It's A Top-10 Rivalry Matchup In Tuscaloosa On Friday Night

No. 8 LSU Gymnastics travels to Tuscaloosa to face No. 9 Alabama on Friday, February 24, for a top-10 rivalry showdown in Coleman Coliseum. The meet will be streamed on SEC Network Plus with Roger Hoover on the play-by-play and Kiana Winston as the analyst. The dual between the Tigers and the Tide will lead off at 7:01 p.m. CT. The last time the two teams met in 2022, when No. 5 LSU defeated No. 8 Alabama inside the PMAC with a score of 198.050-197.600. LSU is 5-26-0 on the road and will look for its first victory over Alabama in Coleman Coliseum since 2019.

Storylines

- LSU owns an overall series record of 30-101-2 against Alabama and are5-26-0 on the road. The Tigers hold a 20-61-2 record against the Tide during the regular season.
- The Tigers began the 2023 season ranked No. 6 in the preseason poll, marking the eleventh straight season the team was ranked in the top-10. The preseason ranking also marks the 26th consecutive season that the Tigers were placed in the top-25.
- LSU has remained ranked in the top-10 for seven consecutive weeks. The Tigers

- remain at eight in the week seven rankings.
- LSU earned the highest road opener score in program history with a score of 196.775 in the squad's season opener against No. 3 Utah. The last time the Tigers opened on the road was in 2012.
- In the squad's three home meets thus far, the program has welcomed three record crowds inside the PMAC, including the arena's 11th largest crowd of 12,099 fans against Georgia. A total of 36,130 fans have shown out for the Tigers in 2023.
- The Tigers recorded a season high score of 198.100 over Florida on February 17 to record the ninth highest overall score in program history.
- LSU's highest road score came at Auburn with a score of 197.500.
- Junior Haleigh Bryant has the potential to win her seventh allaround title on Friday night to tie her at No. 8 all-time single season best in program history.
- Sophomore Aleah Finnegan has recorded three perfect 10's in three consecutive weeks for the Tigers.

JAY CLARK

Jay Clark, a 30-year veteran of college gymnastics and one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his third season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2021 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with fellow LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 30 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive Top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking

on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against lowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the dub level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete collegiately at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark is married to the former Julie Ballard, an All-American Georgia gymnast from 1994-98 and a native of Mandeville, Louisiana. The couple has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.



2023 LSU Gymnastics - Week 8 vs. Alabama

NOTEBOOK

Last Time On The Floor

- No. 8 LSU defeated No. 2 Florida, 198.100-197.975, in a top-10 SEC matchup inside the PMAC on Friday, February 17. It was a season high score for the Tigers and the ninth highest overall score in program history.
- The Gators were previously undefeated before falling to the Tigers at home. It was the first time LSU defeated Florida since 2018.
- Aleah Finnegan recorded her third straight perfect 10 in three consecutive meets. Her first perfect 10 on beam came against the Gators to boost the Tigers to victory. It was her third career perfect score with one on floor, one on vault and one on beam.
- KJ Johnson took the co-floor title with her 9.950 routine to match her career high. The sophomore also recorded a career high in only her fourth appearance on beam with a 9.875.
- Elena Arenas had a career night on Friday. The junior made her first appearance in the all-around, scoring a 39.425. She also recorded a season high on vault with her 9.875 and set a new career high on bars with her 9.900. She earned a 9.825 on beam and floor to complete the night.
- Haleigh Bryant took home the win on vault with her 9.975 performance, moving her total to 18 titles this season and her sixth on vault
- Alyona Shchennikova matched her career high on floor with her 9.925 performance.

Tiger Nation Shows Out

- In the squad's home opener against top-ranked Oklahoma, LSU recorded a record crowd for a home opener with 12,065 fans. The attendance also marked the arena's 13th largest crowd.
- An electric crowd of 11,966 fans showed out for the Tigers on Friday, January 20, as LSU took down No. 12 Missouri.
- Against No. 17 Georgia, 12,099 fans showed out to watch the Tigers defeat the Bulldogs and recorded the 11th largest crowd inside the arena
- 11,887 fans showed out to watch the Tigers take down No. 2 Florida last Friday.
- A total of 48,017 fans have shown out for all three of LSU's home meets thus far in 2023 and all rank in the top-20 attendance records inside the PMAC.

Perfect Scores In 2023

- Bryant earned the perfect 10 in 2023 for the Tigers on her vault against Missouri. It was her sixth career perfect score; al of them being on vault.
- Finnegan recorded her first career perfect scores in 2023 and now owns three in three consecutive weeks. Her first perfect 10 came on floor at home against Georgia, followed by a 10 on vault at Auburn and most recently on beam against the Gators. She will look to be the first gymnast in LSU history to earn a perfect score on every event.

Conference Honors

- Bryant earned the first conference award for the Tigers this season as she was named SEC co-gymnast of the week on January 24, 2023, after her performance against Missouri where she earned a perfect 10 on vault.
- KJ Johnson earned SEC Specialist of the Week on February 7 for her performance against Georgia, where she earned a 9.875 on vault and matched her career high on floor with a 9.950.

198.000 Plus

- LSU hit its first 198.000 mark this season against the Gators to record the program's ninth highest score.
- The Tigers are only one of six teams to record a 198 or higher this season. Others include Oklahoma, Florida, Michigan, Utah and Alabama.

The Squad

 The 2023 squad is comprised of one grad transfer, six seniors, five juniors, three sophomores and three freshmen. The senior class of Kiya Johnson, Alyona Shchennikova, Kai Rivers, Lexi Nibbs, Kamryn Ryan

- and Maddie Rau provide a wealth of experience and routines for the Tigers in their fourth year.
- Graduate transfer Cammy Hall transferred to LSU for her fifth-year season from Utah. She is out for the season due to an Achilles injury, but still plays an important role on the team with her leadership.
- Senior Kiya Johnson suffered an achilles injury in the Tigers meet at Kentucky and is also out for the season. Johnson continues to play a crucial role on thw squad using her voice as a leader in and outside of the gym.
- Shchennikova competed in the all-around for the first time this season against Missouri. The senior matched her season high score of 39.525 against Auburn.
- Rivers brings an experienced routine to the beam lineup after making her return in 2022 after an injury. She owns a season high of 9.900 on beam.
- · Nibbs is available in 2023 after an injury and has been working on her vault routine.
- Juniors Haleigh Bryant, Elena Arenas, Sierra Ballard and Chase Brock have stepped up and shown consistency in the lineups.
- Bryant has won the all-around in six of the Tigers meets thus far, adding to her career total of 48 titles. She recorded a new career high all-around score of 39.775 against Florida and owns season highs of 9.900+ on all four events, including a perfect score on vault.
- Arenas owns a season high score of 9.875 on vault and a 9.900 on bars. She also recorded a career high of 9.925 on beam at Kentucky.
- Ballard brings the energy in the floor lineup as leadoff and recently made her way into the beam lineup, where she continues to show consistency. Brock scored a season high on floor against Arkansas with her 9.950 and earned a caree high 9.950 on vault against Georgia.
- The Tigers sophomore class is making their names known. Aleah Finnegan, Alexis Jeffrey, KJ Johnson and Tori Tatum are all making impacts in the lineups.
- Finnegan competed in the all-around for the first time in Salt Lake City and now owns a career high of 39.800 after her performance at Auburn. The sophomore owns career highs of perfect 10's on floor, vault and beam and a career high 9.925 on bars.
- Jeffrey recorded a career high of 9.925 in the leadoff on bars against Missouri.
- Johnson has earned season high's of 9.875 on beam, 9.950 on vault and 9.950 on floor.
- Tatum made her collegiate debut against Oklahoma and recorded a career high 9.900 against Missouri. She matched that against Georgia and Florida.
- Freshman Ashley Cowan made her collegiate debut at Auburn where she scored a 9.775 on bars while Wilson made her debut on beam against Utah, also scoring a 9.775. The two both have the ability to make appearances in the Tigers remaining meets.

Bryant, Finnegan Two Of Nation's Top Gymnasts

- Bryant, a native of Cornelius, N.C., is arguably one of the top gymnasts in the country and continues to make her mark as she has stepped up for the Tigers this season. Bryant won the SEC vault champion and the NCAA vault title in 2021 with her electric vault, a front handspring-front pike half.
- She is currently ranked in the top-10 on two events as well as the all-around; second on vault, ninth on beam and fourth in the all-around.
- The junior has tallied 18 titles already this season; six on all-around, six on vault, three on beam, two on bars and one on floor. She currently owns 48 titles in her career.
- Etching herself in LSU program records, Bryant currently sits tied at No. 7 career all-around titles with 14 and is tied at No. 9 all-time vault titles with her total of 20. CHECK THIS
- Finnegan, a native of Lee's Summit, Missouri, currently ranks fifth on beam, eighth on floor and seven in the all-around.
- She owns 12 titles this season; five on beam, four on floor, one on vault and two all-around.

The Coaching Staff

- Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons on staff, was named the third head coach
 of the Fighting Tigers in 2021. Clark owns 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is
 one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- Assistant coach Ashleigh Gnat is a 17-time All-American, four-time SEC event champion and 2017 NCAA Floor Champion. Gnat is in her third season as assistant coach with the Tigers after being named to the coaching staff in August 2021 after Clark's promotion to head coach. She brings a wealth of experience as beam coach as she is one of the best gymnasts in school history.
- Following the retirement of longtime assistant coach Bob Moore and the transition of Ashleigh Clare-Kearney Thigpen to an administrative role as Associate AD of Diversity Equity and Inclusion, Clark hired Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth to serve as assistant coaches. The Griffeths come to Baton Rouge after serving as assistant coaches for two seasons at the University of Utah. In that time, the Utes went 21-1 during the regular season, won the 2021 Pac-12 Championship and finished third nationally after advancing to the NCAA Championship Final. Prior to their time in Salt Lake City, Garrett served as the associate head coach and Courtney the volunteer coach and choreographer for two seasons at Arkansas. They spent four seasons at Texas Woman's University from 2014-17 and prior to that coached at Cincinnati Gymnastics Academy in 2013.
