- The No.15/17 Tigers will finally conclude a 9-game road trip this weekend with a threegame series at Kentucky. Friday's opener will be on SECN+ with the Saturday and Sunday contests on ESPN2. Patrick Wright will have the call on the LSU Sports radio Network.
- LSU will conclude the season with six straight at home against Arkansas (May 1-3) and Auburn (May 7-9).
- The Tigers have won 7-of-10 in the month of April, including doubleheader sweeps the last two weeks to win series at Missouri and at NC State, outscoring the competition, 16-7 and 15-3 in those doubleheaders.
- No. 400 in the Books: Head coach Beth
 Torina is in her 10th season at the helm of LSU
 softball and has coached the Tigers to four
 Women's College World Series appearances.
 The team's victory on March 30 over ULM was
 her 400th coaching the Purple and Gold.
- Coach Torina earned her 500th overall career victory February 21, 2020 with a no-hitter against Sam Houston State, thrown by Shelby Wickersham.
- Last Time Out: LSU took two-of-three at NC State, sweeping a Saturday doubleheader by scores of 2-1 and 13-2 in six innings.
- LSU had four home runs in the series with Ciara Briggs, last week's SEC co-Newcomer of the Year taking two out. The second year freshman was 5-of-9 for the weekend with 4 runs scored. Briggs has 4 dingers on the year.
- Raeleen Gutierrez had a homer with 4 hits in 8 at bats during the weekend. Gutierrez now has two homers on the year.
- Taylor Tidwell hit the other home run for her fourth of the year, giving LSU 45 on the year.
- Tidwell's home run in the top of the seventh inning in game one of the DH was the difference in the 2-1 decision.
- Pitcher Ali Kilponen and Shelbi Wickersham both picked up wins in the Saturday sweep.
 Kilponen is now 11-5 on the second, recording her fifth complete game of the season, allowing three hits, 1 run with no walks and 6 strikeouts.
- Wickersham got the start in the second game and pitchers her second complete game of the year to run her record to 5-3. Wickersham allowed five hits, two earned runs with 4 BB

- and 4 Ks.
- Briggs had 11 total bases in the three-game series, a 1.222 slugging percentage.
- The Tigers drew 15 walks in the three-game series with 140 for the season.
- Numbers: The Tigers 45 home runs on the season makes for a 1.1, averaging 1.1 per game.
 Taylor Pleants leads the team with 8, followed by Amanda Doyle with 7 and Georgia Clark and Shelbi Sunseri with 6 each.
- Aliyah Andrews has a career total of stolen bases of 140. She is now 16 away from being the LSU all-time leader. Dee Douglas is the current leader with 155 (1998-2001). Her 140 is second among Division I active players.
- Aliyah Andrews currently leads the team in batting average at .366 after a 3-for-9 weekend ... She has a team high 49 hits and a team best 35 runs scored ... Andrews has 22 stolen bases and that is 13th in the nation.
- Ciara Briggs is now second on the team
 in batting average at .333 after her 5-of-9
 weekend. She is third on the team in hits at 37
 and T2 in runs scored at 22. Taylor Pleasants is
 second on the team with 39 hits and also has
 22 runs scored.
- Aliyah Andrews is currently second among active Division I players with 248 games played and Amanda Doyle is T3 at 247. Doyle did not play the last 2 games against NC State with a minor injury. It was her first time not to start at 3B in 213 games.
- Five true freshmen have seen action in the first 40 games of the season. Danieca Coffey, Ali Newland, Morgan Smith, Kennedi Houshmandzadeh and Hayden Brown have also seen action.
- The Tigers have played 19 games against Top 25 teams so far this season. In those games, LSU is 8-11. The Tigers are 4-8 against Top 10 opponents.
- LSU ranks sixth in the NCAA RPI through games played on April 18. The Tigers strength of schedule for the second straight week remains No. 1 in the NCAA.
- The teams were not set to play last season when the schedule was halted. LSU and UK last met in April 2019 at Tiger Park with LSU winning the last two games, 5-0, 5-2 to take the series



Weekends Look Very Similiar

It was a case of same story each of the last two weekends for the LSU Tigers as they lost the first game of the series at Missouri and at NC State and then came back to sweep doubleheaders. Both series featured a strong third game in which LSU won 12-5 against Missouri in the third game and 13-2 in the final game in Raleigh.

The two wins against NC State equaled LSU's road record at 8-8 this season. LSU is in the midst of a nine-game road swing that has taken place over three straight weekends. LSU had another road game, at McNeese State, washed out by bad weather.

Scoring First, Scoring In First

The Tigers scored first in every game of the NC State series, making 25 times this season that LSU has scored first in games with 21 wins in those 25 games ... Twice LSU scored in the first inning, making 18 games LSU has scored in the opening inning. LSU is 14-4 in those games.

Gutierrez Gives LSU Second Straight SEC Newcomer Honor (April 20)

LSU second-year freshman Raeleen Gutierrez was named the SEC Newcomer of the Week for April 20, as announced by the league office.

In the Tigers' weekend series win over NC State, Gutierrez hit .500 with four hits and a pair of RBI. She hit her second career home run in the series clincher over the Wolfpack. For the year, Gutierrez is hitting .310 for third on the team. She has started 20 games for the Tigers, including the last 14.

Andrews, Briggs Earn SEC Weekly Honors (April 13)

LSU softball players Aliyah Andrews and second year freshman Ciara Briggs were named weekly award winners April 13 as announced by the Southeastern Conference.

Andrews, a senior centerfielder from Oldsmar, Florida, was named the SEC Player of the Week, while Briggs, an outfielder from Yorba Linda, California was named co-Newcomer of the Week with Sara Mosley of Georgia.

Andrews had an outstanding week, hitting .625 after going 10-for-16 at the plate with five runs scored and four runs driven in. She also added five stolen bases to her rising career total. Andrews helped LSU to the double header sweep in the final two games of the series on Sunday, going 3-for-4 in the opener (a 4-2 LSU win) and 4-for-5 in the second game which LSU captured, 12-5.

The four hits in the final Missouri game on Sunday matched her career high for hits and of course she made another diving play in center field that robbed a Missouri hitter of at least a double in game three and was No. 2 on ESPN SportsCenter's Top Plays.

Briggs went 5-for-12 (.417 average) in the four games, including a 3-for-4 game in the finale of the Missouri series in one of her best games of the season against the No. 19 team in the college polls. Briggs also drove in two runs in that contest. She had hits in three-of-the-four games on the week.

Briggs' two-RBI single in that finale against Missouri in the bottom of the fifth inning was a game-changing hit. The single to left field game LSU a 6-5 lead in the game and pushed LSU forward to what would be a 12-5 win.

Andrews Named SEC Player of the Week (March 1)

In a week of Sportscenter Top 10 diving catches, Aliyah Andrews was named SEC Player of the Week for games against Central Arkansas, UL Lafayette, Oklahoma State, and Buffalo. The senior from Oldsmar, Florida, led the Tigers in batting average at .591 for the week. She was 13-for-22 with seven runs scored, two doubles, an RBI and 6-for-7 in stolen bases, finishing with a .609 on-base percentage. She also tallied nine putouts in center field and did not commit an error.

Andrews Named to USA Softball Top 50 Watch List

LSU senior outfielder Aliyah Andrews has been named to the 2021 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 "Watch List" the organization announced during the preseason on January 27.

Andrews, a two-time All-SEC and SEC Defensive Team selection, finished the 2020 season with a .408 batting average, scoring a team-leading 24 runs. She finished the shortened season with team-leading 18 stolen bases on 19 attempts and led the team with 29 hits. Andrews goes into the 2021 season with a total of 118 stolen bases in her career and is 38 away from becoming the all-time leader.

The preseason "Watch List" includes 11 seniors, 15 juniors and five sophomores, with freshman ineligible for consideration. (Freshman can be considered for the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year award once they have competed at the collegiate level). Athletes named to the "Watch List" represent 28 NCAA Division I universities and 13 athletic conferences.

The Top 25 Finalists for the 2021 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year award will be announced April 21. While an athlete does not have to be on the "Watch List" to be considered for the Top 25, the eventual USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year will come from the Top 25 Finalists. The Top 10 Finalists will be announced May 5 and the Top 3 announced May 19. The 2021 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year will be revealed June 1.

Doyle Earns Degree in Fall 2020 & 'Go Teach' Scholarship

Amanda Doyle earned her degree this past fall. Doyle graduated from LSU's College of Human Sciences and Education with a degree in elementary education. She is working towards her master's in curriculum and instruction.

Doyle was the recipient of a \$2,500 scholarship as part of the College Football Playoff Go Teach Initiative. With the help of the College Football Playoff Foundation and in partnership with Dr. Pepper, the SEC awarded one student-athlete from each SEC school with a \$2,500 tuition support.

Four Tigers Named to Preseason All-SEC Softball Team

The Southeastern Conference announced the 2021 Preseason All-SEC Softball Team Thursday morning and the LSU Softball landed four players on the list. Aliyah Andrews, Ali Kilponen, Shelbi Sunseri and Shelby Wickersham represented the Tigers.

LSU has the most of any SEC school listed, while Alabama and Arkansas both have three student-athletes on the squad. Florida, Mississippi State and Tennessee each have two players, and Missouri has one student-athlete named to the preseason team.

The Preseason All-SEC Softball Team is voted on by the league's head coaches and consists of a minimum of 14 players. Each SEC head coach voted for five infielders, four outfielders, three pitchers, one catcher and one designated player/utility. No ties were broken.

Change in Plans

A couple of adjustments to the original schedule have occurred during the season due to weather, but so far only two games have been lost to COVID-19 protocols:

• The Bama Bash on February 20-21 turned into a three-team tournament as Gardner-Webb had to stay home due to positive COVID-19 tests and subsequent quarantining of student-athletes.

Four WCWS Trips in Nine Years Under Torina

The LSU softball program has advanced to the Women's College World Series four times under Torina and three out of the last six seasons. LSU and UCLA were the only programs that advanced to Oklahoma for three-straight years (2015–2017).

LSU Picked Second in Preseason SEC Poll

The 2021 SEC Softball Preseason Coaches' Poll was released January 28 and the league's coaches have predicted the LSU softball team to finish second in the conference. LSU picked up two first place votes as they sit behind Alabama. Florida, Tennessee and Kentucky round out the top five of the SEC. Points for the poll were awarded on a 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10-11-12 basis. Coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team.



- The facility was named after the late Mike Moore, a longtime supporter of LSU softball. During his life, Mr. Moore was an avid and very active fan of LSU Athletics. Mr. Moore and his family were season ticket holders for multiple sports and often traveled across the country to watch the Tigers play.
- Mr. Moore tragically passed away while traveling with his wife supporting the LSU Softball team in Palm Springs, California in February of 2015. Before his passing, Mr. Moore and his family made a financial commitment to the LSU softball program for the performance center.
- This state-of-the-art facility features a fullsized infield, multiple hitting lanes and a team weight room, believed to be the first-ever exclusive weight room for a softball team in the nation.
- With a space of 14,500 square feet, 1,279 square feet is dedicated to the weight room to go along with 770 square feet on the second floor specifically for cardio equipment.
- Each hitting lane will has wired electricity which provides the staff and student-ath-letes the capability to set up multiple hitting machines throughout the facility. The facility is wired with a custom multi-camera system that provides a chance to immediately review film during practice.
- The building is also equipped with 517 square feet of storage space and a 240 square foot locker room area. Lighting is energy efficient with impact-resistant LED fixtures.
- A custom turf, that mirrors real grass in terms of playability and performance, was installed with LSU branding through the entire indoor. Graphics are placed throughout the interior of the facility that honors the history of LSU softball.

The campaign is a joint effort of LSU head coach Beth Torina and MSU head coach Samantha Ricketts and was approved at the SEC coaches' meetings in the fall of 2019.
- Wilcox was a member of the 2018
 Mississippi State softball team
 who inspired the nation with her
 courageous fight against ovarian
 cancer. That fight ultimately took
 her life in the summer of 2018.
- The Geaux Teal Ovarian Cancer Awareness Foundation provided each school with an All for Alex shirt to be worn by teams and their respective staffs during pregame warmups. Videos were played throughout each stadium on March 20.
- MSU immortalized Wilcox on Sept. 15, 2018 when the university retired her No. 8 jersey, making her the first female student-athlete in Mississippi State history to receive the honor.
- All 13 SEC softball teams were awarded the league's Sportsmanship Award in 2018 for their united support of Wilcox throughout her final year of competition.
