GAME NOTES

General

- 1. LSU's streak of 8 consectuive pre-noon kickoff victories came to an end during Saturday's game 40-13 loss against Tennessee.
 - a. Saturday marked only the second time there has been a kickoff before noon in Tiger Stadium for a game between ranked teams. In 1995, No. 3 Florida defeated No. 21 LSU, 28-10 in a pre-noon kickoff.
- 2. The Tigers fell to 144-94-7 all-time against SEC East foes.
- 3. After Saturday's game, Tennessee leads the series 21-10-3. In games where both the Tigers and Volunteers have been ranked, Tennessee holds a 7-3 record.
- 4. LSU wore all white uniforms from head to toe for fourth time of the modern era. The Tigers are 2-2 when wearing the all white uniforms.

Offense

- 1. **QB Jayden Daniels** connected with nine receivers to go 32-45 for 300 yards with 1 touchdown and 1 interception. Daniels also led LSU with 16 rushes for 38 yards.
 - a. Daniels' lone touchdown pass was a five-yard completion to **WR Kayshon Boutte**, his first touchdown reception of the season, with 11:32 remaining in the game.
 - b. Daniels' streak of having no interceptions throughout his first five LSU games came to an end. He threw 7 touchdowns before throwing an interception, tying Max Johnson for third all-time in LSU history for touchdown passes without and inteception thrown.
 - c. Daniels set his LSU career highs in completions (32), attempts (45) and yards (300) $\,$

Defense

- 1. Three defenders finished with double-digit tackles. LB Micah Baskerville had a career-high 15 tackles, S Jarrick Bernard-Converse had 11 tackles and Greg Brooks Jr. finished with 10 tackles.
- $2.\,\mbox{The }239\mbox{-yards}$ passing yards allowed by the LSU defense marked a season-low for Tennessee.

Special Teams

1. P Jay Bramblett had 4 punts for an average of 54.0 yards. He set his LSU career-high with a 60-yard punt in the third quarter.
