STORYLINES

- LSU has advanced to NCAA Championships for the 31st time in school history after finishing second at the NCAA Salt Lake City Regional.

- LSU needs to finish in the top two of NCAA Semifinal II to advance to the NCAA Championship Final on Saturday at 2:30 p.m. CT on ABC.

- If LSU advanced to the championship final, it would mark the program's ninth finals appearance since 2008 and fifth straight.

- The program appeared in seven NCAA Super Six finals and reached the NCAA Championship Final in 2019, which featured just four teams.

- LSU underclassmen Kiya Johnson and Haleigh Bryant are one of the best 1-2 punches in the country. The duo has combined for five perfect scores in 2021.

- Seniors Reagan Campbell, Bridget Dean, Christina Desiderio, Sami Durante and Sarah Edwards own a combined 22 routines at

NCAA Championships in two seasons. The group are the only gymnasts on the team with experience at this meet.

- As a team, the Tigers rank second overall on both vault and floor. The bars lineup ranks sixth overall and the beam lineup is seventh in the country.

- Haleigh Bryant was named the WCGA Region 1 Gymnast of the Year, Jay Clark was selected as the coach of the year and Richard Dempsey was voted as the administrator of the year.

BY THE NUMBERS

LSU gymnasts have won 15 individual national championships in school history, including 14 since 2002. Sarah Finnegan (UB) and Kennedy Edney (VT) won the program's most recent NCAA championships in 2019.

LSU has advanced to the NCAA Championship finals eight times. This includes seven Super Six appearances: 2008, 09, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18. The 2019 championships marked the first time for the format in which only four teams advance to the NCAA Final.

The program has advanced to 31 NCAA Championships overall. The Tigers have advanced to nine straight, including 19 of the last 20 NCAA Championships.



JAY CLARK HEAD COACH • 1ST SEASON

Jay Clark, a 30-year veteran of college gymnastics and one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his first season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2020 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his ninth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with fellow LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPN and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 30 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against Iowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won a NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark is married to the former Julie Ballard, an All-American Georgia gymnast from 1994-98 and a native of Mandeville, Louisiana. The couple has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

Clark Makes History in First Year as Head Coach

- With LSU advancing to NCAA Championships in 2021, first-year head coach Jay Clark has made history as the fourth coach in NCAA Division I Gymnastics history to take two different programs to the championships.
- While the head coach at Georgia, Clark's teams advanced to two NCAA Championships.
- The other three coaches are: KJ Kindler (Iowa State and Oklahoma), Mark Cook (Stanford and Arkansas) and Jdi Markell (Penn State and Florida).

Last Time Out

- LSU advanced out of the NCAA Salt Lake City Regional by thin margins in the second round and regional final.
- The Tigers finished in second place both days behind Kentucky in the second round and Utah in the final.
- LSU won multiple regional titles with Haleigh Bryant capturing vault, Sami Durante winning bars and Kiya Johnson taking titles on vault, floor and all-around.
- LSU's score of 197.725 in the regional final marked the second highest in a regional in school history and best away from Baton Rouge.

Tigers in the Rankings

- The LSU gymnastics team is third in the final week of National Qualifying Score (NQS) rankings.
- The Tigers ended the year with an NQS of 197.813, which marked the third highest NQS ranking in school history. The score was behind a 197.890 in 2018 and 197.865 in 2017.
- LSU's NQS ranking is an average of the top two home scores of 198.050 and 197.200 and away scores of 197.550 and 197.775.
- As a team, LSU ranks second in the nation on vault and floor, sixth on bars and seventh on beam.

Bryant Johnson Take Home SEC's Top Honors

- LSU gymnasts Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson earned the league's top honors, voted by the head coaches from each institution.
- Bryant was named the SEC Freshman of the Year and Johnson was tabbed as the SEC Specialist of the Year.
- Bryant is the third gymnast in LSU history to be named the top freshman in the league, joining April Burkholder and Johnson. It is also the fourth time an LSU gymnast has been named the top specialist in the league. Ashleigh Gnat won the award in 2016 and 2017 and Lloimincia Hall was chosen in 2015.
- Bryant earned a share of the vault title at the 2021 SEC Gymnastics Championships with a 9.95, the

seventh LSU freshman to win an SEC title. Nationally, she finished the season third on vault (9.956 NQS), fourth on vault (9.956 NQS) and ninth in the all-around (39.594 NQS), the highest rankings by any freshman in the Southeastern Conference.

- Bryant is the only freshman in the SEC and just one of two in the country to score a 10 this season. In her debut season, she scored a 9.90 or better eight times on vault and seven times on floor.
- Johnson captured the floor exercise title at the 2021 SEC Gymnastics Championships with a perfect 10.0 in her postseason debut.
- She became the 10th gymnast in conference history to score a 10.0 on the floor exercise at the SEC Championships. Johnson joined fellow LSU gymnasts Sarah Finnegan (2019) and Ashleigh Gnat (2017) as the only competitors to score a 10 at the SEC meet on floor in the past five years.
- She finished the season as the top performer in the country on floor, competing in four meets on the event and scoring a perfect 10.0 three times. Johnson is tied with Trinity Thomas of Florida and Anastasia Webb of Oklahoma for the most perfect scores in the country this season, with Johnson and Thomas the only gymnasts with multiple perfect scores on floor.

Gymnasts Combine for Seven WCGA Regular Season All-America Honors

- Haleigh Bryant, Sami Durante, Kiya Johnson and Alyona Shchennikova combined to earn seven Women's College Gymnastics Association (WCGA) Regular Season All-America honors.
- Overall, LSU gymnasts have combined to earn 79 All-America honors in the regular season since the association began this honor in 2013. LSU has now combined to earn 274 regular season and meet honors in program history.
- Bryant led the group with three All-America honors on vault, floor and all-around. In her debut season, Bryant finished third on vault, fourth on floor and ninth in the all-around in the nation.
- Johnson added two more All-America honors to push her total to five. The sophomore from Dallas, Texas, finished as the No. 1 performer on floor and 12th overall on vault.
- Shchennikova earned her first All-America honor after finishing 12th nationally on vault. This was the first time the sophomore competed vault for the Tigers and she scored a 9.90 or high four times, including a career high 9.95 at Kentucky.
- Durante rounded out the group honored with All-America honors. The Tigers' anchor performer on bars, Durante scored a 9.90 or higher seven times this season. She finished 11th in the country with an NQS of 9.925 and scored a career high of 9.95 twice in 2021.

Johnson and Bryant Own Perfect Scores

- Kiya Johnson opened the 2021 season with a perfect score on floor, marking the third 10.0 of her career. She then scored a 10 on floor in the final meet of the regular season and once again at the SEC Championship.
- Bryant joined Johnson as the only LSU gymnasts with a 10 after doing it against Missouri on vault and once again at the NCAA Regional Final.
- It was the first 10 for Bryant in her career. She became the fourth LSU freshman to score a perfect 10 in school history.
- Bryant is only the second freshman in the country to earn a 10 this year. She is the sixth gymnast in the country to earn a 10 on vault in 2021. The anchor performance in the opening rotation pushed LSU to a 49.550 on vault.
- Johnson scored a 10.0 on vault and beam in her debut season.
- The sophomore joined April Burkholder and Sarah Finnegan as the only gymnasts in school history with a 10.0 on three events.
- Johnson's 10.0 in the opening tied Ashleigh Clare-Kearney (1/5/07) for the earliest by an LSU gymnast in school history.

Bryant and Johnson Are Nation's Top All-Around Performers

- Once in the lineup at the same time, LSU's Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson are one of the best all-around duos in the country.
- Head Coach Jay Clark has put the duo together in the all-around three times.
- Johnson proved herself as one of the best all-around gymnasts in the country a year ago and owns a career high of 39.700.
- Bryant has been in the all-around in five meets and earned the win four times. She owns a career high of 39.625.

Gymnastics Leads Nation in Attendance

- Despite limited capacity numbers, the Pete Maravich Center was home to the best average attendance number in the nation in 2021.
- LSU averaged 2,520 fans a meet, including a high of 2,565 against No. 1 Florida in February.
- The LSU Gymnastics program totaled 10,080 fans through the doors of the PMAC in 2021.
- The Tigers have been in the top three in the country over the years in attendance, finishing second in the nation in 2020 and 2018 and third in 2019 and 2017.

Durante Named LSU's Nominee for AAI Award

- Sami Durante was selected as LSU's nominee for the AAI Award, which goes to the top senior gymnast in the nation.
- A native of Athens, Georgia, Durante has been an integral part of LSU's success over the last four years as a specialist on bars, beam and vault.
- Since starting her career as LSU's bars leadoff performer, she has missed just two performances on the event and served as the team's anchor the last two seasons.
- Durante is a two-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll and pursuing her bachelor's degree in kinesiology. The daughter of former collegiate coach Dana Durante, Sami wants to pursue a career in

- The North Carolina native matched her career high in the all-around and anchored floor with a 9.95. Bryant also scored a 9.90 on vault and a 9.875 on bars and beam.
- It marks the fifth honor for Bryant by the league office. She was named the best freshman in the league in weeks one, three and five. She also was named the top gymnast after the Tigers' road meet against Arkansas.

Shchennikova Named SEC Specialist of the Week

- Sophomore Alyona Shchennikova put together a career night on Friday against No. 1 Florida and was named the SEC Specialist of the Week.
- She set or matched career highs on all three events she competed. Shchennikova set a new high on vault with a 9.925. The sophomore matched career highs on bars and floor with a 9.95 and 9.925.
- It marked the second honor for Shchennikova. She was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week following her all-around debut against Auburn.

- It will be compromised of eight meets per school over 10 weeks, with the regular season concluding with the SEC Gymnastics Championships on March 20.
- The schedule will include two open dates for all schools in Week 5 and Week 10 to allow for rescheduling of postponed events.

Clark Begins New Chapter as Head Coach

- Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons on staff, was elevated to head coach of the Fighting Tigers.
- Clark took over for legendary coach D-D Breaux, who served as head coach for 43 seasons.
- Clark owns 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- In his time at LSU, Clark has elevated the Tigers' bars teams to one of the best in the nation.
- He takes over in 2021 as the third coach in program history.
- Clark previously served for more than 20 years as an assistant coach and head coach at the University of Georgia.

Gnat Makes Her Return to Baton Rouge

- Ashleigh Gnat, a 17-time All-American, four-time Southeastern Conference event champion and 2017 NCAA Floor Champion, was named as the squad's assistant coach in August after Clark's promotion to head coach.
- A two-time graduate of LSU, Gnat's primary responsibility is as the Tigers' beam coach.
- After her gymnastics career, Gnat served as a student coach for two years. She landed her first full-time position in 2019 as an assistant coach at Penn State.
- During her six years in Baton Rouge, Gnat was a part of the most successful stretch of the program's history. The Tigers set the three highest finishes in school history during Gnat's time and won five SEC Championships.
- She brings a wealth of experience as one of the best gymnasts in school history. Gnat led the Tigers inside and outside of the gym as LSU's nominee for the NCAA Woman of the Year Award and a finalist for the Honda Award.
- Gnat set multiple records during her career in Baton Rouge, including the most floor titles in a single season and perfect scores in a career with nine. Gnat was the 2016 and 2017 SEC Specialist of the Year and Central Region Gymnast of the Year.

Seniors Return Ten Routines to 2021

- The senior class of Reagan Campbell, Bridget Dean, Christina Desiderio, Sami Durante, Sarah Edwards and Olivia Gunter provide a wealth of experience and routines for the Tigers in their fourth year.
- Campbell and Desiderio are beam and floor specialists who have earned All-America honors before.
- Dean is a three-event specialist with experience at NCAA Championships. Durante is the Tigers' anchor on beam and has delivered crucial performances on beam in the last two seasons.
- Edwards was sidelined for a majority of 2020 with an injury but returns to the team with her high energy floor routine and 10.0 vault.
- Gunter rounds out the class with a strong floor routine and crucial energy for the team. She could enter the floor lineup at any time in 2021.

Johnson is One of Nation's Top Gymnasts

- LSU's Kiya Johnson has made her name known as the top freshman in the nation and one of the top all-around performers a year ago.
- Prior to the season being canceled due to COVID-19, Johnson was on pace to break every LSU record and compete for SEC and NCAA Championships.
- Johnson won 22 individual titles in 2020 with seven in the all-around, six on floor, five on vault, three on beam and one on bars.
- The Dallas, Texas, native was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week following her performance against Auburn and was named the SEC Freshman of the Week the following four weeks.
- Johnson owns career highs of 39.75 in the all-around, 10 on beam and vault, 9.975 on floor and 9.90 on bars.
- She earned All-America honors on vault, floor and in the all-around after finishing fourth, sixth and second respectively in the final rankings.

Freshman Class Brings Big Routines

- LSU's freshman class of Elena Arenas, Sierra Ballard, Chase Brock, Haleigh Bryant and Olivia Dunne are poised to bring big performances and will be relied on heavily.
- Arenas, Brock, Bryant and Dunne made their debuts in week one.
- Bryant won vault and scored a 9.975 on floor. Dunne scored a 9.875 on bars. Arenas and Brock each delivered strong performances.

Rivers Out for 2021

- Sophomore Kai Rivers will miss the 2021 season after suffering an Achilles injury during training this fall.
- The LSU coaching staff was anticipating training at full health for the all-around.
- In her freshman season, Rivers competed on vault and bars with career highs of 9.90. She competed beam early in the season in three events and earned a 9.95 for a career high.
- Rivers will miss most of the regular season but has the potential to return during postseason competition on bars based on her recovery.

Jeanie Beadle

1977 AIAW Balance Beam National Champion

A pioneer in LSU gymnastics history, Jeanie Beadle won the Tigers' first individual national championship, claiming the AIAW beam title in 1977. She competed for LSU from 1976-80 and earned All-America status in 1977 and 1978. Her national title marked the first individual title for any female student-athlete in LSU history, and her All-America honors were also a first for a female student-athlete at LSU. As the leader of the team during her career, Beadle guided the Tigers to three straight first-place finishes at the AIAW Regionals. For all her accomplishments and firsts at LSU, the Baton Rouge native was inducted into the LSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1999.

Nicki Arnstad

2002 NCAA Floor Exercise National Champion

Nicki Arnstad capped an exceptional four-year career by winning the NCAA floor title at the 2002 national championships in Tuscaloosa, Ala. In the final performance of her career, Arnstad tallied a 9.950 to claim LSU's first NCAA individual national title. She earned a total of four All-America honors during her career as she was recognized twice on the floor and twice in the all-around. Also a two-time First Team All-SEC performer, she still shares the school record on the floor exercise (10.00), posting the perfect score twice during her senior season including at the NCAA Central Regional to lead LSU to the NCAA Championships.

April Burkholder

2006 NCAA Balance Beam National Champion

One of the most decorated gymnasts in LSU history, April Burkholder ended a stellar four-year career by winning the national beam title at the 2006 NCAA Championships. In her final meet as a Tiger, Burkholder posted a 9.9125 on the beam in Corvallis, Ore., to become LSU's second beam national champion. She recorded a school record 14 All-America honors during her career and was named to the All-SEC team four times. Burkholder was also selected as both the NCAA Central Region and SEC Gymnast of the Year twice (2004 and 2005) and was named the SEC Freshman of the Year in 2003. She is also second in school history with eight perfect 10.00's and the only Tiger with at least one on three different events - scoring four on floor, two on vault and two on beam.

Ashleigh Clare-Kearney

2009 NCAA Vault National Champion

2009 NCAA Floor Exercise National Champion

Ashleigh Clare-Kearney finished her outstanding career April 18, 2009, by becoming LSU's first two-time national champion as she captured the vault national title with a 9.900 average and the floor national title with a 9.950 score in Lincoln, Neb. The five-time First Team All-American capped her senior season by earning NCAA Central Region Gymnast of the Year recognition, and she recorded her third straight First Team All-SEC honor after repeating as SEC Floor Exercise Champion. She was also the SEC Gymnast of the Year as a junior as she became LSU's second SEC All-Around champion in 2008. Clare-Kearney ended her career as LSU's all-time leader in individual titles as she finished with 114, and she was instrumental in leading the Tigers to back-to-back NCAA Super Six appearances in 2008 and 2009.

Susan Jackson

2008 NCAA Vault National Champion

2010 NCAA All-Around National Champion

2010 NCAA Balance Beam National Champion

Susan Jackson became LSU's first gymnast to win a national title before her senior season as she earned the vault national title with a 9.8563 average as a sophomore at the 2008 NCAA Championships in Athens, Ga. After finishing as national runner up on vault in 2009 behind Ashleigh Clare-Kearney, Jackson went out on top as a senior in 2010 by capturing two more national titles to become LSU's first three-time champion. She tallied a 39.625 all-around score at the NCAA Championships in Gainesville, Fla., to earn LSU's first All-Around national title, and two days later she punctuated her career with a near-flawless performance to earn the beam national title with a 9.9625 score. Displaying consistency all season as a senior, Jackson was named the SEC Gymnast of the Year and NCAA Central Region Gymnast of the Year, and she became the first LSU gymnast to receive the prestigious AAI Award and Gymnastics Honda Sports Award that both go to the nation's top gymnast. Jackson further cemented her legacy by winning 11 all-around titles in 2010, breaking a 30-year-old school record for the most in a single season.

Rheagan Courville

2013 NCAA Vault National Champion

2014 NCAA Vault National Champion

Rheagan Courville capped one of the best seasons in LSU history by winning the vault national title on April 21, 2013 inside Pauley Pavilion in Los Angeles, Calif. Courville performed a fantastic vault to score a 9.9250 and take home the title. Her sophomore campaign in 2013 will go down as one of the finest in LSU gymnastics. She won SEC Gymnast of the Year and became the first Tiger gymnast to win three titles at one SEC Championship as she captured the vault, beam and all-around titles. Courville was also named the NCAA Central Region Gymnast of the Year after she led the nation with nine all-around victories in 2013. She became the first LSU gymnast in history to repeat as national champion in an event as she captured the 2014 NCAA vault national title. Courville earned the highest score on vault ever in the NCAA Individual Event Finals competition with a 9.9750 to win the national title on April 20, 2014 inside BJCC Arena in Birmingham, Ala. The national title capped another fantastic season for the Baton Rouge native. In 2014, Courville earned Central Region Gymnast of the Year honors for the second straight year, finished No. 2 nationally in the all-around rankings, tallied eight All-America honors including multiple first-team honors on vault and the all-around, and she became only the fourth gymnast in school history to record two or more perfect 10 scores on vault in her career.

Ashleigh Gnat

2017 NCAA Floor National Champion

Ashleigh Gnat finished one of the most successful careers in school history by winning the floor title on April 15, 2017 inside Chaifetz Arena in St. Louis, Missouri. Gnat totaled a 9.9625 in the anchor spot of the Tigers' floor lineup that set a school record with a score of 49.7125. Gnat was named the Southeastern Conference Specialist of the Year and NACGC Central Region Gymnast of the Year for a second-straight season. The Lake Mary, Florida native was also selected as the winner of the 2017 AAI Award, which is given to the nation's top senior gymnast and a finalist for the Honda Award. Gnat finished her career as a four-time SEC Champion and 17-time All-American. She set multiple school records, including the most floor titles in a single season in school history (12) and tied for the most perfect 10.0 scores in a career with nine.

Kennedi Edney

2017 NCAA Vault National Champion

2019 NCAA Vault National Champion

Kennedi Edney became the first freshman in school history to win a national championship when she stuck her Yurchenko 1 1/12 and scored a 9.9875 on April 15, 2017 in St. Louis, Missouri. Edney's score marked the highest by an LSU gymnast ever at an NCAA Championship. Edney went on to become the fifth gymnast in school history to win multiple titles when she scored a 9.95 on the same event in Fort Worth in 2019.

Sarah Finnegan

2017 NCAA Bars National Champion

2019 NCAA Bars National Champion

Sarah Finnegan concluded her career as arguably the best gymnast in LSU history and one of the best athletes to ever wear the Purple and Gold. Finnegan completed her career by winning the 2019 NCAA bars championship in Fort Worth, Texas with a 9.950, becoming the fourth gymnast in school history to win multiple NCAA titles. Finnegan won her first national title in 2017 as a sophomore, becoming the first NCAA champion on bars in school history. The Lee's Summit, Missouri, native was crowned the AAI Award winner in 2019. She finished her career as a two-time SEC Gymnast of the Year, two-time Honda Award Finalist and 23-time All-American, which tied the school record. Finnegan won five SEC titles and earned six perfect scores. She rewrote the LSU history books with records of 27 career beam titles, 14 all-around wins in a season and 49 total individual titles in 2019.
