# No. 5 LSU Returns to PMAC for SEC Finale Against No. 10 Kentucky

The LSU Gymnastics team returns to the PMAC for the first time in two weeks to take on No. 10 Kentucky in the SEC regular season finale at 7:30 p.m. CT Friday. The meet will be streamed live on SEC Network+ through WatchESPN.com and the Watch ESPN app with Lyn Rollins and Kaleigh Dickson Abboud on the call. When the squad takes the floor on Friday they'll be looking to score a 197 or higher to drop the season opener score from its National Qualifying Score (NQS). With three meets left this season, LSU has a strong chance to finish in the top four and take a No. 1 seed going into NCAA postseason. The Tigers will also be looking to remain in the top two in the league to start on vault or bars at SEC Championships. The Tigers (8-2, 4-2 SEC) got some rest this week after competing three times in eight days. LSU is coming off a 197.625, which was the second-highest road score for the Tigers this season. LSU was led by Haleigh Bryant, Kiya Johnson and KJ Johnson in Dallas. KJ Johnson scored a 9.95 on her Yurchenko full, which marked a perfect score for the freshman. Alyona Shchennikova returned to the lineup against TWU with a 9.90 on bars.

# Storylines

• LSU leads the all-time series over Kentucky, 83-8 with the Tigers owning a record of 24-1 in Baton Rouge. LSU lost twice to Kentucky a year ago, once in Lexington and another in the NCAA Second Round. LSU went on to defeat the Wildcats in the NCAA Regional Final to move on to NCAA Championships. LSU's lone loss to UK in Baton Rouge came in 1996.

• LSU owns top-five rankings on vault and bars and top-10 on beam and floor. The Tigers have season highs of 49.500 on vault, 49.500 on bars, 49.650 on beam and 49.775 on floor. The score of 49.775 against Auburn marked a school record.

• LSU will be without star junior Kai Rivers. Rivers, who suffered a shoulder injury against Alabama, has no timetable for return. The Detroit, Michigan native returned to LSU's lineup on vault, bars and beam after missing the 2021 season with an Achilles injury.

•Junior Alyona Shchennikova is expected to return to the LSU lineup on bars and possibly floor after suffering a knee injury at Florida. Senior Bridget Dean is also expected to return to the beam lineup after missing the meet at TWU due to a family matter.

 Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson each scored a perfect 10 in the win over No. 6 Auburn and once again during the double weekend against Alabama and at Missouri.
 Bryant's two 10's came on vault and Johnson earned one on beam and the other on floor. Johnson now owns seven 10's for her career and Bryant has scored four.

# **JAY CLARK** HEAD COACH • 2nd SEASON

Jay Clark, a 30-year veteran of college gymnastics and one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his second season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2020 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented visibility to the program and success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of eight seasons, numerous school records, produced eight NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark was named the WCGA Region 1 Coach of the Year in his first season in 2021. He was also named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. LSU's bars lineup has finished in the top-10 in the nation eight times, including the No. 1 team in 2018.

In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge. As head coach of the Fighting Tigers, Haleigh Bryant was selected as the SEC Freshman of the Year and Kiya Johnson was selected as the SEC Specialist of the Year.

In his first season as the leader of the program, Clark led the squad to the program's 31st NCAA Championships appearance. He became the fourth head coach in NCAA Gymnastics history to lead two division I programs to NCAA Championships.

Five of the six bars workers in 2021 featured underclassmen and the squad ultimately finished sixth in the nation with an NQS of 49.456. Sami Durante moved into the anchor spot of bars and earned All-America honors for the first time in her career. Freshman Olivia Dunne and sophomore Alyona Shchennikova finished in the top eight at NCAA Championships to earn All-America honors.

In the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, LSU finished fifth in the nation on bars with a 49.405 NQS. Ruby Harrold competed in the anchor spot of the bars lineup and finished 19th in the nation, and Sami Durante finished 25th.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against lowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999–2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark is married to the former Julie Ballard, an All-American Georgia gymnast from 1994-98 and a native of Mandeville, Louisiana. The couple has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.



# Last Time Out

- Last week, LSU concluded three meets in seven days with three wins at TWU.
- The Tigers, without Kai Rivers, Bridget Dean and Alyona Shchennikova on only one event, put up its second-highest road score of the season with a 197.625.

•The squad's freshmen continued their stellar seasons. Aleah Finnegan won beam with an outstanding 9.925 and Dallas native KJ Johnson wowed her home crowd with a perfect Yurchenko Full for a career high 9.95.

• Haleigh Bryant competed on three events and was named the SEC Specialist of the Week after earning wins on vault and bars with scores of 9.95 and 9.925.

# LSU Fans Going After Best Attendance in the Nation

• With an average of 11,591 fans per meet already in 2022, LSU currently owns the best average attendance in the nation.

- The Tiger fans have packed the PMAC this season with crowds of 9,707, 13,659 and 11,498.
- The meet against Auburn marked a sell out with the second-largest crowd in school history (13,659).
- Prior to the start of the season, LSU fans set the record for season ticket sold with 7,500-plus.
- The top 10-most attended meets in school history have come since 2015 with LSU hitting the 13,000 mark five times.

• LSU is 10-2 in meets with more than 12,000 fans, proving once again that the PMAC is the top environment in all of collegiate gymnastics.

# Bryant, Johnson Own Perfect Scores in 2022

• LSU gymnastics sophomore Haleigh Bryant and junior Kiya Johnson each own multiple perfect scores in 2022.

• Both of Bryant's perfect scores have come on vault with the first against Auburn at home and the second on the road at Missouri.

• Johnson also scored a 10 against Auburn with hers coming on floor. She then scored a perfect 10 on beam against Alabama at home.

• The 10's marked the fourth in Bryant's career and seventh for Johnson.

• Johnson owns two 10's on beam, one on vault and four on floor. She is the sixth gymnast in LSU history to score multiple perfect scores on beam.

• Bryant has scored all four of her career 10's on vault.

• There have been 75 perfect scores in LSU history with 32 on vault, five on bars, eight on beam and 30 on floor.

• The Auburn meet marked the 15th meet in LSU history with multiple perfect scores. The duo also each earned a perfect score in the Tigers' regular season finale in the PMAC in 2021.

• Ashleigh Gnat and Jennifer Wood own the most perfect scores in school history with nine each. All nine of Wood's came on vault and Gnat split between four on floor and five on vault.

## Bryant Owns Best Vault in NCAA Gymnastics - No. 1 in the Nation

• There is not much to debate when it comes to Haleigh Bryant's front handspring-front pike half being the best vault in NCAA Gymnastics.

• The reigning NCAA and SEC vault national champion has competed 19 times on vault in her fresh career and has scored a 9.90 or higher 17 times.

• The sophomore is the No. 1 vaulter in the nation at the eight-week mark with an NQS of 9.40

• Bryant owns four career perfect scores and five other times has scored a 9.95 or higher, including at the 2021 NCAA Championships when she scored a 9.975.

## **Johnson Back in the All-Around**

• Due to a sensitive Achilles tendon, junior Kiya Johnson has been limited in her return to perform on floor but she made her 2022 debut against Auburn.

· She performed floor against Florida and was slated to return to the lineup against Alabama but with a 198.050 and win locked up, head coach Jay Clark pulled her from the anchor spot.

- In her debut, the top floor performer in the nation made a splash with a perfect score.
- The 10 marked the sixth of her career and fourth on floor.
- In her third floor routine, Johnson scored a 9.95 in her home state to secure the win.

• Johnson's resume speaks for itself and it is why she is considered one of the best gymnasts in the nation. She has scored a 10.0 on vault, beam and floor. She also owns a career high 9.95 on bars and is a stable leadoff performer on the event.

## LSU Owns 12 49.700-Plus Scores in School History

• Since 2014, LSU lineups have put up 12 scores of 49.700 or higher across all four events.

• Already in 2022, LSU scored a 49.775 on floor against Auburn. The score marked the highest in school history and the second-highest score in the country.

• LSU scored four 49.700-plus scores in 2018, which was a record for a season.

• The 49.775 against Auburn marked the first for the program since a 49.725 and 49.750 on beam and bars respectively at Arizona to close the regular season.

The Griffeths come to Baton Rouge after serving as assistant coaches for two seasons at the University of Utah. In that time, the Utes went 21-1 during the regular season, won the 2021 Pac-12 Championship and finished third nationally after advancing to the NCAA Championship Final.
Prior to their time in Salt Lake City, Garrett served as the associate head coach and Courtney the volunteer coach and choreographer for two seasons at Arkansas. They spent four seasons at Texas Woman's University from 2014-17 and prior to that coached at Cincinnati

## Gymnastics Academy in 2013.

• Both earned bachelor and master's degrees from Georgia, where Griffeth served on Clark's staff as a graduate assistant coach in 2011 and an administrative associate in 2012. McCool competed at Georgia from 2007-10, helping the GymDogs to three consecutive NCAA titles from 2007-09. She was the 2008 NCAA floor champion.
