Storylines

- The Tigers enter this week as the No. 2 team in the country with their average of 197.696 in the final week of average rankings.
- LSU owns the top score in the country through seven weeks of competition and are one of only six teams who have surpassed the 198 mark this year.
- LSU had four athletes combine for eight SEC awards in 2024, the most by any school.
- After having been in the top-10 across the board last week, LSU improved to the top-5 on every event for the first time this year following their performance against Auburn.
- The Tigers have posted three scores of 198+ this year, the second most by any team on that scale.
- Bryant was named an AAI Award Nominee, which is a highly regarded award given to the top senior gymnast in the nation.
- The senior duo of Haleigh Bryant and Kiya Johnson currently rank amongst the top-25 all-around gymnasts in the nation.
- This is the 12th consecutive season both Florida and LSU bring a top-10 ranking into their annual dual meet.
- The Tiger rank second on vault, third on bars, fifth on beam and second on floor nationally.

Quote from head coach Jay Clark

"We haven't executed on the highest level yet. In terms of what our next step is, it's just to improve our performance. I would like for us to perform like it's a home meet and have a complete performance on the road. This meet is always a good rivalry and we know it'll be a tough environment, but at this point, it's just about us measuring ourselves against ourselves."

The Matchup

Gymnastics Faces No. 5 Florida On ESPN2

The No. 2 LSU Gymnastics team (7-2, 4-1 SEC) will face No. 5 Florida (9-1, 4-1 SEC) in the nation's top-dual of the weekend on Friday, February 23 at 6 p.m. CT. The meet marks the 32nd consecutive meeting both teams bring top-10 rankings as the two will compete in front of a sold-out Exactech Arena on Friday. The competition between the Tigers and the Gators will air nationally on ESPN2 with Bart Conner and Bridget Sloan on the call. Taylor Davis will be the on-site reporter. The first routine is set for 6:02 p.m. CT inside the Stephen C. O'Connell Center as LSU will begin on bars.



JAY CLARK

HEAD COACH • 4th Season

Jay Clark owns over 30 years of experience in college gymnastics and is one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2021 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Last year, he led the Tigers to their first Final Four appearance under his tenure as he continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive Top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars

championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the second-highest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against Iowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete collegiately at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

2024 LSU Gymnastics - Week 8 at Florida

NOTEBOOK

Last Time On The Floor

- The No. 3 LSU Gymnastics team defeated No. 12 Auburn in front of a sold out crowd by a score of 198.300-197.100 last Friday night in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center.
- The victory marked LSU's eighth straight win over the visiting Tigers when facing off in the PMAC. The score was also the squad's third 198 of the year, making LSU the team with the second-most scores on that scale so far this year.
- The Tigers recorded a season high 49.725 on beam, which matched the highest score on the event in program history. The score has only been achieved four times in school history, with the last time being in 2018.
- Finnegan performed a perfect routine, notching her fifth perfect score and third on floor
- LSU hit every routine in front of 12,740 fans in the PMAC, the seventh largest attendance in school history. The night was highlighted by a program-high beam performance that helped the team earn the victory over No. 12 Auburn and secure their fifth conference win and seventh over a ranked opponent this year.
- Five LSU Tigers had season high performances against Auburn. Finnegan recorded season highs on vault, floor and beam, while Kiya Johnson's beam routine was also a season high. Cowan matched her career high on bars and Jeffrey set a new career high on beam with her 9.925 performance.
- Finnegan finished the meet as the top performer on vault and floor. She now owns 18 titles in her career and added to her individual event titles with six on floor and two on vault.
- Bryant earned a share of the bars title with teammates Schoenherr as well her third straight all-around title and fifth this year. She finished the night with a score of 39.700.
- It was Schoenherr's second title in the Purple & Gold and second on bars.
- McClain's beam routine earned her the victory on the event, moving her total to four this year – three of those coming on beam.

Scouting The Florida Gators

- Friday is the 12th consecutive season both LSU and Florida bring a top-10 ranking into their annual dual meet. The Tigers own an overall series record of 44-77-0 against the Gators and are 8-28-0 away from home. The last time LSU defeated Florida on the road was in 2018.
- A season-best 197.925 elevated No. 6 Florida to win their last competition at the Mizzou at the Lou quad meet. Florida is the nation's only team to improve its score in each 2024 meet.
- Florida's Anya Pilgrim claimed her second consecutive SEC Freshman Gymnast of the Week honor after her performance at Mizzou to the Lou quad meet.
- The freshman, as well as junior Leanne Wong, are amongst the nation's top all-around gymnasts.
- The Gators improved to No. 5 in the week seven rankings with their average of 197.517 and placed in the top-15 on every event nationally. Pilgrim, Wong, Victoria Nguyen and Sloane Blakely make up the four Gators who earned spots in the individual event rankings this week.
- LSU and Florida make up two of the three conference teams that are tied at the top with 4-1 records, along with Kentucky.

Week Seven Road To Nationals Rankings

- The Tigers moved up to No. 2 in the national polls after defeating No. 12 Auburn last Friday night in the PMAC.
- The victory was the team's fourth conference win and seventh win over a ranked opponent this year. The night was highlighted by a perfect floor score from Aleah Finnegan and the LSU beam squad who matched the program record score with their 49.725 on the event.
- The Tigers took down Auburn for the eighth consecutive time in the PMAC. The score was also the squad's third 198 of the year, making LSU the team with the second-most scores on that scale so far this year.
- LSU improved their average to 197.696 on the weekend in the final week of average rankings before moving to National Qualifying Score (NQS). The squads performance on beam against Auburn helped move them to No. 5 on the event, moving LSU to rank in the top-five nationally on all four events for the first time this year.
- The Tigers enter this week with averages of 49.404 (2) on vault, 49.457 (3) on bars, 49.286 (5) on beam and 49.550 (2) on floor.
- Haleigh Bryant was the top performer in the Tigers last meet against Auburn as she took home her third straight all-around title this year and earned a share of the bars title.

- Bryant remains the No. 1 gymnast in the country for the fifth consecutive week with her average of 39.733 in the all-around. The senior owns an average of 9.900 or higher on every event, placing her in the top-10 across the board in the individual event rankings. She has ranked amongst the top-25 performers on every event for six consecutive weeks.
- Kiya Johnson is one of the top-25 gymnasts in the country as she sits at No. 21 in the all-around with her average with 39.465. The fifth-year senior also earned a spot in the individual floor rankings at No. 9 with her average of 9.935.
- Konnor McClain holds onto her spot in the individual floor rankings at No. 10 with her average of 9.925 on the event.

Reaching New Heights

- The Tigers reached a new milestone as the program set a new record of over 8,000 season tickets sold prior to the start of the 2024 season.
- This year, the Tiger's home schedule features six meets inside the PMAC with a chance to set a new attendance record.
- LSU saw a record and sold out crowd in their last meet against No. 12 Auburn as 12,740 fans showed out for the Friday Night Heights competition in the PMAC.
- LSU has finished in the top four of average attendance nationally for six consecutive years, claiming the No. 1 spot in 2022. Over 50,000 fans filled the seats of the PMAC through five home meets in 2023, earning LSU the highest attendance average in the SEC last season with an average of 12,075.

Program History

- Head Coach Jay Clark enters his fourth season leading the Tigers and 13th season overall as he continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program. He is joined on staff by Assistant Coaches Garrett Griffith, Ashleigh Gnat and Courtney McCool Griffith. Gnat is in her fourth season with the Tigers while the Griffith duo enters their third season on staff.
- The Tigers climbed their way to the NCAA Championship Final in Fort Worth for the programs ninth appearance in the finals in 2023. The Final Four appearance marked the second time that LSU has advanced to the finals since the format began in 2019 and the first time under Clark's tenure.
- Last season marked the program's 38th straight appearance in the NCAA postseason and 40th overall appearance for the Tigers. With the team advancing out of regionals, LSU marked their 32nd program appearance in the NCAA Championships.
- LSU has a total of 16 individual national titles across 10 gymnasts in program history, including current senior Haleigh Bryant who was named the NCAA vault champion in 2021.
- The Tigers own four SEC Championship titles in program history, winning three consecutive titles from 2017 to 2019. The last time LSU took home the conference title was in 2019 in the Smoothie King Center, the site of this year's conference championship.

Our Emmy Award-Winning Docuseries "The Climb"

- Season two of the Emmy Award-Winning LSU Gymnastics docuseries titled "The Climb" will air nationally on ESPNU and on local affiliates throughout the 2024 season.

- The show, which is presented by Baton Rouge Super Chevy Dealers, gives fans behind-the-scenes access to the team like no other. From team meetings to one-on-one interviews with coaches and student-athletes, the docuseries allows viewers to get an inside look at the program and get to know the story behind the team.
- Season one of the all-access docuseries won an award at the 2023 Suncoast Regional Emmys for the category of best sport program post-produced or edited series after following the team through an unforgettable journey to the Final Four in Fort Worth, Texas last season.
- The show – produced by Giovanni Lamonte and LSU Athletics team of creatives at South Stadium Productions – will once again take fans through the 2024 season, as the Tigers embark on a new journey to the championship under head coach Jay Clark.
- Season two of "The Climb" will feature eight episodes throughout the 2024 season that will air nationally on ESPNU and local affiliates, including a regional broadcast on Bally Sports Southwest.
- Viewers can find all full-length episodes from season one and the new season on LSU GOLD, the home of "The Climb" and all LSU sports content.

Tigers On The National Stage

- The Tigers will be featured on television seven times in 2024
- ESPN will broadcast more than 20 SEC gymnastics meets across their networks throughout the 2024 season, while SEC Network will air 19 regular season meets.
- The 10th year of SEC Network's "Friday Night Heights" franchise returns in 2024, with a record nine consecutive weekends of action beginning on Friday, January 5.
- No. 3 LSU will be featured in primetime on ESPN2 twice during the regular season, with big matchups against No. 2 Florida in Gainesville on February 23 at 6 p.m. CT and No. 8 Alabama on March 1 at 5 p.m. CT in Baton Rouge.
- SEC Network will showcase the remaining five of the Tigers meets on television this upcoming season.
- LSU's home meets against Arkansas and North Carolina will also be available via streaming on SEC Network+. The Tigers will host the Razorbacks on February 2 and will close out the regular season against the Tar Heels on March 15.

NOTEBOOK

- Both sessions of the 2024 SEC Gymnastics Championship will be televised on SEC Network. The event will take place on Saturday, March 23 at the Smoothie King Center in New Orleans, Louisiana, with the first session of flips slated for 2:30 p.m. CT while the evening session begins at 7 p.m. CT.
- ABC is the home of the 2024 NCAA National Collegiate Women's Gymnastics Championships, with the Championship Final airing live on Saturday, April 20, at 3 p.m. CT. The semifinal rounds are set for Thursday, April 18 on ESPN2, with Semifinal I beginning at 3:30 p.m. and Semifinal II at 8 p.m. CT. Surround championship coverage of each apparatus will stream live on ESPN+.
- Also returning this season is streaming coverage of NCAA Regionals on ESPN+, showcasing real-time action of every gymnast and apparatus from regional rounds in Ann Arbor, Michigan, Berkeley, California, Fayetteville, Arkansas, and Gainesville, Florida.
- All meets on ESPN networks will be available via the ESPN App on smartphones, tablets, connected streaming devices and espn.com/watch.

The Squad

- This year's roster is composed of 22 gymnasts with 11 seniors, four juniors, three sophomores and four freshmen. The Tigers welcomed two sixth-year transfers this year in Savannah Schoenherr and Jillian Hoffman and four new freshmen as Konnor McClain, Amari Drayton, Kylie Coen and Leah Miller begin their first year in the Purple & Gold.
- Cammy Hall is a sixth-year returning from injury. Hall joined the Tigers in 2023 after spending four seasons at Utah, where she was an All-Pac 12 conference member on vault and owns a career high of 9.950 on the event.
- Fifth-year seniors Kiya Johnson, Alyona Shchennikova and Kai Rivers all returned for their final year of competition with the Tigers.
- Haleigh Bryant, Sierra Ballard, Chase Brock, Elena Arenas and Olivia Dunne make up the true senior class.
- Bryant competed in every meet for the Tigers last year and will continue to be one of the top all-around gymnasts in the country this year.
- Ballard led off on floor for the Tigers in every meet last year while also competing on beam in 13 meets. She owns career highs of 9.925 on both events.
- Brock was a key contributor in the vault and floor lineups in 2023, posting career high routines of 9.975 on vault and 9.925 on floor.
- Dunne appeared in the bars lineup four times in 2023 and owns a career high of 9.925 on the event. She has appeared in the floor lineups for the Tigers twice this year.
- Aleah Finnegan, Alexis Jeffrey, Tori Tatum, and KJ Johnson all begin their junior season.
- Jeffrey and Tatum were key contributors to the bars lineups in 2023 as Jeffrey appeared in the lineup in every meet and Tatum appeared in all but two on bars.
- KJ Johnson battled injury in 2023 after the squad's meet against Florida, but has been a constant in LSU's vault and floor lineups so far this year. She owns career highs of 9.95 on vault, 9.875 on beam and 9.950 on floor.
- Ashley Cowan, Bryce Wilson and Annie Beard enter their sophomore year with Tigers.
- In their first year with the Tigers, Cowan and Wilson stepped up for their team and competed in multiple meets as freshmen.
- Annie Beard did not compete in 2023 due to injury. She made her first competition debut on beam at the Sprouts Collegiate Quad Meet.

Bryant Shines In Year Three, Enters Senior Season

- Bryant is in her fourth season at LSU and is not only one of the leaders on the team this year, but one of the best gymnasts in NCAA and LSU history. She is the epitome of what it means to be a Tiger on and off the competition floor as she continues to etch her name into the school record books in her senior campaign.
- A native of Cornelius, N.C., Bryant is a 17-time All-American (5 VT, 3 UB, 2 BB, 3 FX, 4 AA) and three-time All-SEC member. She enters her fourth year at LSU after a historical junior season that etched her name into the record books and continues to be one of the top gymnasts in the country in her senior season.
- A few of her accomplishments last season include Honda Award Finalist, Central Region Gymnast of the Year, three-time SEC Gymnast of the week, All-SEC floor honors and nine All-America honors, which marked the most in

a single season by an LSU gymnast.

- She went 64 for 64 routines for the Tigers as she competed in the all-around in every meet in 2023 and became the first LSU gymnast to average a 9.900+ across all four events in a season.
- As she garnered multiple honors in her junior season, Bryant picked right back up where she left off this year. She continues to be one of the top competitors in the country as she and the Tigers look for their first national title in 2024. So far in her senior season, she has remained the No. 1 gymnast in the country for five consecutive weeks and enters week eight with an average of 39.733 in the all-around.
- Bryant is the all-time perfect 10 leader in school history as she has already added three more to her resume in 2024. She owns career high's of perfect 10's on every event, as she recorded her first career perfect score on beam against Georgia this year to complete her gym slam and become the first LSU gymnast to do so.
- Bryant owns 13 perfect scores in her career (8 VT, 2 UB, 2 FX, 1 BB), the most by any gymnast in school history.
- The senior currently owns 27 titles on vault, 11 on bars, six on beam, seven on floor and 24 in the all-around for a total of 75 career individual titles. Her 75 total individual career titles sits at sixth all-time in school history.
- Bryant remains the No. 1 gymnast in the country for the fifth consecutive week with her average of 39.733 in the all-around. The senior owns an average of 9.900 or higher on every event, placing her in the top-10 across the board in the individual event rankings. She has ranked amongst the top-25 performers on every event for six consecutive weeks.
- She owns an average of 9.900 or higher on every event, placing her amongst the top-10 performers on every event. Bryant has earned a spot in the individual event rankings through all seven weeks of competition thus far.
- She has also earned four SEC Gymnast of the Week honors for her performance on the floor in 2024, the most by any gymnast.
- Bryant remains the top gymnast in the country for the fourth consecutive week after her record-setting performance on Friday night. The senior ranks No. 1 in the all-around with her average of 39.740.

Olympic Qualifier Finnegan Begins Year Three

- Finnegan continues to be a key contributor for the Tigers in 2024 as she competed in the all-around in all but one meet last year. The Lee's Summit, Missouri will represent the Tigers at the 2024 Paris Olympics after booking her Olympic ticket at the 2023 World Championships in Antwerp last October.
- Finnegan earned an all-around score of 51.366 in her world championship debut to become the first active gymnast in school history to become an Olympian and first ever female gymnast from the Philippines to do so. She will continue to prepare for Paris while competing for the Tigers in 2024.
- Finnegan comes off an impressive sophomore year in 2023. The all-arounder set new career high's on all four events last year with perfect scores on vault, beam and floor and a 9.925 on bars and took home 15 career individual titles.
- In only her second season with the Tigers, she earned her first career All-SEC Honors on floor after finishing in the top two at the SEC Championships on floor with her score of 9.950
- In her NCAA Championships debut, she recorded a floor score of 9.9625 in the semifinals to tie the highest score on the event by an LSU gymnast at the championships
- Finnegan finished the 2023 season with six All-America honors (1 UB, 1 BB, 2 FX, 2 AA) and enters her junior season with 15 career individual titles.
- She has been a mainstay in the vault, beam and floor lineups for the Tigers in 2024.
- The junior recorded her third perfect score on floor in the Tigers last meet against Auburn. She now owns four career perfect 10's with three on floor, one on vault and one on beam

Kiya Johnson's Long-Awaited Return

- A native of Dallas, Texas, Johnson officially made her return to the PMAC in the Tigers season opener against Ohio State after suffering a season-ending injury in 2023. The eight-time All-American returns veteran routines to the Tiger's lineups this year.
- Johnson is the 2021 SEC Floor Champion and Special of the Year and owns All-SEC honors
- The all-arounder owns eight perfect scores across three events and a career-high 9.950 on bars
- Johnson scored her fifth perfect on floor this year in a full circle moment against Kentucky, the same team and event that she got injured last year. She had a season-high performance against the Wildcats, taking home the win on floor and finishing the night with a 39.650 in the all-around. Her floor title moved her career total to 16 on the event and 43 overall.
- The fifth-year senior continues to build momentum each meet as she ranks in the top-25 all-arounders in the country and recorded a season-high 39.675 in the all-around for the Tigers against Arkansas.

The Coaching Staff

- Jay Clark, who served on staff for eight seasons prior to his stint as head coach, was named the third head coach of the Fighting Tigers in 2021. Clark owns over 30 years of NCAA Gymnastics experience and is one of the most respected coaches in the country.
- Assistant coach Ashleigh Gnat is a 17-time All-American, four-time SEC event champion and 2017 NCAA Floor Champion. Gnat is in her fourth season as assistant coach with the Tigers. As the primary beam coach, she brings a wealth of knowledge with her own experience as one of the best gymnasts in school history.
- Garrett Griffeth and Courtney McCool Griffeth enter their third season at LSU as they continue to lead the Tigers to top-10 finishes on vault and floor nationally.

Bryant, Drayton Earn Week One SEC Honors

- The LSU Gymnastics pair of senior Haleigh Bryant and freshman Amari Drayton took home the first SEC awards of the 2024 season, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.
- Bryant was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week while freshman Amari Drayton earned Co-Freshman of the Week honors for their performances in the Tigers season opener against No. 14 Ohio State on Friday night.
- A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant finished as the top all-around gymnast in the country after week one with her score of 39.675. She helped lift the Tigers to a 196.975-196.775 victory over the Buckeyes to secure the squad's first victory of 2024.
- The senior's night was highlighted by her front pike half vault that scored a 9.950, while also posting a 9.875 on bars and a 9.925 on beam and floor for the Tigers. Bryant won the vault and all-around titles on the night to move her career total to 62, which ties her at eighth for most career individual titles in LSU history. Her 24 career vault titles and 20 all-around titles also place her amongst the top-five gymnasts in school history.
- Drayton had an impressive night against the Buckeyes in her collegiate gymnastics debut as she scored a pair of 9.925's on vault and floor.
- The freshman out of Spring, Texas started the night off with a stuck yurchenko one and a half on vault before anchoring on floor, capturing second place on vault and a share of second place on floor in her first competition with the Tigers.

McClain Named SEC Specialist of the Week in Week Two

- Freshman Konnor McClain was named the SEC Specialist of the Week for the first conference award of her career, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.
- The honor comes after McClain scored her first career perfect 10 on bars in only her second collegiate routine on the event.
- The freshman's performance on Saturday helped lift the Tigers to a 49.650 in the last rotation, marking the program's highest recorded bars score on the road. LSU finished second at the Sprouts Collegiate Quad Meet, defeating No. 2 Utah and No. 12 UCLA.
- A native of Las Vegas, Nevada, McClain's perfect score earned her the event title at the meet, the first of her career. She currently sits amongst the top-20 bars performers in the nation after week two as she ranks No. 15 on the event.

Bryant Named SEC Gymnast of the Week For Second Time This Year

- Senior Haleigh Bryant continues to be one of the top performers in the country as she was named SEC Gymnast of the Week for the second time this year, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon. She owns averages of 9.900+ on every event after three weeks of competition.
- Bryant helped lead her team to a 198.125 over No. 6 Kentucky on Friday night, marking the second highest score by any team in the country and the highest score by any SEC team so far this year.
- This past weekend against the Wildcats, Bryant posted scores of 9.900 or better on every event for the second week in a row. After performing a nearly-perfect vault with her score of 9.975 on Friday, Bryant continued her night with a perfect score on bars, followed by a 9.900 on beam and finished the night with a 9.950 on floor.
- Already the all-time 10 leader in school history, Bryant added another perfect score to her resume on bars on Friday night in the PMAC. It was the second in her career on the event, making her only the second LSU gymnast to have multiple perfect scores on the event. She now owns 11 perfect scores in her career.
- Bryant finished the night with a season-high 39.825 against the Wildcats, securing the all-around title as well as the wins on vault and bars. Her three titles on the night moved her total to 65, with 25 on vault, nine on bars and 21 all-around.
- A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant's 65 career titles currently sits eighth in program history. She is one win away from tying Jeanie Beadle in seventh place for most career individual titles. Her vault title places her fourth in the records while she's fifth in the all-around.

Bryant, McClain Notch Week Five SEC Honors

- Senior Haleigh Bryant and freshman Konnor McClain both individually notched SEC honors this week for their performances on Friday night against No. 7 Arkansas.
- Bryant was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week for the third time this year, the most in the conference through the first five weeks of competition.
- Against Arkansas, Bryant finished as the top performer on the night and recorded her second career perfect score on floor to help lead the Tigers to a program-record finish over the Razorbacks. She took home three victories on vault, floor and the all-around to move her total to 69 titles in her career.
- A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant continues to show out for the Tigers each week. The senior is the top-ranked gymnast in the country for the third consecutive week with her all-around average of 39.738 and owns top-10 placements on every event.
- McClain builds confidence each week in her already impressive freshman campaign. She competed in three events for the Tigers on Friday night to earn her SEC Co-Freshman of the Week honors and her second conference award this year.
- The freshman earned a spot in the floor rankings at No. 9 this week after competing in the leadoff spot for the first time against the Razorbacks and notched a career-high 9.975 for the Tigers. She also recorded scores of 9.925 on bars and a 9.975 on beam to take home the title.
- A native of Las Vegas, Nevada, McClain moved her career total to three titles after finishing as the top beam performer on Friday.

Bryant Earns Fourth SEC Gymnast of the Week Honor This Year

- Senior Haleigh Bryant was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week for the second straight week, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.
- Bryant finished as the top performer in the Tiger's last meet against No. 19 Georgia with her 39.750 in the all-around. The week six award marks her fourth gymnast of the week honor this year and ninth in her career.
- A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant remains the top gymnast in the country for the fourth consecutive week after her record-setting performance on Friday night. The senior ranks No. 1 in the all-around with her average of 39.740 and owns top-10 placements on every event: third on vault, 10th on bars, fifth on beam and second on floor.
- The senior became the first gymnast in LSU history to complete a gym slam, a perfect score on every event, after notching a 10 on beam against the Bulldogs. The perfect score was her first on the event and 13th overall to extend her lead as the gymnast with the most career 10's in program history.
- In addition to her all-around title, Bryant also took home the titles on vault (9.95), beam (10) and floor (9.95) for her performance in Athens last Friday night. She moved her title totals to 27 on vault, six on beam, seven on floor and 23 in the all-around to tie Sarah Finnegan for the third-most all-around titles in program history.

Finnegan Earns SEC Co-Specialist of the Week Honors

- Aleah Finnegan earned SEC Co-Specialist of the Week honors for her performance against Auburn. The award is the first of her career. She shares the week seven honor with Missouri's Mara Titarsolej.
- A native of Lee's Summit, Missouri, Finnegan competed on vault, beam and floor for the Tigers in their last meet against Auburn.
- The junior started off hot with the highest vault score on the night as her yurchenko 1.5 earned her a 9.50 to take home the title.
- Finnegan posted another strong 9.925 for the Tigers on beam before finishing on floor, where she scored her third career perfect score on the event and fifth in her career.
- Finnegan finished the meet as the top performer on vault and floor against Auburn. She now owns 18 titles in her career and added to her individual event titles with six on floor and two on vault.
