FAST FACTS

- The No. 14/16 Tigers, after a 6-3 threeweekend road trip, will finally return to the hopefully friendly confines of Tiger Park for this Saturday through Monday series. After new announcements this week by state and local officials, all seats will be available for the series for the first time since early in the 2020 season.
- All three games in the series will be on cable channels with Saturday's game on ESPNU and the Senday and Monday contests on the SEC Network. Patrick Wright will have the call of all three games on the LSU Sports Radio Network (107.3 in Baton Rouge).
- LSU will conclude the regular season with six straight with LSU also at home versus Auburn (May 7-9).
- The Tigers won 9-of-13 in April, including doubleheader sweeps the last 3 weeks to win series at Missouri, at NC State and at Kentucky.
- In those three doubleheader sweeps, LSU outscored the competition, 16-7, 15-3 and, 20-11
- No. 400 in the Books: Head coach Beth Torina is in her 10th season at the helm of LSU softball and has coached the Tigers to four Women's College World Series appearances. The team's victory on March 30 over ULM was her 400th coaching the Purple and Gold.
- Coach Torina earned her 500th overall career victory February 21, 2020 with a no-hitter against Sam Houston State, thrown by Shelby Wickersham.
- Last Time Out: LSU took two-of-three at Kentucky last weekend, sweeping a Sunday doubleheader by scores of 10-7 and 10-4.
- LSU has now scored in double figures in 3-of-the-last-4 games, 4-of-the-last-7 and 8 times this season.
- LSU had eight home runs in the series with UK

 3 by Morgan Cummins (1 each game), 2 by

 Taylor Pleasants (1 each game of DH) and one each by Georgia Clark, Amanda Doyle and Taylor Tidwell.
- Ciara Briggs had a 3-hit game in the series opener and six hits for the three games.
- Shelbi Sunseri (7-5) and Ali Kilponen (12-6) picked up the wins for LSU in the circle in the doubleheader.
- In the second game of the doubleheader, caused by a Saturday rainout, Kentucky jumped out to a 3-0 lead after one inning. But LSU

- posted a run in the second and then nine more in the third en route to the 10-4 decision. LSU scored in five-of-the-seven inning in the late afternoon second game Sunday
- The Tigers drew 18 walks in the three-game series with 158 for the season. LSU has allowed 105 BB this season.
- Numbers: The Tigers hit eight home runs against UK upping the HR total to 53 for the year That averages out to 1.23 homers per games this season. Taylor Pleants leads the team with 10, followed by Amanda Doyle iwth 8, Georgia Clark with 7, Shelbi Sunseri wtih 6 and Morgan Cummins and Taylor Tidwell with
- Aliyah Andrews has a career total of stolen bases of 142. She is now 14 away from being the LSU all-time leader. Dee Douglas is the current leader with 155 (1998-2001). Her 142 is first among active D1 leaders through 4/28.
- Aliyah Andrews currently leads the team in batting average at .366 after a 4-for-11 weekend ... She has a team high 53 hits and a team best 37 runs scored ... Andrews has 24 stolen bases and that is 21st in the nation.
- Ciara Briggs is now second on the team in batting average at .344 after her 10-for-14 three-game set. She is tied for second with Taylor Pleasants in hits at 43 and Briggs is third on the team in runs scored at 25. Pleasants has scored 27 runs.
- Aliyah Andrews is currently T2 (4/28) among active Division I players with 254 games played and Amanda Doyle is fourth at 251.
- Five true freshmen have seen action in the first 43 games of the season. Danieca Coffey, Ali Newland, Morgan Smith, Kennedi Houshmandzadeh and Hayden Brown have also seen action.
- The Tigers have played 22 games against Top 25 teams so far this season. In those games, LSU is 10-12. The Tigers are 4-8 against Top 10 opponents.
- LSU ranks fifth in the NCAA RPI through games played on April 25. Arkansas is fourth. LSU's strength of schedule for the third straight week ranks No. 1 in the country. LSU is 12-12 against the top 25 in the RPI.
- LSU leads the series, 60-11, against Arkansas, but Arkansas won 2-of-3 in Fayetteville in 2019, after LSU swept in last Tiger Park visit in 2018.



Thanks to scheduling at North Carolina State and thanks to weather at Missouri and at Kentucky, each of the last three weekends have looked very similiar. A three-game series that started with a single game and then concluded with a doubleheader. To add to the smiliarities, LSU lost the single game each week and swept the doubleheaders.

LSU has scored in double figures in each of the final game of the doubleheader as well, winning 12-5 in the third game at Missouri, 13-2 in the last game at Raliegh and 10-4 in the back half of the DH at Kentucky.

LSU came out of the nine game road trip with a 6-3 mark and is 10-9 on the road this season.

Scoring First, Scoring In First

The Tigers scored first in every game of the NC State series and twice in the UK series, making 27 times this season that LSU has scored first in games with 22 wins in those 27 games ... LSU is 15-4 in games in which the Tigers score in the first inning.

Three Times a Newcomer For LSU, This Time Taylor Pleasants (April 27)

LSU second year freshman Taylor Pleasants was named the SEC Newcomer of the week for April 27. Pleasants hit .444 over the weekend to lead LSU to a series win over No. 14 Kentucky. Pleasants totaled four hits and five RBI. In Sunday's doubleheader sweep over the Wildcats, Pleasants hit a home run in each game. The Houston, Texas native, also drew four walks on the weekend. This season, Pleasants is hitting .316 with 43 hits and a team-high 42 RBI and 10 home runs. Pleasants is in the top-15 of the league in conference games in batting average, slugging percentage, hits, RBI and home runs.

Gutierrez Gives LSU Second Straight SEC Newcomer Honor (April 20)

LSU second-year freshman Raeleen Gutierrez was named the SEC Newcomer of the Week for April 20, as announced by the league office.

In the Tigers' weekend series win over NC State, Gutierrez hit .500 with four hits and a pair of RBI. She hit her second career home run in the series clincher over the Wolfpack. For the year, Gutierrez is hitting .310 for third on the team. She has started 20 games for the Tigers, including the last 14.

Andrews, Briggs Earn SEC Weekly Honors (April 13)

LSU softball players Aliyah Andrews and second year freshman Ciara Briggs were named weekly award winners April 13 as announced by the Southeastern Conference.

Andrews, a senior centerfielder from Oldsmar, Florida, was named the SEC Player of the Week, while Briggs, an outfielder from Yorba Linda, California was named co-Newcomer of the Week with Sara Mosley of Georgia.

Andrews had an outstanding week, hitting .625 after going 10-for-16 at the plate with five runs scored and four runs driven in. She also added five stolen bases to her rising career total. Andrews helped LSU to the double header sweep in the final two games of the series on Sunday, going 3-for-4 in the opener (a 4-2 LSU win) and 4-for-5 in the second game which LSU captured, 12-5.

The four hits in the final Missouri game on Sunday matched her career high for hits and of course she made another diving play in center field that robbed a Missouri hitter of at least a double in game three and was No. 2 on ESPN SportsCenter's Top Plays.

Briggs went 5-for-12 (.417 average) in the four games, including a 3-for-4 game in the finale of the Missouri series in one of her best games of the season against the No. 19 team in the college polls. Briggs also drove in two runs in that contest. She had hits in three-of-the-four games on the week.

Briggs' two-RBI single in that finale against Missouri in the bottom of the fifth inning was a game-changing hit. The single to left field game LSU a 6-5 lead in the game and pushed LSU forward to what would be a 12-5 win.

Andrews Named SEC Player of the Week (March 1)

In a week of Sportscenter Top 10 diving catches, Aliyah Andrews was named SEC Player of the Week for games against Central Arkansas, UL Lafayette, Oklahoma State, and Buffalo. The senior from Oldsmar, Florida, led the Tigers in batting average at .591 for the week. She was 13-for-22 with seven runs scored, two doubles, an RBI and 6-for-7 in stolen bases, finishing with a .609 on-base percentage. She also tallied nine putouts in center field and did not commit an error.

Andrews Named to USA Softball Top 25 Watch List

LSU senior softball outfielder Aliyah Andrews was named one of the Top 25 Finalists for USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year announced last week. The USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year award, which is considered the most prestigious honor in Division I women's collegiate softball, recognizes the outstanding athletic achievement by Division I female players across the country.

Andrews leads the team in batting average (.366), hits (53), runs scored (37) and stolen bases (24-of-26) this season for the Tigers. Andrews is a three-year letterman from Oldsmar, Florida.

Andrews is second in the SEC in stolen bases and 21st in the NCAA, while her four triples is ranked 22nd in the NCAA. She is tied for second in games played for her career at 254 and is the active Division I career leader in steals at 142.

The Finalists include three graduate students, 10 seniors, nine juniors, one sophomore and two freshmen representing 20 NCAA Division I universities and seven athletic conferences. Among the universities, Alabama, Arkansas, Oklahoma, UCLA and Washington are represented by two student-athletes while Arizona, Clemson, Duke, Florida, Fresno State, Kentucky, LSU, Michigan, Northern Iowa,

Amanda Doyle earned her degree this past fall. Doyle graduated from LSU's College of Human Sciences and Education with a degree in elementary education. She is working towards her master's in curriculum and instruction.

Doyle was the recipient of a \$2,500 scholarship as part of the College Football Playoff Go Teach Initiative. With the help of the College Football Playoff Foundation and in partnership with Dr. Pepper, the SEC awarded one student-athlete from each SEC school with a \$2,500 tuition support.

Four Tigers Named to Preseason All-SEC Softball Team

The Southeastern Conference announced the 2021 Preseason All-SEC Softball Team Thursday morning and the LSU Softball landed four players on the list. Aliyah Andrews, Ali Kilponen, Shelbi Sunseri and Shelby Wickersham represented the Tigers.

LSU has the most of any SEC school listed, while Alabama and Arkansas both have three student-athletes on the squad. Florida, Mississippi State and Tennessee each have two players, and Missouri has one student-athlete named to the preseason team.

The Preseason All-SEC Softball Team is voted on by the league's head coaches and consists of a minimum of 14 players. Each SEC head coach voted for five infielders, four outfielders, three pitchers, one catcher and one designated player/utility. No ties were broken.

Four WCWS Trips in Nine Years Under Torina

The LSU softball program has advanced to the Women's College World Series four times under Torina and three out of the last six seasons. LSU and UCLA were the only programs that advanced to Oklahoma for three-straight years (2015–2017).

- The facility was named after the late Mike Moore, a longtime supporter of LSU softball. During his life, Mr. Moore was an avid and very active fan of LSU Athletics. Mr. Moore and his family were season ticket holders for multiple sports and often traveled across the country to watch the Tigers play.
- Mr. Moore tragically passed away while traveling with his wife supporting the LSU Softball team in Palm Springs, California in February of 2015. Before his passing, Mr. Moore and his family made a financial commitment to the LSU softball program for the performance center.
- This state-of-the-art facility features a fullsized infield, multiple hitting lanes and a team weight room, believed to be the first-ever exclusive weight room for a softball team in the nation.
- With a space of 14,500 square feet, 1,279 square feet is dedicated to the weight room to go along with 770 square feet on the second floor specifically for cardio equipment.
- Each hitting lane will has wired electricity which provides the staff and student-ath-letes the capability to set up multiple hitting machines throughout the facility. The facility is wired with a custom multi-camera system that provides a chance to immediately review film during practice.
- The building is also equipped with 517 square feet of storage space and a 240 square foot locker room area. Lighting is energy efficient with impact-resistant LED fixtures.
- A custom turf, that mirrors real grass in terms of playability and performance, was installed with LSU branding through the entire indoor. Graphics are placed throughout the interior of the facility that honors the history of LSU softball.

- The 13 SEC schools joined together to wear teal or teal accents on Saturday, March 20 as the entire league recognized Alex Wilcox's impact on the softball community nationwide and in the fight against ovarian cancer. The campaign is a joint effort of LSU head coach Beth Torina and MSU head coach Samantha Ricketts and was approved at the SEC coaches' meetings in the fall of 2019.
- Wilcox was a member of the 2018
 Mississippi State softball team
 who inspired the nation with her
 courageous fight against ovarian
 cancer. That fight ultimately took
 her life in the summer of 2018.
- The Geaux Teal Ovarian Cancer Awareness Foundation provided each school with an All for Alex shirt to be worn by teams and their respective staffs during pregame warmups. Videos were played throughout each stadium on March 20.
- MSU immortalized Wilcox on Sept. 15, 2018 when the university retired her No. 8 jersey, making her the first female student-athlete in Mississippi State history to receive the honor.
- All 13 SEC softball teams were awarded the league's Sportsmanship Award in 2018 for their united support of Wilcox throughout her final year of competition.

- The Geaux Teal Ovarian Cancer Awareness Walk has been held every year since spring 2013. The first walk, held in April of 2013, featured 216 walkers. The 2019 walk, the last in-person walk held before the Covid-19 pandemic, featured 1,080 walkers who raised over \$90,000.
