It's just about continuing onto step three of our climb and we want to perform at the level that we're capable of and continue to improve week over week. Kentucky is a strong team and we know who we're on the floor with. They are very clean and execute exceptionally well. It will be great to get back in the PMAC. Ticket sales have been great for our home meets and I would just keep encouraging our fans to get there early and get in the stands. I want out students to show up in force and help us sell the arena out. I want our program to be able to announce a sellout and I want it to be an every meet occurence."

#### **Gymnastics Welcomes Kentucky In SEC Home Opener**

The No. 8 nationally ranked LSU Gymnastics team will welcome No. 6 Kentucky for their home SEC opener on Friday, January 19 at 8 p.m. CT in the PMAC. The Tigers meet this weekend is dedicated to cancer awareness. Introductions of the team begin at 7:52 p.m. CT with the first vault set for 8:05 p.m. CT on SEC Network. John Roethlesberger will be joined on the call by three-time Olympic gold medalist Aly Raisman in her NCAA broadcasting debut. Taylor Davis will be the on-site reporter. The competition between the Tigers and the Wildcats marks the 96th overall meeting between the two programs. LSU holds the series record over Kentucky at 85-10-0 and are 24-2-0 at home.

# **JAY CLARK**

**HEAD COACH • 4th Season** 

Jay Clark owns over 30 years of experience in college gymnastics and is one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2021 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Last year, he led the Tigers to their first Final Four appearance under his tenure as he continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive Top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars

championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against lowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the dub level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete collegiately at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

## 2024 LSU Gymnastics - Week 2 at Sprout's Farmers Market Collegiate Quad

#### **NOTEBOOK**

#### **Last Time On The Floor**

- The Tigers finished second in their last meet at the Sprouts Farmers Market Collegiate Quad Meet with their score of 197.150 in the Maverik Center.
- LSU broke the 197.000 mark on the national stage in only their second meet of the year and first road meet. The Tiger's score on the day topped No. 2 Utah (196.975) and No. 12 UCLA (197.100), falling only to No. 1 Oklahoma who won the meet with their score of 197.900.
- The inaugural competition on ABC that highlighted four of the top-teams in the country was the most viewed live regular season gymnastics meet in ESPN history, totaling over 600,000 viewers.
- The LSU bars squad boosted the team to a second-place finish in the quad meet with their score of 49.650 in the last rotation. The score was the highest recorded on the road on that event and matched the program's third highest bars score in school history.
- Seniors Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson competed in the all-around for the Tigers at the meet. Bryant posted scores of 9.900 or higher on every event while Johnson's return to the all-around was highlighted by her 9.950 performance on hars
- In only her second bars routine since beginning her collegiate career as a Tiger, freshman Konnor McClain earned her first perfect 10 on bars to keep the momentum going and help lift her team to victory over the Utes and the Bruins.
- The Tigers also posted a strong 49.525 on floor that was highlighted by junior Aleah Finnegan, who executed a nearly perfect routine and took home the title after scoring a 9.975. Fellow junior KJ Johnson also had a day at the meet, scoring a pair of 9.925's on vault and floor and finishing amongst the top-5 performers on those events at the meet.

#### **Scouting The Wildcats**

- In their last competition, Kentucky defeated No. 11 Auburn by a score of 197.475-197.025 in Neville Arena. Senior Raena Worley won her 22nd All-Around victory following a 39.650 overall score on the night.
- The Wildcats are 3-1 overall on the season entering their competition at LSU and are 1-0 in conference play.
- Kentucky is ranked No. 6 in the week two Road to Nationals standings while also placing in the top-10 on vault and beam. They have an average of 197.150 with their season high score coming in their last meet at Auburn.
- The Wildcats entered the 2024 season after their most accomplished season in program history last season, marking only the second team appearance at the national championships and finishing with their highest ranking of No. 6.

#### **Bryant, Drayton Earn Week One SEC Honors**

- The LSU Gymnastics pair of senior Haleigh Bryant and freshman Amari
   Drayton took home the first SEC awards of the 2024 season, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.
- Bryant was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week while freshman Amari
   Drayton earned Co-Freshman of the Week honors for their performances in the
   Tigers season opener against No. 14 Ohio State on Friday night.
- A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant finished as the top all-around gymnast in the country after week one with her score of 39.675. She helped lift the Tigers to a 196.975-196.775 victory over the Buckeyes to secure the squad's first victory of 2024.
- The senior's night was highlighted by her front pike half vault that scored a 9.950, while also posting a 9.875 on bars and a 9.925 on beam and floor for the Tigers. Bryant won the vault and all-around titles on the night to move her career total to 62, which ties her at eighth for most career individual titles in LSU history.
   Her 24 career vault titles and 20 all-around titles also place her amongst the topfive gymnasts in school history.
- Drayton had an impressive night against the Buckeyes in her collegiate gymnastics debut as she scored a pair of 9.925's on vault and floor.
- The freshman out of Spring, Texas started the night off with a stuck yurchenko
  one and a half on vault before anchoring on floor, capturing second place on vault
  and a share of second place on floor in her first competition with the Tigers.

## McClain Named SEC Specialist of the Week in Week Two

- Freshman Konnor McClain was named the SEC Specialist of the Week for the first conference award of her career, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.
- The honor comes after McClain scored her first career perfect 10 on bars in only her second collegiate routine on the event.

- The freshman's performance on Saturday helped lift the Tigers to a 49.650 in the last rotation, marking
  the program's highest recorded bars score on the road. LSU finished second at the Sprouts Collegiate
  Quad Meet, defeating No. 2 Utah and No. 12 UCLA.
- A native of Las Vegas, Nevada, McClain's perfect score earned her the event title at the meet, the first of her career. She currently sits amongst the top-20 bars performers in the nation after week two as she ranks No. 15 on the event.

#### **Week Two Road To Nationals Rankings**

- The Tigers head into this week ranked at No. 8 team in the national polls after finishing second in the Sprouts Farmers Market Collegiate Quad Meet last Saturday.
- LSU ranks as one of the top-five teams in the country on three events, sitting at No. 5 on vault (49.300), No. 5 on bars (49.513) and No. 2 on floor (49.525). Seven Tigers also placed in the individual rankings.
- Bryant remains one of the top all-arounders in the country after week two as she posted scores of
   9.900 or higher on every event for the Tigers on Saturday night. In addition to being No. 2 in the all-around nationally, the senior also owns top-25 placements on vault, bars, beam and floor.
- A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant owns averages of 9.900+ on every event after week two and an average of 39.650 in the all-around.
- KJ Johnson and Drayton both share a spot at No. 20 on vault in the individual event rankings. Johnson stuck her yurchenko full at the Sprouts Collegiate Quad that scored a 9.925 for the Tigers in the leadoff spot while Drayton posted a 9.825 in her only second routine on the event.
- Kiya Johnson shares fourth place in the bars rankings after matching her career high on Saturday with her score of 9.950 to help lift the Tigers in the last rotation. The fifth-year senior owns an average of 9.938 on the event through two meets.
- Jeffrey continues to be a consistent bars leadoff for the Tigers as she posted her second 9.900 of the year on the event on Saturday, which places her No. 22 nationally.
- McClain also earned a spot in the top-20 gymnasts on bars after scoring her first career perfect 10 last weekend
- Finnegan continues to be one of the top beam and floor performers in the country as she ranks fifth on floor and seventh on beam. The junior posted team-high scores on the two events for the Tigers on Saturday as she executed a nearly-perfect floor routine with her score of 9.975 and earned a 9.925 on beam. She owns an average of 9.938 on both events.
- Drayton also still holds a spot in the floor rankings at No. 10 after her debut in the Tigers season opener against Ohio State in week one.

#### **Reaching New Heights**

- The Tigers reached a new milestone as the program set a new record of over 8,000 season tickets sold prior to the start of the 2024 season.
- With the goal of selling out the PMAC, Tiger fans have the opportunity to set a new attendance record this year as the Tiger's home schedule features six meets inside the PMAC.
- LSU has finished in the top four of average attendance nationally for six consecutive years, claiming the No. 1 spot in 2022. Over 50,000 fans filled the seats of the PMAC through five home meets in 2023, earning LSU the highest attendance average in the SEC last season with an average of 12,075.

#### **Program History**

- Head Coach Jay Clark enters his fourth season leading the Tigers and 13th season overall as he
  continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program. He is joined on staff by Assistant Coaches Garrett
  Griffeth, Ashleigh Gnat and Courtney McCool Griffeth. Gnat is in her fourth season with the Tigers while
  the Griffeth duo enters their third season on staff.
- The Tigers climbed their way to the NCAA Championship Final in Fort Worth for the programs ninth appearance in the finals in 2023. The Final Four appearance marked the second time that LSU has advanced to the finals since the format began in 2019 and the first time under Clark's tenure.
- Last season marked the program's 38th straight appearance in the NCAA postseason and 40th overall
  appearance for the Tigers. With the team advancing out of regionals, LSU marked their 32nd program
  appearance in the NCAA Championships.
- LSU has a total of 16 individual national titles across 10 gymnasts in program history, including current senior Haleigh Bryant who was named the NCAA vault champion in 2021.
- The Tigers own four SEC Championship titles in program history, winning three consecutive titles from 2017 to 2019. The last time LSU took home the conference title was in 2019 in the Smoothie King Center, the site of this year's conference championship.

### **Our Emmy Award-Winning Docuseries "The Climb"**

- Season two of the Emmy Award-Winning LSU Gymnastics docuseries titled "The Climb" is set to air on ESPNU and locally on WBRZ beginning on Thursday, January 18.
- "The Climb" is an exclusive docuseries that follows the LSU Gymnastics program and allows fans to get to know the program on a more personal level. The series will be aired nationally on ESPNU throughout this season with episode one airing at 4 p.m. CT on Thursday prior to the Tigers home SEC opener against Kentucky on Friday, January 19 inside the PMAC.

The show, which is presented by Baton Rouge Super Chevy Dealers, gives fans behind-the-scenes access to the team like no other. From team meetings to one-on-one interviews with coaches and student-athletes, the docuseries allows viewers to get an inside look at the program and get to know the story behind the team.

- · ESPN will broadcast more than 20 SEC gymnastics meets across their networks throughout the 2024 season, while SEC Network will air 19 regular season meets.
- The 10th year of SEC Network's "Friday Night Heights" franchise returns in 2024, with a record nine consecutive weekends of action beginning on Friday, January 5.
- · No. 3 LSU will be featured in primetime on ESPN2 twice during the regular season, with big matchups against No. 2 Florida in Gainesville on February 23 at 6 p.m. CT and No. 8 Alabama on March 1 at 5 p.m. CT in Baton
- SEC Network will showcase the remaining five of the Tigers meets on television this upcoming season as LSU and Kentucky will face off at 8 p.m. CT on January 19 in Baton Rouge before meeting Missouri on the road at 7:30 p.m. CT on January 26.
- The Tigers will travel to face Georgia at 5 p.m. CT on February 9 and will host Auburn at 7 p.m. CT on February 16.
- · LSU's home meets against Arkansas and North Carolina will also be available via streaming on SEC Network+. The Tigers will host the Razorbacks on February 2 and will close out the regular season against the Tar Heels on March 15.

#### The Squad

The Tigers welcomed two sixth-year transfers this year in Savannah Schoenherr and Jillian Hoffman and four new freshmen as Konnor McClain, Amari Drayton, Kylie Coen and Leah Miller begin their first year in the Purple & Gold.
- Cammy Hall is a sixth-year returning from injury. Hall joined the Tigers in 2023 after spending four season at Utah, where she was an All-Pac 12 conference member on vault and owns a career high of 9.950 on the event.
- Fifth-year seniors Kiya Johnson, Alyona Shchennikova and Kai Rivers all returned for their final year of competition with the Tigers.
- · Haleigh Bryant, Sierra Ballard, Chase Brock, Elena Arenas and Olivia Dunne make up the true senior class.
- be one of the top all-around gymnasts in the country this year. She finished 2023 with averages of 9.900+ on all four apparatuses and owns career

highs of 9.950 on beam and perfect 10's on vault, bars and floor

- · Ballard led off on floor for the Tigers in every meet last year while also competing on beam in 13 meets. She owns career highs of 9.925 on both events.
- · Brock was a key contributor in the vault and floor lineups in 2023, posting career high routines of 9.975 on vault and 9.925 on floor.
- Dunne appeared in the bars lineup four times in 2023 and owns a career high of 9.925 on the event. She has appeared in the floor lineups through the squad's two meets so far this year.
- Aleah Finnegan, Alexis Jeffrey, Tori Tatum, and KJ Johnson all begin their junior season.
- · Jeffrey and Tatum were key contributors to the bars lineups in 2023 as Jeffrey appeared in the lineup in
- KJ Johnson battled injury in 2023 after the squad's meet against Florida, but she returns ready to contribute for the Tigers. She owns career highs of 9.95 on vault, 9.875 on beam and 9.950 on floor.
- · Ashley Cowan, Bryce Wilson and Annie Beard enter their sophomore year with Tigers.
- In their first year with the Tigers, Cowan and Wilson stepped up for their team and competed in multiple meets as freshmen.
- · Annie Beard did not compete in 2023 due to injury. She made her first competition debut on beam at the Tigers last meet in the Sprouts Collegiate Quad Meet.

#### **Bryant Shines In Year Three, Enters Senior Season**

- · A native of Cornelius, N.C., Bryant enters her fourth year at LSU after a historical junior season that etched her name into the record books. She continues to be one of the top gymnasts in the country in her
- · A few of her accomplishments last season include Honda Award Finalist, Central Region Gymnast of the Year, three-time SEC Gymnast of the week, All-SEC floor honors and nine All-America honors, which marked the most in a single season by an LSU gymnast.
- · She went 64 for 64 routines for the Tigers as she competed in the all-around in every meet in 2023 and became the first LSU gymnast to average a 9.900+ across all four events in a season.
- She matched the highest all-around score in school history with her 39.875 against West Virginia and scored the second highest ever all-around score for LSU in the NCAA Championship (39.725) in 2023.
- She is also the school's all-time perfect 10 leader, with eight on vault, one on bars and one on floor
- Bryant picked up right where she left off last year as she is the No. 2 all-around gymnast in the country after week two. She owns 62 career individual titles and 17 All-America honors entering her third meet of the year in 2024
- The senior owns averages of 9.900+ across all four events thus far in 2024

#### **Olympic Qualifier Finnegan Begins Year Three**

- Finnegan will continue to be a key contributor for the Tigers in 2024 as she competed in the all-around in all but one meet last year. The Lee's Summit, Missouri will represent the Tigers at the 2024 Paris Olympics at the Smoothie King Center in New Orleans, Louisiana, with the first session after booking her Olympic ticket at the 2023 World Championships in Antwerp last October.
  - Finnegan earned an all-around score of 51.366 in her world championship debut to become the first active gymnast in school history to become an Olympian and first ever female gymnast from the Philippines to do so. She will continue to prepare for Paris while competing for the Tigers in 2024.
  - Finnegan comes off an impressive sophomore year in 2023. The all-arounder set new career high's on all four events last year with perfect scores on vault, beam and floor and a 9.925 on bars and took home 15
  - She owns four career perfect 10's with two on floor, one on vault and one on beam
  - In only her second season with the Tigers, she earned her first career All-SEC Honors on floor after finishing in the top two at the SEC Championships on floor with her score of 9.950
  - In her NCAA Championships debut, she recorded a floor score of 9.9625 in the semifinals to tie the highest score on the event by an LSU gymnast at the championships
  - Finnegan finished the 2023 season with six All-America honors (1 UB, 1 BB, 2 FX, 2 AA) and enters her junior season with 15 career individual titles.

#### Kiya Johnson's Long-Awaited Return

- · A native of Dallas, Texas, Johnson officially made her return to the PMAC in the Tigers season opener against Ohio State after suffering a season-ending injury in 2023. The eight-time All-American returns veteran routines to the Tiger's lineups this year.
- Johnson is the 2021 SEC Floor Champion and Special of the Year and owns All-SEC honors
- The all-arounder owns perfect scores on vault, beam and floor and a career high of 9.950 on bars
- She enters her final season with seven 10's and 40 career individual titles.

#### The Coaching Staff

- · Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons prior to his stint as head coach, was named the third head coach of the Fighting Tigers in 2021. Clark owns over 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- Assistant coach Ashleigh Gnat is a 17-time All-American, four-time SEC event champion and 2017 NCAA Floor Champion. Gnat is in her fourth season as assistant coach with the Tigers. As the primary beam • Bryant competed in every meet for the Tigers last year and will continue to coach, she brings a wealth of knowledge with her own experience as one of the best gymnasts in school
  - Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth enter their third season at LSU as they continue to lead the Tigers to top-10 finishes on yault and floor nationally
