1st Year at LSU - 8th Year as a Head Coach

When Matt McMahon stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach he listed the core values of his coaching career and his teams.

"Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy."

Those words are now the cornerstone of LSU Basketball as it moves into a new era as a very successful head coach begins to reshape the program in his image.

The image was on display during the past seven years at Murray State University where the Racers posted a record of 154-67, a .697 winning percentage. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022 (the 2020 appearance was canceled by the pandemic).

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

Two of those players, Williams and Hill, are now at LSU.

Williams, who ranked 12th nationally in 3-pointers made (94), became the third Murray State player to score 1,500 points and grab 800 rebounds. Hill took over point guard duties in a Racer program known for good guards, leading Murray State in assists in 19 games with a plus-101 margin in assists to turnovers.

McMahon's Racers, picked third in the OVC preseason poll, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3). The Racers were ranked No. 20 in the final AP poll and No. 22 in the Ferris Mowers Coaches Poll.

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have

three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Although the 2019-20 season was called early because of the pandemic, it marked the third year in a three-year run when Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season championships (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

Coach McMahon's commitment to defense showed in those years as the Racers ranked as the league leader twice in defensive field goal percentage and each of the three seasons the team led the league in defending the 3-point shot.

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game by defeating No. 5 seed Marquette. That season is when Morant stepped to the forefront at Murray State.

He was named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team all-America honors from the USBWA. In the NCAA Tournament win over Marquette, Morant posted a triple double of 17 points, 11 rebounds and 16 assists as he became the eighth player to record a triple double in the tournament.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

In 2017-18, McMahon's team won 26 games and the OVC regular season and tournament championship, sending the Racers to what was at that time the school's 16th NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio Valley Conference championships, a CollegeInsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian

State. Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 90 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 124 three-pointers, graduating in 2000..

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as a student assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a student coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Like his time at Murray State, McMahon coached some outstanding talent in the early stages of his coaching career, including Southern Conference POY Donald Sims as well as all-league picks Jeremy Clayton and D.J. Thompson.

At UNCW, he recruited Adam Smith, a Parade All-America Second-Team selection.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

A NEW DAY FOR LSU BASKETBALL

What all began in 1909 has now begun its 115th season of play as LSU Basketball enters a new age under Coach Matt McMahon. The proven winner from Murray State has had to build a roster completely from scratch as players after the 2021-22 season left for NBA dreams, end of eligibility and the transfer portal. As listed above in some 46 days, Coach McMahon has been able to rebuild his roster from 0 to 16 players which includes 13 scholarship players and three walk-ons. Three players on scholarship returned to be a part of this new day of Tiger basketball -- Mwani Wilkinson, Justice Williams and Adam Miller. Miller is the only one that didn't play last year, having torn an ACL just prior to the team's exhibition contest a year ago.

So, after a combined 36 years of Dale Brown and John Brady, Matt McMahon is the fourth LSU Basketball head coach in the last 15 seasons.

TIGERS PICKED EIGHTH IN SEC

The media panel of regional and national media picked the Tigers eighth in the preseason standings poll announced at SEC Tipoff in October. The selections by the media:

Reed passed the ball to Hannibal at the top of the key, who drove past his defender to the goal to apparently tie the game as the clock went from 0.2 to 0.1. The error by the clock operator marred an entertaining game in which neither team had more than a three-point advantage in the final eight minutes.

TUESDAY'S OPPONENT

The Tigers host North Carolina Central for the first of two games this week and the start of three home games prior to Christmas.

The Eagles are 5-5 on the year having last played on Dec. 6 at Marquette, losing 90-78. After being down 52-29 at the half, after Marquette shot 70-plus percent from the field and the three-point arc, NCCU outscored Marquette, 49-38, in the second half for the final margin. Justin Wright led NC Central with 18 points, while Brendan Medley-Bacon had 16 and Kris Monroe 10.

The Eagles shot 46 percent from the field (29-of-63) with nine treys, outrebounding Marquette, 34-27.

Wright leads the team in average for the year at 15.6 points, while Monroe averages 11.0 points and Medley-Bacon is at 10.0 points a contest. The Eagles average 81.3 points a game, while giving up 68.

LaVelle Moton is the veteran head coach at NCCU.

The teams have met on one occasion, ironically, also on Dec. 13, 2016, here in Baton Rouge with LSU winning 70-66.

SOME OTHER NUMBERS FROM THE WAKE FOREST GAME

There haven't been a lot of examples available of LSU coming from 20 down to win a basketball game, but the research staff (namely Todd Politz, LSU's outstanding content manager) has gone back to 2005-06 and cannot find another game like this.

Since the start of the 2015-16 season, the biggest halftime deficit LSU has overcome to win has been eight points and it has happened five times:

Dec. 10, 2022 – LSU down 8 at half, defeats Wake Forest, 72-70
Dec. 19, 2021 – LSU down 8 at half, defeats Louisiana Tech, 66-57
Feb. 12, 2019 – LSU down 8 at half, defeats Kentucky, 73-71
Feb. 6, 2019 – LSU down 8 at half, defeats Mississippi State, 92-88 OT
Dec. 13, 2015 – LSU down 8 at half, defeats North Florida, 119-108

Also, it was LSU's first win on a made shot in the final five seconds since the 2019-20 season when Skylar Mays hit a jumper at the buzzer after driving the length of the floor to defeat Mississippi State, 60-59 on Jan. 12, 2020.

THE START FOR THE TIGERS

Coach Matt McMahon's Tigers at 8-1 is off to the best start by an LSU first-year coach since Trent Johnson was 8-1 to start the 2008-09 season. The only other better starts came over 100 seasons ago as Branch Bocock in 1920-21 and Frank "Tad" Gormley in 1921-22 were 9-0 after nine games in their careers. Bocock won his first 13 games at LSU, Gormley won his first 14.

A DAY FOR KJ

KJ Williams had a day at State Farm Arena against Wake Forest, posting his second 30-point game of the season and the sixth of his career. Here's a look at his two 30-point games for LSU:

Vs. Illinois State (11/22, Cayman Islands Classic) – 33 pts, 13-19 FGs, 1-4 3FGs, 6-6 FTs, 8 rebs, 2 assts
Vs. Wake Forest (12/10), Holiday Hoopsgiving) – 35 pts, 14-21 FGs, 7-9 3FGs, 0-2 FTs, 10 rebs, 1 assts

His career college high was 39 at Tennessee State (2/10/22). The 35 points is the most by a player in the SEC this season in an individual game.

LAST TIME MULTIPLE 30S AT LSU

The last time LSU had a player with multiple 30-point games in a season was the 2020-21 campaign when present Brooklyn Net Cam Thomas had 32 against Texas A&M and 30 against Michigan in the NCAA Tournament.

In the 2017-18 season, Duop Reath had 30 against UNCW and 31 at Vanderbilt.

The last player to score 35 or more points at LSU was Tremont Waters, who scored 36 at Texas A&M on Jan. 30, 2019.

NOW AT 102 AND 92 AND COUNTING

Two milestones in this five-year career of KJ Williams took place on against Wofford (11/27) as the Tigers won 78-75.

The game marked his 100th win of his college career in games he has played in. Murray State actually won 101 games in which he has dressed, but a win early in his freshman season at Murray State in 2018-19, Williams did not play-coaches decision. So, he came to LSU with 94 wins in games he participated in and now, after the Wake Forest win on Dec. 10 has 102 and counting.

His double figure scoring game against Wake marked his eighth double figure game of the season, giving him 92 total for his college career in 133 career games played.

Tasmin Mitchell, the team's special assistant to the head coach, is watching that number as he recorded 107 double figure games in his five-years at LSU. Using just LSU games, there have only been four players total that have had at least 90 double figure scoring games in their careers dating back to the last 40 years.

MORE 100 NUMBERS

With his expected start Tuesday, KJ Williams will start his 100th college game between Murray State and LSU, starting every game (69) over the 2020-21, 2021-22 and now 2022-23 seasons.

There is also another 100 number in play in the game as he now is at 99 career three-point makes, so his first make will be his 100th career three-point field goal.

This season he is 17-of-34 from the arc and for his career he is a 37.4 percent shooter from distance having made 99-of-265 attempts.

2000-1000

KJ Williams is in the hunt for 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds between Murray State and LSU. He enters the week with 1,835 points and 957 rebounds. By averages for 133 games that translates to 13.8 points and 7.2 rebounds a game. For the nine games at LSU, he is averaging 18.7 points and 7.7 rebounds.

Unofficially, 122 players in college basketball have hit the 2,000-1,000 mark in their careers entering the 2022-23 season including some of the biggest named in the history of the game. Among those of interest here in Louisiana would be of course Rudy Macklin of LSU (1976-81) who had 2,080 points and 1,276 rebounds.

Also, from schools in Louisiana are Shawn Long at UL-Lafayette (2012-16) with 2,342 points and 1,447 rebounds; Reggie Jackson at Nicholls (1991-95) with 2,124 points and 1,271 rebounds; Willie Jackson of Centenary (1980-84) with 2,535-1,013; Calvin Natt of ULM (1975-79) with 2,581-1,281; and Robert Parish of Centenary (1973-76) with 2,334 points and 1,820 rebounds.

DOUBLE DOUBLES

It seems to have been something with Kansas for fifth year senior KJ Williams as he has recorded his first two double doubles this season came against Kansas City and Kansas State.

Williams made his first game at LSU a good one with his 28th career double double of 13 points and 14 rebounds versus Kansas City (11/9). Williams had 10 boards entering the final 25 seconds of the first half and six of his 14 were offensive.

Against Kansas State in the finals of the Cayman Islands Classic, Williams made it 29 double doubles with 17 points and 10 rebounds. His 10 rebounds were split 5-5.

His third came Saturday against Wake Forest and it was his 30th of his career.

Entering play Sunday, Williams was third in the SEC among active players in career double doubles:

Oscar Tshiebwe, Kentucky – 43
Jayveous McKinnis, Ole Miss – 38

KJ Williams, LSU – 30

For the season, Williams' three doubles is second behind Tshiebwe's five.

HILL AT THE POINT

Justice Hill's fake of the defender and drive through an open lane was a game-winner for the Tigers against Wake Forest as he continues to find back his scoring stroke that has been a little off in the last few games.

Hill is just 6-of-his-last-20 from the field in his last three games with 13 points, but he continues to be a point guard who can distribute the ball with great ability, dishing out 13 assists with just one turnover in the last three games.

He is averaging 4.2 assists a game with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.2 after the first nine games. He is fourth in the league in assists average and is second in the league in assist-to-turnover ratio.

Like KJ Williams, he is one of the transfers who played for Coach McMahon at Murray State. He is in his third year of playing for Coach after beginning his career at a junior college.

Hill had seven assists in the opening game and added 11 points and three assists in the second game against Arkansas State. He was in double figures again against UNO (11/17) with 12 points, five assists and three steals and an early season best +32 in plus-minus numbers.

He recorded his season high points game against Akron (11/22) with 14 points on 5-of-11 shooting.

Hill as five games of five assists or more this season. He is averaging 8.8 points, 2.0 rebounds and 4.2 assists.

ADAM MILLER

Adam Miller earned all-tournament honors in the Cayman Islands Classic after averaging 15.7 points, 1.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the three games of the tournament. He had a best of 23 against Akron when he hit five three-pointers in the Tigers semifinal wins.

Against Wofford (11/27), he was important for the Tigers rallying win, hitting a late three-pointer that gave the Tigers the winning points in the game.

The Wofford game was the third time that Miller has scored over 20 points this season and the second time he has scored 26 (vs. Arkansas State, 11/12; Wofford, 11/27).

So far Miller has hit at least four three-point field goals:

- 6 – vs. Wofford (11/27)
- 5 – vs. Akron (11/22)
- 4 – vs. Arkansas State (11/12)
- 4 – vs. Kansas City (11/9)

Miller is 26-of-69 overall from the arc or 37.7 percent.

Miller hadn't played in a counting regular season game since March of 2021 when Illinois played its final game of the 2020-21 season. He transferred to LSU but tore his ACL prior to the team's exhibition game and missed the entire 2021-22 season. He was medically cleared during the summer for a full go this season and Tiger fans couldn't be happier.

Miller has started all 40 games he has played in (31 at Illinois), averaging 8.3 points at Illinois. At LSU, he averaging 15.3 points and 2.0 rebounds to go with 1.2 assists.

LSU THREESOME LEADING SCORING

As this season gets going, the threesome of KJ Williams, Adam Miller and Justice Hill have dominated the scoring for LSU with the trio averaging a combined 42.8 points a game, 59.4 percent of LSU's 72.0 points per game the team is averaging.

Speaking of threes, LSU had three players in double figures in eight of the first nine games of the season. Against UTA (12/2), LSU only had two players in double figures.

TRAE HANNIBAL

The third Murray State transfer, Trae Hannibal, has been making his presence felt in the last several games and has played a minimum of 20 minutes in each of the last four games.

Hannibal apparently got the Tigers to overtime in the Cayman Islands against Kansas State (11/23), scoring the tying bucket that was later overruled when the clock operator failed to start the clock.

He is averaging 4.3 points and 4.1 rebounds to go with 2.3 assists. Against Wofford (11/27) and UTA (12/2), he scored 19 points combined (12 against Wofford, 7 against UTA).

Against Wofford (12/27), Hannibal was 4-of-6 field goal shooting and a perfect 4-of-4 at the line. He had one field goal but got to the line, making 5-of-7 against UTA (12/2).

For the season he is 21-of-30 at the free throw line ... 12-of-19 in the first three games and 9-of-11 in the last three.

PLUS-MINUS NUMBERS

The box scores this season are including the plus-minus numbers on each the players individually. This number represents how much the team scores while they are on the floor how many points the team gives up at the same time which gives a player a plus or minus total for the night.

KJ Williams is at +99 for the season with 7 games in the plus, while Derek Fountain after going +13, +15, +13 the last three games is next at +77. Adam Miller is next at +67, while Cam Hayes is +61 for the season.

STARTING LINEUP

For the first eight games, LSU has opened the game with Justice Hill and Adam Miller at guard, and, KJ Williams, Mwani Wilkinson and Jalen Reed at forwards.

LSU made a change on Saturday against Wake Forest (12/10) and moved Derek Fountain into the starting five replacing freshman Jalen Reed.

MWANI WILKINSON

Mwani Wilkinson elected to come back to the LSU program after briefly entering the transfer portal following the 2021-22 season. He is the veteran scholarship returnee, having been a part of the Tiger team in both 2020-21 and 2021-22. He has been a part of two NCAA teams and a team that went to the finals of the SEC Tournament in 2021.

Wilkinson had a good opening night (11/9) for the Tigers with nine points making 3-of-4 three-pointers, tying his career highs in treys made in a 22-minute start for LSU.

Wilkinson has started all nine games this season and is averaging 3.2 points and 2.1 rebounds. Wilkinson is 8-of-18 from the arc.

JALEN REED

The freshman from Jackson, Mississippi started the first eight games before coming off the bench against Wake Forest (12/10). He has scored in every game this season.

His best game came against UNO (11/17) when he scored eight points, hitting all three field goal attempts in 21 minutes. He added six rebounds and a steal in the game.

For the season, Reed is averaging 3.9 points and 3.3 rebounds. He is averaging 19.1 minutes a game. Reed is the son of the late SEC star Justin Reed, who played at Ole Miss (2000-04).

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Fountain earned his first start on Saturday against Wake Forest and played a total of 30 minutes, scoring 11 points with five rebounds and four steals. He is averaging 18.2 minutes per game.

Against UNO (11/17), the junior had a line of 15 points, eight rebounds and seven steals. Fountain was 4-of-5 from the field with a trey and 6-of-6 from the free throw line.

He posted eight points in the UT Arlington (12/2) game, playing 19 minutes, making 3-of-5 field goals including a three-pointer.

Fountain is averaging 5.8 points, 3.9 rebounds and 1.7 steals.

Fountain's best season of his two at Mississippi State was the 2020-21 campaign when as a freshman he

started 10-of-19 games and averaged 5.4 points. Ironically, his career high came against LSU in Baton Rouge when he scored 20 points.

CAM HAYES

Cam Hayes, the transfer from North Carolina State, did not play against Arkansas State (11/12), but the junior came back against UNO (11/17) to play 16 minutes and hit three three-pointers in a 13-point effort. He also had double figures in the opening Cayman Islands game against Illinois State (11/21), scoring 10 on 3-of-5 shooting with a trey.

Hayes had a big game in several ways against Wake Forest (12/10), hitting 5-of-10 field goal attempts, including two treys to post a 13-point scoring line to go with five rebounds and six assists. More importantly, in 28 minutes off the bench, no turnovers.

He is fourth on the team in scoring at 7.0 points per game, with 1.6 rebounds and 1.75 assists per game. He is 8-of-18 from the arc, averaging 16.1 minutes a game.

KENDAL COLEMAN

Coleman played 11 minutes against Wofford (11/27), making both field goal attempts and 3-of-3 at the line to finish with seven points, his second highest total of the season.

In the next game against UTA (12/2), Coleman played 13 minutes, making 3-of-4 field goals to again score seven points with six rebounds.

The Northwestern State transfer is averaging 2.9 points and 2.7 rebounds, playing 9.0 minutes per game.

Coleman's season high at LSU was eight points against Illinois State in the Cayman Islands (11/21) and seven rebounds against UNO (11/17).

JUSTICE WILLIAMS

He hadn't been on the court since the Nov. 17 game against UNO where he suffered an injured left ankle, but when called upon to return to action against Wake Forest (Dec. 10) after missing five games, sophomore Justice Williams was ready.

Last season, he missed the entire non-conference schedule as a freshman before being thrust into action due to other injuries at the start of conference play.

Williams played 17 minutes against the Demon Deacons, scoring five points with a rebound, two assists and a steal.

For the season, Williams is averaging 4.3 points, 1.3 rebounds and 1.2 assists.

TURNOVERS

Finally, the Tigers were able to keep turnovers in the single digits against Wake Forest, recording only seven in the Dec. 10 game.

For the season, even with the seven turnovers against Wake Forest, LSU is averaging 13.1 miscues a game with 118, still less than LSU's nine opponents (142).

In a strange way both teams were affected in different halves in the championship game of the Cayman Islands Classic against Kansas State (11/23).

After a first half in which LSU forced the Wildcats into double figure turnovers and LSU committed just three turnovers, the Wildcats reversed the script and forced LSU into 14 miscues in the last 20 minutes.

LSU is back with a positive assist-to-turnover ratio of 119 assists to 118 turnovers.

STEALS

Last year, the Tigers had their best season ever at stealing the basketball with 373 steals.

So far this season, LSU has also been good at getting steals again with 82 steals, an average of 9.1 per game. LSU had a season high of 17 against UNO (11/17). Opponents have only recorded 50 steals.

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS

Last year, LSU was the Division I leader in shot clock violations drawn according to @CBBAnalytics with 38, four more than Richmond and Virginia in college basketball.

The total so far this season is six.

LSU drew two in each of the first two games – two in the first half against Kansas City (11/9) and then one each in each half against Arkansas State (11/12). The Tigers had one shot clock violation against Akron in the tournament and one in the game against UTA (12/2).

FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE

Last year, LSU was 16-1 when opponents shot under 40 percent and LSU is 4-0 this year in that category as Kansas City (32.8%), Arkansas State (38.6%), Akron (25.9%) and UTA (37.5%) have shot under 40 percent overall.

The Tigers are 56-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season when opponents shoot under 40 percent.

However, LSU was 6-10 last year when opponents shoot 40 percent or better from the field. LSU is 4-1 this season when teams shoot over 40 percent.

Offensively, the Tigers have won the last 16 games when shooting 50 percent or more in a game and LSU is 103-9 in the last 112 games when LSU shot 50 percent or better since the start of the 2007-08 season. The 50 percent games this season:

LSU vs. UNO (11/17) – 30-of-58, 51.7%

LSU vs. Wofford (11/27) – 28-of-53, 52.8%

FROM THE ARC

The Tigers last season shot just 31.6 percent from the arc and LSU has not shot over 35 percent from the arc since 2012-13 season.

But so far this year, LSU has been better from the three-point arc, making 71-of-184 or 38.6 percent through nine games. KJ Williams is at 50 percent (17-34), Cam Hayes is 8-of-18 (44.4%), as is Mwani Wilkinson and shooter Adam Miller is 26-of-69 (37.7%).

LSU made 10 treys against Wake Forest, the second time LSU was in double figures this season from distance.

Tiger opponents are just 54-of-203 or 26.6 percent.

FREE THROWS

LSU had its worst game of the year at the charity stripe, hitting just 6-of-15 or 40 percent against Wake Forest (12/10), the first time LSU was below 50 percent since the Lipscomb game (12/22/21) when the Tigers made just 3-of-10.

LSU for the season is 127-of-181 for 70.2 percent. Opponents have made 107-of-149 or 71.8 percent.

HOME WINNING STREAK

It is modest but LSU's 5-0 home start this season gives LSU a nine-game winning streak at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center dating back to last year. LSU won its last four Southeastern Conference home games last year against Mississippi State, Georgia, Missouri and No. 25 Alabama.

The Tigers are in their 52nd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation followed by the untimely death of the star LSU player.

The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

LSU was 15-2 a year ago in the building and in 810 games the Tigers have an on-court record of 610-201 (75.1%) ... In non-conference games, LSU is 328-44 (88.1%).

There are a couple of guys who know something about the Southeastern Conference because their fathers played in the league with good success.

Director of Player Development Ronrico White's father, Tony, was an All-America at Tennessee. Tony White played from 1983 to 1987 at Tennessee.

Then there is freshman Jalen Reed from Jackson, Mississippi, whose late dad, Justin, was an All-America at Ole Miss and the SEC Freshman of the Year in 2001. Justin Reed was an All-SEC selection in each of his four years at Ole Miss, guiding the Rebels to a first ever "Sweet Sixteen" appearance for the program.

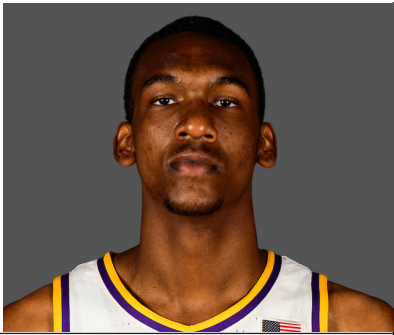

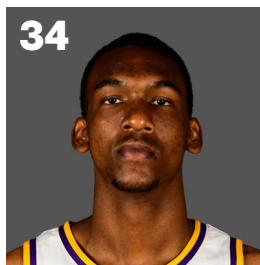
