GAME NOTES

General

- The Tigers have won the past four matchups against the Gators, dating back to the 2019 game. LSU has also won 5 of the last 6, 8 of the last 10, and 10 of the last 13 games against Florida.
 - Over the past four games against Florida, LSU has averaged 43.25 points.
 - It has been over 20 years since this series has had a team win four straight games with it most recently happening from 1998-2001 when Florida won all four of those matchups.
- The LSU offense scored touchdowns during all of its first six drives. The last time the Tigers had six consecutive scoring drives was during the 2019 College Football Playoff Semifinal vs. Oklahoma.
- LSU has won 10 straight games, including 4 in 2022, when reaching the 30-point mark.
- LSU led Florida at halftime, 28-21. The 49 combined points is a record in a first half of an LSU-Florida game; this is game 69 of the series that dates to 1937. The previous mark was 48 set in 1996.
 - The Tigers' 28 first-half points are its tied-second-most in the overall series history with Florida regardless of location; record is 29 in 1977 (led 29-7); tied with 2015 (led 28-14).
- A Combined 34 Points Have Decided Outcome of Last 7 Meetings Between Teams at the Swamp. During that span, the largest margin of victory was eight during the 2018 game that was won by Florida.
- This season marks the first time in LSU history that the Tigers have won on the road at Auburn and at Florida in the same year.

Offense

- QB Jayden Daniels** was in command, leading an explosive LSU attack in the air and on the ground. Daniels was 23-32 throwing the ball for 349 yards with 3 passing touchdowns. He also ran the ball 14 times for 44 yards and another three touchdowns.
 - Daniels became the first player in LSU history to have at least 3 rushing touchdowns and 3 passing touchdowns in regulation.
 - He became the sixth LSU QB with 3 rushing touchdowns in a game; most recently by Joe Burrow during the 2018 7OT game at Texas A&M.
 - He joined Joe Burrow as the only two LSU QBs to account for 6 touchdowns in a game. Burrow had at least six touchdowns during five games of his LSU career.
 - Daniels became just the second LSU QB to throw for over 300-yards in a game against Florida, joining Jamie Howard who threw for 339 yards in 1992 also in The Swamp.
 - Daniels thrived during third-down situations as he was 8-9 for 173 yards on third downs. Six of his third-down completions went for first downs. LSU was 8-12 on third downs Saturday in Gainesville.
- WR Kayshon Boutte** surpassed the 100-yard receiving mark for the first time (by any LSU WR) this season and sixth time of his career. He had 6 catches for 115 yards.
- RB Josh Williams** ran tough on Saturday, picking up 106 yards on 14 carries.
 - Josh Williams' 50-yard rush on the first play of the second half was the longest run of his career and LSU's longest run this season.
- WR Jaray Jenkins** finished Saturday's game with 2 receptions for 67 yards with a touchdown.
 - Jenkins continued his career success against the Gators. After Saturday's production, Jenkins has caught 5 touchdowns in three games against Florida. The Jena, La. native had 3 TD receptions in 2021 against Florida and had another TD grab during 2020's LSU vs. Florida contest.

Defense

- LB Micah Baskerville** finished the game as the game's leading tackler, with 11 tackles, including one sack.
 - Saturday marked Baskerville's 13th career double-digit tackle game. His first double-digit tackle game also came at Florida during his Freshman season in 2018.

Special Teams

- K Damian Ramos** made his only field goal attempt of the game, a 47-yard career-long kick with 1:52 left in the game to put the Tigers up by 10.
