Gymnastics Competes for Fourth SEC Title in Five Years

The fifth-ranked LSU gymnastics team will compete for the program's fifth Southeastern Conference title and fourth in five years in the second session at 7 p.m. CT Saturday at Legacy Arena in Birmingham, Alabama. The meet will be televised live on SEC Network with Bart Conner, Kathy Johnson Clarke and Sam Peszek on the call. There will also be event-specific streams available on WatchESPN.com and the app. The Tigers will face off against seven teams for the top spot in the most difficult conference in the country. All eight teams are ranked in the top-25 and five of the top-10 teams are from the SEC. The squad is the second seed and will compete in the same order as a year ago by starting on bars and going to beam, floor and wrapping up on vault. LSU is ranked fifth in the nation with an NQS of 197.735. This will be the final meet for the Tigers to improve their NQS before the NCAA bracket is revealed on Tuesday. With a score of 197.200 or higher, LSU will improve its NQS. LSU boasts, when healthy, two of the top all-around performers in the nation in Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson. Both are expected to compete on all four events and will assuredly fight for the all-around crown and help the team toward another SEC title. This will mark the second time in 2022 that both will compete in the all-around. Bryant owns season highs of 10 on vault and 9.95 on bars, beam and floor. Johnson owns season highs of 10 on floor and beam, 9.975 on vault and 9.90 on bars. A leader of this squad, Kai Rivers is expected to compete on beam and Alyona Shchennikova is back for LSU on vault, bars and floor. Freshmen KJ Johnson and Aleah Finnegan are also going to make their SEC Championships debut on vault and floor and beam and floor respectively. The duo has been major contributors with career high scores of 9.90 or higher.

Story Lines

- LSU has finished in the top two at SEC Championships 10 times with four victories in the program's history.
- A year ago, LSU finished second behind Alabama by .100. The second-place finish ended a run of three-straight titles for the Tigers.
- Twenty-five SU gymnasts have combined to win 47 SEC titles since 1981. A total of 97 All-SEC honors have been earned over the years and 17 SEC All-Freshman team honors have been awarded since 2009.

- LSU ranks in the top-10 nationally on all four events. The Tigers are ranked third on vault, eighth on bars, sixth on beam and seventh on floor.
- Kiya Johnson is the reigning SEC floor champion and Haleigh Bryant and Elena Arenas are the reigning SEC vault champions. Johnson earned the program's 14th floor title with her perfect score. Bryant and Arenas secured the vault titles with a 9.95 as freshmen in 2021.
- In addition to All-SEC honors from Kiya Johnson, Arenas and

Bryant a year ago, LSU's Christina Desiderio and Sarah Edwards also have been named All-SEC performers. Olivia Dunne in 2021 and Sami Durante in 2018 also earned SEC All-Freshman Team honors.

- In 2021, LSU scored a 197.775 for the third-highest score at an SEC Championship in school history. The vault lineup also set the record at an SEC meet in the final rotation with a 49.625.



JAY CLARK

HEAD COACH • 2nd SEASON

Jay Clark, a 30-year veteran of college gymnastics and one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his second season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2020 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented visibility to the program and success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of eight seasons, numerous school records, produced eight NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark was named the WCGA Region 1 Coach of the Year in his first season in 2021. He was also named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPN and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. LSU's bars lineup has finished in the top-10 in the nation eight times, including the No. 1 team in 2018.

In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge. As head coach of the Fighting Tigers, Haleigh Bryant was selected as the SEC Freshman of the Year and Kiya Johnson was selected as the SEC Specialist of the Year.

In his first season as the leader of the program, Clark led the squad to the program's 31st NCAA Championships appearance. He became the fourth head coach in NCAA Gymnastics history to lead two division I programs to NCAA Championships.

Five of the six bars workers in 2021 featured underclassmen and the squad ultimately finished sixth in the nation with an NQS of 49.456. Sami Durante moved into the anchor spot of bars and earned All-America honors for the first time in her career. Freshman Olivia Dunne and sophomore Alyona Shchennikova finished in the top eight at NCAA Championships to earn All-America honors.

In the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, LSU finished fifth in the nation on bars with a 49.405 NQS. Ruby Harrold competed in the anchor spot of the bars lineup and finished 19th in the nation, and Sami Durante finished 25th.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priesman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene

Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priesman combined for three All-America honors. Priesman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priesman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against Iowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won a NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark is married to the former Julie Ballard, an All-American Georgia gymnast from 1994-98 and a native of Mandeville, Louisiana. The couple has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

LSU Draws No. 2 Seed for SEC Championships

- The draw for the SEC Championships is determined by each team's national qualifying score (NQS) ranking. As the second-ranked team in the SEC and No. 5 team in the nation, LSU will start on bars. No. 2 Florida will start on vault, No. 6 Auburn will start on beam and No. 5 Alabama will start on floor.

LSU Goes for Fifth SEC Championships in Birmingham

- The LSU Gymnastics program has won three of the last SEC Championships as the premier team in the most difficult conference in the country.
- LSU won its second league title in school history and the first since the inaugural championship at the 2017 championships in Jacksonville. At that meet, Ashleigh Gnat won the vault, beam and floor titles, McKenna Kelley won the floor exercise, and Lexie Priessman won LSU's first bars title in 20 years.
- The squad then defended its crown in 2018 in St. Louis. Sarah Finnegan won the all-around title to help the Tigers outlast Florida in a tight contest.
- The Tigers completed the three peat at SEC Championships in New Orleans in 2019. Finnegan dominated the meet with wins on bars, beam, floor and all-around. The Tigers three championships marked the fifth time in league history a team has won three in a row.
- The 2020 SEC Championships were canceled a week prior to competition due to the COVID-19 pandemic. LSU's bid for four straight came up short by .100 in 2021 to the league champion, Alabama.

LSU's History at the SEC Championship

- LSU captured the SEC title when the Tigers hosted the first championship in 1981. Here is a breakdown of LSU's finishes at the SEC Championship: 1st Place - 4 times (1981, 2017, 2018,2019); 2nd Place - 6 (1990, 1995, 2000, 2005, 2015, 2021); 3rd Place - 10 (1982, 1983, 1991, 1994, 1997, 1998, 2004, 2013, 2014, 2016); 4th Place - 17 (1984, 1985, 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1993, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2012); 5th Place - 3 (1992, 1996, 2011); 6th Place - 0; 7th Place - 0; 8th Place - 0

Last Time Out

- Last week, LSU put together the best performance of the season with a season-high 198.125 against fourth-ranked Utah.
- The Tigers and Utes went blow for blow on all 24 routines with the home squad ultimately winning.
- Haleigh Bryant scored her third 10 of the season and the fifth of her career for the win. She also took the all-around title with a 39.700.
- LSU also had outstanding performances from Kiya Johnson who scored a 9.975 on vault, 9.90 on bars and 9.95 on beam. Alyona Shchennikova also delivered a 9.925 on bars for the win and Sarah Edwards scored a career high 9.975 on floor on senior night.
- The score for LSU helped jump Auburn and Alabama in the polls and secure the No. 2 seed at SEC Championships

Bryant Owns Best Vault in NCAA Gymnastics

- There is not much to debate when it comes to Haleigh Bryant's front handspring-front pike half being the best vault in NCAA Gymnastics.
- The reigning NCAA and SEC vault national champion has competed 21 times on vault in her fresh career and has scored a 9.90 or higher 19 times.
- The sophomore is the No. 2 vaulter in the nation at the 10-week mark with an NQS of 9.960.
- Bryant owns five career perfect scores and six other times has scored a 9.95 or higher, including at the 2021 NCAA Championships when she scored a 9.975 to win the NCAA title.

Johnson, Bryant Join Elite LSU Company with Career High 9.95 or Better on All Four Events

- Already two of the greatest to wear the Purple and Gold, Kiya Johnson and Haleigh Bryant are a part of elite company in LSU Gymnastics history with career highs of 9.95 or higher on all four events.
- Bryant and Johnson join Sarah Finnegan, Kennedy Edney, Myia Hambrick, Ashleigh Clare-Kearney, April Burkholder, Jennifer Wood, Rheagan Courville, Susan Jackson and Abbey Burns as the LSU gymnasts to achieve that.
- Johnson owns career highs of 10.0 on vault, beam and floor and 9.95 on bars. Bryant's career highs are 10 on vault, 9.975 on floor and 9.95 on bars and beam.

LSU Overakes Utah for Best Average Attendance

- LSU made history in 2022 by overtaking Utah with the best average attendance in NCAA Gymnastics.
- An average of 11,691 fans attended meets inside the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. The number beat out Utah's 11,595. Utah held the record every year since 2004 and sat atop the attendance ranking in 36 of 40 years.
- Tiger fans packed the PMAC this season with crowds of 9,707, 13,659, 11,498, 12,838 and 10,845.
- The meet against Auburn marked a sell out with the second-largest crowd in school history (13,659).
- Prior to the start of the season, LSU fans set the record for season ticket sold with 7,500-plus.
- The top 10-most attended meets in school history have come since 2015 with LSU hitting the 13,000 mark five times.
- LSU is 10-3 in meets with more than 12,000 fans, proving once again that the PMAC is the top environment in all of collegiate gymnastics.

Bryant, Johnson Own Perfect Scores in 2022

- LSU gymnastics sophomore Haleigh Bryant and junior Kiya Johnson each own multiple perfect scores in 2022.
- All three of Bryant's perfect scores have come on vault with the first against Auburn at home, the second on the road at Missouri and the latest at home in the regular season finale against Utah.
- Johnson also scored a 10 against Auburn with hers coming on floor. She then scored a perfect 10 on beam against Alabama at home.
- The 10's marked the fifth in Bryant's career and seventh for Johnson.
- Johnson owns two 10's on beam, one on vault and four on floor. She is the sixth gymnast in LSU history to score multiple perfect scores on beam.
- Bryant has scored all five of her career 10's on vault.
- There have been 76 perfect scores in LSU history with 33 on vault, five on bars, eight on beam and 30 on floor.
- The Auburn meet marked the 15th meet in LSU history with multiple perfect scores. The duo also each earned a perfect score in the Tigers' regular season finale in the PMAC in 2021.
- Ashleigh Gnat and Jennifer Wood own the most perfect scores in school history with nine each. All nine of Wood's came on vault and Gnat split between four on floor and five on vault.

Johnson Back in the All-Around

- Due to a sensitive Achilles tendon, junior Kiya Johnson has been limited in competing in the all-around with just three times in 2022.
- She performed floor against Florida and was slated to return to the lineup against Alabama but with a 198.050 and win locked up, head coach Jay Clark pulled her from the anchor spot.
- In her debut, the top floor performer in the nation made a splash with a perfect score.
- The 10 marked the sixth of her career and fourth on floor.
- In her third floor routine, Johnson scored a 9.95 in her home state to secure the win.
- Johnson's resume speaks for itself and it is why she is considered one of the best gymnasts in the nation. She has scored a 10.0 on vault, beam and floor. She also owns a career high 9.95 on bars and is a stable leadoff performer on the event.

KJ Johnson, Aleah Finnegan Make Name Known in Year One

- Freshmen KJ Johnson and Aleah Finnegan have secured spots in all four events and made their name known in their first season as Tigers.
- Johnson, out of Dallas, Texas, has brought incredible consistency for LSU on vault and floor. She owns an average of 9.880 on vault and 9.890 on floor.
- Johnson set a career high on vault with a 9.95, which is perfect for her Yurchenko Full. She also owns career highs of 9.95 on floor set in consecutive meets against No. 6 Auburn and on the road at No. 4 Florida.
- Finnegan has been brought into LSU's lineups and is the fifth performer on beam and fourth on floor.
- She owns career highs of 9.925 on beam and floor.
- Finnegan has competed once on bars and Johnson performed an exhibition on beam.

Bryant Named SEC Specialist of the Week After TWU Quad Meet

- Sophomore gymnast Haleigh Bryant was named the Southeastern Conference Specialist of the Week after earning wins on vault and bars in the Tigers' win at the Texas Woman's quad meet
- One of the top all-around gymnasts in the nation, Bryant competed on vault, bars and beam.
- She scored a 9.95 on vault and 9.925 on bars to earn the wins. She also scored a 9.875 on beam to finish third overall.

LSU Owns 12 49.700-Plus Scores in School History

- Since 2014, LSU lineups have put up 12 scores of 49.700 or higher across all four events.
- Already in 2022, LSU scored a 49.775 on floor against Auburn. The score marked the highest in school history and the second-highest score in the country.
- LSU scored four 49.700-plus scores in 2018, which was a record for a season.
- The 49.775 against Auburn marked the first for the program since a 49.725 and 49.750 on beam and bars respectively at Arizona to close the regular season.

Kiya Johnson Named Specialist of the Week After Double Weekend

- Kiya Johnson was named the Southeastern Conference Specialist of the Week after a resounding weekend against Alabama at home and Missouri and Arkansas on the road.
- The reigning SEC Specialist of the Year, Johnson scored a 9.90 or higher on five of six routines she competed.
- The highlight came against Alabama on Friday night when she anchored LSU's beam lineup with a perfect score. The Dallas, Texas native also earned two 9.90's on vault, a 9.90 on bars and 9.925 on beam.
- The 10 marked the seventh of her career and second on beam. Johnson is the sixth gymnast in LSU history to score multiple perfect scores on beam. She is also the first in the SEC to score a 10 on the event. The 10 anchored LSU's beam lineup which scored a 49.650 for the fourth-highest score in school history.

LSU Earns Win No. 300 in the PMAC Against Auburn

- LSU earned its 300th victory inside the PMAC against Auburn.
- LSU's home for 250 meets since 1975, the PMAC has provided one of the best atmospheres in all of collegiate gymnastics.
- The Tigers own a winning percentage of .830 in 48 years of competition in the arena.

Desiderio Named SEC Specialist of the Week

- Senior Christina Desiderio had the top performance of her career against Auburn and was rewarded by being named the SEC Specialist of the Year.
- Arguably the top leadoff performer on beam and floor, Desiderio scored a season high 9.925 on beam and career high 9.95 on floor.
- She set the table on floor for LSU's 49.775, which set a new school record and marked the highest for any team in 2022.
- The honor for Desiderio marked the first league honor since being named the SEC Freshman of the Week in February 2018.

Johnson Named SEC Freshman of the Week in Debut

- KJ Johnson provided a spark for the Tigers in her debut and was rewarded as the SEC Freshman of the Week.
- Johnson, out of Texas Dreams in Dallas, scored a 9.90 on vault and floor in her first meet as a Tiger.
- She secured her first career victory as the top floor performer on the night.

Rivers Returns in 2022

- Junior Kai Rivers returned to training in the fall and has been a mainstay in LSU's vault and bars lineup.
- Rivers owns season highs of 9.85 on vault, 9.90 on bars and against Florida hit a 9.90 on beam.
- Rivers suffered an Achilles injury during the fall of 2020 while rehabbing from shoulder surgery.

Clark Heads Into Year Two as Head Coach

- Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons on staff, was elevated to head coach of the Fighting Tigers in 2020 and is now in his second season as head coach.
- Clark owns 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- LSU finished sixth nationally in 2021 after advancing to NCAA Championships for the 31st time in school history.
- He became the fourth coach in NCAA Division I Gymnastics history to take two different programs to the championships.
- Clark previously served for more than 20 years as an assistant coach and head coach at the University of Georgia.

Griffeths Join Clark and Gnat on Staff

- Following the retirement of longtime assistant coach Bob Moore and the transition of Ashleigh Clare-Kearney Thigpen to an administrative role as Associate AD of Diversity Equity and Inclusion, Clark hired Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth to serve as assistant coaches.
- The Griffeths come to Baton Rouge after serving as assistant coaches for two seasons at the University of Utah. In that time, the Utes went 21-1 during the regular season, won the 2021 Pac-12 Championship and finished third nationally after advancing to the NCAA Championship Final.

- Prior to their time in Salt Lake City, Garrett served as the associate head coach and Courtney the volunteer coach and choreographer for two seasons at Arkansas. They spent four seasons at Texas Woman's University from 2014-17 and prior to that coached at Cincinnati Gymnastics Academy in 2013.
- Both earned bachelor and master's degrees from Georgia, where Griffith served on Clark's staff as a graduate assistant coach in 2011 and an administrative associate in 2012. McCool competed at Georgia from 2007-10, helping the GymDogs to three consecutive NCAA titles from 2007-09. She was the 2008 NCAA floor champion.

Johnson, Bryant Two of Nation's Top Gymnasts

- LSU's Kiya Johnson and Haleigh Bryant are regarded as two of the top all-around gymnasts in the country.
- Bryant completed arguably the greatest freshman season in school history, culminating by winning the NCAA vault title. She was named the WCGA Region 1 Gymnast of the Year and selected as the SEC Freshman of the Year.
- Bryant won the SEC vault title with her electric vault, a front handspring-front pike half.
- She earned six all-america honors in 2021.
- Johnson is the reigning SEC floor champion and finished 2021 as the No. 1 performer on floor.
- She has totaled eight all-america honors in her career and combined for five perfect 10's on vault, beam and floor.

Seniors Return Ten Routines to 2022

- Five members of LSU's 2021 senior class returned to the team for their fifth and final season.
- Reagan Campbell, Bridget Dean, Christina Desiderio, Sami Durante and Sarah Edwards provide a wealth of experience and routines for the Tigers in their fifth year.
- Campbell and Dean have moved exclusively train on beam
- Desiderio is a beam and floor specialist who has earned All-America honors.
- Edwards is a vault and floor performer who provides a 10.0 vault and high energy on the floor.
- After competing on three events for most of her career, Durante is now training in the all-around for the Tigers.

Freshman Class Brings Big Routines

- LSU's freshman class of Aleah Finnegan, KJ Johnson and Tori Tatum bring a lot to the table and are expected to contribute significantly in their first year.
- Finnegan, the sister of two-time NCAA champion Sarah Finnegan, is regarded as one of LSU's top beam workers and will train the all-around.
- Johnson brings power on her Yurchenko Full and could potentially compete a double. She will also fight for a spot in LSU's floor lineup.
- Tatum trains on vault and bars and will compete a Yurchenko 1 1/2 for the Tigers.
