2nd Year at LSU · 9th Year as a Head Coach

LSU Men's Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

**Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.**

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

And even though the first season proved difficult as Coach McMahon and staff had to rebuild a roster completely from scratch in less than 45 days, the characteristics of a Matt McMahon program were there for people to clearly see.

Now as the LSU Basketball program begins its second season, Coach McMahon under the cornerstone of those core values has welcomed in an older, more experienced group of players who not only understand the fundamentals of the game, but also the culture of the environment with many having lived and played in around the Baton Rouge/LSU area.

LSU, Coach McMahon and staff laid a new foundation a year ago and now has many of the tools needed to build on that foundation.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67, a .697 winning percentage. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022 (the 2020 appearance was canceled by the pandemic).

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

Williams and his successfully play translated to the Southeastern Conference where he earned All-SEC honors in a super senior year when he became at the time in January 2023 the 123rd player in Division I college basketball to amass 2,000 career points and 1,000 rebounds.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the

sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3). The Racers were ranked No. 20 in the final AP poll and No. 22 in the Ferris Mowers Coaches Poll.

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season championships (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game by defeating No. 5 seed Marquette.

That season, Morant named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team all-America honors from the USBWA.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

In 2017-18, McMahon's team won 26 games and the OVC regular season and tournament championship, sending the Racers to what was at that time the school's 16th NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio Valley Conference championships, a CollegeInsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

In 2014-15, MSU became the first team in school history to go undefeated in the OVC at 16-0 and set a league record with a 25-game win streak that was second best in the nation. Three seasons earlier, McMahon was named to the list of best

assistant coaches by FoxSports.com and CollegeInsider.com.

In his first season as an assistant at Murray State, the team was 31-2 and earned a No. 6 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

### PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 90 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 124 three-pointers, graduating in 2000 with a bachelor's in marketing.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as a student assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a student coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

Honestly, one almost has to put the 2023-24 season into two sections -- the first 10 games and the last four games after Jalen Cook was finally allowed to play again for the Tigers.

Over those last four games Jordan Wright averaged 19.0 points, 2.0 assists and 3.2 steals, while Cook is averaging 14.0 points, 3.3 rebounds, 4.7 assists and 1.7 steals. Six players are averaging at least eight points over that period.

The Texas game on Dec. 16 was when Jalen Cook made his first appearance for the Tigers since the end of the 2020-21 season when he came in during the first half from off the bench. LSU struggled in the first half as Cook shook off the rust of not playing in the first 10 games, but in the second half Cook and Wright got in a rhythm that saw them cut a 19-point deficit down to seven and Wright score 31 second half points while Cook had 13 points and six assists with just one turnover in 32 minutes.

Cook started the next three games and has been in double figures every game.

One thing that has become quite apparent is that LSU with Cook on the floor has an offense that is much more efficient from an assist-to-turnover realm. The difference in assists to turnover average in the first 10 games versus the last four.

**First 10 games (6-4 record): 10.4 assists per game -- 14.4 turnovers per game**

**Last 4 games (3-1 record): 16.8 assists per game -- 11.8 turnovers per game**

Cook played for LSU in the 20-21 season for the Tigers before heading to Tulane for two first-team All-AAC seasons in 21-22 and 22-23. He then elected to transfer back to his original school for 23-24 making him a multi-time transfer. Cook and his family were in the process of appealing an NCAA original denial of the waiver when a court decision and a subsequent negotiated settlement by the NCAA allowed all multi-transfers immediate eligibility for the remainder of the season shortly before LSU's game with Texas in Houston (Dec. 16).

In his first stint at LSU during the 2020-21 season, he played 20 games and averaged 3.1 points. He had no starts that season and his most playing minutes was against Nicholls when he played 25 minutes. He scored in double figures twice -- 10 versus Louisiana Tech (12/6/20) and 11 at Georgia (2/23/21) in nine minutes. That was the only game he hit more than one three-pointer for the Tigers until his first game back at LSU (Dec. 16) when he hit three from distance.



LSU GOES 1-0 IN THE SEC, BUT ...

In completely different ways, LSU has started 1-0 in the Southeastern Conference for both seasons under Matt McMahon. To start the 22-23 season, the Tigers played their best game of the season to defeat No. 9 Arkansas in the Maravich Center. Unfortunately, LSU's league schedule was one of the toughest handed out and LSU went into a tailspin, losing 14 straight before defeating Vanderbilt in the Maravich Center to finish 2-16. Now, the "new look" Tigers must again challenge that same road with an opening league win at Texas A&M (1/6) to start 1-0 in the SEC. LSU is 53-39 in SEC opening games. The rest of January moving forward is three home dates and three road contests. The Tigers will be home this coming Tuesday to face Vanderbilt (8 p.m., SEC Network); Jan. 17 versus Ole Miss (6 p.m., SEC Network); and the second meeting with Texas A&M on Jan. 20 (3 p.m., ESPN2/U). LSU's January road swing continues Jan. 13 at Auburn (5 p.m., SEC Network); Jan. 24 at UGA (5:30 p.m. CT, SEC Network); and Jan. 27 at Alabama (7 p.m., ESPN2). LSU is one of three teams tied for second in most regular season championships with 11 (joining Alabama and Tennessee) behind only Kentucky. LSU's last title came in 2019. Of course, the SEC Tournament will be back in Nashville for another run, this time March 13-17.

SOME OF THE WINNING NUMBERS FROM THE LEAGUE OPENER

The primary number is scoring as LSU, down two at the half, outscored A&M, 38-21, in the final 20 minutes, never losing the lead after scoring eight consecutive points out of the locker room. Texas A&M, which is No. 1 in the country in offensive rebounds at 16.4 a game, was held to 13, one less than the Tigers and LSU had a 46-40 total rebound edge. That and poor shooting by A&M helped the Tigers to an 18-3 advantage in second chance points and 36-20 in points in the paint. The Aggies shooting performance of 25.4 percent for field goals is the second lowest FG percentage by an LSU opponent on its home court in records that go back to 1965-66. The lowest was 25.0 percent by Kentucky on Jan. 18, 1987 in Rupp Arena. The last time the Tigers outscored an opponent by 17+ in the second half on their home court was Feb. 26, 2005 at Auburn. That team was coached by present day LSU Network radio analyst John Brady. The last time The Tigers held a team to 53 or fewer on the road was in March 2014, when LSU won at Vandy, 57-51. Texas A&M was ranked No. 23 in KenPom coming into the game. The last road win LSU had over a top 25 KenPom team was a buzzer beater vs. Kentucky in 2019.

13 DOES NOT TURN INTO 14

LSU stopped a 13-game losing streak on opponents home courts with the win at A&M. It was primarily an SEC streak as 12 games were in the league and then this year's ACC-SEC Challenge game at Syracuse in November. Ironically, LSU's last road win and the road win that snapped the streak came in Bryant-College Station's Reed Arena. LSU defeated the Aggies, 76-68, on Feb. 8, 2022 and then won on Saturday (1/6/24), 68-53, over Texas A&M. The Tigers are hovering about 40 percent all-time in road game wins in its history.

JORDAN WRIGHT GETS DOUBLE FIGURE DOUBLE FIGURES AND A DOUBLE DOUBLE

He was under his scoring average but he kept his double figure scoring streak alive with his 10 points in 22 minutes against Northwestern State (12/29). More importantly, he made it 10 consecutive games in double figures in that game and he is the first Tiger to hit double figures in 10 or more games since Darius Days went for double figures in 14 consecutive games (Jan. 29, 2022 to March 18, 2022). He made up for it against A&M (1/6) with 20 points and 10 rebounds. It was his 11th consecutive double figure game, his 10th double double and his second 20-10 game of his career. Wright had his career scoring game against Texas (12/16) as one of the best games for LSU in the second half of play. A total of 31 of his 33 points were scored in the final 20 minutes. It appears to be the most second half points scored by an LSU player since Dec. 18, 1990 when Shaquille O'Neal scored 37 second half points in a 53-point effort in a 98-74 victory over Arkansas State at Baton Rouge. The more recent game everyone remembers is in November 2015 when Ben Simmons scored 25 points in a 43-point total as LSU defeated North Florida, 119-108. Wright's two first half points against the Longhorns came with 17:19 to go in the first half and was actually LSU's first made field goal of the contest. Wright would not score again until the 18:23 mark of the second half when he hit the first of five second half three-pointers. For the game, the Waggaman, Louisiana player was an efficient 9-of-14 from the field, including 5-of-7 from distance. He drew five fouls, all shooting fouls, and was 10-of-10 at the charity stripe for his 33 points. Ironically, his most previous free throw mark in his career was seven for Vanderbilt against LSU in last year's SEC Tournament matchup. His previous career high was 28 points for Vanderbilt versus Winthrop on Nov. 10, 2021. He has had eight games of 20 points or more in his career. In the 11 consecutive games scoring in double figures, Wright has raised his scoring average from 9.0 to 15.0 in that time. Wright has played 138 collegiate games with 87 starts and is eight points shy of 1,400 career points at 1,392.

#### MIKE WILLIAMS III NAMED SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK TO END 2023

Mike Williams III wasn't in the starting lineup against Northwestern State (12/29) but he certainly didn't let it bother him a bit as he responded with his best LSU scoring game that earned him SEC Freshman of the Week honors on Jan. 1.

Williams played 21 minutes, hit 7-of 11 field goals and 6-of-9 three-pointers in scoring 20 points against the Demons (12/29).

Only 13 times in the history of the three-point shot has an LSU player made more than six three-pointers in a game.

Williams started the first 12 games of the season handling the point guard position in the first 11 games before Jalen Cook became eligible. Williams is averaging 19.8 minutes a game and 7.4 points for the season, 1.9 rebounds, 1.8 assists and 1.4 steals.

The native of Baltimore, Maryland now has four double figure games this season, all in the last eight games played. Another of Williams' highlights came against North Florida when he grabbed six steals (11/24).

#### MORE FREE THROWS

Although it didn't happen in the A&M win, the Tigers did make a good percentage of the 11 free throw attempts, but LSU is still making more free throws for the season than opponents. LSU averages 22.1 attempts a game, up from 19.2 a contest a year ago. More important is the free throw makes of 15.5 a game, a full four over last year when LSU made just 11.5 a contest.

LSU is 217-of-309 or 70.2 percent at the line, while opponents are at 182-of-250. LSU has made 35 more free throws than opponents and attempted 59 more than opponents.

LSU's best single game percentage was 78.1 percent this season, making 25-of-32 against North Florida (11/24).

#### HUNTER DEAN CONTINUES STRONG PLAY

Grad student Hunter Dean has gotten more playing time off the bench in important situations and in the last four games has contributed big points and rebounds. In the last four contests, Dean, from Mandeville, Louisiana has averaged 8.0 point per game, a team co-high 5.8 rebounds and six blocks while playing 19.4 minutes per game.

Against Northwestern State (Dec. 29) he had his first LSU double double of 11 points and 10 rebounds. It was his sixth double double of his career, having recorded five at George Washington.

Dean is perfect from the field in the last three games (9-of-9). For the season, Dean has made 18-of-23 field goals (78.3%) and the three-point make against Texas was the first of the grad transfer's career in eight attempts over his five seasons. For his career at Southern Miss, George Washington and LSU he has made 186-of-304 attempts (61.2%).

For his career, he has played in 91 contests, starting 48. All the starts were at GW.

#### CARLOS STEWART HAS NICE REBOUND AGAINST LAMAR

One of the things the present LSU lineup situation makes decisions on how much the guards play and divide the minutes. Practice and preparation are things Coach McMahon has said will possibly be a factor moving forward. Ready for your turn is one thing proven recently by transfer Carlos Stewart.

The Baton Rouge native didn't see the floor in the game in Houston against Texas (Dec. 16), but played 21 minutes against Lamar (Dec. 21) and posted his first double figure game at LSU with 16 points with three assists and three steals with just one turnover. Stewart was 5-of-9 from the field, including 4-of-8 from distance.

It was his first three-point attempts since he went 0-of-3 at Syracuse (11/28) and 0-of-4 versus Southeastern (12/1).

Stewart, who started the first seven games, returned to the starting lineup against Northwestern State (12/29) where he had seven points, two steals in 26 minutes.

For the season, he is averaging 4.7 points, 2.2 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game.

#### TRAE HANNIBAL

The fifth year senior had been a good factor in the 13 games he played in, averaging 17.9 points a game. Hannibal earned SEC Player of the Week honors a year ago in the opening SEC game win over Arkansas. He's known as an aggressive, full-speed ahead type point guard opening things up for his teammates.

In the Northwestern State game (12/29), Hannibal had eight assists in 19 minutes. It was the most assists by an LSU player since Brandon Murray had nine assists versus Missouri, March 10, 2022.

Hannibal was 3-of-6 from the field in the game with two rebounds and two steals.

Hannibal had a very successful outing against ASU (12/13), getting his first double figure scoring game of the season (11 points).

In fact, Williams and Hannibal in that game combined for the No. 3 play on ESPN's SportsCenter when a Mike Williams' steal ended in an alley-oop dunk to Hannibal.

Hannibal is averaging 4.5 points a game, 2.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.2 steals.

#### JALEN REED

Jalen Reed had seven points in the Tigers win over Lamar, again getting most of his points at the free throw line, making 5-of-8 as his starting streak has continued through the first 12 games.

That streak was interrupted as he did not dress for the Northwestern State game (12/29) with an illness. He was back for the Texas A&M game (1/6) and played 17 minutes off the bench, scoring eight points with two rebounds, two assists and two steals.

Reed started early in his freshman season but had limited success at times and saw games where he did not have lots of minutes and averaging 3.7 points per game.

This season after a summer of player development workouts, Reed is a solid contributor for the Tigers averaging 9.2 points a game and 5.0 rebounds a contest to go with 1.3 assists.

Reed has had six double figure scoring games, including a 13-point effort against Alabama State (12/13) and his first collegiate double double of 14 points and 11 rebounds against Syracuse (11/28).

Where Reed can improve is in control of the basketball as he is just shy of three turnovers a game and only three games in the last nine with below three miscues including the A&M game when he had no turnovers. .

Reed's late father Justin played at Ole Miss (2001-05) and was a four-time All-SEC selection and freshman of the year in the league in 2001.

**TYRELL WARD**

Ward also missed the final non-conference game against Northwestern State because of illness, but came back to score eight points against A&M (1/6).

The sophomore is averaging 7.5 points and 2.3 rebounds. He has made 17 three pointers this season.

Ward has had four games scoring in double figures, including 14 against North Florida (11/24).

**WILL BAKER**

Will Baker played his 100th career game against Texas A&M, his 14th for the Tigers.

Against Northwestern State (12/29), Baker went over 1,000 career points for his Texas-Nevada-LSU career when he scored 17 points in 23 minutes against the Demons.

Baker has scored in double figures in eight games this season.

In his double figure scoring games, he has shot 50 percent or better in seven of them.

He is averaging 12.1 points and 5.1 rebounds for the season.

Baker's best games came first in the opener against Mississippi Valley (11/6) when he scored 29 points, making 10-of-11 field goals including 2 from distance and 7-of-8 free throws. He also scored 23 against Wake Forest in the final game in Charleston, with 8 rebounds.

For the season he is 61-of-115 for 53.0 percent from the field. He has made seven treys.

Baker started his career at Texas, before two seasons at Nevada where he graduated and transferred to LSU.

**DEREK FOUNTAIN CONTINUING TO HELP TIGERS**

When Derek Fountain came to LSU prior to the 2022-23 season after two years at Mississippi State, he had averaged 5.4 points as a freshman in 19 games and then 1.8 points in 25 games as a sophomore.

But LSU jump started his career and he became a vital part of the offense in Matt McMahon's first year, starting 23-of-31 games and averaging 8.0 points and 23.5 minutes per game.

After dealing with some off-season stomach issues that limited his preseason practice, he has played many games off the bench before returning to the starting lineup the last two games.

Fountain stepped into the opportunity to start against Northwestern State (12/29) and responded with his fifth career double double (all at LSU) with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Fountain was 3-of-3 from the field and 4-of-5 at the free throw line.

He was a major factor in the win over North Texas (Nov. 17), hitting all six field goal attempts, including a three-pointer in scoring 14 points while grabbing a team high seven boards in 24 minutes. In the three Charleston games, he averaged 8.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in 20.7 minutes per game.

Against Kansas State (12/9) he hit 4-of-7 field goals to get eight points with a team best six boards and three steals in 26 minutes. He also had eight points in the win over Alabama State (12/13). Against Texas, Fountain was in double figures for the second time this season with 13 points in 32 minutes, hitting 6-of-9 field goals and a three-pointer. He also had three blocks.

In the last four games, he is averaged 8.3 points and 4.8 rebounds. He is shooting 13-of-20 from the field in those games

Fountain overall is averaging 6.8 points and 4.6 rebounds, making 35-of-55 field goal attempts (63.6%).

**TIGERS POST SEVENTH DOUBLE FIGURE STEALS GAME VS. NW STATE**

The Tigers remain number one in the league in steals, entering the week at 9.93. At the start of the week, LSU is also ninth in the latest NCAA stats in steals per game.

LSU is seventh in the country at 13.7 percent steals per possession (according to TeamRankings.com), compared to just 9.9 percent a year ago.

Jordan Wright is one of five players in the SEC averaging more than 2.0 steals per game.

**TONIGHT'S OPPONENT**

Vanderbilt battled Alabama at Nashville's Memorial Coliseum to the buzzer before falling, 78-75, in the opener on Saturday. Tyrin Lawrence led Vanderbilt with 20 points with Jason Rivera-Torres also scoring 20 points. Ezra Manjon added 16 points for the Commodores. Vandy made 26-of-65 field goals for 40 percent with seven from distance and 16-of-20 free throws. Manjon averages 16.5 points per game, Lawrence 13.8 points and Ven-Allen Lubin 10.0 points.

Vanderbilt leads the series, 65-57. LSU won one-of-the-three games last year against the Commodores, an 84-77 decision at the Maravich Center on Feb. 22, 2023.

LSU leads the overall series, 35-21, in games played in Baton Rouge.

Jerry Stackhouse is in his fifth year as the head coach of Vanderbilt.

**AGAIN, CLOSE TO SINGLE DIGIT TURNOVERS**

In the last-two non-conference games, it was in the waning seconds of the game that LSU drifted into double figures in turnovers, but having it happen in the waning minutes hasn't been something that had been happening for LSU.

Particularly the unforced turnover has plagued the Tigers all season long.

The Tigers were on the verge of a single digit turnover game for the first time all season for the first time in two weeks against Lamar (12/21) with just four first half turnovers. The number didn't reach double figures until the final two minutes of the game when LSU had three turnovers in four possessions.

Then in the game against Northwestern State (12/29), after five first half turnovers, the Tigers were on the verge of a 10-turnover game before a miscue with 30 seconds to play in the contest.

But, again back-to-back 11 turnover games was a good sign for LSU after turning it over as many as 19 times in the loss to Syracuse.

In the conference opener, LSU had 12 turnovers but it would have been 10 or 11 again but for two turnovers in the final 44 seconds. The 12th was a self-decided shot clock violation with the game decided in the final 10 seconds.

While LSU is averaging 13.6 turnovers a game, in the last four games, the turnover average is down to 11.8.

The Tigers have turned the ball over 191 times in 14 games. Despite the self-made turnover issues, the Tigers have forced 218 turnovers and LSU has forced opponent turnovers at a 15.6 clip.

LSU is also averaged a good 19.2 points off turnovers, compared to 13.8 for opponents.

**SHOOTING THE THREE**

The three-pointer had been an issue for LSU, primarily on defense, but that became a real problem on both sides as LSU had its first percentage of less than 10 percent since January 2020 against Syracuse (11/28).

While LSU made nine three-pointers against Lamar (12/21) the Tigers took the most three-pointers it had taken all season and the most since taking 26 against Mississippi Valley in the opener. The Tigers took 38 three-point attempts, which is the most taken in the history of the Pete Maravich Assembly Center (the former record was 36 versus Southeastern on Nov. 30, 2021). The 38 attempts explain why LSU was just at 23.7 percent shooting for the game.

For the season, the Tigers are 101-of-302 (33.4 percent). Opponents has made 21 more threes in 60 more attempts.

Individually for LSU, Jordan Wright leads the team with 28 makes from distance. Tyrell Ward has 17 for 45 of the team's 101 makes from distance.

Last year, LSU averaged 7.2 threes over 33 games.

### LOUISIANA INFLUENCE RETURNS

After a year away, the logo and phrase "Boot Up" has truly returned to the LSU Basketball program as five players have Southeast Louisiana ties to the program in 2023-24.

Carlos Stewart is from Baton Rouge and Jordan Wright is from Waggaman. Both played for The Dunham School in Baton Rouge. Stewart transferred from Santa Clara and Wright from Vanderbilt.

Jalen Cook played for LSU in the 2020-21 season and returns to Baton Rouge after two seasons at Tulane. He is from Walker. Hunter Dean is from Mandeville and came to LSU from George Washington.

Freshman Corey Chest hails from New Orleans where he played three years of high school before finishing up last year at The Link Academy in Missouri.

It is the most since there were eight players from Louisiana on the 2017-18 roster.

### KENPOM RATES LSU EXPERIENCE HIGHER THIS YEAR

For the last several years, Kenpom.com had LSU's experience rating deep in the 300s of the 360-plus Division I teams.

But this year the experience is listed at 2.30 years which is listed as 85th in the rankings. The DI average this year is 1.81.

This is one of the older rosters in recent LSU basketball history with 11 players who are at least in their third year of college basketball.

Three players – Jordan Wright (Vanderbilt), Will Baker (Nevada), Hunter Dean (George Washington) – are grad transfers, while Trae Hannibal is a fifth-year senior thanks to the pandemic season of 2020.

### BUT A STATISTICAL NOTE ABOUT THEIR BIRTHDATES

The 2023-24 edition of the Tigers marks the first year that every player on the roster was born in 2000 or later. Only Graduates Jordan Wright and Will Baker were born in 2000.

### MWANI WILKINSON

He's almost a survivor and a rarity in college basketball – a player who has stayed at the same school for all four years. After entering the transfer portal after his sophomore season, he decided to stay at LSU and play for Coach Matt McMahon. Unfortunately, his junior year was slowed by a preseason shoulder injury that he tried to play through, but after 12 games required surgery.

Again, his 2023-24 season has had a bump as he has missed the last two games with a hip issue. So far, he is averaging 12.4 minutes a game, 1.6 points and 1.1 rebounds.

Wilkinson is looking to break out a mini slump, having gone 0-of-13 from distance his last six games he has played.

### DAIMION COLLINS

Daimion Collins was playing well against North Florida (11/24), having scored nine points and grabbed four rebounds on 4-of-6 shooting in 13 minutes before he dislocated his right shoulder in the second half. He missed six games before returning to game action against Northwestern State (12/29).

He had played just a combined three minutes in games against Dayton and Wake Forest with a DNP against North Texas in the three games in Charleston prior to the North Florida game.

His season best was 11 points in the opener against Mississippi Valley (11/6) in the opener.

Against Northwestern State, Collins played 13 minutes and had two points and two rebounds.

He is averaging 4.3 points and 2.2 rebounds.

### FOUR STAR SIGNED INKED

LSU received the national letter of intent papers from two four-star signees for the 2024-25 season on national signing day.

The signees are 6-11 forward Robert Miller III of Houston's Pasadena Memorial High School and 6-3 guard Curtis Givens III of Memphis, Tennessee, who attends Monteverde Academy in Florida.

Miller III was ranked No. 40 by On3 and No. 49 nationally by 247sports and the No. 2 recruit in the state of Texas.

Miller is the son of former LSU football defensive lineman Robert Miller II. His mother Teana (McKiver) Miller played basketball for Tulane and in the WNBA. As a junior at Pasadena Memorial, Miller III averaged 19.7 points, 13.4 rebounds and 5.4 blocks per game.

This past summer, Miller III was invited to the 2023 NBPA Top 100 Camp at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex in Orlando, Florida. The camp features some of the best high school basketball players from around the country and provides comprehensive on and off the court programming to maximize a player's potential. He also attended the Pangos All-American Camp in both 2022 and 2023.

---

Givens III is ranked No. 33 by On3 nationally and number four among point guards, while ESPN's recruiting rankings has Givens III ranked at number 48.

Givens III has had great success on the AAU and EYBL circuit, playing for Moka Elite in Missouri. He had games of 18 points, 4 assists; 21 points; and, 23 points and 5 asts and in the Peach Jam had games of 16 points-4 assists and, 13 points-8 rebounds. In session one on the EYBL circuit, he averaged 18.8 points a contest. He also was invited to the NBPA Top 100 camp for top high school prospects. The camp features some of the best high school basketball players from around the country and provides comprehensive on and off the court programming to maximize a player's potential.

### ESPN ANNOUNCER JIMMY DYKES PUTS MARAVICH, SHAQ ON HIS ALL-TIME SEC TEAM

As part of the inaugural SEC/ACC Challenge in November, ESPN announcer Jimmy Dykes put together his all-time All-SEC team and included were two all-time LSU stars.

With several very good players to choose from, LSU was the only team with two players in his starting five in Pistol

Pete Maravich (1967-70) and Shaquille O'Neal (1989-92).

Maravich of course remains the all-time leading scorer (3,667) and the top average in Division I basketball of over 44 points a game (44.2).

O'Neal dominated the game as a center for the Tigers, winning national player of the year honors in 1991 and twice was SEC Player of the Year.

The other members of the team were Auburn's Charles Barkley, Tennessee's Ernie Grunfeld and Kentucky's Anthony Davis.

Of course, there are several other players that easily could have been on that list for a five-man all-time team including the legendary Bob Pettit and Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf.

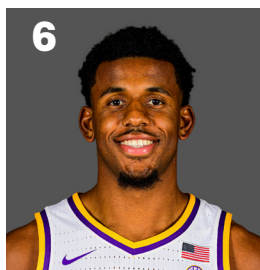
