LAST GAME: LSU 76, OLE MISS 73 (NASHVILLE, SEC TOURNAMENT QUARTERFINALS)

For the second straight time out for LSU, the six-minute game that has been a staple of Coach Will Wade's coaching philosophy in his four years proved again pivotal as LSU rallied from behind to advance in the SEC Tournament with the three-point win over Ole Miss Friday night.

After leading by two at the half and expanding the lead to 11 in the first 2:30 of the second half, the Tigers found themselves in some trouble as Ole Miss came back with a 10-0 run of their own that gave the Rebels a five-point, 51-46, advantage with 11:17 to play. LSU was still down five, 53-48, as the game ticked under 10 minutes.

But LSU used an 8-3 run to tie the game at 56-56 and took the lead for good on a Cameron Thomas three-pointer with 6:51 to play, 61-58. Javonte Smart and Trendon Watford got field goals to push the lead back to seven, 65-58 with 4:29 to play.

The Rebels get the game to one at 69-68 with 1:17 to play, but Darius Days hit a three and Watford a layup off an offensive rebound to seal the game in the final 30 seconds.

With Thomas and Smart a little under their averages, it was up to Watford and Days to carry the team. Watford hit 11-of-14 shots to finish with 24 points (two under his career high) and seven boards. Days had his 15th career double double with 20 points and 12 rebounds. It was his fourth career 20-point game.

Watford and Days combined to shoot 19-of-29 from the field with three treys from Days. LSU shot 44.6 percent with 7 treys, while Ole Miss hit 40.6 percent with six treys. Ole Miss outrebounded LSU, 42-37.

YES, THAT REALLY WAS AN LSU WIN AT THE SEC TOURNAMENT

The win by LSU Friday night was the first for the Tigers since a win in the quarterfinals in 2016. LSU now has a chance on Saturday to erase one of the more forgetful moments for LSU in the SEC Tournament, also in 2016, when they lost to Texas A&M, 71-38. LSU is in the semifinals for the 27th time, the 16th since the renewal of the tournament. LSU is trying to make the championship game for the first time since 1993. LSU's only SEC Tournament title came in 1980. LSU is now 4-7 overall at Bridgestone Arena. Ironically, LSU's three-point win over Ole Miss Friday seems appropriate after dropping its last two SEC Tournament games by three-points each -- 80-77 in a second-round game in 2018 to Mississippi State and in 2019, 76-73, to Florida.

LEAGUE LEADING 39 WINS FOR LSU IN SEC PLAY

LSU's win over Missouri to close the regular season gave LSU 39 wins in SEC play in 2019, 2020 and 2021 combined (16 in 2019, 12 in 2020 and 11 in 2021), the most of any team in the SEC over that period of time. LSU won the SEC in 2019, finished in a tie for second in 2020 and was third in 2021.

TIGERS A DOUBLE BYE FOR THE THIRD STRAIGHT YEAR

LSU by winning in the next-to-last-game of the season clinched a double bye to the quarterfinals of the SEC Tournament and then was able to get the third seed clinched with its victory on Saturday at Missouri. LSU is the only team in the league to get the double bye in the 2019, 2020 and 2021 tournaments. LSU was the one seed in 2019, was the three seed in the aborted 2020 season and is the three seed for the 2021 event. The seeds:

SERIES AGAINST ARKANSAS

LSU and Arkansas split again this year with each team winning on its home courts. It is the third straight seasons the team have split games. In 2019 both teams won on the opponents' courts and then in 2020 home teams prevailed. Arkansas leads the overall series, 38-33. In the two games this year, LSU defeated Arkansas, 92-76 in Baton Rouge and Arkansas won, 83-75, in Fayetteville. LSU shot 45.4 percent for the two games (64-141) while Arkansas was at 38.4 percent (53-138). LSU made 16 treys, Arkansas 14. LSU was just 63.9 percent at the free throw line for the two games (23-36) while Arkansas was 39-of-51. Cam Thomas averaged 21 points in the two games, while Trendon Watford averaged 19.5 points and 8.5 rebounds with Javonte Smart at 14.0 and 4.5 assists. Darius Days averaged just nine points in the two games. LSU had 87 rebounds in the pair of games and Arkansas 84. The teams are 2-2 in SEC Tournament play:

- 2012 – New Orleans Arena – LSU 70, Arkansas 54**
- 2003 – Superdome – LSU 85, Arkansas 56**
- 2001 – Gaylord Center – Arkansas 77, LSU 72**

LSU A TRIPLE OF DOUBLE FIGURES

Coach Will Wade has always talked about consistent behavior and making the LSU program a team that was consistently finishing in the top four of the SEC and in some years competing for a championship. The wins last week against Vanderbilt and Missouri are more steps in that direction. With the wins the Tigers have won double figure games in the SEC for three straight seasons. For LSU that is a big deal as it marks the first time 30 years that the Tigers have won 10 or more in league play over a three-or-more-year period. The Tigers last scored double figures win in the league from 1988 through 1992. To put the three-year streak in perspective, it marks just the fourth time in school history that LSU has put together a streak of at least three years of posting double figure wins in the league:

- 1934-36 – 3 years**
- 1978-84 – 8 years**
- 1988-92 – 5 years**
- 2019-21 – 3 years**

This will mark the 30th time in conference play that LSU has won double figures in the history of the men's basketball program which began in the 1909 season. A total of 26 times has LSU reached 11 conference wins in schedules that have over the last 55 years roamed between 16 and 18 conference games.

LSU LOOKS FOR BACK-TO-BACK NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCES

Since the 2020 NCAA Tournament was canceled before the selections were made, the Tigers are looking to get a spot in the 64-team event in 2021 that will be played in the Indianapolis area. If LSU is successful in going back to the tournament in 2021, it will mark the first time that LSU goes to the NCAA Tournament in back-to-back events (2019, 2021) since LSU went to the NCAA Tournament in 2005 and 2006. With the win on Saturday at Missouri, TeamRankings.com has put LSU's NCAA bid probably at 100 percent.

LAST 5 GAMES

LSU is averaging 79.6 points per game over the last five games, as LSU was 3-2 in those games with three straight wins. LSU in those five games averaged 41.2 rebounds a contest. As a team in the last five games, LSU shot 44.1 percent from the field with 39 treys. Ironically, in the last five games, LSU was at its worst at the free throw line, making just 65-of-97 (67.0%).

Cam Thomas led the team over the five games at 23.2 points per game. Trendon Watford was at 17.2 points and 9.0 rebounds with Javonte Smart at 13.8 points per contest.

Thomas made nine treys in the last five games, but had his worst segment of the season at the free throw line where for almost 20 games he shot between 89-91 percent. Over the last five games he is 31-of-40 (77.5%)

TIGERS 20-POINT GAME LIST

It only took through 15 games for LSU to equal the 22 times that players scored 20 or more in 31 games last year. This year the total is up to 36 in 25 games: 19 by Cam Thomas, 9 by Trendon Watford, 7 by Javonte Smart and 1 by Darius Days. The breakdown:

AVERAGING 20 POINTS A GAME

Cameron Thomas is at this moment the 20th player in LSU history to average 20 points or more in a season. That last player to average 20 points for a season for LSU was senior Marcus Thornton, who averaged 21.1 points for 35 games in 2009.

500 POINTS AND COUNTING

Cam Thomas is getting into some of the top air of seasonal scoring for LSU in a season that will definitely not have as many games as normal. His 572 points marks the 52nd time in school history that a player has scored 500 points in a season.

While he won't reach the 4-digit numbers that Pete Maravich scored in his three seasons, he is already moving up on the single season scoring list and with 600 points definitely as a possible target, that would give him a shot at hitting that mark for the 19th time in a single season in school history.

WATFORD SCORING AND DISHING

Trendon Watford has had double doubles in three-of-the-last-six games and 12 in his LSU career. He had 14 points and 13 rebounds in the game against Vanderbilt and finished the regular season with 19 points, eight boards and four assists in 36 minutes.

Last month he had a 26-10 double double at Kentucky (1/23), equaling his career high in points. He was just under that against Ole Miss in the tournament quarterfinal with 24 points on 11-of-14 shooting. Watford has had nine 20-point games this season:

Watford, from Birmingham, averaged 13.6 points and 7.2 rebounds as a freshman and for the 2021 season is averaging 16.5 points, 7.4 rebounds to go with a good 3.2 assists average. In the last six games, Watford's rebound average has gone from 6.7 to 7.4 a game.

Watford is second on the team in scoring, rebounds and assist average.

DARIUS DAYS

After a couple of sluggish games, Darius Days came out made a couple of early plays and hit his first three-pointer against Vanderbilt Tuesday night and that was a signal that it probably was going to be a good night for the Tigers.

Days hit 5-of-8 total field goals and 3-of-5 from the arc in a 13-point, 10 rebound night that also included a career high four assists against the Commodores.

Days came through even though saddled with foul trouble at Missouri getting 12 points and nine rebounds.

In LSU's February win streak at Mississippi State, against Tennessee and Auburn, Days made 6-of-10 field goals in each of the three games with 10 three-pointers in those three games. Included in that was a 16-11 double double against Mississippi State (2/10) and 17 points against Auburn.

The stat becomes obvious as the season goes on. When Darius Days scores in double figures this season, LSU is 17-1.

Against Ole Miss in the tournament he hit his first three-pointer and was off on a 20-point, 12 rebound night for his seventh double of the season and the 15th of his career at LSU. His 15 doubles make him the active leader in the SEC in career double doubles.

Days was among the league leaders in rebounds last year, averaging 6.8 boards overall (8th in the SEC) and 6.4 in conference games for No. 11 in the league games rankings.

So far this season, the junior from Raleigh, Florida is fourth on the team in scoring at 12.1 points and the team leader at 7.7 boards. He is fourth in rebound average in the league.

He again this season is one of the top players inside the arc, ranking eighth in the NCAA at 68.8 percent on attempts inside the arc.
