No. 5 LSU to make ESPN Debut Friday Against No. 8 Alabama

The LSU Gymnastics team will makes its ESPN debut against No. 8 Alabama at 8 p.m. CT Friday inside the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. The Tigers (3-1, 2-1 SEC) begin a double weekend against the Crimson Tide (4-3, 2-2 SEC) before traveling to Columbia, Missouri to face Arkansas and Missouri in a tri meet. The premier meet of the weekend will be televised on ESPN with Bart Conner, Kathy Johnson Clarke and Samantha Peszek on the call. LSU is coming off a 197.825 score in Gainesville, which was the top away score for the team and the fourth-highest away score in the nation in 2022. The squad put together four consistent rotations of 49.400-plus against the Gators, including season-high scores of 49.475 on vault and beam. Haleigh Bryant Kiya Johnson continued their stellar seasons with wins on bars and beam respectively. Kiya Johnson scored a 39.575 in the all-around for third in the competition. KJ Johnson matched her career highs with 9.90 on vault and 9.95 on floor. Junior Kai Rivers made her debut on beam as a last-minute substitute in the fifth spot. With a fall ahead of her and raucous crowd celebrating a 10 flor Florida, Rivers hit a 9.90. Senior Christina Desiderio also had a stellar meet with a 9.875 on beam and 9.90 on floor.

Storylines

- Alabama leads the all-time series over LSU with a record of 100-29-2. The Crimson Tide has a 17-13-2 record agains the Tigers in the PMAC. LSU has won three of the last four meetings against Alabama in the PMAC.
- LSU owns top-five rankings in three of four events already in 2022. The Tigers have season highs of 49.475 on vault, 49.500 on bars, 49.475 on beam and 49.775 on floor. The score of 49.775 against Auburn marked a school record.
- LSU is going after its secondstraight sellout in the PMAC, which would mark just the second time in school history. The No. 1 meet in school history came against Alabama in 2018 when 13,729 fans packed the PMAC to watch LSU defeat Alabama, 197.450-196.725.
- Freshman KJ Johnson has made an immediate impact for LSU in her first four meets with six scores of 9.90 or higher on vault and floor. Johnson has been named the SEC Freshman of the Week twice and owns career highs of 9.90 on vault and 9.95 on floor.
- Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson each scored a perfect 10 in the win over No. 6 Auburn. The 10 marked the third for Bryant and sixth overall for Johnson. It marked the 15th meet in LSU history with multiple perfect scores. The duo also each earned a perfect score in the Tigers' regular season finale in the PMAC in 2021.
- LSU will also travel to Columbia, Missouri for a rescheduled tri meet against Missouri and Arkansas.
 First vault is set for noon CT Sunday.

JAY CLARK

HEAD COACH • 2nd SEASON

Jay Clark, a 30-year veteran of college gymnastics and one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his second season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2020 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented visibility to the program and success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of eight seasons, numerous school records, produced eight NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark was named the WCGA Region 1 Coach of the Year in his first season in 2021. He was also named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. LSU's bars lineup has finished in the top-10 in the nation eight times, including the No. 1 team in 2018.

In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge. As head coach of the Fighting Tigers, Haleigh Bryant was selected as the SEC Freshman of the Year and Kiya Johnson was selected as the SEC Specialist of the Year.

In his first season as the leader of the program, Clark led the squad to the program's 31st NCAA Championships appearance. He became the fourth head coach in NCAA Gymnastics history to lead two division I programs to NCAA Championships.

Five of the six bars workers in 2021 featured underclassmen and the squad ultimately finished sixth in the nation with an NQS of 49.456. Sami Durante moved into the anchor spot of bars and earned All-America honors for the first time in her career. Freshman Olivia Dunne and sophomore Alyona Shchennikova finished in the top eight at NCAA Championships to earn All-America honors.

In the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, LSU finished fifth in the nation on bars with a 49.405 NQS. Ruby Harrold competed in the anchor spot of the bars lineup and finished 19th in the nation, and Sami Durante finished 25th .

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene

Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against lowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark is married to the former Julie Ballard, an All-American Georgia gymnast from 1994-98 and a native of Mandeville, Louisiana. The couple has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

- The away score marked the fourth-highest in the nation in 2022.

LSU Fans Going for Back-To-Back Sellouts

- LSU fans packed the PMAC against Auburn on February 5 in a sell out with 13,659 fans.
- The program is now going after back-to-back sellouts for the second time in school history.
- In 2018, LSU set the PMAC gymnastics record with 13,729 against Alabama and then two weeks later hit 13,185 against Kentucky.
- LSU already set the record for season tickets sold in 2022 with 7,500-plus.
- The top 10-most attended meets in school history have come since 2015 with LSU hitting the 13,000 mark five times.
- LSU is 10-2 in meets with more than 12,000 fans, proving once again that the PMAC is the top environment in all of collegiate gymnastics.

Johnson Back in the All-Around

- Due to a sensitive Achilles tendon, junior Kiya Johnson has been limited in her return to perform on floor but she made her 2022 debut against Auburn.
- In that debut, the top floor performer in the nation made a splash with a perfect score.
- The 10 marked the sixth of her career and fourth on floor.
- Johnson's resume speaks for itself and it is why she is considered one of the best gymnasts in the nation. She has scored a 10.0 on vault, beam and floor. She also owns a career high 9.95 on bars and is a stable leadoff performer on the event.

LSU Owns 12 49.700-Plus Scores in School History

- Since 2014, LSU lineups have put up 12 scores of 49.700 or higher across all four events.

- LSU earned its 300th victory inside the PMAC against Auburn.
- LSU's home for 250 meets since 1975, the PMAC has provided one of the best atmospheres in all of collegiate gymnastics.
- The Tigers own a winning percentage of .830 in 48 years of competition in the arena.

Desiderio Named SEC Specialist of the Week

- Senior Christina Desiderio had the top performance of her career against Auburn and was rewarded by being named the SEC Specialist of the Year.
- Arguably the top leadoff performer on beam and floor, Desiderio scored a season high 9.925 on beam and career high 9.95 on floor.
- She set the table on floor for LSU's 49.775, which set a new school record and marked the highest for any team in 2022.
- The honor for Desiderio marked the first league honor since being named the SEC Freshman of the Week in February 2018.

Johnson Named SEC Freshman of the Week in Debut

- KJ Johnson provided a spark for the Tigers in her debut and was rewarded as the SEC Freshman of the Week.
- Johnson, out of Texas Dreams in Dallas, scored a 9.90 on vault and floor in her first meet as a Tiger.
- She secured her first career victory as the top floor performer on the night.

- Junior Kai Rivers returned to training in the fall and has been a mainstay in LSU's vault and bars lineup.
- Rivers owns season highs of 9.85 on vault, 9.90 on bars and against Florida hit a 9.90 on beam.
- Rivers suffered an Achilles injury during the fall of 2020 while rehabbing from shoulder surgery.

Clark Heads Into Year Two as Head Coach

- Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons on staff, was elevated to head coach of the Fighting Tigers in 2020 and is now in his second season as head coach.
- Clark owns 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- LSU finished sixth nationally in 2021 after advancing to NCAA Championships for the 31st time in school history.
- He became the fourth coach in NCAA Division I Gymnastics history to take two different programs to the championships.
- Clark previously served for more than 20 years as an assistant coach and head coach at the University of Georgia.

Griffeths Join Clark and Gnat on Staff

- Following the retirement of longtime assistant coach Bob Moore and the transition of Ashleigh Clare-Kearney Thigpen to an administrative role as Associate AD of Diversity Equity and Inclusion, Clark hired Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth to serve as assistant coaches.
- The Griffeths come to Baton Rouge after serving as assistant coaches for two seasons at the University of Utah. In that time, the Utes went 21-1 during the regular season, won the 2021 Pac-12 Championship and finished third nationally after advancing to the NCAA Championship Final.
- Prior to their time in Salt Lake City, Garrett served as the associate head coach and Courtney the volunteer coach and choreographer for two seasons at Arkansas. They spent four seasons at Texas Woman's University from 2014-17 and prior to that coached at Cincinnati Gymnastics Academy in 2013.
- Both earned bachelor and master's degrees from Georgia, where Griffeth served on Clark's staff as a graduate assistant coach in 2011 and an administrative associate in 2012. McCool competed at Georgia from 2007–10, helping the GymDogs to three consecutive NCAA titles from 2007–09. She was the 2008 NCAA floor champion.

Johnson, Bryant Two of Nation's Top Gymnasts

- LSU's Kiya Johnson and Haleigh Bryant are regarded as two of the top all-around gymnasts in the country.
- Bryant completed arguably the greatest freshman season in school history, culminating by winning the NCAA vault title. She was named the WCGA Region 1 Gymnast of the Year and selected as the SEC Freshman of the Year.
- Bryant won the SEC vault title with her electric vault, a front handspring-front pike half.
- She earned six all-america honors in 2021.
- Johnson is the reigning SEC floor champion and finished 2021 as the No. 1 performer on floor.
- She has totaled eight all-america honors in her career and combined for five perfect 10's on vault, beam and floor.

Seniors Return Ten Routines to 2022

- Five members of LSU's 2021 senior class returned to the team for their fifth and final season.
- Reagan Campbell, Bridget Dean, Christina Desiderio, Sami Durante and Sarah Edwards provide a wealth of experience and routines for the Tigers in their fifth year.
- Campbell and Dean have moved exclusively train on beam
- Desiderio is a beam and floor specialist who has earned All-America honors
- Edwards is a vault and floor performer who provides a 10.0 vault and high energy on the floor.
- After competing on three events for most of her career, Durante is now training in the all-around for the Tigers.

Freshman Class Brings Big Routines
