Golden Window Classic, Nov. 25, 26 and 28.

2 -- Saint Louis elected to stay in Saint Louis and invited LSU to join them for the Billiken Classic where LSU played SIUE and Saint Louis, Nov. 26 and 28.

3 -- To replace the third game that would have been played in Nebraska, LSU scheduled Southeastern for a game played, Nov. 30.

4 -- LSU pulls out of a game with South Florida in Atlanta at Holiday Hoopsgiving Dec. 12 because of SEC and NCAA Covid protocols involving the LSU team.

5 -- LSU quickly schedules Sam Houston State for a game on Dec. 14. Associate Head Coach Bill Armstrong coaches the game solo as Coach Will Wade announced earlier in the day he had tested positive for Covid-19.

6 -- LSU announces postponements against UNO (Dec. 16), North Texas (Dec. 19) and VCU (Dec. 22) because of SEC and NCAA protocols regarding Covid.

7 -- LSU on Dec. 21 schedules Texas Southern for a Dec. 26 game.

8 -- On Dec. 24, Texas Southern has to withdraw because of NCAA Covid-19 protocols. That evening, Nicholls signs a contract to come to Baton Rouge for a game on Dec. 26.

9 -- LSU opens SEC play as scheduled on Dec. 29 playing Texas A&M.

10 -- LSU is scheduled to play Missouri, Jan. 9; Conference announces at 1 p.m. on Jan. 8 that the LSU game at Missouri postponed; LSU travels to Oxford for a Jan. 9 game at Ole Miss instead of as scheduled on Feb. 17 as Ole Miss' game with South Carolina is also postponed for that date.

11 -- LSU's scheduled home game with Florida, Feb. 6, is postponed mid-morning on Feb. 5 because of Covid issues with the Florida program.

12 -- SEC announces after moving the LSU game at Ole Miss to Jan. 9 that the teams will meet on Feb. 17 (then Feb. 18) in Oxford again. Game part of three men's postponements on Feb. 18 due to weather conditions.

THE ROAD WARRIORS

After LSU played Alabama on Jan. 19, LSU would not play another home Southeastern Conference game until Saturday's Feb. 13 game against Tennessee.

LSU had four-straight SEC road games in between in which LSU went 2-2 over the four games. LSU played at Kentucky on Jan. 23, at Texas A&M on Jan. 26, Alabama on Feb. 3 and at Mississippi State (Feb. 10).

That was the first time LSU played four SEC games in succession on the road since the 1972 season (Dale Brown's first year) when LSU faced Alabama, Auburn, Georgia and Florida all on the road from Jan. 6 through Jan. 22. LSU is now 3-3 in the league on the road.

SO HOW DOES THIS ALL WORK OUT IN THE BIG PICTURE

With a postponement already announced for Tuesday, here are game totals heading to this week:

Georgia is the only team to have played on all 15 dates scheduled
Alabama, Auburn, Kentucky, Ole Miss, Miss. State, Tennessee have played on 14 dates.
Arkansas, LSU and Missouri have played on 13 dates.
Florida, Vanderbilt, South Carolina have played on 12 dates.
Texas A&M has played eight games.

LSU with the postponement of the Ole Miss game on Feb. 18, now has at least one road game and a home game to be made up. The original Jan. postponement was at Missouri. Who the road replacement will be remains to be seen. LSU lost a home game with Florida in early February. Everything would remain to be seen it appears.

ALABAMA AND THE REST

As we move part the last week of February, Alabama has a 3.5 game lead in the standings with a 13-1 record over Arkansas and LSU at 9-4. Florida is 1.5 games behind LSU and Arkansas for the fourth spot (two games down in the win column).

The top four teams receive the double bye for the SEC Tournament in March in Nashville. Florida is 1 game ahead of Tennessee (who has played two more games). Missouri is one game down in the loss column to Florida and

WATCH LIST UPDATES

The Basketball Hall of Fame announced earlier this month that two LSU players were among their 10 candidates to watch for two of their starting five awards.

Cam Thomas was on their list of 10 for the Jerry West shooting guard of the year and Tendon Watford was on the list of 10 candidates for the Karl Malone Award, given to the top power forward in college basketball.

Thomas was also listed on the mid-season team selected by the Naismith Trophy.

JAVONTE SMART HITS TWO MILESTONES

It didn't take long for Javonte Smart to get one of his milestones he was trying to hit at Alabama (2/3) as he became the 43rd player in LSU basketball history to become a member of the 1,000-point club. He needed four points entering the game and finished with 14. He has already moved up to 39th place and needs two points to move into 38th on the school list. He enters the game with 1,068 points.

He also had the two steals he had to get to become the 35th player in LSU history to record 100 career steals.

He is the 13th player in LSU history to record at least 1,000 points-200 assists and 100 steals in his career in Baton Rouge.

TIGERS 20-POINT GAME LIST

It only took through 15 games for LSU to equal the 22 times that players scored 20 or more in 31 games last year. This year the total is up to 30: 15 by Cam Thomas, 8 by Tendon Watford, 6 by Javonte Smart and 1 by Darius Days. The breakdown:

Cam Thomas has now recorded six consecutive games over 20 points, the first to reach six straight over 20 since Antonio Blakeney had six consecutive 20-point games in the month of February 2017.

AVERAGING 20 POINTS A GAME

Cameron Thomas now that he has played 20 games has at the moment become the 20th player at LSU to average 20 points or more. That last player to average 20 points for a season for LSU was senior Marcus Thornton, who averaged 21.1 points for 35 games in 2009.

LET'S TALK FREE THROWS, MANY IN SUCCESSION

After missing his first free throw against Sam Houston State on Dec. 14, Cam Thomas made his last seven of that game. That started what would be a record-breaking streak of 42 consecutive made free tosses:

Sam Houston State (Dec. 14) -- last 7

Nicholls (Dec. 26) -- 7

Texas A&M (Dec. 29) -- 3

At Florida (Jan. 2) -- 11

Georgia (Jan. 6) -- first 14 (before a miss in the first of a two-shot to finish 15-16 for the game)

It was at the 7:04 mark of the second half against UGA when Thomas made free throws No. 35 and No. 36 that he broke the LSU record for consecutive free throws made set originally by Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf during the 1989-90 season of 35.

Thomas had made 25 in a row on a current streak before missing the final free throw of a 10-of-11 day against Auburn (2/20).

GETTING TO THE LINE

Both Tendon Watford and Cam Thomas continue to show the ability to draw fouls this season and it has resulted in both players picking up lots of free points at the line. Watford was fouled eight times and Thomas seven in the game

against South Carolina (1/16) and both players were 9-of-10 at the free throw line. Against Alabama (1/19), both players were fouled six times and Thomas was 8-of-8 at the line.

Again, the fouls proved important in the Texas A&M game (1/26) as Watford was fouled eight times and was 5-of-7 at the line and Thomas fouled seven times and was 9-of-9 at the line.

Thomas was fouled eight times in the Tennessee game (2/13) and six times in the Auburn game (2/20) and was 21-of-22 combined at the line.

After the Auburn game, Thomas leads the team in fouls drawn at 101 (5.05 a game) with Watford at 98 for the season (4.9 a game).

Thomas is first in the league in free throws made (138) and second in the NCAA (Jalen Moore of Oakland is the leader at 154). He is also first in the league in percentage at 90.2 percent (138-153). That is 13th in the nation. He is 95-of-104 in league games of 91.3 percent.

As far as best free throw percentage for a season, here are some of LSU's best to date (minimum 75 percent):

As a team, LSU is second in the league in free throw makes at 342 and first in percentage at 76.0 (342-450). LSU is 14th in the country in makes and 37th in percentage. LSU is averaging 17.1 makes a game. LSU has made 92 more free throws than opponents, 342-250. Opponents are 250-of-346 (72.3%).

FIVE TIMES THREE

Cam Thomas hit five treys in the win over A&M in the league opener (Dec. 29). The last player to hit five treys for LSU was Javonte Smart which happened to be in the opening win last season at Tennessee. Smart has again now become the latest to hit five treys in the win over Georgia (1/6).

The 32 points that Thomas scored in the first meeting with A&M on Dec. 29 is tied for the most points in a game by a D1 freshman this season with Marcus Fitzgerald of Tennessee State who had 32 against SIUE on Jan. 21.

Thomas is averaging 22.8 points a game which leads the conference and is fourth in the NCAA. He also averages 2.9 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game.

ESPN STATS AND INFO WITH SOME DATA

ESPN Stats & Info reported earlier this season that when Cam Thomas had four consecutive 25-point games earlier in the year it made him the only SEC freshman with a four-game 25-point streak in the last 25 seasons and also the only to surpass 200 points in nine career games during that span as well.

But, Jared Berson, a researcher for ESPN Stats and Info tweeted that with his 12th 25-point or more game against Auburn (2/20), Cam Thomas has recorded the most 25-point games by an SEC freshman in the one-and-done era. That began in 2006.

TIGERS SHOOTING

LSU is first in the league in field goal percentage at 47.5 percent (579-of-1219). Opponents are shooting 41.9 percent (532-of-1269). LSU is 36th in the nation in field goal percentage.

LSU is 99-9 since the start of the 2007-08 season when shooting 50 percent or more in a game. The Mississippi State game (2/10) marked the fourth time in the Will Wade era that the Tigers shot over 60 percent in a game.

The Tigers' 39 field goals made in the Auburn game (2/20) is tied for third best in the Will Wade era at LSU.

Both Javonte Smart (3rd, 50.0%) and Trendon Watford (7th, 47.4%) are in the top 10 of field goal percentage in the league.

Cam Thomas, Trendon Watford and Javonte Smart are all in the league top ten in field goals made. Thomas is second in the league at 136 with Smart at 112 field goals in eighth and Watford at 110 in ninth.

WILL WADE IN CONFERENCE GAMES

Coach Will Wade in his eighth season as a head coach has had good success in conference games in all three of his head coaching stops, winning double figure games every year except his first year at LSU.

Wade won 27 league games in two years at Chattanooga, 28 in two years at VCU and now 44 SEC games in his fourth year at LSU. Wade is presently 99-36 in league games including 44-22 at LSU. Wade was 8-10 his first season in the league, 15-2 in a conference championship team in 2019 (He did not coach the final game of the 2019 season.) and,

WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

Trendon Watford posted his third double double of the campaign and the 10th of his LSU career vs. Auburn (2/20) when he made 8-of-16 field goals and two free throws for 18 points and 11 rebounds. Last month he had a 26-10 double double at Kentucky (1/23), equaling his career high in points. His first double of the year came against Arkansas (1/13) when he went 23-10.

Watford has had eight 20-point games this season:

Watford, from Birmingham, averaged 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds as a freshman and for the 2021 season is averaging 16.3 points and 6.9 rebounds to go with a good 3.2 assists average.

Against Mississippi State (2/10), Watford finally got back in double figures with 14 points, hitting 7-of-14 field goal attempts. He followed that up with his 18 points against Auburn (2/20).

Watford is second on the team in scoring, rebounding and assists.

Watford is all over the SEC statistics leaders showing sixth in scoring, seventh in rebounds, seventh in field goal percentage (47.4%), second in defensive rebound average at 5.3 a game and fourth in minutes played average (33.9).

JAVONTE SMART

When the LSU offense is running smooth one of the components is either Javonte Smart and/or Trendon Watford distributing the basketball. Not only was Smart distributing the ball against Mississippi State (2/10), he was scoring a lot as well.

Against the Bulldogs, Smart was a crisp 8-of-10 from the field, including 2-of-3 from the arc and 4-of-4 from the free throw line for 22 points. He had a career high 11 assists as he recorded his second points-assists double double. He had a 13-10 double in the season finale of 2020 against Georgia. Eight of the 11 assists came in the second half when LSU scored 53 points and shot 65 percent from the field.

It was probably one of his most standout performances since his two threes in the final two-minutes of the game against Georgia (Jan. 6) that allowed LSU to come from six down to force overtime in the eventual LSU win.

He followed it up against Tennessee (2/13) scoring 20 points, hitting 8-of-13 shots with a three pointer and 3-of-3 at the line. It was his fifth consecutive game in double figures.

That figure reached six straight as he got 16 points and six assists in the Auburn win (2/20).

Smart is averaging 16.1 points, 3.5 rebounds and 4.2 assists per game. He leads the league at 45.0 percent from beyond the arc (50-of-111). He is second in the league in three-point field goals made 2.6 a contest.

At Texas A&M he posted nine assists, which is now his third highest assist total in his three-year career at LSU.

Smart ended up with wonderful assist-to-turnover numbers and much of that came in league play last year. In his first five games last year, Smart had 25 assists and 26 turnovers. He finished the season with 129 total assists and 70 turnovers. For the last 26 games of the season, he posted a 2.93 assist-to-turnover ratio. For the entire 31 games season, Smart's 129-70 assist-to-turnover ratio was 1.84, fourth in the league.

In the 18 SEC games, Smart was equally as impressive with 65 assists and 31 turnovers (2.10 ratio) which was tops in the league.

Smart this season is at a 1.51 assist to turnover margin overall and that is third in the league. He is eighth in the league in scoring, third in field goal percentage and fourth in assists average.

SMART EQUALS CAREER HIGH VS. TEXAS TECH

Against Texas Tech (1/30), Javonte Smart equaled the career high of 29 points he set against Tennessee his freshman campaign. It was his fourth game of 20 points or more this season:

For the year, LSU is 162-of-461 or 35.1 percent. LSU is fourth in the SEC in three-point field goal percentage and fourth in three-pointers made per game at 8.1. LSU is second in 3-point field goal percentage defense at 30.2 percent (174-of-577).

LSU's 162 makes are 12 less than opponents that have taken 118 more attempts.

SHAREEF O'NEAL

Problems with his foot has kept him out for the most part in the conference season and specialists are trying to figure out the situation as O'Neal tries to get back on court before the end of the year.

For the first time since league play began, Shareef O'Neal was able to return to play for LSU against Alabama (1/19). O'Neal had been out since the weekend before conference play began on Dec. 29 after suffering a right foot injury in practice.

He has missed the last two games as specialists continue to look at his foot which has continued to bother

him.

O'Neal played 15 minutes against Alabama in the first meeting and was 2-of-4 from the field with two free throws to finish with 6 points, five rebounds and two steals. Against Kentucky, O'Neal played almost 10 minutes, hitting 1-of-2 shots to finish with two points, two rebounds and one steal.

He played 10 minutes against Texas A&M and was in on some of the defensive stops for the Tigers during the 18-0 run and made two free throws to help the final number. He had a season high 21 minutes against Texas Tech (1/30) with two points and six rebounds (offensive).

O'Neal has appeared in 10 games this season and is averaging 2.8 points and 4.4 rebounds.

FATHERS AND SONS

Shareef O'Neal brings an addition to the list of Fathers and Sons who have been a part of the LSU men's basketball program over the years.

O'Neal is wearing 32 this year and there are a number of things to consider with this number choice – 1) His dad wore No. 32 when he was the center for the Orlando Magic in the first stop on his NBA career and later with the Miami Heat and Phoenix Suns; 2) The younger O'Neal was very close to the late Kobe Bryant and of course Kobe's two NBA numbers were 8 and 24 which also add up to 32.

The younger O'Neal has made two three-pointers which is two more than his dad made in his three years at LSU.

SERIES AGAINST GEORGIA

LSU has won four straight games in the series and leads, 67-47, in a series that first began in Athens in 1920.

The teams are meeting twice for the second time in the last three seasons. LSU defeated Georgia, 94-92, in overtime in the first meeting back on Jan. 6. Javonte Smart made two three-pointers in the final two minutes when LSU was down six points that got the game to overtime.

Cam Thomas led LSU with 26 points, hitting 15-of-16 free throws in the first game. Javonte Smart had 21 points with five treys and six steals. Darius Days had 13 points and 11 rebounds, while Trendon Watford had 17 points.

Georgia leads in games played in Athens, 28-22.

Sahvir Wheeler leads the Bulldogs at 14.1 points a game. K.D. Johnson is at 13.3 points and Toumani Camara is at 12.4 a game.

Tom Crean is in his third year as the head coach at Georgia.

ROAD TRIPPING

With both games on the road this week, LSU is 3-4 overall and 3-3 in the SEC this year. In Will Wade's four seasons, LSU is 20-19 on opponents' home court.

SMART AND DAYS NOW OVER 100 THREE-POINTERS

In the course of the season, now two players have topped 100 career treys for LSU. On Dec. 14, against Sam Houston, Javonte Smart made his 100 career three-pointer. Smart has already moved to 14th on the list with 137 threes.

On Feb. 20 against Auburn, Darius Days' first three-pointer of his four made his the 24th player in LSU history to record 100 career three-pointers. Days has 103 total three-pointers now.

DARIUS DAYS

Darius Days sat out the Alabama game with a bad ankle, but his return for the Mississippi State game (2/10) has meant so many good things for the Tigers, most importantly three consecutive wins.

Days has made 6-of-10 field goals in each of the three games against State, Tennessee and Auburn with 10 three-pointers in those three games. Included in that was a 16-11 double double against Mississippi State (2/10) and 17 points against Auburn.

Days was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

So far this season, the junior from Raleigh, Florida is fourth on the team in scoring at 12.7 points and 7.7 boards. He is fourth in rebound average in the league. He is third in conference games only rebounding at 7.3 a game.

He again this season is one of the top players inside the arc, ranking fifth in the NCAA at 72.2 percent on attempts inside the arc.

DARIUS DAYS DOUBLES

Days was heading for another double double when he got hurt in the Texas Tech game halting his game at 11 points and nine rebounds.

So, LSU fans were very happy when he posted his fifth double double in his return game against Mississippi State (2/10). Days had 16 points and 11 rebounds with four three-pointers in 29 minutes.

His last double figure rebound game had come against Arkansas (1/13) when he pulled down a season high 13 rebounds.

It was part of his fourth double double of the season as Days scored 18 points. His other doubles came against Sam Houston State, A&M and Georgia.

Days with his five double doubles this year, gives him a total of 13 for his three years at LSU.

Keyontae Johnson of Florida and Days of LSU now leads "active" SEC players with 13 career double doubles. Jeremiah Tilton of Missouri the only other player in double figures at 12.

AUNDRE HYATT

Aundre Hyatt has done a great job in the last three games as he returned to the starting lineup. In the three games, Hyatt has scored 7 points with three rebounds against Mississippi State (2/10), 8 points and 8 rebounds against Tennessee (2/13) and 6 points and five rebounds (all offensive) against Auburn (2/20).

In the last three games, Hyatt is averaging 7.0 points and 5.3 rebounds.

There have been a couple of times when Aundre Hyatt has been buried on the bench and not seen the court, but with Mwani Wilkinson out with the (regular) flu and not on the trip, Coach Wade reached to someone who had started early in the season to be the starter against Mississippi State (2/10).

Hyatt played a solid 18 minutes in the spot and his best minutes came early in the second half when he scored a three and two layups that helped LSU expand his two-point halftime lead.

Against Georgia (1/6), Hyatt played seven minutes, hitting 3-of-5 shots to score six points with three offensive rebounds and an assist. He followed that up at Ole Miss (1/9) with a 2-of-4 shooting night with five rebounds in 17 minutes.

For the season, he is averaging 4.3 points and 2.9 rebounds. He has played in 15 games with six starts, averaging 13.4 minutes a game.

JOSH LEBLANC COMES OFF BENCH FOR GOOD GAME

In the three-game winning streak, Josh LeBlanc has come off the bench to make 10-of-10 field goals over the three games. Against Mississippi State (2/10), LeBlanc hit all four field goal attempts to score eight points.

Then against Auburn (2/20), LeBlanc hit all six field goal attempts to score 12 points. He also had 10 rebounds for his first LSU double double.

The transfer from Georgetown who arrived at LSU in Jan. 2020 and sat out almost 12 full months played 25 minutes in his start against Alabama with four points and three rebounds.

LeBlanc's first game for LSU came against Sam Houston State (12/14) back in his hometown.

The Baton Rouge native spent a season and a half at Georgetown playing for the Hoyas before returning to Baton Rouge and enrolling at LSU in time for the second semester of the 2019-20 school year.

And, after the Jan. 26 game at Texas A&M, he also has to his credit a No. 1 SportsCenter play to show for his efforts this season after his dunk in the first half against the Aggies.

He is averaging 17.8 minutes a game and his totals are 3.3 points and 4.1 rebounds a game. He is 25-of-34 from the field (73.5%).

MWANI WILKINSON

Freshman Mwani Wilkinson from Las Vegas got his first start of his LSU career on Dec. 6 against Louisiana Tech and has remained there since provided his own moments and helping on the offensive boards. His first big game was against Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 30, scoring 12 points on 5-of-8 field goal attempts.

Wilkinson had his first double figure game in the SEC against Arkansas (1/13) hitting 4-of-4 field goals his first three-pointer and two free throws to finish with 11 points to go with six rebounds and two steals. Against South Carolina (1/16), Wilkinson was again a perfect 2-of-2 from the field, scoring five points, with three rebounds and two assists.

Wilkinson is averaging 3.9 points and 3.2 rebounds. He is 30-of-39 from the field for 76.9%.

JALEN COOK

The Walker, Louisiana product missed the Southeastern game with a minor injury but came back against Louisiana Tech (12/6) and played 13 minutes, scoring 10 points with two assists. Cook had nine in 11 minutes against Sam Houston.

Cook played for the first time in a few games versus Alabama (2/3), playing 10 minutes with three steals.

Cook is averaging 3.3 points with a 1.0 steal average. With Javonte Smart out, Cook played 25 minutes off the bench against Nicholls (12/26) getting two field goals and 4-of-6 at the line to score eight points with four assists and two steals. He is averaging 8.9 minutes a game.

ERIC GAINES -- STUDENT-ATHLETE OF THE MONTH

Freshman Eric Gaines was named one of the Student-Athletes of the Month for January by the staff at the Cox Communications Academic Center For Student Athletes.

When it came time for someone to move in and keep the offensive flow going when Cam Thomas went out against Ole Miss (1/9), Lithonia, Georgia freshman Eric Gaines moved in and played 28 minutes in the game. He scored a season high 10 points with two rebounds, two assists and four steals.

Gaines played 14 minutes against Arkansas (1/13) with three points and an assist.

Gaines, who is averaging 2.5 points, 1.2 rebounds and 1.4 assists a game, had one of his best shooting nights from the field hitting 3-of-7 field goals and 2-of-3 long-range attempts against the Rebels. That gives him three makes for the season from distance.

Gaines got his first start against Nicholls (12/6) with Javonte Smart out and played 15 minutes. While he scored just one point, Gaines had two rebounds two assists, a block and a steal.

ROAD WEEK SCHEDULED TO CONTINUE

The Tigers road week continues on Saturday at 1 p.m. as LSU travels to Fayetteville to take on Arkansas. Both teams entered the week at 9-4 and trying to solidify a top four seeding in the SEC Tournament as well as seeding in the NCAA Tournament. The game will be televised on either ESPN or ESPN2 and broadcast on the LSU Sports Radio Network.
