TOP STORYLINES

» Michigan opens the 2021 campaign at the LSU Tiger Classic.

- » U-M starts the season with two consecutive road tournaments for the first time since 2011.
- » Senior All-American Paige Jones led the Wolverines with 179 kills in the spring campaign.
- » Four newcomers join the squad, including impact freshman middle Jacque Boney.

The University of Michigan volleyball team opens the 2021 campaign in Baton Rouge at the Tiger Classic to take on host LSU, Florida State and Northern Arizona Friday, Aug. 27 through Sunday, Aug. 29.

• The Wolverines have five seniors and a graduate student on their fall roster, highlighted by 2019 AVCA All-American **Paige Jones**. Jones played in 50-of-51 sets during the spring season, leading the team with 179 kills (3.58 kills per set) and coming in second on the team with 123 (2.46 digs per set) digs. The other fouryear seniors include **Kayla Bair**, **Abbey Malinowski**, **Grace Persson** and **Lizzie Sadilek**.

Joining the Maize and Blue for a final go-around is graduate transfer Haley Hallgren. Hallgren spent the past four years earning her degree from the University of Southern California, where she played beach volleyball. Hallgren was a two-time team captain and helped the Trojans win the 2021 NCAA Championship. The Southlake, Texas native is a true utility player, using her skills from beach to make her an asset as a hitter, defender, or setter.

• A dynamic duo highlights the junior class, as middle blocker **Jess Robinson**, and opposite hitter **May Pertofsky** return to the court this fall. Robinson, who spent part of her summer practicing at the USA Volleyball training center, had 94 kills (1.84 kills per set) and was second on the team in total blocks (30) during the spring campaign. Pertofsky was third on the team with 112 kills (2.49 kills per set) and led the team in service aces (14).

Joining the bigs from the Junior class are setters **Maddie Dowd** and **Jenni Liu**, as well as defensive specialist **Amber Beals**. Dowd saw action this past spring, including an eye-popping 65-assist match against Indiana (March 12).

• The sophomore class includes contributors in all facets of the game, highlighted by the all-around skill from **Jess Mruzik**. The Livonia, Mich. native enrolled at U-M as the national Gatorade Player of the Year, and tuned in a freshman campaign that saw her earn Big Ten All-Freshman team honors. She was second on the team in kills with 163 (3.54 kills per set), had 10 service aces, and added 84 digs and 20 blocks defensively.

Joining Michigan in her first collegiate season was Michigan State transfer **Hannah Grant**. The Northville, Mich. native stepped in and controlled the libero position from day one, finishing the season with a teambest 214 digs (4.20 digs per set).

Another rookie that saw a bulk of the playing time at her position was Scottee Johnson. The setter

played in all but one game this spring, leading the Wolverines with 383 assists (8.33 assists per set). She also added 122 digs and nine service aces.

Local product Kendall Murray stepped into a crucial role in her freshman campaign, finishing the season with 33 kills, 37 digs and nine total blocks. The Skyline High School alumna earned the first two starts of her career against Nebraska.

The last member of the sophomore class is **Brooke Humphrey**. The defensive specialist saw action as a serve specialist as well as a DS.

• Michigan had a small freshman class for the 2021 fall, bringing in Jacque Boney, Mira Chopra, and Maddi Cuchran.

Boney hails from Brookhaven, Georgia where she was an Under Armour First Team All-American. The 6-4 middle blocker was also ranked the No. 26 recruit in the country and No. 4 middle by Prep Volleyball, and was one of VolleyMag.com's 23 Underclassmen to Watch in 2020. Boney holds the Georgia state single-match records for total blocks (10) and kills (42).

Chopra joins the Wolverines from the heart of Big Ten country in Champaign, Illinois. The middle blocker hit .514 and averaged 2.5 blocks and 5.8 digs per set as a senior, helping her earn honorable mention Under Armour All-American honors.

Cuchran, a Downers Grove, Illinois native, comes in as reinforcement for the Wolverines' defensive unit. As a libero, Cuchran had 1,243 digs in her high school career (13.5 digs per set) to go along with 182 career assists and 96 career aces.

OPPONENT PREVIEW

The Wolverines square off with three relatively unfamiliar opponents this weekend, having played LSU six times, Florida State five times, and Northern Arizona only once.

U-M holds the all-time edge over the Tigers, 4-2, having won each of the last two meetings in 2015 and 2018. LSU won the first ever meeting between the two storied institutions, taking a fiveset thriller in the 1985 season. This will be the first time in program history that the two teams have played in Louisiana.

On the flip side, Michigan trails the series with Florida state, three games to two. The Seminoles won the last time these two teams played in 2013, 3-2.

Northern Arizona nearly pulled of the upset over No. 15 Michigan in the first and only meeting between the two at the Michigan Invitational in 2019. The Wolverines, facing a 2-1 deficit, came back and won the final two sets for a five-set thriller.

• The 2021 volleyball campaign marks the program's 49th season and 23rd under head coach Mark Rosen. In his time leading the Maize and Blue, Rosen has compiled a 433-274 record and guided Michigan to 18 of its 20 NCAA postseason appearances. In addition to serving as the longest-tenured volleyball coach at Michigan, Rosen is the winningest coach in program history.

• This season marks the first since 2011 that Michigan is opening up the campaign with two road tournaments. After the Tiger Classic, the Wolverines head to Annapolis, Maryland to take part in the Kristen Dickmann Invitational, hosted by the U.S. Naval Academy.

In 2011 U-M opened the season at the Morehead

State Eagle Challenge in Morehead, Kentucky before heading west to the La Quinta Inn and Suites Challenge in Orem, Utah, hosted by Utah Valley.

The Maize and Blue would go on to make a run to the NCAA Regional Semifinals that season.

Rosen Enters His 23rd Year at Michigan

Mark Rosen completed his 22nd year at Michigan in 2018, compiling a 432-274 mark in Ann Arbor. He has coached seven All-Americans in Paige Jones, Carly Skjodt, Abby Cole, Erin Moore, Lexi Zimmerman, Juliana Paz, Alex Hunt and Jennifer Cross. Rosen is joined on the sidelines by his wife and associate head

coach, Leisa Rosen, and assistants Jerome Fraisse and Ali Bastianelli (volunteer).

400 at Michigan

Head coach Mark Rosen and associate head coach Leisa Rosen won the 400th match of their tenure at Michigan with a thrilling 3-2 victory at Ohio State on Oct. 12, 2018. Mark Rosen is the fourth active coach to record 400 wins at Michigan, joining Carol Hutchins (softball), Bev Plocki (women's gymnastics), and Kurt Golder (men's gymnastics).

Winningest Coach at Michigan

With a 3-1 win over Purdue during the 2008 season, Mark Rosen became the program's winningest coach. The victory was his 178th at Michigan, passing Sandy Vong's previous mark of 177 triumphs. With a 3-0 win over Marguette during 2009, Rosen became the first coach at Michigan to win 200 matches.

How He Stacks Up

With his 617 career wins at four-year colleges to enter the 2019 season, Mark Rosen ranks 16th among the winningest active coaches in Division I. He is the fourth Big Ten coach on the list behind Penn State head coach Russ Rose, Nebraska head coach John Cook, and Michigan State head coach Cathy George. Rosen also is 30th by all-time winning percentage (.680) in Division I.

600-Win Club

Mark Rosen picked up his 600th career win on Sept. 7, 2018, in a 3-0 win over Oakland. Rosen has over 600 career wins at Northern Michigan, Cal State Bakersfield, Boise State and Michigan and is one of 21 active coaches in Division I with 600 career wins.

First Final Four in 2012

Mark Rosen became the first coach in history to lead the Wolverines to the NCAA Final Four when U-M reached the national semifinals in 2012. Michigan knocked off No. 2 Stanford in four sets in the regional final in Berkeley, Calif., to advance to the national semifinal against Texas in Louisville, Ky. The Wolverines were the only team to take sets off the Longhorns in the NCAA Tournament, falling to Texas in a five-set thriller.

Mark Rosen has had at least one player earn All-Big First Ten honors in 15 of the last 17 seasons, led by Lexi Zimmerman's (2008, '09, '10) and Abby Cole's (2014, '15, '16) three consecutive first team honors. In his 19 years at Michigan, Rosen has coached players to 38 Big Ten recognitions, including Stesha Selsky's Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honor in 2007.

- Leisa (Wissler) Rosen completed her 20th season at the University of Michigan working with her husband, head coach Mark Rosen. Prior to the 2001 season, Rosen was promoted to Associate Head Coach after spending her first two years at Michigan as an Assistant Coach.
- Rosen preceded her appointment at Michigan with a one-year coaching stint at Boise State University. While at
 Boise State, Rosen served as recruiting coordinator for the volleyball program, and was promoted to associate
 head coach before accepting the Michigan position. In addition to organizing Boise State's recruiting efforts,
 Rosen worked with the Bronco squad in all phases of the game, with her primary focus being the middle blockers.
- Began her coaching career with the Central Ohio Volleyball Club in 1992. She followed that with a two-year stint as the 16-Gold coach of the Kern River Volleyball Club in Bakersfield, Calif. (1993-94).
- Played professionally for the San Diego Spikers of the National Volleyball Association.
- Before her professional career, Rosen was a standout collegiate performer for the Ohio State University Buckeyes (1988-91). During her collegiate career, the Buckeyes won two Big Ten Conference champion-ships (1989, '91) and advanced to the 1991 NCAA Championship Semifinals.
- Garnered numerous individual accolades at Ohio State. As a senior, she was selected the Big Ten Conference Player of the Year, AVCA All-America second team and was the Ohio State Female Athlete of the Year. Rosen was named to the AVCA All-Mideast Region team three times (1989, '90, '91). She captured Big Ten Freshman of the Year honors in 1988 and also competed in the United States Olympic Festival in 1989 and 1991. She was inducted into the Ohio State Athletics Hall of Fame in 2001.
