#### The Matchup **Gymnastics Hosts No. 12 Auburn Friday Night**

#### The No. 3 LSU Gymnastics team is set to host No. 12 Auburn for a Friday Night Heights showdown in the PMAC on Friday, February 16. The competition between the Tigers begins at 8 p.m. CT, with introductions of the team starting at 7:52 and the first vault at 8:05 p.m. CT. There will be a scrunchie giveaway as well as free t-shirts for students. Doors to the arena open at 6:30 p.m. CT. The last time LSU and Auburn faced off during the regular season was in 2023, when LSU fell on the road. The home Tigers are 28-4-0 in the PMAC against Auburn and own the 85-18-0 overall record.

# **JAY CLARK** HEAD COACH • 4th Season

Jay Clark owns over 30 years of experience in college gymnastics and is one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2021 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Last year, he led the Tigers to their first Final Four appearance under his tenure as he continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive Top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the secondhighest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against lowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete collegiately at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

### **NOTEBOOK**

#### **Last Time On The Floor**

• The No. 3 LSU Gymnastics team defeated No. 19 Georgia by a score of 197.625-196.300 last Friday night in Stegeman Coliseum.

• The Tiger's win on the night marked their sixth victory over a top-20 opponent so far this year and first on the road in a dual-meet. The score was a season high on the road as the squad hit all 24 routines in Athens and continues to improve each week.

• Haleigh Bryant led the Tigers as she etched her name into the school record books. The senior earned her first career perfect 10 on beam against the Bulldogs, making her the first LSU gymnast to achieve perfection on every event

and only the 14th in the NCAA. The 10 was the 13th perfect score of her career.
Junior Alexis Jeffrey took home a share of the bars victory with her score of

9.875 for her first title this year.

• Freshman Konnor McClain posted a 9.925 on beam to finish second on the night, only behind Bryant's perfect score.

• Kiya Johnson also posted a solid performance for the Tigers in the all-around as she finished the meet with a 39.525.

• The Tigers secured the win over the Bulldogs with a final score of 197.625-197.075 in a solid road performance.

• Bryant finished as the top performer in the meet with a 39.750 in the meet to earn her fourth all-around title this year. The senior also took home the titles on vault (9.95), beam (10) and floor (9.95).

#### **Scouting The Auburn Tigers**

• LSU has not lost to Auburn at home since 2006. Since then, LSU leads the regular season home/away series 12-5.

The Auburn gymnastics team moved up to No. 12 in this week's Road To Nationals rankings after their performance last Friday.

• The team's current average bumped up to 197.079 after scoring a seasonhigh 197.725 last Friday in their win over then-No. 7 Alabama.

• Auburn's rankings places them amongst the rest of the SEC in the top 20 – Florida (No. 6), Alabama (No. 9), Missouri (No. 14), Arkansas (No. 16), and Georgia (No. 18).

The orange & blue Tigers are fifth in the conference entering this weekend.

• Auburn's beam squad is ranked fifth nationally with a 49.250 average after scoring a season-high 49.4750 on Friday. The floor crew is 12th with a 49.408. The vault team moved up to 12th with a 49.238 after tying a program record last week with a 49.500. Bars remain in the top 20 with a 49.183 average.

• Individually, fifth-year Cassie Stevens is 19th in the all-around with a 39.500 average and is 18th nationally on vault while senior Gabby McLaughlin is 19th nationally on beam and leads the team on floor with a 9.892 average.

#### Week Six Road To Nationals Rankings

• The Tigers are holding steady at No. 3 in the national polls in this week's rankings after defeating No. 19 Georgia in Athens last Friday night.

• The Tiger's win on Friday marked the team's 21st consecutive win over the Bulldogs and their sixth victory over a top-20 opponent so far this year. The squad continues to improve each week as they hit all 24 routines and recorded a season-high on the road.

• LSU's victory over Georgia boosted their team average to 197.596 to hold their spot in the top-five nationally. The Tigers also rank in the top-10 on all four events for the first time this year with their averages of 49.392 (3) on vault, 49.454 (3) on bars, 49.213 (9) on beam and 49.538 (2) on floor.

• Bryant remains the top gymnast in the country for the fourth consecutive week after her record-setting performance on Friday night. The senior ranks No. 1 in the all-around with her average of 39.740 and owns top-10 placements on every event: third on vault, 10th on bars, fifth on beam and second on floor.

• Fifth-year senior Kiya Johnson placed amongst the top-25 gymnasts in the country as she sits at No. 21 in the rankings. The senior had another solid allaround performance for the Tigers last weekend as she posted scores of 9.90 on vault, 9.850 on bars, 9.85 on beam and 9.925 against the Bulldogs.

- The Dallas native also earned a spot in the individual floor rankings at No. 7 with her average of 9.935 on the event.

• Freshman Konnor McClain enters this week as one of the top-10 floor performers with her average of 9.925 on the event.

#### **Reaching New Heights**

• The Tigers reached a new milestone as the program set a new record of over 8,000 season tickets sold prior to the start of the 2024 season.

• With the goal of selling out the PMAC, Tiger fans have the opportunity to set a

new attendance record this year as the Tiger's home schedule features six meets inside the PMAC.
LSU has finished in the top four of average attendance nationally for six consecutive years, claiming the No. 1 spot in 2022. Over 50,000 fans filled the seats of the PMAC through five home meets in 2023, earning LSU the highest attendance average in the SEC last season with an average of 12,075.

#### **Program History**

• Head Coach Jay Clark enters his fourth season leading the Tigers and 13th season overall as he continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program. He is joined on staff by Assistant Coaches Garrett Griffeth, Ashleigh Gnat and Courtney McCool Griffeth. Gnat is in her fourth season with the Tigers while the Griffeth duo enters their third season on staff.

• The Tigers climbed their way to the NCAA Championship Final in Fort Worth for the programs ninth appearance in the finals in 2023. The Final Four appearance marked the second time that LSU has advanced to the finals since the format began in 2019 and the first time under Clark's tenure.

 Last season marked the program's 38th straight appearance in the NCAA postseason and 40th overall appearance for the Tigers. With the team advancing out of regionals, LSU marked their 32nd program appearance in the NCAA Championships.

• LSU has a total of 16 individual national titles across 10 gymnasts in program history, including current senior Haleigh Bryant who was named the NCAA vault champion in 2021.

• The Tigers own four SEC Championship titles in program history, winning three consecutive titles from 2017 to 2019. The last time LSU took home the conference title was in 2019 in the Smoothie King Center, the site of this year's conference championship.

access to the team like no other. From team meetings to one-on-one interviews with coaches and studentathletes, the docuseries allows viewers to get an inside look at the program and get to know the story
behind the team.

She enters her fourth vear at LSU after a historical junior season that etched her name into the record books and continues to be one of the top gymnasts in the country in her senior season

· A few of her accomplishments last season include Honda Award Finalist, Central Region Gymnast of the Year, three-time SEC Gymnast of the week, All-SEC floor honors and nine All-America honors, which marked the most in a single season by an LSU gymnast.

· She went 64 for 64 routines for the Tigers as she competed in the allaround in every meet in 2023 and became the first LSU gymnast to average a 9.900+ across all four events in a season.

 Bryant is the all-time perfect 10 leader in school history as she has already added three more to her resume in 2024. She owns 13 perfect scores in her career with eight on vault, two on bars, two on floor and one on beam

· The Cornelius, North Carolina native moved her totals 27 titles on vault, six on beam, seven on floor and 23 in the all-around to tie Sarah Finnegan for the third-most all-around titles in program history. She now owns 73 titles in her career, which is just one shy of tying Susan Jackson at sixth for most career individual titles.

Missouri will represent the Tigers at the 2024 Paris Olympics after booking her Olympic ticket at the 2023

· Finnegan earned an all-around score of 51.366 in her world championship debut to become the first active gymnast in school history to become an Olympian and first ever female gymnast from the Philippines to do so. She will continue to prepare for Paris while competing for the Tigers in 2024.

• Finnegan comes off an impressive sophomore year in 2023. The all-arounder set new career high's on all four events last year with perfect scores on yault, beam and floor and a 9.925 on bars and took home 15 career individual titles.

- · She owns four career perfect 10's with two on floor, one on vault and one on beam
- In only her second season with the Tigers, she earned her first career All-SEC Honors on floor after finishing in the top two at the SEC Championships on floor with her score of 9.950

 In her NCAA Championships debut, she recorded a floor score of 9.9625 in the semifinals to tie the highest score on the event by an LSU gymnast at the championships

• Finnegan finished the 2023 season with six All-America honors (1 UB, 1 BB, 2 FX, 2 AA) and enters her junior season with 15 career individual titles.

• The LSU Gymnastics pair of senior Haleigh Bryant and freshman Amari Drayton took home the first SEC awards of the 2024 season, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.

• Bryant was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week while freshman Amari Drayton earned Co-Freshman of the Week honors for their performances in the Tigers season opener against No. 14 Ohio State on Friday night.

• A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant finished as the top all-around gymnast in the country after week one with her score of 39.675. She helped lift the Tigers to a 196.975-196.775 victory over the Buckeyes to secure the squad's first victory of 2024.

• The senior's night was highlighted by her front pike half vault that scored a 9.950, while also posting a 9.875 on bars and a 9.925 on beam and floor for the Tigers. Bryant won the vault and all-around titles on the night to move her career total to 62, which ties her at eighth for most career individual titles in LSU history. Her 24 career vault titles and 20 all-around titles also place her amongst the top-five gymnasts in school history.

 Drayton had an impressive night against the Buckeyes in her collegiate gymnastics debut as she scored a pair of 9.925's on vault and floor.

• The freshman out of Spring, Texas started the night off with a stuck yurchenko one and a half on vault before anchoring on floor, capturing second place on vault and a share of second place on floor in her first competition with the Tigers.

#### McClain Named SEC Specialist of the Week in Week Two

Freshman Konnor McClain was named the SEC Specialist of the Week for the first conference award of her career, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.

The honor comes after McClain scored her first career perfect 10 on bars in only her second collegiate routine
on the event.

• The freshman's performance on Saturday helped lift the Tigers to a 49.650 in the last rotation, marking the program's highest recorded bars score on the road. LSU finished second at the Sprouts Collegiate Quad Meet, defeating No. 2 Utah and No. 12 UCLA.

 A native of Las Vegas, Nevada, McClain's perfect score earned her the event title at the meet, the first of her career. She currently sits amongst the top-20 bars performers in the nation after week two as she ranks No. 15 on the event.

#### Bryant Named SEC Gymnast of the Week For Second Time This Year

• Senior Haleigh Bryant continues to be one of the top performers in the country as she was named SEC Gymnast of the Week for the second time this year, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon. She owns averages of 9.900+ on every event after three weeks of competition.

• Bryant helped lead her team to a 198.125 over No. 6 Kentucky on Friday night, marking the second highest score by any team in the country and the highest score by any SEC team so far this year.

• This past weekend against the Wildcats, Bryant posted scores of 9.900 or better on every event for the second week in a row. After performing a nearly-perfect vault with her score of 9.975 on Friday, Bryant continued her night with a perfect score on bars, followed by a 9.900 on beam and finished the night with a 9.950 on floor.
