GAME NOTES

General

- 1. LSU's sustained success through the 21st Century has been impressive and with Saturday's win, the Tigers have had 16 nine-win seasons since 2000.
- 2. Brian Kelly coached teams have won 19 straight November games.
- 3. LSU has won 13 straight games, including 7 this season, when scoring 30+ points. 5. The Tigers have won five games in a row at Florida, vs. No. 7 Ole Miss, vs. No. 6 Alabama, at Arkansas and Saturday night vs. UAB.

Offense

- 1. **QB Jayden Daniels** put on a show Saturday in Tiger Stadium completing 22-29 passes for 297 yards and a touchdown and rushing 12 times for 111 yards and a touchdown.
 - a. Daniels now has 2,377 passing yards and 740 rushing yards on the season. i. Him and UCF's John Rhys Plumlee are the only QBs in the
 - country with at least 2,000 passing yards and 700 rushing yards.
 - b. He has accounted for a total of 26 touchdowns (15 passing, 11 rushing)
 i. Daniels 10 rushing touchdowns going into Saturday's game ranked No. 3 among QBs nationally.
- 2. **RB Noah Cain** came up big in the red zone. He carried the ball 13 times for 76 yards for 3 touchdowns.
 - a. Saturday marked Cain's secong multi-touchdown game of the season (had 2 TDs against New Mexico).
- 3. **WR Malik Nabers** had a career-high 7 receptions for 129 yards. On his third reception of the game a 37-yard catch with 14:04 remaining in the second quarter Nabers went over 1,000 receiving yards in his career.
 - a. Saturday was Nabers' second career 100-yard receiving game and first this season. As a freshman last year, he had 143 receiving yards against ULM.
- 4. The LSU offense was humming on Saturday to the tune of 565 yards (299 passing, 266 rushing.
- 5. The Tigers came through on third-down situations, going 11-13 on third-down conversions.

Defense

- 1. LSU limited UAB's rushing attack, that entered the game averaging 247.1 yards per game and 5.8 yards per rush, to 48 yards rushing and 2.2 yards per attempt.
 - a. It is the second time this season that LSÚ held its opponent to under 50 yards rushing as the Tigers allowed only 41 yards rushing against New Mexico.
- 2. LB Greg Penn III led the Tigers with 8 tackles and 1 tackle for loss.
- 3. LB Harold Perkins Jr. had 5 tackles, 2 for loss.
 - a. He now has 10.0 tackles for loss on the season to lead the Tigers.

Special Teams

1. P Jay Bramblett was only called upon to punt one time and it was a 44-yard punt that was downed inside the 20-yard line.
