No. 6 LSU Gymnastics Opens SEC Schedule at Georgia

No. 6 LSU Gymnastics returns to competition after a two-week hiatus to open Southeastern Conference play at No. 36 Georgia at 6 p.m. CT Friday inside Stegeman Coliseum. Steve Schlanger and Ashley Miles will call the meet for the SEC Network from home. LSU's meets against Missouri and Arkansas were postponed after COVID-19 protocols. A veteran LSU team returns every routine from a year ago as well as a healthy Kai Rivers and stacked freshman class featuring Aleah Finnegan, KJ Johnson and Tori Tatum. Haleigh Bryant, the reigning NCAA vault national champion and SEC Freshman of the Year, is expected to compete on vault and bars Friday after suffering an injury during warmups prior to floor in the season opener. Kiya Johnson, the reigning SEC Specialist of the Year, will compete on vault, bars and beam. In the season opener against Centenary, LSU started out strong with a 49.400 and 49.500 on bars. The scores still stand as the No. 2 and No. 1 scores in the nation respectively.

Story Lines

- Georgia owns the all-time series over LSU with a record of 71-39-2 and 22-6 record in Athens. The Tigers have won 15 straight over the Bulldogs since 2016 and won the last two regular-season meets in Athens. In 2018, LSU won its first regular season meet since 1983.

- Jay Clark is in his second season as the LSU Gymnastics head coach and 10th season overall on the Tiger staff. In his first season as head coach, LSU compiled a 14-9 record in the altered schedule. Clark's squad finished second at SEC Championships and advanced to NCAA Championships for the 31st time in school history. The Tigers finished fourth in NCAA Semifinal II and sixth overall.

- Following the retirement of assistant coach Bob Moore and Ashleigh Clare-Kearney Thigpen's transition from volunteer coach to LSU's Assistant AD of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, Clark hired Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth to serve as assistant coaches. The Griffeths bring a wealth of experience as coaches and Courtney as an Olympian and gymnast at Georgia under Clark. The duo joins Clark and assistant Ashleigh Gnat as one of the top coaching staffs in the nation.

- LSU welcomes a dynamic freshman class featuring Aleah Finnegan, KJ Johnson and Tori Tatum. Finnegan will compete

for the first time in her career on Friday in Athens. KJ Johnson made an impression in her first meet with a 9.90 on vault and floor. She was named the SEC Freshman of the Week after her performance.

- The LSU team features two of the best all-around gymnasts in the country in Kiya Johnson and Haleigh Bryant. Bryant won the 2021 NCAA vault national championship, SEC vault title and was named the SEC Freshman of the Year and WCGA Region 1 Gymnast of the Year. Johnson was named the SEC Specialist of the Year and finished the season as the No. 1 performer in the country on floor.



JAY CLARK

HEAD COACH • 2nd SEASON

Jay Clark, a 30-year veteran of college gymnastics and one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his second season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2020 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented visibility to the program and success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of eight seasons, numerous school records, produced eight NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark was named the WCGA Region 1 Coach of the Year in his first season in 2021. He was also named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. LSU's bars lineup has finished in the top-10 in the nation eight times, including the No. 1 team in 2018.

In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge. As head coach of the Fighting Tigers, Haleigh Bryant was selected as the SEC Freshman of the Year and Kiya Johnson was selected as the SEC Specialist of the Year.

In his first season as the leader of the program, Clark led the squad to the program's 31st NCAA Championships appearance. He became the fourth head coach in NCAA Gymnastics history to lead two division I programs to NCAA Championships.

Five of the six bars workers in 2021 featured underclassmen and the squad ultimately finished sixth in the nation with an NQS of 49.456. Sami Durante moved into the anchor spot of bars and earned All-America honors for the first time in her career. Freshman Olivia Dunne and sophomore Alyona Shchennikova finished in the top eight at NCAA Championships to earn All-America honors.

In the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, LSU finished fifth in the nation on bars with a 49.405 NQS. Ruby Harrold competed in the anchor spot of the bars lineup and finished 19th in the nation, and Sami Durante finished 25th.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priesman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene

Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priesman combined for three All-America honors. Priesman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priesman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against Iowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won a NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark is married to the former Julie Ballard, an All-American Georgia gymnast from 1994-98 and a native of Mandeville, Louisiana. The couple has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

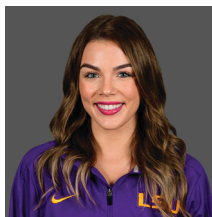

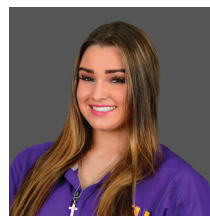

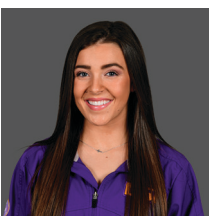

Last Time Out

- In the season opener against Centenary, LSU scored a 196.950 to take the victory and the program's 10th-straight win to start a season. .
- The Tigers scored a 49.400 on vault and 49.500, which are the No. 2 and No. 1 scores respectively in the nation.
- The bars lineup posted the highest score on the event in a season opener in school history.
- LSU gymnasts swept the events with Haleigh Bryant winning vault and beam, Alyona Shchennikova taking the bars and all-around titles and KJ Johnson taking home floor in her first career performance for LSU.

The Georgia Connections

- LSU head coach Jay Clark is an alum of the University of Georgia and was on staff for more than 25 years. He spent the last three years in Athens as the head coach.
- Assistant coaches Garrett Griffith and Courtney McCool Griffith graduated from UGA. Courtney is an Olympian and competed for the Bulldogs from 2007-10, helping the GymDogs to three consecutive NCAA titles from 2007-09. Garrett served on Clark's staff as a graduate assistant coach in 2011 and an administrative associate in 2012.
- Danna Durante, the mother of LSU senior Sami Durante, followed Jay Clark as the head coach of the Bulldogs. Sami Durante was originally committed to Georgia before ultimately signing with LSU.
- Haleigh Bryant grew up in the state of Georgia and trained at Georgia All Stars before moving to North Carolina at the end of 2010.
- Elena Arenas trained at Georgia Elite Gymnastics, the same club as Sami Durante. Arenas' parents, Pete and Kim, own Georgia Elite. Pete played baseball and Kim Arnold won two NCAA all-around titles for the Bulldogs. Kim was coached by Clark while in Athens.
- Sierra Ballard's mother is Lori Strong Ballard. Lori is an Olympian and competed at the University of Georgia while Clark was on staff. She was the 1994 NCAA bars champion, 1993 SEC bars champion and 1996 SEC all-around champion.

Johnson Named SEC Freshman of the Week in Debut

- KJ Johnson provided a spark for the Tigers in her debut and was rewarded as the SEC Freshman of the Week.
- Johnson, out of Texas Dreams in Dallas, scored a 9.90 on vault and floor in her first meet as a Tiger.
- She secured her first career victory as the top floor performer on the night.

Clark Heads Into Year Two as Head Coach

- Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons on staff, was elevated to head coach of the Fighting Tigers in 2020 and is now in his second season as head coach.
- Clark owns 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- LSU finished sixth nationally in 2021 after advancing to NCAA Championships for the 31st time in school history.
- He became the fourth coach in NCAA Division I Gymnastics history to take two different programs to the championships.
- Clark previously served for more than 20 years as an assistant coach and head coach at the University of Georgia.

Griffeths Join Clark and Gnat on Staff

- Following the retirement of longtime assistant coach Bob Moore and the transition of Ashleigh Clare-Kearney Thigpen to an administrative role as Associate AD of Diversity Equity and Inclusion, Clark hired Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth to serve as assistant coaches.
- The Griffeths come to Baton Rouge after serving as assistant coaches for two seasons at the University of Utah. In that time, the Utes went 21-1 during the regular season, won the 2021 Pac-12 Championship and finished third nationally after advancing to the NCAA Championship Final.
- Prior to their time in Salt Lake City, Garrett served as the associate head coach and Courtney the volunteer coach and choreographer for two seasons at Arkansas. They spent four seasons at Texas Woman's University from 2014-17 and prior to that coached at Cincinnati Gymnastics Academy in 2013.
- Both earned bachelor and master's degrees from Georgia, where Griffeth served on Clark's staff as a graduate assistant coach in 2011 and an administrative associate in 2012. McCool competed at Georgia from 2007-10, helping the GymDogs to three consecutive NCAA titles from 2007-09. She was the 2008 NCAA floor champion.

Johnson, Bryant Two of Nation's Top Gymnasts

- LSU's Kiya Johnson and Haleigh Bryant are regarded as two of the top all-around gymnasts in the country.
- Bryant completed arguably the greatest freshman season in school history, culminating by winning the NCAA vault title. She was named the WCGA Region 1 Gymnast of the Year and selected as the SEC Freshman of the Year.
- Bryant won the SEC vault title with her electric vault, a front handspring-front pike half.
- She earned six all-america honors in 2021.
- Johnson is the reigning SEC floor champion and finished 2021 as the No. 1 performer on floor.
- She has totaled eight all-america honors in her career and combined for five perfect 10's on vault, beam and floor.

Seniors Return Ten Routines to 2022

- Five members of LSU's 2021 senior class returned to the team for their fifth and final season.
- Reagan Campbell, Bridget Dean, Christina Desiderio, Sami Durante and Sarah Edwards provide a wealth of experience and routines for the Tigers in their fifth year.
- Campbell and Dean have moved exclusively train on beam
- Desiderio is a beam and floor specialist who has earned All-America honors.
- Edwards is a vault and floor performer who provides a 10.0 vault and high energy on the floor.
- After competing on three events for most of her career, Durante is now training in the all-around for the Tigers.

Freshman Class Brings Big Routines

- LSU's freshman class of Aleah Finnegan, KJ Johnson and Tori Tatum bring a lot to the table and are expected to contribute significantly in their first year.
- Finnegan, the sister of two-time NCAA champion Sarah Finnegan, is regarded as one of LSU's top beam workers and will train the all-around.
- Johnson brings power on her Yurchenko Full and could potentially compete a double. She will also fight for a spot in LSU's floor lineup.
- Tatum trains on vault and bars and will compete a Yurchenko 1 1/2 for the Tigers.

Rivers Returns in 2022

- Junior Kai Rivers returned to training in the fall and will be a mainstay in LSU's vault and bars lineup at least in 2022.
- Rivers suffered an Achilles injury during the fall of 2020 while rehabbing from shoulder surgery.
- In her debut in the season opener Rivers scored a 9.875 on both vault and bars.

Meets Rescheduled for Feb. 20

- LSU's meet against Missouri during the second week of competition and meet at home against Arkansas on the third week were postponed due to COVID-19 protocols.
- The Tigers will now face both teams in a tri meet on Feb. 20 in Columbia, Missouri.
- Rotations and television and streaming information will be announced at a later date.
