2nd Year at LSU · 9th Year as a Head Coach

LSU Men's Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

And even though the first season proved difficult as Coach McMahon and staff had to rebuild a roster completely from scratch in less than 45 days, the characteristics of a Matt McMahon program were there for people to clearly see.

Now as the LSU Basketball program begins its second season, Coach McMahon under the cornerstone of those core values has welcomed in an older, more experienced group of players who not only understand the fundamentals of the game, but also the culture of the environment with many having lived and played in around the Baton Rouge/LSU area.

LSU, Coach McMahon and staff laid a new foundation a year ago and now has many of the tools needed to build on that foundation.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67, a .697 winning percentage. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022 (the 2020 appearance was canceled by the pandemic).

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

Williams and his successfully play translated to the Southeastern Conference where he earned All-SEC honors in a super senior year when he became at the time in January 2023 the 123rd player in Division I college basketball to amass 2,000 career points and 1,000 rebounds.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the

sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3). The Racers were ranked No. 20 in the final AP poll and No. 22 in the Ferris Mowers Coaches Poll.

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season championships (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game by defeating No. 5 seed Marquette.

That season, Morant named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team all-America honors from the USBWA.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

In 2017-18, McMahon's team won 26 games and the OVC regular season and tournament championship, sending the Racers to what was at that time the school's 16th NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio Valley Conference championships, a CollegeInsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

In 2014-15, MSU became the first team in school history to go undefeated in the OVC at 16-0 and set a league record with a 25-game win streak that was second best in the nation. Three seasons earlier, McMahon was named to the list of best

assistant coaches by FoxSports.com and CollegeInsider.com.

In his first season as an assistant at Murray State, the team was 31-2 and earned a No. 6 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 90 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 124 three-pointers, graduating in 2000 with a bachelor's in marketing.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as a student assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a student coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

FIRST VISIT BY "POWER" CONFERENCE SCHOOL IN NOVEMBER-DECEMBER SINCE 2015

Kansas State and LSU sets up the first non-conference game in the months of November-December at the Maravich Center between LSU and the so-called major/power conferences (Big 12, Big 10, Pac 12, ACC, Big East) since Dec. 28, 2015 when Wake Forest came to Baton Rouge.

The previous year LSU met Texas Tech in the Maravich Center on Nov. 18, 2014.

LSU has hosted three non-conference games on the final Saturday in January during the days of the Big 12/SEC Challenge since the 2015 game -- Jan. 30, 2016 against Oklahoma; Jan. 30, 2021 and Jan. 28, 2023 versus Texas Tech.

LSU HIGH SCHOOL SIGNINGS OF '22 and '23 STILL PROVIDING MOMENTS

Jalen Reed and Tyrell Ward represent the high school signees of Coach Matt McMahon and staff prior to his first season as head coach before the 2022-23 season and Mike Williams III is the high school signing prior to the 2023-24 season that has provided good things for this year's team of Tigers.

Here's a look at each of the three:

JALEN REED -- Reed had one of his best games of the year at Syracuse (11/28) as he recorded his first double double with 14 points (on 6-of-10 shooting) and 11 rebounds (5 offensive). He has recorded four double figure scoring games this season with a college best 16 points vs. Dayton in the Charleston Classic (11/16).

Reed, who signed with LSU prior to the 2022-23 season out of Southern California Academy, has made 9-of-14 field goals in the last two games and 27-of-48 for the season (56.3 percent) is averaging 9.6 points and 5.9 rebounds. He is averaging 1.6 assists and 2.4 blocks a game.

TYRELL WARD – Ward, who started eight games a year ago, started his first game of the season against Southeastern (12/1) and posted 11 points, 2 blocks, 2 steals for his fourth double figure game of the season. Ward had two treys in the game and for the season is 12-of-30 from distance (40.0%).

He had a high of 14 against North Florida (11/24). He has had at least two treys in all four games he has scored in double figures. Fewest points scored is six twice. He has played at least 23 minutes in each of the last four games.

Ward, from Washington D.C. found his stride in the latter stages of the 2022-23 season and has continued this season. He is averaging 9.5 points and 2.6 rebounds. Again, comparing some numbers for Ward over his two seasons:

MIKE WILLIAMS – The high school signee for the 2023-24 season has started every game this season at the point guard position, trying to grow into the position as he transfers from high school to college. The Baltimore, Maryland signee is averaging 7.1 points per game, 1.9 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 2.0 steals a game.

In his last two home games against North Florida (11/24) and Southeastern (12/1), Williams has scored 26 points combined (11 vs. North Florida, 15 vs. Southeastern). In those two games, Williams was a combined 9-of-13 from the field with six boards, 5 assists and 7 steals (6 vs. North Florida).

Through eight games, Williams is averaging 7.1 points, 1.9 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 2.0 steals a game.

ON THE GRAD TRANSFER SIDE

In the analysis of this team to date, you can't forget especially a couple of graduate transfers – Will Baker from Nevada and Jordan Wright of Vanderbilt. They are part of three grad transfers on this year's Tiger squad.

WILL BAKER -- Played the 2019-20 season in Texas, and then Nevada in 2021-22 and 2022-23 before graduating and then moving to LSU for this season. Baker had his fourth game of 16 points or more when he scored 18 against Southeastern (12/1) on 5-of-8 shooting, with a three-pointer and 7-of-9 from the free throw line. For the season, he is averaging 14.9 points and 5.8 rebounds. He is 42-of-76 from the field (55.3%), 6-of-13 from distance (46.2%) and a good 29-of-35 at the free throw line (82.9%). In three games, he had made at least seven free throws. He is averaging 26.1 minutes per game.

JORDAN WRIGHT – Wright started the first seven games this season for LSU and the Vanderbilt graduate responded with a strong 21-minute performance off the bench against Southeastern (12/1).

In the last four games, Wright has scored 15 each against Wake Forest (11/19), vs. North Florida (11/24) and at Syracuse (11/28) before scoring 16 against Southeastern (12/1). Against the Lions, Wright hit 4-of-8 field goals, including three treys and 5-of-6 at the free throw line. He also had three steals in the game.

Wright is averaging 12.3 points a game, 5.3 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 2.1 steals. He is the first Tiger this year to score double figures in five consecutive games. He has double figures in seven-of-the-first-eight games.

Wright is at 1,282 points for his 132 career games, 18 points shy of 1,300 career points.

HUNTER DEAN – Dean, a graduate from George Washington, has seen good minutes in the last two games with Daimion Collins out with a dislocated shoulder. Dean played 12 minutes at Syracuse (11/28), scoring three points and eight minutes versus Southeastern (12/1) with two points.

He is averaging 6.7 minutes a game, 1.7 points and 1.3 rebounds.

RECAP: The Tigers carried the day at the free throw line after failing to get a FG to drop in the final 6:56 of the contest ... Southeastern closed a 15-points deficit with 15:56 to play down to three on four occasions in the final 3:30 of the game, but LSU never gave up the lead ... Despite 17 turnovers, Southeastern was only able to get 10 points off the miscues, while LSU recorded 17 points off 11 Lion turnovers ... LSU held steady at distance with both teams recording eight three-pointers.

LSU had four players in double figures with Will Baker getting 18 points and seven boards, while Jordan Wright came off the bench to hit three treys and score 16 points. Freshman Mike Williams III had his best game as a Tiger with 15 points and four assists, and Tyrell Ward, starting his first game of the year, added 11 points.

RECAP: With neither team shooting well in the opening half, LSU was able to play even with Syracuse in the inaugural challenge game between conferences, but with LSU up three with just over seven minutes to play in the first half, the Orange went on a 22-7 run that encompassed Syracuse getting a five-point halftime lead and then scoring the first five points of the second half to advance the lead to 10, a margin LSU could not overcome.

Syracuse, which made 14-of-15 first half free throws, made 8-of-13 three-pointers in the second half. LSU shot its worst three-point percentage (9.1%) since Jan. 2020, making only 2-of-22 from distance. The Tigers had 44 of their 57 points in the paint. Jalen Reed had his first collegiate double double with 14 points and 11 rebounds. Jordan Wright added 15 points (his third straight game with 15 points).

The Tigers are first in the league and 21st in the country in team steals per game at 9.8 a contest.

LSU has four games of double figure steals in the first eight games:

Mississippi Valley (11/6) – 12

Nicholls (11/10) – 11

Wake Forest (11/19) – 13

North Florida (11/24) – 10

In the other four games, the Tigers had seven versus Southeastern, eight each against Dayton and North Texas and nine against Syracuse. Last year, LSU averaged just over six steals a contest.

LSU is seventh in the country at 13.7 percent steals per possession (according to TeamRankings.com), compared to just 9.9 percent a year ago.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Kansas State comes into the game with a 7-2 record after a 72-71 overtime win over Villanova in Manhattan on Tuesday. It marked the third straight overtime game that Kansas State has played and the fourth of the season, all wins.

Arthur Kaluma led K State with 26 points, nine rebounds and four assists, while Cam Carter added 16 points. Tylor Perry, who hit the game winner in the final 10 seconds of overtime, finished with 10.

For the season, Kaluma leads the Wildcats in scoring at 16.5 points a game. Carter and Perry both average 16.4 points per game.

Jerome Tang is in his second year as the head coach of Kansas State after serving 19 years on the coaching staff at Baylor, including 2021 when Baylor won the SEC title. Last season, Tang took the Wildcats to the NCAA Elite Eight.

That game in the Cayman Islands last year was the first meeting between the schools in men's basketball. The game will be returned next year in Manhattan, Kansas.

AT THE PMAC

LSU is 3-1 at the Maravich Center in the first three home games this year ... Coach Matt McMahon is 11-2 in his time at LSU in non-conference games.

The Tigers are 616-209 all-time in the building, now in its 53rd season as the home of LSU Basketball. LSU is 326-51 in non-conference contests.

The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous use basketball arena in the league having hosted its first men's game in Jan. 1972. Memorial Coliseum in Nashville opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum in Alabama had its first game in 1968.

SHOOTING THE THREE

The three-pointer had been an issue for LSU, primarily on defense, but that became a real problem on both sides as LSU had its first percentage of less than 10 percent since January 2020 against Syracuse (11/28).

Against Mississippi State in 2020, the Tigers were 2-of-21 from distance (9.5%).

At Syracuse, the Tigers were 2-of-22 from the arc, which translates to 9.1 percent.

In its last game against Southeastern (12/1), the Tigers were even in three-pointers with their opponents at eight makes, the first time since the season opener on Nov. 6 that LSU was even or made more three-point baskets than their opponents.

For the season, the Tigers are just 49-of-151 (32.5 percent), averaging 6.1 threes a game. LSU is just 16-of-59 from the arc in the last three games (27.1%).

But defensively, LSU has not been able to stop consistently teams from shooting the ball from the arc as five of the last seven teams have hit for double digits. Opponents are 79-of-221 from the arc (35.7 percent). Opponents have made 30 more three-pointers and attempted 70 more treys. Opponents are averaging over 27 attempts a game, making 9.87 three-pointers a game.

LSU ranks 203 nationally in field goal percentage and 291 in three-point defense.

Individually for LSU, Tyrell Ward and Jordan Wright leads the team with 12 makes each. Will Baker has hit six from distance and Carlos Stewart five for 35 of LSU's 49 makes.

Last year, LSU averaged 7.2 threes over 33 games.

BUT ON THE OTHER HAND, LSU GETTING TO THE FREE THROW LINE

In six of the eight games, LSU has been able to get fouled and get to the free throw line at least 18 times. Only the Dayton game in Charleston (11/16) when LSU had 12 attempts and at Syracuse (11/28) when the Tigers had just 10 attempts was the two games outside that number, both losses.

Against Southeastern (12/1), the Tigers were 21-of-29 and now is 139-of-192 after eight games or 72.4 percent. LSU is averaging 17.4 makes a game from an average of 24.0 attempts. Those are both ranked 49th in the national rankings.

The Tigers have made almost as many free throws as opponents have attempted (108-of-141). LSU has made 31 more free throws and attempted 51 more than opponents.

Will Baker has made 29 free throws, Jordan Wright 26, Jalen Reed 22 and Tyrell Ward 20 free throws.

Baker is at 82.9 percent (29-35), while Mike Williams is 81.3 percent (13-16) and Derek Fountain (12-15) at 80.0 percent. Jordan Wright has made 26-of-34 for 76.5 percent.

SOME NUMBERS AFTER EIGHT GAMES

The Tigers have improved in some categories early in the season compared to last season. LSU inside the arc in 2023-24 is hitting at 53.8 percent, compared to 46.2 percent a season ago. On the defensive side inside the arc this year, the Tigers are holding opponents to 41.1 percent this year compared to last year when opponents made over 50 percent of their shots inside the arc (52.1%). LSU is 13th in the country in two-point defensive FG percentage.

As a point of LSU success inside the arc, LSU is averaging 34.5 points in the paint a game (276 for eight games), compared to 21.2 for opponents (170 total). LSU's low points in the paint total has been 28 twice this season. The Tigers had 44 of their 57 points in the paint against Syracuse (11/28).

LOUISIANA INFLUENCE RETURNS

After a year away, the logo and phrase "Boot Up" has truly returned to the LSU Basketball program as five players have Southeast Louisiana ties to the program in 2023-24.

Carlos Stewart is from Baton Rouge and Jordan Wright is from Waggaman. Both played for The Dunham School in Baton Rouge. Stewart transferred from Santa Clara and Wright from Vanderbilt.

Jalen Cook played for LSU in the 2020-21 season and returns to Baton Rouge after two seasons at Tulane. He is from Walker. Hunter Dean is from Mandeville and came to LSU from George Washington.

Freshman Corey Chest hails from New Orleans where he played three years of high school before finishing up last year at The Link Academy in Missouri.

It is the most since there were eight players from Louisiana on the 2017-18 roster.

KENPOM RATES LSU EXPERIENCE HIGHER THIS YEAR

For the last several years, Kenpom.com had LSU's experience rating deep in the 300s of the 360-plus Division I teams.

But this year the experience is listed at 2.20 years which is listed as 95th in the rankings. The DI average this year is 1.81.

This is one of the older rosters in recent LSU basketball history with 11 players who are at least in their third year of college basketball.

Three players – Jordan Wright (Vanderbilt), Will Baker (Nevada), Hunter Dean (George Washington) – are grad transfers, while Trae Hannibal is a fifth-year senior thanks to the pandemic season of 2020.

BUT A STATISTICAL NOTE ABOUT THEIR BIRTHDATES

The 2023-24 edition of the Tigers marks the first year that every player on the roster was born in 2000 or later. Only Graduates Jordan Wright and Will Baker were born in 2000.

STILL WAITING ON NCAA APPEAL

As of the start of the week, Jalen Cook remained unable to play after his request for a transfer waiver was denied by the NCAA. Cook played at LSU during the 2020-21 season before transferring to Tulane for the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.

LSU and Cook is appealing the decision as the Walker, Louisiana product looks to come back to his original school. He is one of many still awaiting final decision from the NCAA regarding his transfer situation.

Cook has been with the team and has continued to practice with the squad while awaiting a decision.

Last Friday after the Southeastern game, Coach Matt McMahon said the following during the postgame: "For Jalen Cook we're still waiting. He meets all the criteria and we're certainly hoping for good news on his appeal. I don't know what the holdup is."

DEREK FOUNTAIN AGAIN HELPING LSU

When Derek Fountain came to LSU prior to the 2022-23 season after two years at Mississippi State, he had averaged 5.4 points as a freshman in 19 games and then 1.8 points in 25 games. But LSU jump started his career and he became a vital part of the offense in Matt McMahon's first year, starting 23-of-31 games and averaging 8.0 points and 23.5 minutes per game.

While he is coming off the bench through the first eight games, he was a major factor in the win over North Texas (Nov. 17), hitting all six field goal attempts, including a three-pointer in scoring 14 points while grabbing a team high seven boards in 24 minutes. In the three Charleston games, he averaged 8.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in 20.7 minutes per game.

Fountain overall is averaging 5.8 points and 4.1 rebounds, making 16-of-25 field goal attempts (64.0%).

TRAE HANNIBAL CONTINUES TO BE PART OF OFFENSE

Hannibal is the backup point guard for LSU, a spot he found himself in a year ago for the Tiger. The fifth-year senior is known as an aggressive up-tempo guard that loves to drive to the goal.

So far this season, he is averaging 3.8 points a game, making 13-of-19 field goal attempts. He is averaging 2.1 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game.

He has struggled the last two games battling a dislocated finger suffered in the North Florida game (11/24).

Hannibal had his season high of seven points at Syracuse (11/28) with three assists. He has scored in every game but the North Florida contest (11/24).

MWANI WILKINSON GETS FIRST START OF SEASON VERSUS SOUTHEASTERN

For the first time this season and for the 54th time in his four years at LSU, Mwani Wilkinson got the starting nod against Southeastern (12/1). He played 18 minutes in the game with three rebounds.

He's almost a survivor and a rarity in college basketball – a player who has stayed at the same school for all four years. After entering the transfer portal after his sophomore season, he decided to stay at LSU and play for Coach Matt McMahon. Unfortunately, his junior year was slowed by a preseason shoulder injury that he tried to play through, but after 12 games required surgery.

But Wilkinson is healthy and worked hard in the off-season to get his game back in shape. So far, he is averaging 12.5 minutes a game, 2.0 points and 1.4 rebounds.

Wilkinson is looking to break out a mini slump, having gone 0-of-8 from distance the last three games.

DAIMION COLLINS

Daimion Collins was playing well against North Florida (11/24), having scored nine points and grabbed four rebounds on 4-of-6 shooting in 13 minutes before he dislocated his right shoulder in the second half. He has missed the last two games and is questionable early in the week for the contest.

He had played just a combined three minutes in games against Dayton and Wake Forest with a DNP against North Texas in the three games in Charleston prior to the North Florida game.

His season best was 11 points in the opener against Mississippi Valley (11/6) in the opener. He is averaging 4.8 points and 2.2 rebounds.

CARLOS STEWART

The Baton Rouge product started the first seven games before coming off the bench to play 17 minutes against Southeastern (12/1). He is averaging 4.4 points and 3.3 rebounds a game, averaging 22.2 minutes per game.

FOUR STAR SIGNEES INKED

LSU received the national letter of intent papers from two four-star signees for the 2024-25 season on national signing day.

The signees are 6-11 forward **Robert Miller III** of Houston's Pasadena Memorial High School and 6-3 guard **Curtis Givens III** of Memphis, Tennessee, who attends Monteverde Academy in Florida.

Miller III was ranked No. 40 by On3 and No. 49 nationally by 247sports and the No. 2 recruit in the state of Texas.

Miller is the son of former LSU football defensive lineman Robert Miller II. His mother Teana (McKiver) Miller played basketball for Tulane and in the WNBA. As a junior at Pasadena Memorial, Miller III averaged 19.7 points, 13.4 rebounds and 5.4 blocks per game.

This past summer, Miller III was invited to the 2023 NBPA Top 100 Camp at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex in Orlando, Florida. The camp features some of the best high school basketball players from around the country and provides comprehensive on and off the court programming to maximize a player's potential. He also attended the Pangos All-American Camp in both 2022 and 2023.
