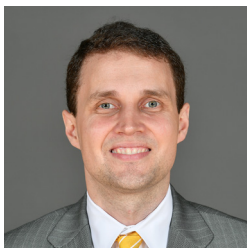

5th Year at LSU • 7th Year as a Head Coach

When LSU basketball won its final regular season Southeastern Conference game of the 2020-21 season, it marked 39 league regular season wins over a three-year period.

It was the most SEC wins by any team in the league over that same period.

It was part of a successfully negotiated pandemic year in which the team and its staff had to stop the program for almost two weeks in December, won 19 games, finished third in the league, made the SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 1993 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Basketball Tournament.

In a strange new world, the 2020-21 season again showed the consistency of the LSU program to be successful, and that consistency has been a buzzword for Coach Will Wade since he took the job at LSU.

When he arrived in Baton Rouge, Wade wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

He has worked hard to put together a program with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot early in the Southeastern Conference.

Now entering his fifth season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tigers basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In four years, the Tigers have won 86 games with three post-season appearances (and what would have been a fourth in 2020 before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019, a tie for second in 2020 and a third place finish in 2021. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018, to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships and to the second round of the NCAAs in 2021.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first Tiger mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to quickly know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first four seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

In 2021, LSU had to make several changes to the schedule because of the pandemic, losing and rescheduling several games in December and having the league change the schedule at one point on less than 48 hours notice with a road trip to Missouri becoming a road game at Ole Miss.

LSU would finish with one home loss for the second straight year, despite playing one less home game than other league schools, finishing at 7-1. The Tigers were third in the league, earning the double bye in the tournament for the third straight year. But this time LSU made the run that fans had been looking for, defeating Ole Miss and Arkansas to get

to the SEC Championship game for the first time since the 1993 season.

The Tigers would proceed to the NCAA bubble in Indianapolis where they advanced to the second round.

The 2021 team would average 81.8 points, marking the third straight year the Tigers averaged over 80 points a game. It was the highest scoring average since LSU averaged 87.5 points a game during the 1991-92 season. The three consecutive years marks the most since LSU had four straight seasons over 80 points from the 1988-89 season through the 1991-92 campaigns.

In 2020, LSU opened with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

The highlight of Wade's four years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

The team dedicated the season to Wayde and his parents, which included former Tiger player Wayne Sims. It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer. The Tigers would win 16 league games, one of their best overall 18-game league records.

So far in four seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 24 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

More than anything, LSU fans saw the advancement of returning players under Coach Wade and his staff and the way that the new players blended with the improved veterans.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 39, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded in kind.

PRIOR TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was the youngest head coach in the NCAA Tournament in 2016.

In 2017, VCU lost to St. Mary's in the first round of the NCAA tourney. The Rams were 28-8 over his two years in the Atlantic 10 Conference, posting 14-4 records both years.

The team was 25-11 in 2016 and earned a share of the Atlantic 10 Conference regular

season crown. The 2017 team won 26 games and finished second in the league.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The 18 wins overall were the most by the program since 2008-09 and the 12 wins in league games was the highest total since 2010-11. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

Wade was honored with the Anton Foy Southern Conference Coach of the Year award in 2014.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 and finished 15-3 in the league as Wade guided Chattanooga to its first 20-win season since 2004-05. He finished his two seasons there at 40-25 and 27-7 in league play. In the two seasons prior to his arrival, Chattanooga was 24-40 overall and 13-23 in SoCon play.

In his eight years as a head coach, he has a combined record at Chattanooga, VCU and LSU of 174-85 and 101-40 in conference play with six post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (4).

LAST GAME: LSU 84, Texas State 59 (Baton Rouge, 11/12/21)

The LSU Tigers broke open quite a battle with a tough Liberty squad with a 27-6 run over the final 7:06 to score a third consecutive victory to open the season.

For the second straight game, the Tigers found themselves in the hole at halftime, 26-25, before being able to make coaching adjustments that eventually impose their will on the Flames. LSU shot 56.7 percent overall in the final 20 minutes (17-of-30), including 6-of-10 from three-point range and 9-of-9 from the free throw line.

LSU got Liberty to turn the ball over 21 times and recorded 23 points off turnovers to just 14 for the 14 LSU turnovers for Liberty. LSU had 16 steals and a 20-2 advantage in fast break points.

Darius Days scored 20 second-half points, hitting four treys to finish with 26 points. Efton Reid hit his first college three-pointer in the late game run to finish with 13 points while Xavier Pinson and Eric Gaines each scored 10. Pinson had seven assists and Gaines had five steals.

FIELD GOALS

In the second half combined in the three games, LSU has allowed just 21 total field goals with no opponent getting double figures in the second half.

ULM scored just four field goals in the final 20 minutes in LSU's 101-39 win, while Texas State made just 8.

Neither ULM or Texas State made a three-pointer in the final 20 minutes of play as both teams were 0-of-6 from the arc. LSU has outscored the three opponents, 150-73, combined in the final 20 minutes.

Regarding ULM's 4 field goals in the second half (11/9), the last time LSU held an opponent to fewer than 4

FGs in a half was Jan. 8, 2011, at Auburn when Auburn made just 2-of-24 in the first half.

HOLDING UNDER 60

POSSESSION NUMBERS

Last Friday against Texas State, LSU scored on 23-of-34 second half possessions or 1.529 points per possession, while the Bobcats were 11-of-34 and a points per possession of 0.647.

In the second half on Monday against Liberty, LSU scored on 22-of-37 possessions with 1.324 points per possession. LSU held Liberty to just 14 scores on 35 possession in the second half

In the three games LSU has scored on 114-of-204 possessions (55.9%), while opponents are 71-of-202 (35.1%).

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS

In the first two games of the season, the Tigers have forced nine shot clock violations – 4 against ULM and 5 against Texas State. The Tigers have forced 62 turnovers in the first three games and scored 83 points off turnovers.

A DIFFERENCE OF HALVES

LSU was down 37-32 at the half last Friday against Texas State and turned the game around to an 84-59 advantage ... The 35-point differential between its 1st half (-5) and 2nd half margins (+30) was its largest since March 3, 2004, vs. Ole Miss (-11, +24) – 555 games ago.

LSU was able to turn a one-point deficit halftime into a 17-point differential for the Tigers in the 74-58 win on Monday.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING FOR THE TIGERS

The Tigers are 30-of-69 (43.5%) for the early season from the arc, including shooting 10-of-18 (55.6%) against Texas State (11/12). On the other hand, opponents are 17-of-60 (28.3%). Entering play Tuesday, the Tigers are third in the league in three-point field goal percentage.

The eight treys by Darius Days against ULM (11/9) marks the most in the Will Wade era, topping the six by Tremont Waters at Texas A&M in 2019, but also the third most made by a player in school history:

100 POINTS

The Tigers went to 5-0 under Will Wade when scoring 100 in the ULM game (11/9) and LSU has now won 19 straight games when hitting the century mark and 41-of-the-last-42. LSU is 104-8 overall when scoring 100 or more.

LAST YEAR QUICK RECAP

LSU finished its season on March 22 when it lost in the NCAA bubble in the round of 32 to Michigan. The Tigers defeated St. Bonaventure in its opening round game, marking two consecutive NCAA Tournaments (2019, 2021) that LSU won at least one game in the tournament. That hadn't happened for the Tigers since the 1986 and 1987 tournaments. LSU made the tournament for the first time in back-to-back events since the 2005 and 2006 seasons.

LSU finished 19-10 in a season that started later, had several schedule changes and included almost two weeks when the team couldn't play because of COVID-19 protocols that involved the coaching staff and players.

In the league, LSU was 11-6 (one canceled) to finish third in the SEC. LSU defeated Ole Miss and Arkansas to get to the finals of the SEC Tournament for the first time since 1993, where they lost to Alabama by just one point in the championship game.

LSU WINS

The numbers under Will Wade:

LSU has won 39 Southeastern Conference regular season games over the last three seasons (16, 12, 11), the most in the SEC in that time span. Five schools won 30 or more games in those three seasons combined:

Over the last three seasons, LSU's 69 wins is tied for third as the most in a three-year period in school history. LSU's four-year total (2018-21) of 87 victories is tied for the fourth most in a four-year period in school history.

LSU is looking for a fifth consecutive winning season which would tie for the fourth longest streak of consecutive winning campaigns in school history. (LSU had a 5-year streak from 2012-2016 and 1977-81).

LSU after the first three games needs seven victories to record the 600th on-court win in the Assembly Center. LSU is 593-199 (74.9%). LSU will play its 800th men's basketball game in the building on Jan. 15 against Arkansas.

WINNING STREAK

With the three home wins to start the season, LSU enters the McNeese game with a six-game win streak at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. LSU defeated Tennessee, Auburn and Vanderbilt last season in its final three regular-season home games.

MCNEESE NOTES

The Cowboys come into the game with a 1-2 record after road losses at SMU (86-62) and TCU (77-61) before defeating Champion Christian, 116-66, on Monday in Lake Charles.

Six players were in double figures with Brendan Medley-Bacon leading the Cowboys with 20 points. Myles Lewis added 18 and Zach Scott added 15. The Cowboys shot 43-of-77 for the game, 55.8%, with 12 made threes.

The game was the first NCAA Division I win for McNeese head coach John Aiken. Earlier, Aiken was the head coach for two years at NAIA Belhaven.

McNeese and LSU are meeting for the first time since the 2015 season when LSU won, 81-70. The teams have met 24 times, 23 in Baton Rouge, and LSU is 24-0 in the series.

LOUISIANA OPPONENTS

The Tigers have won 25 consecutive regular season and post-season games against Louisiana schools going into Thursday's game against McNeese.

LSU's last loss against a state school in regular season play came on Nov. 16, 2010 when the Tigers were defeated by Nicholls State, 62-53.

LSU defeated ULM in the season opener and after the McNeese game, has a Dec. 14 game with Northwestern State.

NUMBERS, NUMBERS

There are again some number changes on players returning to the LSU roster for the 2021-22 season:

Mwani Wilkinson goes from "0" to "5" this season.

Eric Gaines drops the five from "25" and is just "2" this season.

Shareef O'Neal has changed from "32" to "24" for the 2021-22 season.

Parker Edwards has upped his number to 30 for this campaign.

But for the first time in his career, Darius Days did not change numbers, staying with the "4" he picked up prior to the 2020-21 season. Days has worn 22 as a freshman, 0 as a sophomore before picking up his high school number "4" for his junior season.

FATHERS AND SONS

Hopefully as he is finally getting cleared to practice again with the Tigers, LSU fans will get to see more of Shareef O'Neal in uniform in 2021-22. He appeared in 10 games, averaging 2.4 points and 4.4 rebounds a contest.

DAYS PRESEASON ALL-SEC SELECTION

Back for his fourth season, Darius Days is beginning to put his name in the LSU record book and has been an integral part of this Tiger team for three seasons now. The numbers started off in a very positive way for Days with his first two games that have him averaging 23.5 points and hitting 69.2 percent for field goals overall and 73.3 percent from the arc:

96 career games played with 63 starts.

899 points, 101 away from 1,000.

584 rebounds, 40th members of 500 rebounds club, No. 28 presently.

71 wins in games he has played in for LSU.

LSU's last four-year player, Skylar Mays, had 77 wins in his four years for the Tigers (2017-20), while current assistant coach Tasmin Mitchell is one of the leaders in wins over the last couple of decades with 85 wins in his career that included the 2006 NCAA Final Four season and the 2009 SEC Championship team.

Days, who averaged 11.6 points and 7.8 rebounds a year ago, was selected first-team preseason All-SEC by the league coaches in their vote last month ... He shot over 50 percent last season, making 123-of-237 (51.9%) with 52 three-pointers. He has posted 20 games in double figures in 2020-21, 47 over his career with eight double doubles, 16 over three seasons. His 16 is the most by active SEC players for their career.

The native of Raleigh, Florida was third in the SEC in rebound average a year ago and also defensive rebound average at 5.3 a game. He was sixth in the league in offensive rebound average at 2.5.

By the way, it should be pointed out he missed his first three-point attempt of the season Tuesday at the 18:22 mark and then made his next nine straight stretching to his first attempt of the Texas State game.

The totals right now for Days are 24.3 points a game with 6.7 rebounds. He is averaging 29.1 minutes through the first three games.

TARI EASON

Darius Days has been a double double work for the Tigers but Cincinnati transfer has doubled up in his first two games this season. Eason posted 11 points and 10 boards against ULM (11/9) and followed that up with 17 points and 10 boards against Texas State (11/12). Eason has come off the bench in all three games and is averaging 11.3 points and 7.7 rebounds a contest.

He is 14-of-29 from the field with two treys.

Eason had 22 points and 15 rebounds in the charity exhibition game at Nicholls State last month. He had one double double at Cincinnati, with 20 points and 13 rebounds versus Tulane.

X-MAN

It's officially X-avier when it comes to pronouncing the Missouri transfer's name but one thing is certain that he has moved in to the point guard position held by Javonte Smart very well for the LSU Tigers. Pinson has 26 points in the three games with 17 assists and five steals.

Against Liberty (11/12), Pinson had 10 points, seven assists and two steals.

Pinson played three seasons for Missouri before transferring to LSU for his fourth season.

Pinson needs just 71 points to get to a career college total of 1,000 points. He has made 10-of-24 from the field (41.7%) and is averaging 25 minutes a game.

ADAM MILLER

It was three transfers for the Tigers with Adam Miller, coming to LSU from Illinois, to go with Tari Eason and Xavier Pinson. Miller, however, injured his knee last month in practice and has had ACL surgery and is expected to be out 6-to-9 months.

ERIC GAINES

He seems like a true veteran of the program after a year and he has come off the bench to have some great moments for the Tigers, including five steals against Liberty on Monday to go with 10 points. Gaines is averaging 9.3 points with 15 assists and eight steals. He is averaging 27 minutes off the bench and is a perfect 10-of-10 at the free throw line early on.

EFTON REID

The five-star freshman has made his presence felt in a lot of ways and none bigger than when he stepped out to the corner and made his first college three-pointer. But the center has the post moves and rebound ability to help LSU and in his three games he is 14-of-23 from the field (60.9%) and is averaging 10.3 points and 5.3 rebounds.

BRANDON MURRAY

The freshman from Baltimore has started the first three games and is averaging 8.7 points through the first three games with 3.3 rebounds a game.

Murray has hit 9-of-19 shots, with five being three-pointers. Murray is averaging 29.0 minutes a game, second most on the Tiger team early on.

RECRUITING CLASS FOR 2021-22

The recruiting class that LSU brought in for the 2021-22 season was ranked seventh in the national team rankings and LSU fans have seen some of those players in action early on.

Efton Reid has held the center spot through the first two games, giving something LSU hasn't really had since the 2019 season. Reid has the post moves as he tries to continue to get used to the college games. Through two games, he is averaging nine points and five rebounds. He was a five-star recruit.

Four-star recruit Brandon Murray has started at one of the guard positions and has made 7-of-11 field goals in two games with four treys. He is averaging 10.5 points per game and 1.5 rebounds.

THE STEALS

LSU has four players with at least five steals through the first three games with a team total of 37 so far.

Eric Gaines and Mwani Wilkinson each has eight takeaways, while Alex Fudge has six and Xavier Pinson five.

NOW ON TO THE RECRUITING CLASS FOR 2022-23

LSU signed two players in the early signing period and has another five-star inking players for Coach Will Wade.

Five-star forward Julian Phillips from Blythewood, South Carolina and Link Year Academy in Branson, Missouri, will be the sixth five-star recruit to play for Will Wade. Phillips is ranked No. 14 nationally by both ESPN, Rivals and 247sports.com. He is ranked No. 2 at the position by 247sports and No. 5 by ESPN.

This past year, Phillip averaged over 20 points this season for Blythewood High School.

LSU's other signee is Terry, Mississippi native Devin Ree who is now at Oak Hill Academy in Virginia. Ree was all-state last season at Terry High, averaging 23.2 points and 12 rebounds. He was ranked No. 84 in the nation by the recruiting services and the No. 1 player in the state of Mississippi.

SEC BESTS

As mentioned Darius Days entered the season the leader in career double doubles in the SEC with 16. Here are where others stand on active league leaders entering the weekend:

Points – Pinson is second at 929, behind only Jaden Shackelford of Alabama; Days is third on the list.

Rebounds – Days is the active career leader in the SEC at 591.

Assists – Pinson at 250 is 2nd behind Wheeler at 348.

DEFLECTIONS

Thanks to the coach and the managers keeping stuff, we are privy to the deflection totals and in the opening game the Tigers recorded 41 deflections. That total was matched in the Liberty contest (11/12). In three games, LSU has a total of 111 deflections.

The complete list for each player for the season is on the CHART at the back of the notes.

Darius Days and Tari Eason led LSU against Liberty with nine assists each with Eric Gaines posting eight deflections.

Days and Eason tied the early season high of nine set by Mwani Wilkinson against ULM (11/9).
