FAST FACTS

- The No. 13/16 Tigers, after a 1-2 weekend against No. 7 Arkansas, will conclude the 2021 regular season with three games at home against Auburn. The opening game on Friday will be telecast on ESPNU with the final two games streamed on SEC Network +. Patrick Wright will have the call of all three games on the LSU Sports Radio Network (107.3 in Baton Rouge).
- As of the start of play on Wednesday in the league this week, LSU is in seventh place in the league and if the tournament started now LSU would face 10-seeded Georgia. But there is still a lot to be decided. Tennessee, in fifth, will play five games this week and has the tiebreaker over LSU, while LSU has the tiebreaker over sixth place Ole Miss, one game ahead of LSU. UK is one game behind LSU in eighth, but again LSU has the tiebreaker in winning the series.
- The 2021 SEC Tournament will be played at Rhoads Stadium in Tuscaloosa, May 11-15.
- Last week, LSU was one of 20 sites selected by the NCAA as a possible preliminary round site for this year's DI Softball Championship. Of the 20 selected sites, the committee will choose 16 to host regional round games. Participating teams and the final 16 sites will be revealed during the selection show on Sunday, May 16, at 8 p.m. CT on ESPN2.
- The Tigers by schedule and by weather considerations, has had to conclude series with doubleheaders each of the last four weekends. The Tigers have won 7-of-the-8 gaames in the doubleheaders at Missouri, at NC State, at Kentucky and versus Arkansas.
- No. 400 in the Books: Head coach Beth Torina is in her 10th season at the helm of LSU softball and has coached the Tigers to four Women's College World Series appearances. The team's victory on March 30 over ULM was her 400th coaching the Purple and Gold.
- Last Time Out: LSU took one-of-three fairly low scoring games in a series with No. 7 Arkansas Saturday and Monday ... LSU lost on Saturday night 1-0, won game two on Monday in the opening game of a doubleheader, 2-1, and then fell 4-1 in the Monday nightcap.
- Aliyah Andrews led LSU wtih five hits over the three games. Andrews had multiple hits in twoof-the-three games.
- Pitcher Ali Kilponen continued her stellar work with a complete game win (2-1) in the second game of the series. She allowed one hit and one

- earned run while running her record to 13-6. On LSU's first weekend back at home since April 4 and with restrictions eased that allowed all seats to be available in Tiger Park, the Tigers drew 1,732 for the Saturday single game and 2,246 for the Monday doubleheader.
- Numbers: For the first time in several weeks, the home run tracker did not add any numbers and LSU remains at 53 home runs for the year That averages out to 1.15 homers per game this season. Taylor Pleasants leads the team with 10, followed by Amanda Doyle iwth 8, Georgia Clark with 7, Shelbi Sunseri wtih 6 and Morgan Cummins and Taylor Tidwell with 5 each, A total of 11 LSU players have posted home runs.
- Pleasants hit two home runs on April 25 at UK for her last blasts, while Doyle's UK homer was her first since March 14. Sunseri is looking for her first round tripper since March 21.
- Aliyah Andrews has a career total of stolen bases of 143. She is now 13 away from being the LSU all-time leader. Dee Douglas is the current leader with 155 (1998-2001). Andrews' 143 is second among active D1 leaders through 5/5 ... Her 25 SBs is ranked 26th in the country.
- Aliyah Andrews currently leads the team in batting average at .377, raising her average 11 pts from the start of the Arkansas series ... She has a team best 57 hits and 37 runs scored. after a 4-for-11 weekend ... She has a team high 53 hits and a team best 37 runs scored ... She has a current team best 8-game hitting streak.
- Alivah Andrews is currently third (5/5) among active Division I players with 256 games played with Amanda Doyle fourth at 253.
- Five true freshmen have seen action in the first 43 games of the season. Danieca Coffey, Ali Newland, Morgan Smith, Kennedi Houshmandzadeh and Hayden Brown have also seen action.
- The Tigers have played 22 games against Top 25 teams so far this season. In those games, LSU is 11-14. The Tigers are 5-10 against Top 10 opponents
- LSU ranks fifth in the NCAA RPI through games played on May 2. SEC schools are 2, 3, 4, and 5. LSU's strength of schedule for the fourth straight week ranks No. 1 in the country.
- LSU leads the series with Auburn, 52-20. The teams last met in March, 2018 with LSU sweeping a three-game set in Baton Rouge, 3-2, 1-0, 1-0.



Tigers Go For 1,200Th Victory This Weekend

LSU enters the weekend two victories short of 1,200 in program history ... LSU enters the weekend at 1,198-425-1 for a program that began with three seasons in the AIAW in 1979, 1980 and 1981 ... The program restarted in 1997 and this is the 25th season of NCAA play, 28th overall ... In that time, LSU has made 21 NCAA regional appearances, eight Super Regional appearances and six times has been in Oklahoma City for the Women's College World Series.

Last Four Weekends Look Very Similiar

Thanks to scheduling at North Carolina State and thanks to weather at Missouri, at Kentucky and last weekend here against Arkansas, each of the last four weekends have looked very similiar. A threegame series that started with a single game and then concluded with a doubleheader.

All four times LSU lost the first game of the series only to sweep doubleheaders against Missouri, NC State and Kentucky. LSU won the first game of the doubleheader against No. 7 Arknasas.

Thanks to a 6-3 road trip in April, LSU finished the month up 9-4.

Hit Streaks, Miscellaneous Numbers

Two Tigers have multiple game hit streaks going at present with Aliyah Andrews hitting in eight straight games. She is one off her longest streak of the season at nine games. That is also co-longest on the team as Ciara Briggs also had a nine-game hit streak earlier in the year.

Amanda Doyle enters with a five-game hitting streak and that is one off her season high of six straight games with a hit.

Andrews has had 15 multiple hit games including two against Arkansas. Taylor Pleasants (13) and Briggs and Doyle (10 each) are the others with doulbe figure multiple hit games. LSU has recorded 69 total multiple hit games.

Pleasants is the only player with multiple RBI games with 12-of-the-team's 51 multiple RBI contests.

Three Times In April, LSU Has Newcomer of the Week Taylor Pleasants (April 27)

LSU second year freshman Taylor Pleasants was named the SEC Newcomer of the week for April 27. Pleasants hit .444 over the weekend to lead LSU to a series win over No. 14 Kentucky. Pleasants totaled four hits and five RBI. In Sunday's doubleheader sweep over the Wildcats, Pleasants hit a home run in each game. The Houston, Texas native, also drew four walks on the weekend. This season, Pleasants is hitting .316 with 43 hits and a team-high 42 RBI and 10 home runs. Pleasants is in the top-15 of the league in conference games in batting average, slugging percentage, hits, RBI and home runs.

For the year, Gutierrez is hitting .310 for third on the team. She has started 20 games for the Tigers, including the last 14.

Ciara Briggs With SEC POW Aliyah Andrews (April 13)

LSU softball players Aliyah Andrews and second year freshman Ciara Briggs were named weekly award winners April 13 as announced by the Southeastern Conference.

Andrews, a senior centerfielder from Oldsmar, Florida, was named the SEC Player of the Week, while Briggs, an outfielder from Yorba Linda, California was named co-Newcomer of the Week with Sara Mosley of Georgia.

Andrews had an outstanding week, hitting .625 after going 10-for-16 at the plate with five runs scored and four runs driven in. She also added five stolen bases to her rising career total. Andrews helped LSU to the double header sweep in the final two games of the series on Sunday, going 3-for-4 in the opener (a 4-2 LSU win) and 4-for-5 in the second game which LSU captured, 12-5.

Four Tigers Named to Preseason All-SEC Softball Team

The Southeastern Conference announced the 2021 Preseason All-SEC Softball Team Thursday morning and the LSU Softball landed four players on the list. Aliyah Andrews, Ali Kilponen, Shelbi Sunseri and Shelby Wickersham represented the Tigers.

LSU has the most of any SEC school listed, while Alabama and Arkansas both have three student-athletes on the squad. Florida, Mississippi State and Tennessee each have two players, and Missouri has one student-athlete named to the preseason team.

- The facility was named after the late Mike Moore, a longtime supporter of LSU softball. During his life, Mr. Moore was an avid and very active fan of LSU Athletics. Mr. Moore and his family were season ticket holders for multiple sports and often traveled across the country to watch the Tigers play.
- Mr. Moore tragically passed away while traveling with his wife supporting the LSU Softball team in Palm Springs, California in February of 2015. Before his passing, Mr. Moore and his family made a financial commitment to the LSU softball program for the performance center.
- This state-of-the-art facility features a fullsized infield, multiple hitting lanes and a team weight room, believed to be the first-ever exclusive weight room for a softball team in the nation.
- With a space of 14,500 square feet, 1,279 square feet is dedicated to the weight room to go along with 770 square feet on the second floor specifically for cardio equipment.
- Each hitting lane will has wired electricity which provides the staff and student-ath-letes the capability to set up multiple hitting machines throughout the facility. The facility is wired with a custom multi-camera system that provides a chance to immediately review film during practice.
- The building is also equipped with 517 square feet of storage space and a 240 square foot locker room area. Lighting is energy efficient with impact-resistant LED fixtures.
- A custom turf, that mirrors real grass in terms of playability and performance, was installed with LSU branding through the entire indoor. Graphics are placed throughout the interior of the facility that honors the history of LSU softball.

- The 13 SEC schools joined together to wear teal or teal accents on Saturday, March 20 as the entire league recognized Alex Wilcox's impact on the softball community nationwide and in the fight against ovarian cancer. The campaign is a joint effort of LSU head coach Beth Torina and MSU head coach Samantha Ricketts and was approved at the SEC coaches' meetings in the fall of 2019.
- Wilcox was a member of the 2018
 Mississippi State softball team
 who inspired the nation with her
 courageous fight against ovarian
 cancer. That fight ultimately took
 her life in the summer of 2018.
- The Geaux Teal Ovarian Cancer Awareness Foundation provided each school with an All for Alex shirt to be worn by teams and their respective staffs during pregame warmups. Videos were played throughout each stadium on March 20.
- MSU immortalized Wilcox on Sept. 15, 2018 when the university retired her No. 8 jersey, making her the first female student-athlete in Mississippi State history to receive the honor.
- All 13 SEC softball teams were awarded the league's Sportsmanship Award in 2018 for their united support of Wilcox throughout her final year of competition.

- The Geaux Teal Ovarian Cancer Awareness Walk has been held every year since spring 2013. The first walk, held in April of 2013, featured 216 walkers. The 2019 walk, the last in-person walk held before the Covid-19 pandemic, featured 1,080 walkers who raised over \$90,000.
