## **GAME NOTES**

#### General

- 1. Saturday's game marked the first-ever meeting between LSU and Georgia State. 2. LSU has won 15 straight and 64 of its last 65 games against non-conference opponents in Tiger Stadium. LSU head coach Brian Kelly is 6-0 in non-conference games in Tiger Stadium since taking over the program in 2022.
- 2. LSU has won 12 straight night games in Tiger Stadium and is 6-0 in night games in Tiger Stadium this year (Grambling, Arkansas, Auburn, Army, Florida and Georgia State) and the Tigers won all 4 of their night games in 2022.
- a. LSU head coach Brian Kelly is 10-0 in night games at Tiger Stadium 3. Daniels is the only player in NCAA FBS history to have 12,000 passing yards and 3,000 rushing yards in a career.
  - a. In 54 career games, Daniels has thrown for 12,514 yards and rushed for 3,187 yards.
- 5. QB Jayden Daniels has rushed and passed for a TD in the same game 13 times during his 25-game LSU career. The Tigers are 11-2 when Daniels rushes and passes for a TD in the same game.
- 6. LSU has now featured a 100-yard receiver in 10 straight games. Malik Nabers (140 yards), Brian Thomas Jr. (103 yards) and Kyren Lacy (101 yards) kept the streak going.
  - a. The Tigers had three 100-yard receivers for the second time in program, history (2019 vs. Texas).
    - i. Nabers is tied with Justin Jefferson (2019) with eight 100-yard receiving games in a season, the third most in program history.
- 7. The Tigers have now scored on their opening possessions of both the first and second halves in five straight games dating back to the Auburn game.
- 8. Daniels became the 11th player in FBS history to throw for 3,000+ yards and rush for 1,000+ yards in the same season. He has thrown for 3,577 yards and run for 1,014 yards this season.

#### Offense

- 1. QB Jayden Daniels finished the game with xxx passing yards and 6 passing TDs while adding 96 rushing yards and 2 TDs on the ground as he continues his Heisman campaign.
- a. Daniels' 8 total TDs tied LSU QB Joe Burrow for the most in a single game. 2. LSU capped off its opening 75-yard drive with a touchdown as Daniels found WR Malik Nabers on an 18-yard strike to tie the game 7-7 with 9:30 remaining in the first quarter.
  - a. On the TD reception, Nabers went over 1300 receiving yards for the 2023 season, becoming 4th player in program history to do so.
- 3. On the next drive, Daniels rushed for a 14-yard TD as LSU extended its lead to 14-7 as the first quarter came to a close.
  - a. Daniels now has 22 career games with 1 TD rushing and 1 TD passing, which ties Oregon QB Bo Nix for active players.
- 4. WR Kyren Lacy caught a 27-yard TD from Daniels with 10 minutes remaining in the first half as LSU went up 21-14.
- 5. WR Brian Thomas Jr. outran the defender and caught a 70-yard TD strike from Daniels as LSU extended the lead to 28-14 with 2:26 left in the half.
- 6. Daniels connected with Lacy again on a 13-yard TD to put LSU up 35-14 heading into the half.

- 7. Freshman TE Mac Markway caught a 3-yard pass from Dabiels as LSU extended the lead to 42-14 with 11 minutes left in the third quarter. It was the first TD of Markway's collegiate career.
- 8. Daniels snuck in for another TD from the one-yard line as LSU went up 49-14 with 14:44 remaining in the game.
  - a. It was Daniels' 7th TD responsible for on the night, which is the second-most by a Tiger in a single game (Joe Burrow vs. Oklahoma in 2019 CFP Semifinal).
  - b. Daniels is the first player in school history with 6 passing TDs and 2 rushing TDs in one game.
- 9. Daniels connected with Nabers on a 40-yard TD pass as LSU led 56-14 with 8:59 left in the game.

#### **Defense**

- 1. LB Omar Speights had a team-high 10 tackles. Freshman DB Ashton Stamps added 8 tackles of his own for the game.
- 2. LB Ovie Oghoufo, DE Maason Smith, DT Jacobian Guillory and DE Sai'vion Jones each recorded 0.5 sacks.
