GAME NOTES

General

1. Saturday's game officially marked the end of a 32-year streak (1992-2023) between LSU and Auburn as the teams are not scheduled to face each other in the 2024 season.
 - a. With the win, LSU now holds a 33-24-1 advantage in the series that dates back to 1901
2. Against Arkansas in week 4, Daniels became just the 6th player in FBS history to pass for 10,000 yards and rush for 4,000 yards in a career when he went over the 10,000 passing yard mark vs. the Razorbacks.
 - a. In his 50-game career, Daniels has thrown for 11,231 yards and rushed for 2,663.
3. All 5 starters on LSU's offensive line have at least 17 career starts to their credit with C Charles Turner leading the way with 21. He's followed by LT Will Campbell (20), RG Miles Frazier (20), RT Emery Jones Jr. (19) and LG Garrett Dellinger (17). The group has combined for 97 career starts.
4. LSU has now won 8 straight night game wins in Tiger Stadium. LSU is 3-0 in night games in Tiger Stadium this year (Grambling, Arkansas, Auburn) and the Tigers won all 4 of their night games in 2022.
 - a. Brian Kelly is 7-0 in night games at Tiger Stadium.
 - a. In the last 7 games, Daniels has thrown 21 TD passes and run for 4 scores.
5. LSU has scored 48+ in 3-straight games for the second time in the SEC era (since 1933).
6. LSU has also amassed 500+ yards in 6-straight games, a 1st in program history.
7. LSU's 48-18 victory is the second-largest margin of victory over Auburn in series history. LSU won, 45-10, in 2011.

Offense

1. QB Jayden Daniels finished the game with 325 yards. That performance helped him surpass 5,000 career passing yards at LSU. Daniels also passed for 3 touchdowns and rushed for 93 yards.
2. LSU TE Mason Taylor tied for No. 5 in LSU history for career receptions by a tight end on the first play from scrimmage when Daniels connected with Taylor on a 9-yard pass.
 - a. Through 20 games at LSU, Taylor matched former LSU TE Brad Boyd's 56 total receptions.
 - b. After adding another reception in the game, Taylor now ranks No. 5 for career receptions by a TE at LSU. Richard Dickson holds the LSU record with 90 career receptions.
3. Daniels and WR Malik Nabers connected on the fourth play from scrimmage for LSU, scoring on a 29-yard pass to take a 7-0 lead over Auburn in the first quarter.
4. RB John Emery broke the plain of the goal line on a 1-yard TD run to pad LSU's lead to 17-0. Emery finished the game with 42 rushing yards, which was enough to help him elapse 1,000 career rushing yards for his LSU career.

It was his first rushing TD of the season and his first since scoring vs. Purdue in the Cheez-It Citrus Bowl at the conclusion of the 2022 season.
5. Daniels hit WR Kyren Lacy on a 25-yard TD strike to extend LSU's lead to 27-10 with 8 minutes remaining in the third quarter.
 - a. His second TD pass of the game marked the 38th time Daniels has thrown for a touchdown. He holds sole possession of No. 5 on the all-time LSU list, surpassing Matt Mauck's 37 career TD passes.
 - b. With a 57-yard catch-and-run on the next drive, it was Lacy's career-long.

C. Lacy finished the game with 111 receiving yards and a score. That is Lacy's first career game with 100+ receiving yards.

6. Daniels found RB Josh Williams in the flat and Williams ran it in for the score, giving LSU a 34-10 advantage over Auburn in the third quarter.

a. Daniels' third TD pass of the night was the 39th of his LSU career.

7. Diggs and Williams each added another touchdown of their own down the stretch as LSU pulled away, 48-18.

Defense

1. DB Zy Alexander led the team in tackles with 9, tying his career-high. He also added 2 pass breakups.

2. DT Mekhi Wingo and LB Harold Perkins Jr. each added a sack.

3. True freshman safety Kylin Jackson saw his first action as a Tiger on kickoff coverage.

Special Teams

1. PK Damian Ramos went 2-for-2 on field goals and was a perfect 6-6 on PATs in the game.

2. Ramos hit a 30-yard FG in the first quarter to give LSU a 10-0 lead with 6:39 remaining.

3. With 10:21 remaining in the first half, Ramos put a 35-yard FG through the uprights to make LSU's lead 20-7

4. RB Kaleb Jackson returned a kickoff for 64 yards, which marks the longest by a Tiger since Trey Palmer's 93-yard KOR for a TD vs. South Carolina (10/24/2020).
