#### **SERIES RECORD VS. TENNESSEE**

• LSU leads the all-time series with Tennessee, 58-28 ... LSU has won 14 of its last 21 games versus UT; however, Tennessee has won the last six meetings, including a 5-2 victory last season in the SEC Tournament in Hoover, Ala. ... the Vols won five straight games over the Tigers in 2021, sweeping a three-game SEC regular-season series and a two-game NCAA Super Regional – all five games were played in Knoxville ... this weekend's series marks Tennessee's first appearance in Baton Rouge since 2018, when LSU recorded a three-game sweep over the Vols.

#### **ABOUT THE TIGERS**

- LSU has won four of its last five games, including an SEC series victory over No. 3 Arkansas last weekend and a 17–5 win over Grambling on Tuesday night ... LSU's 22–3 record is the Tigers' best through 25 games since the 2015 team also posted a 22–3 mark.
- LSU, which has been ranked No. 1 all season by all of the college baseball polls, enters the Tennessee series at or near the top of several NCAA statistical categories ... the Tigers are No. 1 in the nation in fielding percentage (.988), on-base percentage (.465) runs scored (278) and shutouts pitched (7) ... LSU is No. 2 in the nation in batting average (.339), hits allowed per nine innings (5.83) and scoring average (11.1 runs per game); No. 3 in WHIP (1.06); and No. 4 in slugging percentage (.597).
- LSU centerfielder **Dylan Crews** is No. 1 in the nation in batting average (.542), on-base percentage (.667) and in runs scored (48), and he is No. 2 in slugging percentage (.988) and hits (45) ... third baseman Tommy White is No. 1 in the nation in RBI per game (1.91) and No. 2 in total RBI (42) ... right-hander **Paul Skenes** leads the nation in strikeouts (71), hits allowed per nine innings (3.38) and WHIP (0.56) ... Skenes is No 2 in the nation in ERA (0.72) ... right-hander **Ty Floyd** is No. 5 in the nation in hits allowed per nine innings (4.10).
- Junior centerfielder **Dylan Crews** earned **SEC Co-Player of the Week** and Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** recognition on Monday after he led the top-ranked Tigers to three wins in four games last week, including an SEC series victory over third-ranked Arkansas ... he batted a sizzling .625 (10-for-16) in four games with four homers, nine RBI and nine runs ... Crews homered once in each of the four games the Tigers played ... he also walked three times and was hit by a pitch, which contributed to his .700 on-base percentage for the week ... Crews enters this

weekend's series versus Tennessee riding a 23-game hitting streak and a 29-game reached base streak; the reached base streak includes all 25 games this season and the final four games of the 2022 season.

- In the Tigers' SEC series victory over Arkansas, **Crews** batted .615 (8-for-13) with three homers, seven RBI, seven runs, a .667 on-base percentage and a 1.308 slugging percentage ... he leads the SEC with a .542 cumulative batting average, and he is also No. 1 in the league in on-base percentage (.667), slugging percentage (.988), base hits (45) and runs scored (48).
- Graduate first baseman/DH **Cade Beloso** started in Games 2 and 3 of the Arkansas series last weekend and responded by batting .571 (4-for-7) with one double and two RBI ... Beloso blasted a three-run homer and collected four RBI in Tuesday night's win over Grambling ... sophomore third baseman **Tommy White** launched two homers, including his second grand slam of the season, and collected eight RBI in LSU's series win over Arkansas ... first baseman/leftfielder **Tre' Morgan** batted .385 (5-for-13) in the Arkansas series with one triple, one homer, two RBI and five runs scored ... second baseman **Gavin Dugas** homered twice and collected four RBI vs. the Razorbacks.
- Junior right-hander **Paul Skenes** pitched seven innings in Game 1 of the Arkansas series on Friday, allowing just one run on two hits with three walks and 12 strikeouts ... Skenes received Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** recognition for the fourth time this season.
- Junior right-hander **Ty Floyd** defeated Arkansas in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, working 6.1 innings and limiting the Razorbacks to one earned run on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts.
- Junior right-hander **Garrett Edwards** pitched in both games of Saturday's doubleheader vs. Arkansas, working a total of 4.2 scoreless innings and allowing just two hits with one walk and eight strikeouts ... freshman left-hander Griffin Herring posted two relief wins last week over Central Arkansas and Arkansas, pitching a combined 4.1 innings and allowing one run on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts.
- Sophomore third baseman **Tommy White** was named **SEC Player of the Week** on March 20 after he batted .474 (9-for-19) in LSU's games last week and helped lead the Tigers to an SEC series victory at No. 11 Texas A&M ... White collected one double, one homer, 11 RBI and seven runs in the Tigers' four games versus New Orleans and Texas A&M ... in LSU's series victory at Texas A&M, White hit .500 (7-for-14) with one double, seven RBI and four runs .... his two-out, bases-loaded two-run single in the fourth inning of Game 2 sparked a six-run rally that allowed the Tigers to erase a 4-0 deficit and go on to post a 12-7 win.

- Junior right-hander Paul Skenes received Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week recognition on March 20 after he defeated No. 11 Texas A&M on March 17, working 6.1 scoreless innings while allowing four hits and recording no walks and 11 strikeouts ... Skenes fired a season-high 106 pitches in the outing to lead LSU to the seriesopening victory over the Aggies.
- Freshman first baseman **Jared Jones** was named **SEC Co-Freshman of the Week** on March 13 after he batted .600 (6-for-10) for LSU last week with four homers, 11 RBI and five runs ... he homered four times in four consecutive plate appearances over the course of the Tigers' games versus Samford on March 10 and 11 ... in Game 1, Jones launched two 2-run homers in his final two plate appearances, and in Game 2, he unloaded two 3-run dingers in his first two plate appearances ... he added an RBI single in the Game 3 win over Samford, as the Tigers completed a three-game sweep.
- Sophomore right-hander Thatcher Hurd received SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week and Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week recognition on March 13 after he posted two wins in two starts, working a total of 11 scoreless innings with three walks and 18 strikeouts ... Hurd allowed just four hits and limited opponents to a .111 batting average in his two outings ... he defeated Butler on March 6, firing six shutout innings with three hits, one walk and 11 strikeouts, just one strikeout shy of his career high ... Hurd then posted a win over Samford on March 12, working five scoreless innings and limiting the Bulldogs to one hit with two walks and seven strikeouts ... Hurd pitched 3.2 perfect innings versus Samford before allowing a batter to reach base.
- Junior first baseman **Tre' Morgan** became the first LSU player to hit for the cycle since 2010, when he posted a "natural" cycle vs. Southern on Feb. 21 ... he collected a single in the second, a double in the third, and a triple in the fifth; he then put an exclamation point on the outing with a dinger to right field in the sixth, officially completing the natural cycle ... Morgan was 4-for-5 on the day with a careerbest eight RBI, and he became the first Tiger to hit for the cycle since April 6, 2010, when Mikie Mahtook accomplished the feat versus Alcorn State.
- LSU graduate second baseman **Gavin Dugas** wears jersey No. 8 for the second consecutive season. The No. 8 jersey is given each season to the upperclassman who exemplifies the spirit of LSU Baseball through his leadership and dedication to the program. **The No. 8 tradition** was started by outfielder Mikie Mahtook (2009-11) and has since been continued by first baseman Mason Katz (2012-13), shortstop Alex Bregman (2014-15), outfielder Jake Fraley (2016), second baseman Cole Freeman (2017), outfielder Antoine Duplantis (2018-19), outfielder Daniel Cabrera (2020) and pitcher Matthew Beck (2021).

- Pitched seven innings in Game 1 of the Arkansas series on March 24, allowing just one run on two hits with three walks and 12 strikeouts ... Skenes received Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** recognition for the fourth time this season on March 27
- Received Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** recognition on March 20 after he defeated No. 11 Texas A&M on March 17, working 6.1 scoreless innings while allowing four hits and recording no walks and 11 strikeouts ... Skenes fired a season-high 106 pitches in the outing to lead LSU to the series-opening victory over the Aggies
- Posted win over Samford on March 10, working six innings and limiting the Bulldogs to one run on two hits with one walk and 12 strikeouts
- Voted **SEC Pitcher of the Week** and a Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** on March 6 after defeating Butler on March 3 in a dominating six-inning outing ... he limited Butler to no runs on one hit with no walks and a career-high 13 strikeouts ... Skenes allowed a two-out single in the first inning, then retired 16 straight Butler hitters to complete his outing ... his 13 Ks represented the most by an LSU pitcher since March 2, 2018, when Zack Hess recorded 13 strikeouts against Toledo
- Defeated Kansas State on Feb. 24 in the opening game of the Round Rock Classic ... Skenes worked six innings, limiting the Wildcats to one run on two hits with two walks and 11 strikeouts, firing 101 pitches in the outing ... he retired 17 of the final 18 Kansas State hitters that he faced, and he was voted to the Round Rock Classic All-Tournament team
- Named **SEC Pitcher of the Week** and a Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** on Feb. 20 as he worked six shutout frames on Feb. 17 to defeat Western Michigan, allowing just three hits with one walk and 12 strikeouts ... the 12 Ks represented the most by an LSU pitcher since April 15, 2021, when Landon Marceaux recorded 12 strikeouts versus South Carolina ... Skenes' effort also marked the most strikeouts by an LSU pitcher in a season opener since Scott Schultz fanned 12 Lamar batters in 1995 in the Winn-Dixie Showdown at the Louisiana Superdome

#### **At Air Force**

Played the 2021 and 2022 seasons at Air Force before transferring to LSU ... earned first-team 2022 and 2021 All-America recognition for the Falcons ... recipient of the 2022 John Olerud Award as the best two-way player in college baseball ... recorded a 2.96 ERA and 96 strikeouts in 85.2 innings (15 starts) in 2022, limiting opponents to a .224 batting average; also batted .314 in 2022 with 10 doubles, 13 homers and 38 RBI ... in 2021, he was voted National Co-Freshman of the Year by Collegiate Baseball, sharing the honor with LSU's Dylan Crews ... Skenes was voted the Mountain West Conference Freshman of the Year in 2021; made 18 relief appearances on the mound and saw action at DH, catcher and first base ... batted .410 in 2021 and finished second in the Mountain West Conference in hits with 77 ... recorded 11 saves on the mound in 2021 and limited opponents to a .208 batting average ... pitched against LSU in Alex Box Stadium during the opening weekend of the 2021 season and posted a save in Air Force's 6-5 win over the Tigers on February 21; he pitched one inning to earn the save, allowing one run on one hit with no walks and two strikeouts.

# **JAY JOHNSON**

LSU BASEBALL HEAD COACH

A proven track record of postseason success, explosive lineups and highly-ranked recruiting classes make LSU's Jay Johnson one of the best college baseball coaches in the nation. He has made a significant impact at every program he's led, and he is one of the most energetic, innovative and focused coaches in America.

In his second season as the head coach of the storied, six-time national champion LSU program, Johnson is poised to lead the Tigers to an elite level.

He was named the head coach at LSU on June 25, 2021, after guiding Arizona to the Pac-12 championship and a berth in the College World Series.

"I view this as the opportunity of my lifetime," Johnson said on the day of his LSU hiring, "and I will do everything in my power to have our team playing a brand of baseball that makes everyone at LSU, the Baton Rouge community and the entire state of Louisiana incredibly proud."

In addition to his reputation for developing hitters, Johnson is also considered one of the top recruiters in college baseball. His

impact at LSU was immediate, as Perfect Game ranked the Tigers' November 2021 signing class No. 1 in the nation. Perfect Game, Collegiate Baseball and Baseball America in the fall of 2022 named LSU's combined class of incoming signees and transfers the best in America, signaling tremendous optimism for the Tigers' 2023 season.

The 2022 LSU squad posted a 40-22 mark under Johnson's direction and advanced to the final round of the NCAA Hattiesburg Regional. The Tigers finished 17-13 in the SEC and placed fourth in the league, marking LSU's first Top 4 conference finish since 2017.

The '22 Tigers were led by centerfielder Dylan Crews, who was voted a consensus first-team All-American and the Southeastern Conference Co-Player of the Year. Crews, who is projected to be the No. 1 overall pick in the 2023 MLB Draft, become the first LSU Tiger to earn SEC Player of the Year honors since outfielder Raph Rhymes in 2012.

Johnson also developed LSU third baseman Jacob Berry, the sixth overall pick – and the first college player selected – in



# **Head Coach**

When he was hired by Arizona after the 2015 season, Johnson took the reins of a program with a rich tradition and instantly made it richer. In 2016, he became the fifth coach ever - and the first since 1994 - to lead his team to the College World Series finals in his first season. That team slugged its way to Omaha, finishing fifth nationally in hits and leading the conference in walks, doubles, hits, runs, and stolen bases.

Prior to his success at Arizona. Johnson spent two seasons as head coach at Nevada. earning Mountain West Coach of the Year honors in 2015 after leading the Wolfpack to their first-ever conference championship.

Johnson spent 2006 to 2013 as the associate head coach at the University of San Diego, where he spearheaded recruiting efforts and served as the hitting coach. There, Johnson helped sign the nation's No. 1 class in 2008 and No. 2 class in 2010, and USD's lineups topped

Johnson's coaching career began at his alma mater, Point Loma Nazarene, where he served as an assistant coach from 2002 to 2004 before accepting the head coaching position in 2005 at 27 years old. He finished his playing career at Point Loma in 2001, hitting .326 as a senior and earning a Gold Glove as the team's starting second baseman.

the WCC in hitting six times. At USD, Johnson

recruited and coached Kris Bryant, who won

the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser

Award as the nation's top player before the Cubs

selected him No. 2 overall in the 2013 MLB Draft.

A native of Oroville, Calif., Johnson becomes the 26th head coach in LSU baseball history, succeeding Paul Mainieri, who retired after the 2021 season. Johnson and his wife Maureen, a former University of Arizona soccer player, were married in 2016.

the 2022 MLB Draft by the Miami Marlins; and second baseman Cade Doughty, the secondround choice of the Toronto Blue Javs.

Johnson's first season at LSU featured tremendous SEC road series victories at eighth-ranked Florida; at Mississippi State, the 2021 College World Series champion; and at Vanderbilt, the 2021 CWS runners-up.

The '22 Tigers were one of the top offensive teams in the nation, finishing in the Top 3 in the SEC in runs scored (No. 2 - 503), slugging percentage (No. 2 - .516), total bases (No. 2 -1100); on-base percentage (No. 2 - .404), RBI (No. 2 - 477), home runs (No. 3 -114), batting average (No. 3 - .289) and hit-by-pitch (No. 1 - 125).

The architect of college baseball's best offense in 2021, Johnson led Arizona to two College World Series appearances - including a Championship Series berth in 2016 - over five full seasons.

After landing college baseball's No. 4 recruiting class in the fall, Johnson's 2021 Wildcats smashed their way to Omaha in the spring, leading the nation in hits and ranking first in the Pac-12 in runs, hits, doubles, triples, RBI, walks, batting average, on base percentage, slugging percentage, total bases, and extra base hits.

Overall, Johnson's Wildcat teams finished first in the Pac-12 in hits, runs, and on base percentage in four of his five full seasons, while leading the league in slugging percentage, on base percentage, runs per game, and batting average in three seasons. And in each of his final two full seasons, the Wildcats topped the league in hits, walks, runs, runs per game, slugging percentage, on base percentage, and batting average.
