#### The Ninth Ranked Tigers Host No. 17 Georgia On Friday Night

No. 9 LSU Gymnastics is set to host No. 17 Georgia in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center for a top-20 SEC matchup. The meet will be televised on SEC Network with Steve Schlanger and Bridget Sloan on the call. Introductions are set for 7:52 inside the PMAC with the first vault leading off at 8:05 p.m. CT. The last time the two teams met was in 2022, when No. 6 LSU defeated Georgia 196.850-196.100 on the road in Stegeman Coliseum. The victory marked the Tigers 16th-straight win over the Bulldogs.LSU will look for its sixth straight win over Georgia inside the PMAC on Friday night.

### Storylines

- · LSU owns an overall record of 41-71-2 against the Georgia Bulldogs. The Tigers are 10-12-1 at home against the Bulldogs and 24-55-2 in the regular season.
- The Tigers began the 2023 season ranked No. 6 in the preseason poll, marking the eleventh straight season the team was ranked in the top-10. The preseason ranking also marks the 26th consecutive season that the Tigers were placed in the top-25.

- · LSU earned the highest road opener score in program history with a score of 196.775 in the squad's season opener against No. 3 Utah. The last time the

# **JAY CLARK**

Jay Clark, a 30-year veteran of college gymnastics and one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his third season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2021 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with fellow LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 30 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive Top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking

on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against lowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the dub level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete collegiately at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark is married to the former Julie Ballard, an All-American Georgia gymnast from 1994-98 and a native of Mandeville, Louisiana. The couple has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.



#### **Last Time On The Floor**

- No. 8 LSU fell to No. 23 Arkansas with a score of 197.250-197.475 on Friday, January 27, in Barnhill Arena.
- Haleigh Bryant recorded her fifth-straight all-around title in five meets with her score of 39.575. She also took the co-title on vault with her score of 9.95 against the Razorbacks, along with teammate KJ Johnson.
- Aleah Finnegan won beam as she earned a 9.925 on the night. This
  moved her title total to five this season and second on beam.
- KJ Johnson recorded her first title this season on vault and her second on the event in her career.
- · Shchennikova recorded a season high all-around score of 39.300.

#### **First Victory In The PMAC**

- In the battle between the Tigers, LSU recorded their first victory of the season at home with a score of 197.150-196.525
- An electric crowd of 11,966 fans showed out for the Tigers on Friday night as LSU took down No. 12 Missouri.

#### 2023 Schedule

- The Tigers 2023 schedule is one of the most difficult schedules in the nation with 11 meets, facing all eight SEC opponents, as well as top-10 ranked Utah and Oklahoma.
- LSU will welcome Oklahoma, Missouri, Georgia, Florida and West Virginia to the PMAC this season
- Postseason begins on March 18 at the SEC Championships in Duluth, Ga. The NCAA Championnships are set for April 15.

#### The Squad

- The 2023 squad is comprised of one grad transfer, six seniors, five juniors, three sophomores and three freshmen.
- Graduate transfer Cammy Hall transferred to LSU for her fifth-year season from Utah. She is out for the season due to an Achilles injury, but still plays an important role on the team.
- The senior class of Kiya Johnson, Alyona Shchennikova, Kai Rivers, Lexi Nibbs, Kamryn Ryan and Maddie Rau provide a wealth of experience and routines for the Tigers in their fourth year.
- Shchennikova competed in the all-around for the first time this season against Missouri and earned a season high 39.350 at Arkansas
- Rivers brings an experienced routine as the beam leadoff after making her return in 2022 after an injury.
- Nibbs is returning in 2023 after an injury and has been working on her vault routine.
- Juniors Haleigh Bryant, Elena Arenas, Sierra Ballard and Chase Brock have stepped up and shown consistency in the lineups.
- Bryant has won the all-around in all five of the Tigers meets thus far, adding to her career total of 43 titles. She matched her career high all-around score of 39.750 against Missouri and owns season highs of 9.900+ on all four events.
- Arenas owns a season high score of 9.850 on the vault and a 9.875 on bars. She also recorded a career high of 9.925 on beam at Kentucky.
- Ballard is a main stay in the floor lineup as leadoff and recently made her way into the beam lineup. Brock had a night against Arkansas and scored season highs on vault and floor.
- The Tigers sophomore class is making their names known. Aleah Finnegan, Alexis Jeffrey, KJ Johnson and Tori Tatum are all making impacts in the lineup.
- Finnegan competed in the all-around for the first time in Salt Lake City and earned a score of 39.450. The sophomore owns career-highs of 9.950 on floor, 9.950 on beam, 9.850 on vault and 9.925 on bars.
- Jeffrey recorded a career high of 9.925 in the leadoff on bars against Missouri.
- Johnson has earned season high's of 9.725 on beam, 9.950 on vault and 9.925 on floor.
- Tatum made her collegiate debut against Oklahoma and recorded a career high 9.900 against Missouri.
- Freshman Ashley Cowan and Bryce Wilson have the potential to

make an immediate impact in the bars and beam lineups. Wilson can impact the vault and beam lineups in their first year.

• Wison made her collegiate debut on beam against Utah, scoring a career high 9.775.

#### **Climbing Season Tickets**

- LSU marked a new season ticket record in 2023 with over 7,400 season tickets sold before the home opener.
- · The record surpasses last year's record of 7,351

#### **Clark as Head Coach**

- Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons on staff, was elevated to head coach of the Fighting Tigers in 2021.
- Clark took over for legendary coach D-D Breaux, who served as head coach for 43 seasons
- Clark owns 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- In his time at LSU, Clark has elevated the Tigers' bars teams to one of the best in the nation.
- He takes over in 2021 as the third coach in program history.
- Clark previously served for more than 20 years as an assistant coach and head coach at the University of Georgia.

#### **Gnat In Her Return to Baton Rouge**

- Ashleigh Gnat, a 17-time All-American, four-time Southeastern Conference event champion and 2017 NCAA Floor Champion, is in her third season as assistant coach with the Tigers after being named to the coaching staff in August 2021 after Clark's promotion to head coach.
- A two-time graduate of LSU, Gnat's primary responsibility is as the Tigers' beam coach.
- After her gymnastics career, Gnat served as a student coach for two years. She landed her first full-time position in 2019 as an assistant coach at Penn State.
- During her six years in Baton Rouge, Gnat was a part of the most successful stretch of the program's history. The Tigers set the three highest finishes in school history during Gnat's time and won five SEC Championships.
- She brings a wealth of experience as one of the best gymnasts in school history. Gnat led
  the Tigers inside and outside of the gym as LSU's nominee for the NCAA Woman of the Year
  Award and a finalist for the Honda Award.
- Gnat set multiple records during her career in Baton Rouge, including the most floor titles in a single season and perfect scores in a career with nine. Gnat was the 2016 and 2017 SEC Specialist of the Year and Central Region Gymnast of the Year.

#### **Griffeths Begin Second Year On Staff**

- Following the retirement of longtime assistant coach Bob Moore and the transition of Ashleigh Clare-Kearney Thigpen to an administrative role as Associate AD of Diversity Equity and Inclusion, Clark hired Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth to serve as assistant coaches.
- The Griffeths come to Baton Rouge after serving as assistant coaches for two seasons at the University of Utah. In that time, the Utes went 21-1 during the regular season, won the 2021 Pac-12 Championship and finished third nationally after advancing to the NCAA Championship Final.
- Prior to their time in Salt Lake City, Garrett served as the associate head coach and Courtney the volunteer coach and choreographer for two seasons at Arkansas. They spent four seasons at Texas Woman's University from 2014-17 and prior to that coached at Cincinnati Gymnastics Academy in 2013.
- Both earned bachelor and master's degrees from Georgia, where Griffeth served on Clark's staff as a graduate assistant coach in 2011 and an administrative associate in 2012. McCool competed at Georgia from 2007-10, helping the GymDogs to three consecutive NCAA titles from 2007-09. She was the 2008 NCAA floor champion.

#### Haleigh Bryant One Of Nation's Top Gymnasts

- LSU's Haleigh Bryant completed arguably the greatest freshman seasons in school history, culminating by winning the NCAA vault title. She was named the WCGA Region 1 Gymnast of the Year and selected as the SEC Freshman of the Year.
- Bryant won the SEC vault champion and the NCAA vault title in 2021 with her electric vault, a front handspring-front pike half.
- She earned six all-america honors in 2021 and two in 2022.
- The Cornelius, N.C., native continues to make her mark as she has stepped up for the Tigers this season after the injury of teammate and senior Kiya Johnson.
- The junior has tallied 13 titles already this season; five on all-around, four on vault, two on beam, one on bars and one on floor. She currently owns 43 titles in her career.
- Bryant recorded her first 10 of the season on vault against No. 12 Missouri, moving her total to six career perfect scores, all of them on vault.
