2nd Year at LSU · 9th Year as a Head Coach

LSU Men's Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

And even though the first season proved difficult as Coach McMahon and staff had to rebuild a roster completely from scratch in less than 45 days, the characteristics of a Matt McMahon program were there for people to clearly see.

Now as the LSU Basketball program begins its second season, Coach McMahon under the cornerstone of those core values has welcomed in an older, more experienced group of players who not only understand the fundamentals of the game, but also the culture of the environment with many having lived and played in around the Baton Rouge/LSU area.

LSU, Coach McMahon and staff laid a new foundation a year ago and now has many of the tools needed to build on that foundation.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67, a .697 winning percentage. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022 (the 2020 appearance was canceled by the pandemic).

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

Williams and his successfully play translated to the Southeastern Conference where he earned All-SEC honors in a super senior year when he became at the time in January 2023 the 123rd player in Division I college basketball to amass 2,000 career points and 1,000 rebounds.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the

sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3). The Racers were ranked No. 20 in the final AP poll and No. 22 in the Ferris Mowers Coaches Poll.

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season championships (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game by defeating No. 5 seed Marquette.

That season, Morant named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team all-America honors from the USBWA.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

In 2017-18, McMahon's team won 26 games and the OVC regular season and tournament championship, sending the Racers to what was at that time the school's 16th NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio Valley Conference championships, a CollegeInsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

In 2014-15, MSU became the first team in school history to go undefeated in the OVC at 16-0 and set a league record with a 25-game win streak that was second best in the nation. Three seasons earlier, McMahon was named to the list of best

assistant coaches by FoxSports.com and CollegeInsider.com.

In his first season as an assistant at Murray State, the team was 31-2 and earned a No. 6 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 90 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 124 three-pointers, graduating in 2000 with a bachelor's in marketing.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as a student assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a student coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

SOMETHING TO NOTICE

There is always it seems a lot of talk in modern college basketball about the transfer portal, but it has been high school signees of the Matt McMahon era from 2022 and 2023 that have helped this Tiger team in recent wins.

Jalen Reed and Tyrell Ward, now sophomore but high school signees prior to the 2022-23 season, and Mike Williams III, high school signee prior to this 2023-24 season, have provided valuable moments for this team in the first six games.

Reed, who started at the beginning of the 2022-23 season, has returned after a summer of players development with a new confidence and an ability to do several different things to help his team.

After just one double figure game a year ago, Reed has recorded three double figure scoring games, including back-to-back career numbers of 14 against Nicholls (11/10) and 16 against Dayton (11/16).

But his versatility this year was shown in the last game against North Florida (11/24). Although only scoring two points, he had a career high nine rebounds and five assists to go with two blocks in 24 minutes of play.

Reed now has six blocks in the last two games. For the season, he is averaging 9.2 points and 5.3 rebounds along with 2.0 assists per game.

Ward came on at the end of his freshman season in 2023 and has come off the bench in all six games this season, averaging 21 minutes a game. He has had three double figure games this season and played 28 minutes in the Wake Forest win, putting together a five-point run in overtime after Wake Forest took a brief lead after a minute of play in the extra season.

Ward had his season high of 14 against North Florida (11/24), hitting 4-of-5 field goals with two treys. He had a big three after LSU's lead dropped to just nine points that put the Tigers back on the right track.

Ward is averaging 9.7 points, 2.8 rebounds, 1.0 assists per game and has hit nine three-pointers this season.

For true freshman Mike Williams III, the point guard position fell his way while the Jalen Cook situation continues to play itself out.

Williams against North Florida had his first double digit collegiate scoring game with 11 points, hitting 4-of-6 field goals and all three free throw attempts.

Williams had six steals in the North Florida game, his second game of four steals or more this season. It is the most steals by an LSU freshman in a game since Tiger Tremont Waters had eight steals in a game against Texas A&M in January 2018 in his 2017-18 season.

Williams is averaging 6.7 points per game, 1.5 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 2.5 steals a game.

In the last two contests, Williams is 7-of-14 from the field.

BUT LET'S NOT FORGET THOSE TRANSFER PORTAL TYPES

In the analysis of this team to date, you can't forget especially a couple of graduate transfers -- Will Baker from Nevada and Jordan Wright of Vanderbilt. They are part of three transfer portal/grad transfers that are part of the present LSU starting lineup.

Baker, played the 2019-20 season in Texas, and then Nevada in 2021-22 and 2022-23 before graduating and then moving to LSU for this season. So far this season, Baker has had five games in double figures (including the last four) with two games over 20 points – a career high 29 versus Mississippi Valley and 23 against Wake Forest. Baker has hit 36-of-63 from the field (57.1%) and 5-of-10 treys. He is also 21-of-24 from the free throw line. Baker is averaging a team best 16.3 points and 6.5 rebounds a game. Wright, who played at Vanderbilt the last four seasons, has scored in double figures five times, including the last three games. Wright has had season highs of 15 points the last two games. He has averaged 28.8 minutes per game and is averaging 11.5 points per game, 5.2 rebounds, 2.0 assists per game and 2.2 steals per game. Wright, the 2022 SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year, has hit two three pointers each of the last three games. Stewart, like Wright, played at the Dunham School in Baton Rouge and transferred after two years at Santa Clara. Stewart has had a game of nine points and two games of eight as he looks to find his shooting touch. He is averaging 5.5 points in the early going.

TONIGHT'S OPPONENT

Syracuse and LSU will meet for the first time since February 1985 when the two teams met at the then Carrier Dome with Syracuse winning, 76-64. Of course, since then the Carrier Dome has been renamed to the JMA Wireless Dome. The last LSU team in the Dome was the Tigers football team in 2017, winning over Syracuse, 35-26. The Orange is 4-2 on the season, coming off a 1-2 swing in Honolulu, at the Maui Invitational. Syracuse lost to Tennessee, 73-56; and, Gonzaga, 76-57, before defeating Chamaine, 105-56. In current statistics, Judah Mintz leads the Orange with 18.3 points per game, while Chris Bell comes in at 13.7 and JJ Starling at 12.7 points. Syracuse averages 78.17 points per game. Adrian Autry is in his first season as the head coach. He is a former Syracuse player and longtime assistant coach.

THE ACC/SEC CHALLENGE

It was the SEC and the Big East, then the SEC and Big 12 and now the SEC and the ACC and this one has the official designation of being men and women in the same general time period. LSU is at Syracuse on Tuesday in a men's game and the LSU women's team hosts Virginia Tech on Thursday in Baton Rouge. In nine of these so-called challenge games since 2007, the Tigers have won four and lost six:

Against the present members of the ACC, LSU has a record of 40-57.

ON THE ROAD

This will be the first true road game of the season for the Tigers and LSU will be looking for its first win on a road court since winning in Gainesville against Texas A&M on Feb. 8, 2022. That spans 12 road games, including all nine road games in the 2022-23 season. LSU has a 443-666 all-time road record (39.9 percent). LSU's last win in a November-December game on an opponent's home court was actually on Dec. 28, 2017 at Memphis.

RECAP: Tigers were able to shut down UNF's prolific three-point shooting in the first 27 minutes and made 11-of-23 first half field goals in building a 36-18 halftime advantage and a 30-point lead with 13:56 to play ... But the Ospreys were able to get its offense, which was shooting 25 percent for the game through 27 minutes and was 3-of-21 from deep, going, making eight second half three pointers to cut the LSU lead to nine at the final media timeout before LSU scored five straight to virtually clinch the win. Will Baker had another strong game with 18 points (including 8-of-10 at the line) with eight rebounds, while Jordan Wright had 15 points, Tyrell Ward 14 and Mike Williams 11 points and six steals. Jalen Reed only scored two points but grabbed nine boards and dished out five assists.

RECAP: For the second straight game, a three-pointer made in the final five seconds doomed LSU in the opening round game of the Charleston Classic ... Dayton broke a tie with 4.1 seconds to play and an attempt to tie by LSU fell short ... It marked the first time in 19 games that LSU lost when shooting 50 percent or better from the floor ... The game featured seven ties and 14 lead changes, with most of that in the first half which LSU led, 32-30 ... The Tigers scored the first eight points of the second half to go up by 10, and would lead by 15, 60-45, with 9:07 to play. But Dayton got its offense going and the Tigers were unable to sustain the momentum, outscoring LSU, 19-2, to take a 64-62 lead with 3:42 to play. But LSU rebounded and got the lead back to 67-64 with 1:25 to play before Dayton hit two different three-pointers in the final 50 seconds to win the game.

Jalen Reed had his career high for the second straight game to lead LSU with 16 points on 7-of-9 shooting. Tyrell Ward finished with 12, including three treys, and Will Baker added 10 points and eight rebounds. LSU shot 53.1 percent overall (26-of-49) and 7-of-16 from the arc. Dayton made 22-of-56 overall and 11-of-34 from distance. Dayton out rebounded LSU, 35-28, including 14-4 on the offensive end, leading to a 10-4 advantage in second chance points.

LOUISIANA INFLUENCE RETURNS

After a year away, the logo and phrase "Boot Up" has truly returned to the LSU Basketball program as five players have Southeast Louisiana ties to the program in 2023-24.

Carlos Stewart is from Baton Rouge and Jordan Wright is from Waggaman. Both played for The Dunham School in Baton Rouge. Stewart transferred from Santa Clara and Wright from Vanderbilt.

Jalen Cook played for LSU in the 2020-21 season and returns to Baton Rouge after two seasons at Tulane. He is from Walker. Hunter Dean is from Mandeville and came to LSU from George Washington.

Freshman Corey Chest hails from New Orleans where he played three years of high school before finishing up last year at The Link Academy in Missouri. It is the most since there were eight players from Louisiana on the 2017-18 roster.

KENPOM RATES LSU EXPERIENCE HIGHER THIS YEAR

For the last several years, Kenpom.com had LSU's experience rating deep in the 300s of the 360-plus Division I teams. But this year the experience is listed at 2.22 years which is listed as 90th in the rankings. The DI average this year is 1.81. Eight SEC teams are listed with more experience than LSU in the Kenpom rankings – Missouri (3.05, 9); South Carolina (2.94, 13); Tennessee (2.80, 20); Arkansas (2.68, 31); Texas A&M (2.61, 39); Mississippi (2.56, 46); Mississippi State (2.30, 82); Alabama (2.30 82).

This is one of the older rosters in recent LSU basketball history with 11 players who are at least in their third year of college basketball. Three players – Jordan Wright (Vanderbilt), Will Baker (Nevada), Hunter Dean (George Washington) – are grad transfers, while Trae Hannibal is a fifth-year senior thanks to the pandemic season of 2020.

BUT A STATISTICAL NOTE ABOUT THEIR BIRTHDATES

The 2023-24 edition of the Tigers marks the first year that every player on the roster was born in 2000 or later. Only Graduates Jordan Wright and Will Baker were born in 2000.

STILL WAITING ON NCAA APPEAL

As of the start of the week, Jalen Cook remained unable to play after his request for a transfer waiver was denied by the NCAA. Cook played at LSU during the 2020-21 season before transferring to Tulane for the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons. LSU and Cook is appealing the decision as the Walker, Louisiana product looks to come back to his original school. He is one of many still awaiting final decision from the NCAA regarding his transfer situation. Cook has been with the team and has continued to practice with the squad while awaiting a decision.

SOME NUMBERS AFTER SIX GAMES

The Tigers have improved in some categories early in the season compared to last season. LSU inside the arc in 2023-24 is hitting at 47.4 percent, compared to 41.0 percent. On the defensive side this year, the teams are holding opponents to 42.0 percent this year compared to last year when opponents made over 50 percent of their shots inside the arc (52.1%). LSU is 20th in the country in two-point defensive FG percentage. As a point of LSU success inside the arc, LSU is averaging 34.0 points in the paint a game (204 for six games), compared to 20.0 for opponents (120 total). LSU has only had below 30 points in the paint in the second game of the season against Nicholls (11/10) with 28. LSU is averaging double figure steals early on in the season and is 10th in the country at 10.3 takeaways a game. Last year, the Tigers averaged just 6.8 steals a game.

MORE ON STEALS

We've already discussed Mike Williams' six steals from the game the other night, but LSU's 10.3 steals average wasn't built on just a one-game big number. LSU has four games of double figure steals in the first six games:

- Mississippi Valley (11/6) – 12
- Nicholls (11/10) – 11
- Wake Forest (11/19) – 13
- North Florida (11/24) – 10

In the other two games, the Tigers had eight each against Dayton and North Texas. Williams (15) and Jordan Wright (13) have double digit steals and both are averaging over two steals a game. Williams is at 2.5 a contest, with Wright at 2.2.

SHOOTING THE THREE

The Tigers did not make a lot of threes in Charleston but shot a decent percentage of 38.3 percent (18-of-47) in the three games. LSU for the season is 39-of-106 or 36.8 percent, an average of 6.5 a game. LSU has had one game with double figure threes – in the Nov. 6 opener against Mississippi Valley State (14). However, opponents have had great success from the arc, although North Florida didn't get to their average of 11 a game until they made eight in the last 13 minutes of Friday's contest. Besides the 11 by North Florida, North Texas (11/17) and Nicholls (11/10) both made 12 three-pointers. For the season, the opponents have made 60-of-169 attempts or 35.5 percent. Opponents have made 21 more treys from 63 more attempts than LSU. Opponents are averaging 10 a game. As far as the Tigers individually, Tyrell Ward has nine treys, Jordan Wright eight and Will Baker and Carlos Stewart five each. Last year, LSU averaged 7.2 threes over 33 games.

BUT ON THE OTHER HAND, LSU GETTING TO THE FREE THROW LINE

LSU has been able to get to the line in the first six games, making 111-of-153 or 72.5 percent. That includes 25-of-32 on Friday against North Florida. LSU has made 36 more free throws and has attempted 51 more tosses.

LSU has made nine more free throws than opponents have attempted. The Tigers have attempted an average of 18.5 free throws a game, up from last year's 13.8 a contest. Mike Williams is 10-of-11 for 90.9 percent, while Will Baker has made 21-of-24 (87.5%), Jordan Wright has made 19 (19-26, 73.1%), Jalen Reed 18 (18-25, 72.0%); and, Tyrell Ward 17 (17-25, 68.0%).

DEREK FOUNTAIN AGAIN HELPING LSU

When Derek Fountain came to LSU prior to the 2022-23 season after two years at Mississippi State, he had averaged 5.4 points as a freshman in 19 games and then 1.8 points in 25 games. But LSU jump started his career and he became a vital part of the offense in Matt McMahon's first year, starting 23-of-31 games and averaging 8.0 points and 23.5 minutes per game. While he is coming off the bench through the first six games, he was a major factor in the win over North Texas (Nov. 17), hitting all six field goal attempts, including a three-pointer in scoring 14 points while grabbing a team high seven boards in 24 minutes. In the three Charleston games, he averaged 8.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in 20.7 minutes per game. Fountain overall through six games, is averaging 6.5 points and 4.2 rebounds, making 13-of-21 field goal attempts (61.9%).

TAE HANNIBAL CONTINUES TO BE PART OF OFFENSE

Hannibal is the backup point guard for LSU, a spot he found himself in a year ago for the Tiger. The fifth-year senior is known as an aggressive up-tempo guard that loves to drive to the goal. So far this season, he is averaging 3.8 points a game, making 10-of-14 field goal attempts. He is averaging 2.2 rebounds and 1.6 assists per game.

MWANI WILKINSON FULLY HEALTHY IN 2023-24

He's almost a survivor and a rarity in college basketball – a player who has stayed at the same school for all four years. After entering the transfer portal after his sophomore season, he decided to stay at LSU and play for Coach Matt McMahon. Unfortunately, his junior year was slowed by a preseason shoulder injury that he tried to play through, but after 12 games required surgery. But Wilkinson is healthy and worked hard in the off-season to get his game back in shape. So far in six games, he is averaging 12.2 minutes a game, 2.7 points and 1.3 rebounds. He has made 4-of-12 three-pointers this season. For his career, he has played in 79 games with 53 starts and made 39-of-97 three-point attempts (40.2 percent).

FOUR STAR SIGNEES INKED

LSU received the national letter of intent papers from two four-star signees for the 2024-25 season on national signing day. The signees are 6-11 forward Robert Miller III of Houston's Pasadena Memorial High School and 6-3 guard Curtis Givens III of Memphis, Tennessee, who attends Monteverde Academy in Florida. Miller III was ranked No. 40 by On3 and No. 49 nationally by 247sports and the No. 2 recruit in the state of Texas. Miller is the son of former LSU football defensive lineman Robert Miller II. His mother Teana (McKiver) Miller played basketball for Tulane and in the WNBA. As a junior at Pasadena Memorial, Miller III averaged 19.7 points, 13.4 rebounds and 5.4 blocks per game. This past summer, Miller III was invited to the 2023 NBPA Top 100 Camp at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex in Orlando, Florida. The camp features some of the best high school basketball players from around the country and provides comprehensive on and off the court programming to maximize a player's potential. He also attended the Pangos All-American Camp in both 2022 and 2023. Givens III is ranked No. 33 by ON3 nationally and number four among point guards, while ESPN's recruiting rankings has Givens III ranked at number 48. Givens III has had great success on the AAU and EYBL circuit, playing for Moka Elite in Missouri. He had games of 18 points, 4 assists; 21 points; and, 23 points and 5 asts and in the Peach Jam had games of 16 points-4 assists and, 13 points-8 rebounds. In session one on the EYBL circuit, he averaged 18.8 points a contest. He also was invited to the NBPA Top 100 camp for top high school prospects. The camp features some of the best high school basketball players from around the country and provides comprehensive on and off the court programming to maximize a player's potential.

GOOD NBA SEASON SO FAR FOR FORMER TIGERS

There are a total of nine former LSU players on the rosters of six LSU teams this season, the most Tigers on NBA rosters in many a year. Leading that group is veteran player Garrett Temple, in his first season with the Toronto Raptors, and in his 14th season in the NBA. Temple through Sunday, has played 721 games, fourth most among former LSU players in the NBA. Shaquille O'Neal played 1,207 games, Bob Pettit 792 and Brandon Bass 758. It is possible that Temple could pass Bass to move into third place before the end of the season. Brooklyn has three LSU players -- Ben Simmons, Cam Thomas and Trendon Watford. Simmons was the No. 1 player in the 2016 NBA Draft at that time by Philadelphia. Thomas has had five games of 30 or more points this season, including a 45 point efforts against Milwaukee on Nov. 6. The third-year first-round draft pick is averaging over 26 points a game for the Nets. Houston has Tari Eason in his second season with the Rockets, while Minnesota's Naz Reid, who went undrafted, but after his 2019 summer league performance has now signed a new deal with the Timberwolves. Portland has center Duop Reather and Skylar Mays, who recently had his two-way contract converted to a rest-of-season contract with the team; and, Javonte Smart is on a two-way contract with Philadelphia.

BACK HOME FOR TWO GAMES BEFORE AND AFTER SEMESTER EXAMS

LSU will go into semester exams on Monday and before that the Tigers will host Southeastern at 7 p.m. Friday night at the Maravich Center. The game will be streamed on the SECN+.
