This is a chance to create a narrative and for our team to put themselves in the conversation. It's early in the year; only the second meet of the season and our first road meet. We just want to make sure their minds stay where they need to and compete hard. That's what we want to do."

Gymnastics Set To Compete In ESPN's First-Ever Invitational

The No. 5 nationally ranked LSU Gymnastics team is set to compete in ESPN's first-ever invitational, the Sprouts Farmers Market Collegiate Quad Meet, on Saturday, January 13 at 3 p.m. CT in West Valley City, Utah. The podium meet features four of the top-ranked teams in the country, who all competed in last year's Final Four. LSU will take on No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 2 Utah and No. 12 UCLA on national television as the competition will air on ABC. The meet will run in the new quad meet format, which will have a maximum of two events competing simultaneously. The Tigers will begin the meet on beam and rotate in Olympic order. Bart Conner and Kathy Johnson Clarke will be on call with Taylor Davis as the on-site reporter. The first event will start at 3:06 p.m. CT in the Maverik Center.

JAY CLARK

HEAD COACH • 4th Season

Jay Clark owns over 30 years of experience in college gymnastics and is one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2021 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Last year, he led the Tigers to their first Final Four appearance under his tenure as he continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive Top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars

championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against lowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the dub level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete collegiately at the NCAA Division I level. A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his

Clark has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

Last Time On The Floor

- The No. 3 LSU Gymnastics team defeated No. 14 Ohio State by a score of 196.975-196.775 on Friday night in the PMAC to start off the new year. The last time LSU opened the season with a win against a ranked opponent was in 2021, when the squad took down No. 15 Arkansas.
- The night was highlighted by senior Haleigh Bryant, who took home vault and all-around titles on the night and freshman Amari Drayton, who had an impressive debut on vault and floor in her first competition as a Tiger.
- Fifth-year senior Kiya Johnson took home the bars title in her first competition back with her score of 9.925 to move her total to 41 career titles and her fourth on the event
- Junior Aleah Finnegan's 9.950 performance on beam earned her the win on the night, moving her career total to 16 and eighth on beam.
- The floor squad posted a 49.525 in the last rotation to help lift the Tiger's over the Buckeyes and secure the first win of the year.
- Bryant was able to secure the all-around title for the meet with her score of 39.675. The senior now owns 62 wins, which ties her with Ashleigh Gnat and Jennifer Woods at eighth for most career titles in school history.

First Annual ESPN Invitational

- No. 5 LSU is set to compete in ESPN's first-ever invitational, the Sprouts Farmers Market Collegiate Quad Meet. There are three sessions of competition this weekend, with LSU being featured in session two on Saturday, January 13 at 3 p.m. CT on ABC.
- Competition in the Maverik Center kicks off with session one at 8 p.m. CT on Friday and session three will follow the conclusion of session two on Saturday at 8 p.m. CT.

Scouting The Opponents

- No. 1 Oklahoma remains the top team in the nation after posting a 197.850 in their opening competition of the season at the Mean Girls Super 16 in Las Vegas, where they defeated defeated #9 Kentucky (196.775), #11 Michigan State 196.300, and #6 Michigan (195.875). The Sooners were one of just four schools to post a 197-plus score in the first week of competition.
- The Tigers own an overall record of 11-23-0 against the Sooners and are 8-19-0 at a neutral site.
- No. 2 Utah topped their highest season-opening score in opening weekend, taking down Boise State 197.300-194.350 on Friday night. The Utes own the series over the Tigers with a 36-8 record. LSU is 4-24 against Utah at neutral site venues.
- UCLA placed fourth in the season-opening Super 16 with a score of 196.550, finishing behind Alabama (197.125), California (196.850), and Auburn (196.600). They sit at No. 12 in the rankings after week one.
- \bullet The Tigers are 7-25-1 against the Bruins and 6-19-1 at a neutral site.

Bryant, Drayton Earn Week One SEC Honors

- The LSU Gymnastics pair of senior Haleigh Bryant and freshman Amari
 Drayton took home the first SEC awards of the 2024 season, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.
- Bryant was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week while freshman Amari
 Drayton earned Co-Freshman of the Week honors for their performances in the
 Tigers season opener against No. 14 Ohio State on Friday night.
- A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant finished as the top all-around gymnast in the country after week one with her score of 39.675. She helped lift the Tigers to a 196.975-196.775 victory over the Buckeyes to secure the squad's first victory of 2024.
- The senior's night was highlighted by her front pike half vault that scored a 9.950, while also posting a 9.875 on bars and a 9.925 on beam and floor for the Tigers. Bryant won the vault and all-around titles on the night to move her career

total to 62, which ties her at eighth for most career individual titles in LSU history. Her 24 career vault titles and 20 all-around titles also place her amongst the top-five gymnasts in school history.

- Drayton had an impressive night against the Buckeyes in her collegiate gymnastics debut as she scored a pair of 9.925's on yault and floor.
- The freshman out of Spring, Texas started the night off with a stuck yurchenko one and a half on vault before anchoring on floor, capturing second place on vault and a share of second place on floor in her first competition with the Tigers.

Week One Road To Nationals Rankings

- LSU sits at fifth in the week one Road to Nationals rankings after defeating No. 14 Ohio State in opening weekend
- The Tigers put up a solid 196.975-196.775 on Friday night against the Buckeyes to start the 2024 season in the win column.
- LSU is the top team on vault and floor in the nation after week one, while also sitting in the top-10 on bars. The Tigers posted scores of 49.375 on vault, 49.375 on bars and 49.525 on floor on Friday night.
- Haleigh Bryant, Kiya Johnson, Sierra Ballard, Aleah Finnegan, Alexis Jeffrey and Amari Drayton all sit in the top-25 individually for their performances in week one.
- With her score of 39.675 in the all-around against the Buckeyes, Bryant picked up right where she left off from last season and is the top gymnast in the country after the weekend, while also placing second on vault, sixth on beam and sixth on floor.
- The senior posted a 9.950 on vault, 9.875 on bars, and a pair of 9.925's on beam and floor for the Tigers on Friday night.
- Johnson earned a 9.925 on bars in her first competition back from injury to place her at No. 13 in the week one rankings. Jeffrey also ranks No. 21 on the event with her score of 9.900.
- Ballard and Finnegan both posted scores of 9.900 on floor in the Tiger's competition against the Buckeyes to place them tied at No. 13 in the individual event rankings.
- In her collegiate gymnastics debut, Drayton had an impressive showcase in her first competition with the Tigers. The freshman scored a pair of 9.925's on vault and floor and is tied for sixth on both events nationally.

Reaching New Heights

- The Tigers reached a new milestone as the program set a new record of over 8,000 season tickets sold prior to the start of the 2024 season.
- With the goal of selling out the PMAC, Tiger fans have the opportunity to set a new attendance record this year as the Tiger's home schedule features six meets inside the PMAC.
- LSU has finished in the top four of average attendance nationally for six consecutive years, claiming the No. 1 spot in 2022. Over 50,000 fans filled the seats of the PMAC through five home meets in 2023, earning LSU the highest attendance average in the SEC last season with an average of 12,075.

Program History

- Head Coach Jay Clark enters his fourth season leading the Tigers and 13th season overall as he
 continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program. He is joined on staff by Assistant Coaches Garrett
 Griffeth, Ashleigh Gnat and Courtney McCool Griffeth. Gnat is in her fourth season with the Tigers while
 the Griffeth duo enters their third season on staff.
- The Tigers climbed their way to the NCAA Championship Final in Fort Worth for the programs ninth appearance in the finals in 2023. The Final Four appearance marked the second time that LSU has advanced to the finals since the format began in 2019 and the first time under Clark's tenure.
- Last season marked the program's 38th straight appearance in the NCAA postseason and 40th overall
 appearance for the Tigers. With the team advancing out of regionals, LSU marked their 32nd program
 appearance in the NCAA Championships.
- LSU has a total of 16 individual national titles across 10 gymnasts in program history, including current senior Haleigh Bryant who was named the NCAA vault champion in 2021.
- The Tigers own four SEC Championship titles in program history, winning three consecutive titles from 2017 to 2019. The last time LSU took home the conference title was in 2019 in the Smoothie King Center, the site of this year's conference championship.

Tigers On The National Stage

- The Tigers will be featured on television seven times in 2024, kicking off with No. 14 Ohio State on SEC Network for the return of Friday Night Heights.
- The 2024 television schedule showcases nine of the top 10 teams in the country and 16 of the WGCA Preseason Top 25 across ESPN platforms. ESPN will broadcast more than 20 SEC gymnastics meets across their networks throughout the 2024 season, while SEC Network will air 19 regular season meets.
- The 10th year of SEC Network's "Friday Night Heights" franchise returns in 2024, with a record nine consecutive weekends of action beginning on Friday, January 5.
- No. 3 LSU will be featured in primetime on ESPN2 twice during the regular season, with big matchups against No. 2 Florida in Gainesville on February 23 at 6 p.m. CT and No. 8 Alabama on March 1 at 5 p.m. CT in Baton Rouge.
- SEC Network will showcase the remaining five of the Tigers meets on television this upcoming season.
 No. 3 LSU and No. 9 Kentucky will face off at 8 p.m. CT on January 19 in Baton Rouge before meeting No.
 Missouri on the road at 7:30 p.m. CT on January 26.
- The Tigers will travel to face No. 16 Georgia at 5 p.m. CT on February 9 and will host No. 17 Auburn at 7

p.m. CT on February 16.

- LSU's home meets against No. 15 Arkansas and No. 32 North Carolina will also be available via streaming on SEC Network+. The Tigers will host the Razorbacks on February 2 and will close out the regular season against the Tar Heels on March 15.
- Both sessions of the 2024 SEC Gymnastics Championship will be televised on SEC Network. The event will take place on Saturday, March 23 of flips slated for 2:30 p.m. CT while the evening session begins at 7 p.m. CT.
- ABC is the home of the 2024 NCAA National Collegiate Women's Gymnastics Championships, with the Championship Final airing live on Saturday, April 20, at 3 p.m. CT. The semifinal rounds are set for Thursday, April 18 on ESPN2, with Semifinal I beginning at 3:30 p.m. and Semifinal II at 8 p.m. CT. Surround championship coverage of each apparatus will stream live on ESPN+.
- · Also returning this season is streaming coverage of NCAA Regionals on ESPN+, showcasing real-time action of every gymnast and apparatus from regional rounds in Ann Arbor, Michigan, Berkeley, California, Fayetteville, Arkansas, and Gainesville, Florida.
- All meets on ESPN networks will be available via the ESPN App on smartphones, tablets, connected streaming devices and espn.com/watch.

The Squad

- This year's roster is composed of 22 gymnasts with 11 seniors, four juniors, three sophomores and four freshmen. The Tigers welcomed two sixth-year transfers this year in Savannah Schoenherr and Jillian Hoffman and four new freshmen as Konnor McClain, Amari Drayton, Kylie Coen and Leah Miller begin their first year in the Purple & Gold.
- Cammy Hall is a sixth-year returning from injury. Hall joined the Tigers in 2023 after spending four season at Utah, where she was an All-Pac 12 conference member on vault and owns a career high of 9.950 on the event.
- Fifth-year seniors Kiya Johnson, Alyona Shchennikova and Kai Rivers all returned for their final year of competition with the Tigers.
- Shchennikova competed in the all-around in 11 meets for the Tigers last year and owns career highs of 9.950 on vault and bars, 9.925 on beam and 9.975 on floor.
- · Haleigh Bryant, Sierra Ballard, Chase Brock, Elena Arenas and Olivia Dunne make up the true senior class.
- Bryant competed in every meet for the Tigers last year and will continue to **Meet The Newcomers** be one of the top all-around gymnasts in the country this year. She finished 2023 with averages of 9.900+ on all four apparatuses and owns career highs of 9.950 on beam and perfect 10's on vault, bars and floor
- Ballard led off on floor for the Tigers in every meet last year while also competing on beam in 13 meets. She owns career highs of 9.925 on both events
- Brock was a key contributor in the vault and floor lineups in 2023, posting the Utes. She owns career high's of 9.975 on both events. career high routines of 9.975 on vault and 9.925 on floor.
- the all-around for the first time in her career against Florida.
- Dunne appeared in the bars lineup four times in 2023 and owns a career high of 9.925 on the event. She has the potential to impact the beam and floor lineups this year.
- Aleah Finnegan, Alexis Jeffrey, Tori Tatum, and KJ Johnson all begin their iunior season.
- Jeffrey and Tatum were key contributors to the bars lineups in 2023 as Jeffrey appeared in the lineup in every meet and Tatum appeared in all but two on bars.
- KJ Johnson battled injury in 2023 after the squad's meet against Florida, but she returns ready to contribute for the Tigers. She owns career highs of 9.95 on vault, 9.875 on beam and 9.950 on floor.
- · Ashley Cowan, Bryce Wilson and Annie Beard enter their sophomore year with Tigers.
- In their first year with the Tigers, Cowan and Wilson stepped up for their team and competed in multiple meets as freshmen.
- Annie Beard did not compete in 2023 due to injury, but is expected to make her debut in 2024.

Bryant Shines In Year Three, Enters Senior Season

- · A native of Cornelius, N.C., Bryant enters her fourth year at LSU after a historical junior season that etched her name into the record books.
- A few of her accomplishments last season include Honda Award Finalist. Central Region Gymnast of the Year, three-time SEC Gymnast of the week, All-SEC floor honors and nine All-America honors, which marked the most in a single season by an LSU gymnast.
- · She went 64 for 64 routines for the Tigers as she competed in the all-around in every meet in 2023 and at the Smoothie King Center in New Orleans, Louisiana, with the first session became the first LSU gymnast to average a 9.900+ across all four events in a season.
 - She matched the highest all-around score in school history with her 39 875 against West Virginia and scored the second highest ever all-around score for LSU in the NCAA Championship (39.725) in 2023.
 - Bryant picked up right where she left off last year as she is the top all-around gymnast in the country after week one. She owns 62 career individual titles and 17 All-America honors entering her second meet of the vear in 2024.

Olympic Qualifier Finnegan Begins Year Three

- Finnegan will continue to be a key contributor for the Tigers in 2024 as she competed in the all-around in all but one meet last year. The Lee's Summit, Missouri will represent the Tigers at the 2024 Paris Olympics after booking her Olympic ticket at the 2023 World Championships in Antwerp last October.
- · Finnegan earned an all-around score of 51.366 in her world championship debut to become the first active gymnast in school history to become an Olympian and first ever female gymnast from the Philippines to do so. She will continue to prepare for Paris while competing for the Tigers in 2024.
- Finnegan comes off an impressive sophomore year in 2023. The all-arounder set new career high's on all four events last year with perfect scores on vault, beam and floor and a 9.925 on bars and took home 15 career individual titles.
- She owns four career perfect 10's with two on floor, one on vault and one on beam
- In her second season with the Tigers, she earned her first career All-SEC Honors on floor after finishing in the top two at the SEC Championships on floor with her score of 9.950
- In her NCAA Championships debut, she recorded a floor score of 9.9625 in the semifinals to tie the highest score on the event by an LSU gymnast at the championships
- Finnegan finished the 2023 season with six All-America honors (1 UB, 1 BB, 2 FX, 2 AA) and enters her iunior season with 15 career individual titles.

Kiya Johnson's Long-Awaited Return

- · A native of Dallas, Texas, Johnson will officially make her return to the PMAC this weekend. The eighttime All-American returns veteran routines to the Tiger's lineups this year
- Johnson is the 2021 SEC Floor Champion and Special of the Year and owns All-SEC honors
- · The all-arounder owns perfect scores on vault, beam and floor and a career high of 9.950 on bars
- · She enters her final season with seven 10's and 40 career individual titles.

- · A three-time All-American and All-SEC performer, Savannah Schoenherr is a sixth-year transfer out of Florida. The Athens, Georgia native brings depth on all four events for the Tigers. During her career as a Gator, she posted career high performances of 9.975 on vault, 9.975 on bars, 9.875 on beam and 9.925 on floor.
- A native of Murrietta, California, Jillian Hoffman is a fifth-year transfer from Utah who owns a powerful. yurchenko one and a half. While at Utah, she won three event titles as she appeared on vault and floor for
- · This year's freshmen class consists of Konnor McClain, Amari Drayton, Kylie Coen and Leah Miller.
- Arenas competed in every meet for the Tigers last season and appeared in McClain is a 2022 U.S. Champion and a five-time member of Team USA out of Las Vegas, Nevada who trained at Gymcats
 - · A native of Spring, Texas, Drayton is an Olympic trials qualifier and US National Team Member who trained at World Champions Centre
 - Kylie Coen is a J.O. All-Around Champion from Bedford, Texas who trained at Empire Gymnastics
 - Leah Miller is an elite gymnast out of Tucson, Arizona, who trained at Arizona Dynamics Gymnastics and owns top finishes on floor.

- Assistant coach Ashleigh Gnat is a 17-time All-American, four-time SEC event champion and 2017 NCAA Floor Champion. Gnat is in her fourth season as assistant coach with the Tigers. As the primary beam coach, she brings a wealth of knowledge with her own experience as one of the best gymnasts in school history.
- Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth enter their third season at LSU as they continue to lead the Tigers to top-10 finishes on vault and floor nationally
