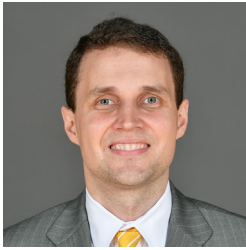

5th Year at LSU • 7th Year as a Head Coach

When LSU basketball won its final regular season Southeastern Conference game of the 2020-21 season, it marked 39 league regular season wins over a three-year period.

It was the most SEC wins by any team in the league over that same period.

It was part of a successfully negotiated pandemic year in which the team and its staff had to stop the program for almost two weeks in December, won 19 games, finished third in the league, made the SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 1993 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Basketball Tournament.

In a strange new world, the 2020-21 season again showed the consistency of the LSU program to be successful, and that consistency has been a buzzword for Coach Will Wade since he took the job at LSU.

When he arrived in Baton Rouge, Wade wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

He has worked hard to put together a program with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot early in the Southeastern Conference.

Now entering his fifth season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tigers basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In four years, the Tigers have won 86 games with three post-season appearances (and what would have been a fourth in 2020 before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019, a tie for second in 2020 and a third place finish in 2021. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018, to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships and to the second round of the NCAAs in 2021.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first Tiger mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to quickly know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first four seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

In 2021, LSU had to make several changes to the schedule because of the pandemic, losing and rescheduling several games in December and having the league change the schedule at one point on less than 48 hours notice with a road trip to Missouri becoming a road game at Ole Miss.

LSU would finish with one home loss for the second straight year, despite playing one less home game than other league schools, finishing at 7-1. The Tigers were third in the league, earning the double bye in the tournament for the third straight year. But this time LSU made the run that fans had been looking for, defeating Ole Miss and Arkansas to get

to the SEC Championship game for the first time since the 1993 season.

The Tigers would proceed to the NCAA bubble in Indianapolis where they advanced to the second round.

The 2021 team would average 81.8 points, marking the third straight year the Tigers averaged over 80 points a game. It was the highest scoring average since LSU averaged 87.5 points a game during the 1991-92 season. The three consecutive years marks the most since LSU had four straight seasons over 80 points from the 1988-89 season through the 1991-92 campaigns.

In 2020, LSU opened with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

The highlight of Wade's four years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

The team dedicated the season to Wayde and his parents, which included former Tiger player Wayne Sims. It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer. The Tigers would win 16 league games, one of their best overall 18-game league records.

So far in four seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 24 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

More than anything, LSU fans saw the advancement of returning players under Coach Wade and his staff and the way that the new players blended with the improved veterans.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 39, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded in kind.

PRIOR TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016.

In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years.

The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the Atlantic 10 Conference regular

season crown. The 2017 team won 26 games and finished second in the league.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The 18 wins overall were the most by the program since 2008-09 and the 12 wins in league games was the highest total since 2010-11. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

Wade was honored with the Anton Foy Southern Conference Coach of the Year award in 2014.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 and finished 15-3 in the league as Wade guided Chattanooga to its first 20-win season since 2004-05. He finished his two seasons there at 40-25 and 27-7 in league play. In the two seasons prior to his arrival, Chattanooga was 24-40 overall and 13-23 in SoCon play.

In his eight years as a head coach, he has a combined record at Chattanooga, VCU and LSU of 174-85 and 101-40 in conference play with six post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (4).

LAST GAME: LSU 83, BELMONT 53 (Baton Rouge, 11/22/21)

It was expected to be LSU's toughest game of the five-game homestand at the Maravich Center Monday night, facing a Belmont team that was averaging 25 wins over the last four seasons and with 97 percent of its offensive production back. It looked like it would be that way when Belmont got off to a 7-0 start and LSU was 1-of-7 from the field to open the game.

But LSU made 9-of-its-next 13 shots to move back into position and just kept going, outscoring the Bruins 36-16 to lead 36-23 at the half. LSU continued to pour it on offensively and defensively in the second half, with a 14-0 scoring run in the final 20 minutes that eventually built to a 39-point lead with 5:12 to play.

Four LSU players were in double figures with Tari Eason and Brandon Murray each scoring 15 points. Eason was 7-of-11 from the field, while Murray was 5-of-7 with 3-of-3 from distance. Xavier Pinson had his season high of 14 points and Efton Reid had 12 points and nine rebounds.

LSU was 32-of-59 from the field for 54.2% with six treys and 13-of-15 at the free throw line. Belmont shot just 32.3 percent (20-of-62) and made 10-of-39 three-pointers. LSU had a 42-31 advantage at the free throw line.

LSU won despite Darius Days only scoring nine points. LSU is 23-1 in the last 24 games when he has scored in double figures, but it is the first time since the final game of the pandemic halted 2019-20 season that LSU has won when Days was not in double figures. Days, who was injured in the previous game that year, only played one minute against Georgia in March 2020 in LSU's 94-64 win.

HOLDING UNDER 60

In the first five games, ULM scored 39, Texas State 59, Liberty 58, McNeese 46 and Belmont 53 points.

Amazingly, the last time LSU held five teams under 60 points to open the season was the start of the 1946-47 season when the Coach Harry Rabenhorst led Tigers would run off 20 straight games holding teams under 60 in a different era of college basketball. The first five games:

That year, LSU was 4-1 in those games.

THE UNDEFEATED

Ken Pomeroy has been counting down each team as it lost its first game in the college basketball season. From the original number of 358, as of Wednesday morning, the number was down to 44.

ONE OF THE REMAINING PROGRAM GOALS

Coach Will Wade discussed after the game on Monday night that the Tigers have accomplished many things in the first four years of his direction with the program -- conference championship (2019), first conference tournament final (since 1993), back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances and wins (2019, 2021) but the Tigers have not been good in regular season tournaments. The Will Wade era MTE results:

2020 – 1-1 – W versus SIUE, L at Saint Louis in the Billiken Classic.

2019 – 1-1 – L, vs. Utah State, W vs. Rhode Island in Jamaica.

2018 – 1-2 – W, vs. Charleston, L vs. Florida State (OT), L vs. Oklahoma St. in Orlando

2017 – 1-2 – W, vs. Michigan, L vs. Notre Dame, L vs. Marquette in Maui

One has to go back to 2103 in Orlando for the last time LSU won more than it lost in an event when the Tigers went 2-1.

The technical last MTE LSU won was a two-weekend round-robin event when LSU went 4-0 in the 2008 LSU Invitational, defeating Alcorn State, Northwestern State, Centenary and Troy. The last tournament win for LSU in a bracketed event where tournament results determined the next round pairings was the 2004 LSU Louisiana Classic when LSU defeated Tulane and UL-Lafayette.

AGAINST THE FIELD

LSU and Penn State haven't played since 1954 and that was in the regional semifinals of the NCAA East Regional. Penn State won, 78-70, on March 12, 1954.

Wake Forest and Oregon State have had more recent meetings with Wake Forest and LSU having met three times with Wake Forest winning twice. The last meeting was a 110-76 win by Wake on Dec. 22, 2016. The teams played a home-and-home in December of 2015 and 2016 after meeting in Dec. 1981 in the Sugar Bowl Classic.

Oregon State and LSU have met six times with LSU winning five games. The teams last played in Dec. 2006 and 2007 in a home-and-home series with LSU winning both games.

FIELD GOALS

In the second half combined in the four games, LSU has allowed just 44 total field goals with only McNeese (11) and Belmont (12) getting double figures in the second half.

ULM scored just four field goals in the final 20 minutes in LSU's 101-39 win, while Texas State made just 8.

Neither ULM or Texas State made a three-pointer in the final 20 minutes of play as both teams were 0-of-6 from the arc. LSU has outscored the five opponents, 239-133, combined in the final 20 minutes.

Regarding ULM's 4 field goals in the second half (11/9), the last time LSU held an opponent to fewer than 4 FGs in a half was Jan. 8, 2011, at Auburn when Auburn made just 2-of-24 in the first half.

McNeese (11/18) made just 6-of-31 first half field goals (19.4%)

For the season, LSU is at an even 50 percent through five games (158-316), while opponents are hitting just 33.2 percent (89-of-268).

POSSESSION NUMBERS

Against Texas State (11/12), LSU scored on 23-of-34 second half possessions and scored 1.529 points per possession, while the Bobcats were 11-of-34 and a points per possession of 0.647.

In the second half against Liberty, LSU scored on 22-of-37 possessions with 1.324 points per possession. LSU held Liberty to just 14 scores on 35 possession in the second half.

The numbers bear out what happened in the first half in the game with McNeese (11/18) as the Cowboys scored on just 7-of-39 possessions, scoring .410 points per possession. LSU scored on 39-of-73 possessions

In the five games, LSU has scored on 192-of-349 possessions (55.0%).

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS

In the first two games of the season, the Tigers forced nine shot clock violations – 4 against ULM and 5 against Texas State. The total for five games is 12 as LSU forced a late first half violation in the Belmont game (11/22).

The Tigers caused 52 turnovers combined against Liberty and McNeese (25 against Liberty, 27 versus McNeese) and after another 16 by Belmont, the Tigers have forced 105 through five games (an average of 21 a game). LSU has turned the ball over 66 times in four games (13.2 a contest).

A DIFFERENCE OF HALVES

LSU was down 37-32 at the half against Texas State (11/19) and turned the game around to an 84-59 advantage ... The 35-point differential between its 1st half (-5) and 2nd half margins (+30) was its largest since March 3, 2004, vs. Ole Miss (-11, +24) - 555 games ago.

LSU was able to turn a one-point deficit halftime into a 17-point differential for the Tigers in the 74-58 win against Liberty (11/18).

THREE-POINT SHOOTING FOR THE TIGERS

The Tigers are 43-of-112 for the early season from the arc, including shooting 10-of-18 (55.6%) against Texas State (11/12). On the other hand, opponents are 31-of-126 (24.6%).

The eight treys by Darius Days against ULM (11/9) marks the most in the Will Wade era, topping the six by Tremont Waters at Texas A&M in 2019, but also the third most made by a player in school history:

100 POINTS

The Tigers went to 5-0 under Will Wade when scoring 100 in the ULM game (11/9) and LSU has now won 19 straight games when hitting the century mark and 41-of-the-last-42. LSU is 104-8 overall when scoring 100 or more.

50 REBOUNDS

When LSU grabbed 50 rebounds against McNeese State (11/18), it marked the fifth time that the LSU Tigers have grabbed 50 boards or more against opponents in the Will Wade era. The previous 50 rebound game came in the regular season home finale against Vanderbilt in March 2021.

LAST YEAR QUICK RECAP

LSU finished its season on March 22 when it lost in the NCAA bubble in the round of 32 to Michigan. The Tigers defeated St. Bonaventure in its opening round game, marking two consecutive NCAA Tournaments (2019, 2021) that LSU won at least one game in the tournament. That hadn't happened for the Tigers since the 1986 and 1987 tournaments. LSU made the tournament for the first time in back-to-back events since the

2005 and 2006 seasons.

LSU finished 19-10 in a season that started later, had several schedule changes and included almost two weeks when the team couldn't play because of COVID-19 protocols that involved the coaching staff and players.

In the league, LSU was 11-6 (one canceled) to finish third in the SEC. LSU defeated Ole Miss and Arkansas to get to the finals of the SEC Tournament for the first time since 1993, where they lost to Alabama by just one point in the championship game.

LSU WINS

The numbers under Will Wade:

LSU won 39 Southeastern Conference regular season games over the last three seasons (16, 12, 11), the most in the SEC in that time span. Five schools won 30 or more games in those three seasons combined:

Over the last three seasons, LSU's 69 wins is tied for third as the most in a three-year period in school history. LSU's four-year total (2018-21) of 87 victories is tied for the fourth most in a four-year period in school history.

LSU is looking for a fifth consecutive winning season which would tie for the fourth longest streak of consecutive winning campaigns in school history. (LSU had a 5-year streak from 2012-2016 and 1977-81).

LSU after the first five games needs five victories to record the 600th on-court win in the Assembly Center. LSU is 595-199 (74.9%). LSU will play its 800th men's basketball game in the building on Jan. 15 against Arkansas.

HOME WINNING STREAK

With the five home wins to start the season, LSU has an eight-game win streak at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. LSU defeated Tennessee, Auburn and Vanderbilt last season in its final three regular-season home games.

THE GREATEST GAMES

As LSU celebrates the 50th anniversary of play in the former LSU Assembly Center, not Pete Maravich Assembly Center, fans are helping choose the greatest men's basketball game in the building in a 32-game NCAA bracket tournament.

Fans are voting on the LSU Sports App and the third bracket is available for voting this week, which will close on Saturday. Bracket Four will be announced and open for voting at the Dec. 1 Ohio game. Second round matchups will begin later in December eventually leading the announcement of the greatest game on Feb. 12 when LSU will celebrate the 50th anniversary with basketball alums.

PENN STATE NOTES

The Nittany Lions enter the Classic with a 3-1 record, with a win over undefeated Cornell in their last game on Monday, 85-74. Penn State has also won over Youngstown State, 75-59, and St. Francis Brooklyn, 74-59. The loss came on the road at UMass.

Three players are averaging in double figures, Sam Sessions (19.3 ppg), Seth Lundy (17.8 ppg) and John Harrar (11.3 ppg). Harrar is also averaging an amazing 12.8 rebounds a game.

TIGERS WERE HOME WARRIORS

The game on Monday night completed a 14-day, five-game opening run for LSU. It marks the first time LSU has opened with five straight home games in the period prior to Thanksgiving.

LSU opened with six straight home games in the 2012-13 season, but three of those games were after Thanksgiving. The Tigers had eight straight at home in the 2008-09 season, but again some of those games were played after Thanksgiving.

The Tigers also started with long opening homestands in 2003 and 2004 but in those years the NCAA college basketball season did not start until Nov. 19 or later.

NUMBERS, NUMBERS

There are again some number changes on players returning to the LSU roster for the 2021-22 season:

Mwani Wilkinson goes from "0" to "5" this season.

Eric Gaines drops the five from "25" and is just "2" this season.

Shareef O'Neal has changed from "32" to "24" for the 2021-22 season.

Parker Edwards has upped his number to 30 for this campaign.

But for the first time in his career, Darius Days did not change numbers, staying with the "4" he picked up prior to the 2020-21 season. Days has worn "22" as a freshman, "0" as a sophomore before picking up his high school number "4" for his junior season.

FATHERS AND SONS

Hopefully as he is finally getting cleared to practice again with the Tigers, LSU fans will get to see more of Shareef O'Neal in uniform in 2021-22. He appeared in 10 games, averaging 2.4 points and 4.4 rebounds a contest.

A DIFFERENCE IN THE STATS

Last year, the points were concentrated primarily with four of the starters – Cam Thomas, Javonte Smart, Trendon Watford, Darius Days.

This year three two players (Days, Tari Eason and Elton Reid) are averaging in double figures through the first five games, but three other players are averaging at least 9.0 points a game.

LSU has been going with a primarily eight-player rotation that is averaging 79.1 points of LSU's current average of 85.4 points a game. LSU has averaged over 80 points on the offensive end each of the last three seasons.

NOTICE THE MINUTES

In the past three seasons, LSU with a heavily depended on starting five, three players on each of the 2019, 2020 and 2021 teams averaged over 30 minutes a game and were at the top of the minutes played list in the league.

After five games, Brandon Murray is averaging 27.1 minutes and Darius Days is averaging 26.5 minutes a game.

There is no one in the top 15 in the league at present in minutes played this year.

DAYS EARNS SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Senior Darius Days was named on Monday the SEC Player of the Week and through five games he is averaging 19.2 points and 54 percent from the field and from three-point range. He is averaging 7.4 rebounds a game with a 30-point game, a 26-point game and his 17th career double double.

DAYS PRESEASON ALL-SEC SELECTION

Back for his fourth season, Darius Days is beginning to put his name in the LSU record book and has been an integral part of this Tiger team for three seasons now. The numbers:

99 career games played with 66 starts.

948 points, 52 away from 1,000.

608 rebounds, tied for No. 27th on the school rebound list presently.

73 wins in games he has played in for LSU.

LSU's last four-year player, Skylar Mays, had 77 wins in his four years for the Tigers (2017-20), while current assistant coach Tasmin Mitchell is one of the leaders in wins over the last couple of decades with 85 wins in his career that included the 2006 NCAA Final Four season and the 2009 SEC Championship team.

Days, who averaged 11.6 points and 7.8 rebounds a year ago, was selected first-team preseason All-SEC by the league coaches in their vote last month ... He shot over 50 percent last season, making 123-of-237 (51.9%) with 52 three-pointers. He posted 20 games in double figures in 2020-21, 48 over his career with eight double doubles.

The native of Raleigh, Florida was third in the SEC in rebound average a year ago and also defensive rebound average at 5.3 a game. He was sixth in the league in offensive rebound average at 2.5.

By the way, it should be pointed out he missed his first three-point attempt of the season in the Nov. 9 opener at the 18:22 mark and then made his next nine straight stretching to his first attempt of the Texas State game (11/12).

TARI EASON, DAYS AND THE DOUBLES

Each of the last two seasons, Darius Days had eight double doubles. Against McNeese (11/18), he got his first of the year and his 17th of his career, the active leader in the league.

But in the first five games, double double talk has been more about the sophomore transfer from Cincinnati, Tari Eason.

Eason kind of made his name known in the charity exhibition at Nicholls when he scored 22 points and grabbed 15 rebounds in October.

But in the first five games, he has doubled three times, including a 19-14 effort in the game against McNeese (11/18). That was a college career high for rebounds and one off his 20-point game at Tulane while playing for Cincinnati.

Eason, who had 15 against Belmont (11/22), is 29-of-53 from the field (54.7%) in the first five games with three treys. He is averaging 13.6 points and 8.8 rebounds. He is fifth in the league in rebound average.

Eason is one of the reinforcements for the Tigers, coming off the bench to play 21.2 minutes.

X-MAN

It's officially X-avier when it comes to pronouncing the Missouri transfer's name but one thing is certain that he has moved in to the point guard position held by Javonte Smart very well for the LSU Tigers. Pinson is averaging 9.0 points and 5.4 assists and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.25 with 27 assists and 12 turnovers.

Pinson has had eight assists against McNeese (11/18) and seven dimes in two other games.

Pinson played three seasons for Missouri before transferring to LSU for his fourth season.

Pinson needs just 52 points to get to a career college total of 1,000 points. Pinson is averaging 24.6 minutes a game this season.

MORE ON PINSON'S ASSISTS

After 5 games, Xavier Pinson's assists per minute (.253) are the most for LSU Basketball since Randy Livingston ran the point for the Tigers in the 1994-95 season (.275) Livingston played just 16 games that year due to injury.

ADAM MILLER

It should be three transfers for the Tigers with Adam Miller, coming to LSU from Illinois, to go with Tari Eason and Xavier Pinson. Miller, however, injured his knee last month in practice and has had ACL surgery and is expected to be out 6-to-9 months.

ERIC GAINES

The transition from freshman to sophomore has been good for Eric Gaines and other than Darius Days, he is one of the elder statesmen on this team and he has been one to help the younger guys get used to what they are in for in college basketball.

Gaines has come off the bench in all four games and has played no less than 23 minutes in each game. Three time he has posted 10 points, he has 12 steals and three games of five or more assists.

Gaines is averaging 9.2 points, 4.8 assists, along with 2.4 steals per game.

He is also 15-of-16 at the free throw line.

EFTON REID

The five-star freshman has made his presence felt in a lot of ways and none bigger than when he stepped out to the corner and made his first college three-pointer earlier this year. But the center has the post moves and rebound ability to help LSU.

Fans and media feel he is the old-school type of center and through five games he is averaging 10.2 points, and 6.0 rebounds. He posted 12 points and just missed a double with nine rebounds against Belmont (11/22).

Reid has made 24-of-39 shots (61.5%) and is averaging 21.3 minutes in his five starts.

BRANDON MURRAY

The freshman from Baltimore has started the first five games and is averaging 9.6 points with 3.2 rebounds a game.

He exploded against Belmont (11/22) with 15 points, hitting 5-of-7 field goals, including all three of his three-point attempts.

Murray has hit 17-of-33 shots, with eight three-pointers. Murray is averaging a team best 27.1 minutes a game. Murray has also had a 14-point game with three treys against Texas State (11/12).

RECRUITING CLASS FOR 2021-22

The recruiting class that LSU brought in for this 2021-22 season was ranked seventh in the national team rankings and LSU fans have seen some of those players in action early on.

Efton Reid was a five-star recruit and four-star recruit Brandon Murray highlighted that class.

THE STEALS

In LSU's first five games, the Tigers had double figure steals in four-of-the-five contests highlighted by 16 against Liberty and 17 against McNeese.

Mwani Wilkinson and Eric Gaines are in double figures for steals through five games with Wilkinson at 17 and Gaines at 12.

LSU has 69 steals through five games, an average of 13.80, close to doubling opponents at 7.00 a game.

Last year, LSU had 225 steals for the season. Although it is impossible to keep the pace up for a full season, the early pace of LSU would be good for over 400 steals this year.

THE YOUNG TIGERS

The Tigers are listed No. 324 of 358 teams on the Kenpom.com list based on experience this year. For the first time in several years, there are no Southeastern Conference teams below LSU on that list.

LSU is listed at 1.20 years with the D1 average at 1.89 in experience.

NOW ON TO THE RECRUITING CLASS FOR 2022-23

LSU signed two players in the early signing period and has another five-star inking players for Coach Will Wade.

Five-star forward Julian Phillips from Blythewood, South Carolina and Link Year Academy in Branson, Missouri, will be the sixth five-star recruit to play for Will Wade. Phillips is ranked No. 14 nationally by both ESPN, Rivals and 247sports.com. He is ranked No. 2 at the position by 247sports and No. 5 by ESPN.

This past year, Phillip averaged over 20 points this season for Blythewood High School.

LSU's other signee is Terry, Mississippi native Devin Ree who is now at Oak Hill Academy in Virginia. Ree was all-state last season at Terry High, averaging 23.2 points and 12 rebounds. He was ranked No. 84 in the
