# **JAY CLARK** HEAD COACH • 4th Season

Jay Clark owns over 30 years of experience in college gymnastics and is one of the best recruiters in the sport, is in his fourth season as the head coach of the LSU gymnastics program.

Clark was tabbed as the third head coach in program history in August 2021 following the retirement of D-D Breaux. Clark is in his tenth season overall at LSU following his hiring as the Tigers' associate head coach in 2012.

Last year, he led the Tigers to their first Final Four appearance under his tenure as he continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program.

Clark is regarded as one of the best recruiters in the sport and the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. The Tigers' associate head coach for eight seasons and co-head coach for one, Clark's leadership and expertise has helped bring unprecedented success on the recruiting trail and in the gym.

During the time since Clark's arrival, LSU has earned the best performances in school history as the NCAA Runner-Up in 2016, 2017 and 2019, appearances in the NCAA Championship Finals in six of seven seasons, numerous school records, produced seven NCAA individual national champions, and five SEC meet and regular season championships.

His work with the Fighting Tigers of LSU has not gone unnoticed. Clark has been named the Central Region Co-Assistant Coach of the Year along with former LSU assistant Bob Moore five times.

Clark also earned the 2014 and 2017 National Co-Assistant Coach of the Year award with Moore. It marked the third time in his distinguished coaching career he has garnered the nation's top award. He was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Region 8 Hall of Fame in 2018. Because of his recruiting success, ESPNU and ESPN the Magazine selected Clark as the ninth-best recruiter in all of collegiate athletics in 2011.

In the gym, Clark is viewed as the top bars coach in collegiate gymnastics history. Clark has coached the Tigers to 33 All-America honors on bars, four of the five highest bars team scores in school history and the top two bars title winners in LSU history. In his illustrious career, Clark has coached nine NCAA bars champions and two during his time in Baton Rouge.

Clark tutored Sarah Finnegan, who ended her career in April 2019 as one of the greatest gymnasts in LSU history. Finnegan became the first NCAA bars champion in school history in 2017 and earned the title once again in 2019. Finnegan and Lexie Priessman won SEC bars champions in 2019 and 2017 respectively, scored perfect scores in 2019 and led the squad that finished fourth in the nation.

The 2018 season on bars under Clark marked the best lineup in LSU history and one of the best in the history of the NCAA. The group posted a school record score of 49.725 and once again went on to break the record against Arizona with a 49.750 for the second-highest in all of NCAA Gymnastics since 1988.

The lineup, anchored by Finnegan, led the nation on bars for the first time in school history. Finnegan became the first gymnast in school history to finish the season ranked No. 1 on the event and joined Sharene Mamby (2001) and Syreeta Barnett (1997) as the only gymnasts at LSU to score a perfect 10.0 on the event.

In 2017, Clark coached Finnegan to the first NCAA Uneven Bars Championship in school history. Clark set the record for the most individual national champions on the event in NCAA gymnastics history.

Clark's bars squad finished ranked third in the nation for a fourth-consecutive Top-5 finish in 2017. The team's average score of 49.367 broke the previous record set in 2015. Finnegan and Priessman combined for three All-America honors. Priessman also took home the program's first SEC Uneven Bars

championship in more than 20 seasons at the league meet.

LSU earned another Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2016 with an average score of 49.252. Finnegan, Priessman and Myia Hambrick combined to tally four All-America honors during the historic season.

The Tigers posted a Top-5 national ranking on bars in 2015, and the team totaled the secondhighest bars total in school history with a 49.600 against lowa. The Tigers also accumulated the second-best season average on bars in school history with a 49.288 average.

As a team LSU produced four All-America honors on bars in 2015 with three gymnasts (Rheagan Courville, Randii Wyrick and Shae Zamardi) earning First-Team All-America honors at the NCAA Championships. It marked the first time in program history that three gymnasts secured First-Team All-America honors on bars in one season.

Under Clark's direction, LSU shattered the school record with a 49.330 average on bars and finished the 2014 season ranked No. 5 nationally in the event. In addition, the Tigers tallied three of the top-10 bars scores in school history, including a 49.600 that ranks as the second best, and LSU produced three All-America honors on bars.

Clark coached Courville to a First-Team All-America honor at the 2014 NCAA Championships, and Courville went on to finish fifth in the event at the NCAA Individual Finals.

LSU reached the Super Six in the 2013 season, and under Clark's guidance the Tigers finished the season with a 49.260 regional qualifying score on bars, the highest final RQS in that event since the 2009 season.

Clark coached Morrison and Wyrick to First-Team All-America honors on bars in his first season with the Tigers, and it marked the first season LSU produced at least two All-Americans on bars since 2010.

Before Clark joined LSU after he spent 20 seasons at the University of Georgia where he helped guide the Gym Dogs to seven NCAA National Titles and 14 Southeastern Conference Championships.

Clark primarily coached bars at Georgia, and he coached the Gym Dogs to 64 All-America honors and seven NCAA individual national titles on bars, including two-time champions Courtney Kupets and Kat Ding.

From 2009-12, Clark served as the head coach at Georgia, and during that time the Gym Dogs captured three NCAA individual national championships, won the 2012 NCAA Auburn Regional, and produced 23 All-America honors. In 2012, his Georgia team won the Bulldog Cup, which recognizes the UGA team that excels academically, supports their peers in athletics and consistently serves the community.

Prior to his stint as head coach, Clark was the recruiting coordinator at Georgia from 1999-2009 while serving as assistant coach from 1999-2004 and associate head coach from 2005-09 when Georgia won an NCAA record five-straight national titles.

Clark also coached at the club level for 13 years from 1992-2005 as the founder, owner and head coach of Classic City Gymnastics in Athens, Georgia. He coached several Classic City gymnasts to state, regional, national championships and to the Junior Olympic National Team, and eight gymnasts went on to compete collegiately at the NCAA Division I level.

A native of Roswell, Georgia, Clark earned his undergraduate degree in exercise science from Georgia.

Clark has two children – a son, Cole, and a daughter, Kinsey.

# NOTEBOOK

### Last Time On The Floor

• The Tigers finished on top of the Podium Challenge with a program-high road score of 198.425 last Friday night in the Raising Cane's River Center.

No. 3 LSU topped No. 14 Auburn (197.050), George Washington (195.100) and Texas Woman's (194.725) with their second highest score on the season.
It was a record night for LSU as the team improved their NQS to their highest in program history on the night with a record 198.125. The NQS marked the first

time LSU has surpassed the 198+ mark.
The Tigers also set a new program floor NQS after scoring a 49.675 in the meet to improve their NQS to 49.695, the highest floor NQS in LSU and NCAA history.

 Haleigh Bryant recorded back-to-back perfect 10's on vault and bars and finished the night strong with a 9.95 on beam and 9.975 on floor. Her perfect score on vault was her ninth in her career to complete a season slam, as she now owns a perfect score on every event in 2024. She is only the 10th gymnast in NCAA history to record that achievement.

• The Tigers came out hot on vault with a season high score of 49.675 to match the program's second highest score. The first event was highlighted by Bryant's perfect 10 as LSU took the early lead in the River Center after the first rotation.

• Bryant wasted no time picking up her 16th career perfect score, this time on bars in the second rotation.

• It was a 99.250 LSU lead at the halfway point in the River Center. Auburn followed in second with a 98.550, then George Washington with a 97.850 and Texas Woman's in fourth with their 97.650.

• LSU scored a 49.500 on beam and rotated to floor for the final rotation on the night.

• The Tigers closed the competition with a 49.675 in the last rotation to cap off a record night.

Olivia Dunne matched her career high 9.900 in the leadoff spot on floor

• Bryant continued to shine for the Tigers after finishing as the top performer in the meet and took home all five titles on the night. Bryant now owns the highest all-around score in the country through the tenth week of competition and set a new school record with her 39.925 in the all-around at the meet.

• Her score on the night is also the second best all-around score in SEC history and all-time fourth-best in NCAA history.

#### **Scouting The Tar Heels**

• LSU owns an undefeated 5-0-0 record against North Carolina and are 1-0-0 at home, having only met once in the PMAC in 2009. Friday's competition marks the two teams sixth all-time meeting.

• The Tar Heels had their final home competition of the 2024 season last Friday, falling to Kentucky by a final score of 196.525-197.800.

• Their final score in the competition was their second highest team score of the year. In the meet, the Tar Heels recorded three rotations above 49.000, including a season high bars rotation.

• Heading into Week 11, Carolina junior Lali Dekanoidze leads the ACC with her 9.842 average on vault and ranks eighth in the Southeast Region. Her NQS of 9.855 on vault and 9.885 on bars both rank third in the ACC, with bars ranking seventh in the region.

#### Week Ten Road To Nationals Rankings

• The Tigers improved their record to 11-3 last Friday and posted a programbest National Qualifying Score (NQS) to move them back up to the No. 2 in the national polls.

• LSU recorded the program's highest road score in their last meet at the Podium Challenge to improve their NQS above the 198 mark for the first time in school history. LSU earned their fifth score of 198+ this year as they finished the meet with a 198.425 on Friday night to top No. 14 Auburn, George Washington and Texas Woman's.

• The Tigers enter the eleventh week of competition with an NQS of 198.125 and have ranked in the top-five nationally for all 10 weeks of competition this season. The squad's five counting scores heading into the regular season finale this week are 198.425, 198.325, 198.300, 197.950 and 197.625.

• LSU remains in the top-five on every event for the fourth consecutive week and seventh week in the top-20. The squad enters their final home meeting ranked second on vault (49.490), third on bars (49.530), fifth on beam (49.470) and first on floor (49.695).

• The Tigers own the highest floor score by any team in the country and have placed at the top of the event on six occasions this season.

• Bryant remains the top performer in the country for the eighth consecutive

week. She sits at No. 1 in the all-around with her NQS of 39.800 and owns an NQS of 9.900 or higher on every event.

 Bryant enters the eleventh week of competition ranked individually on every event to mark her second straight week in the top-10 on every event and eighth week in the top-25. She currently ranks first on vault, sixth on bars, seventh on beam and third on floor.

Kiya Johnson improved her NQS to 39.570 in the all-around to move her up to No. 14 in the rankings.
 The fifth-year senior has ranked amongst the top-25 gymnasts in the country for seven consecutive weeks, while also earning a spot at No. 13 in the floor rankings.

• Aleah Finnegan and KJ Johnson remained in the top-20 in the floor rankings after scores above 9.900 at the Podium Challenge last Friday. Finnegan is the No. 5 floor performer in the country with her NQS of 9.955 on the event, marking her third straight week in the top-five while Johnson owns an NQS of 9.940 on the event to place her in the top-20 for the second straight week

• Freshman Konnor McClain owns an NQS of 9.940 on beam as she remains in the top-10 on the event for the third straight week.

#### **Reaching New Heights**

• The Tigers set a new record of over 8,000 season tickets sold prior to the start of the 2024 season as the program looks to finish first in attendance this year.

• LSU has finished in the top four of average attendance nationally for six consecutive years, claiming the No. 1 spot in 2022. Over 50,000 fans filled the seats of the PMAC through five home meets in 2023, earning LSU the highest attendance average in the SEC last season with an average of 12,075.

• The Tigers have already seen four top-15 crowds in PMAC history this year with only one home meet remaining on March 15. In addition to those record crowds, Tiger nation recorded two back-to-back sellouts as a combined 25,320 Tiger fans came out to watch LSU defeat Auburn and Alabama this year.

#### **Program History**

 Head Coach Jay Clark enters his fourth season leading the Tigers and 13th season overall as he continues to grow the LSU Gymnastics program. He is joined on staff by Assistant Coaches Garrett Griffeth, Ashleigh Gnat and Courtney McCool Griffeth. Gnat is in her fourth season with the Tigers while the Griffeth duo enters their third season on staff.

• The Tigers climbed their way to the NCAA Championship Final in Fort Worth for the programs ninth appearance in the finals in 2023. The Final Four appearance marked the second time that LSU has advanced to the finals since the format began in 2019 and the first time under Clark's tenure.

Last season marked the program's 38th straight appearance in the NCAA postseason and 40th overall

• LSU has a total of 16 individual national titles across 10 gymnasts in program history, including current senior Haleigh Bryant who was named the NCAA vault champion in 2021.

• The Tigers own four SEC Championship titles in program history, winning three consecutive titles from 2017 to 2019. The last time LSU took home the conference title was in 2019 in the Smoothie King Center, the site of this year's conference championship.

 Haleigh Bryant, Sierra Ballard, Chase Brock, Elena Arenas and Olivia Dunne make up the true senior class.

· Bryant competed in every meet for the Tigers last year and will continue to career individual titles. be one of the top all-around gymnasts in the country this year.

· Ballard led off on floor for the Tigers in every meet last year while also competing on beam in 13 meets. She owns career highs of 9.925 on both events.

• Brock was a key contributor in the vault and floor lineups in 2023, posting career high routines of 9.975 on vault and 9.925 on floor.

 Dunne appeared in the bars lineup four times in 2023 and owns a career high of 9.925 on the event. She has appeared in the floor lineups for the Tigers twice this year.

• Aleah Finnegan, Alexis Jeffrey, Tori Tatum, and KJ Johnson all begin their junior season

· Jeffrey and Tatum were key contributors to the bars lineups in 2023 as Jeffrey appeared in the lineup in every meet and Tatum appeared in all but two on bars.

 KJ Johnson battled injury in 2023 after the squad's meet against Florida, but has been a constant in LSU's vault and floor lineups so far this year. She owns career highs of 9.95 on vault, 9.875 on beam and 9.950 on floor.

 Ashley Cowan, Bryce Wilson and Annie Beard enter their sophomore year with Tigers.

• In their first year with the Tigers, Cowan and Wilson stepped up for their team and competed in multiple meets as freshmen.

 Annie Beard did not compete in 2023 due to injury. She made her first competition debut on beam at the Sprouts Collegiate Quad Meet.

#### **Bryant Shines In Year Three, Builds In Senior Season**

· Bryant is in her fourth season at LSU and is not only one of the leaders on the team this year, but one of the best gymnasts in NCAA and LSU history. She is the epitome of what it means to be a Tiger on and off the competition floor as she continues to etch her name into the school record books in her senior campaign.

· A native of Cornelius, N.C., Bryant is a 17 time All-American (5 VT, 3 UB, 2 BB, 3 FX, 4 AA) and three-time All-SEC member. She enters her fourth year at LSU after a historical junior season that etched her name into the

record books and continues to be one of the top gymnasts in the country in her senior season.

 A few of her accomplishments last season included Honda Award Finalist, Central Region Gymnast of the Year, three-time SEC Gymnast of the week, All-SEC floor honors and nine All-America honors, which marked the most in a single season by an LSU gymnast.

She went 64 for 64 routines for the Tigers as she competed in the all-around in every meet in 2023 and became the first LSU gymnast to average a 9.900+ across all four events in a season.

 As she garnered multiple honors in her junior season. Bryant picked right back up where she left off this at the Smoothie King Center in New Orleans, Louisiana, with the first session year. She continues to be one of the top competitors in the country as she and the Tigers look for their first national title in 2024.

> • Bryant currently owns the highest all-around score in the nation this year and remains at No. 1 in the allaround for the eighth consecutive week with her NQS of 39.800. She has an NQS of 9.900 or higher on every event as she has recorded seven meets with scores of 9.900 or higher on every meet so far for the Tigers this year.

She enters the eleventh week of competition ranked individually on every event to mark her second straight week in the top-10 on every event and eighth week in the top-25. She currently ranks first on vault, sixth on bars, seventh on beam and third on floor.

• Bryant now owns 84 titles in her career with 30 on vault, 13 on bars, six on beam, nine on floor and 26 in the all-around. Her total career vault titles is the second most in school history while she is tied at the top with Rheagan Courville for most career all-around titles in program history.

· After already achieving a gym slam earlier this year, her perfect score on vault in the Tigers last meet was her first this year to complete a season slam, a perfect score on every event in the same season.

- · She is only the 10th gymnast in NCAA history to record perfection on every event in a single season as she now owns six this year and 16 (9 VT, 3 UB, 3 FX, 1 BB) in her career.
- · Her 16 career perfect scores sit at 10th-most in NCAA history.
- The senior has also earned six SEC Gymnast of the Week honors for her performance on the floor in
- 2024, the most by any gymnast this year as she continues to lead the conference.

#### **Olympic Qualifier Finnegan In Year Three**

• Finnegan continues to be a key contributor for the Tigers in 2024 as she competed in the all-around in all but one meet last year. The Lee's Summit, Missouri will represent the Tigers at the 2024 Paris Olympics after booking her Olympic ticket at the 2023 World Championships in Antwerp last October.

- Finnegan earned an all-around score of 51.366 in her world championship debut to become the first active gymnast in school history to become an Olympian and first ever female gymnast from the Philippines to do so. She will continue to prepare for Paris while competing for the Tigers in 2024.
- Finnegan comes off an impressive sophomore year in 2023. The all-arounder set new career high's on all four events last year with perfect scores on vault, beam and floor and a 9.925 on bars and took home 15
- In only her second season with the Tigers, she earned her first career All-SEC Honors on floor after finishing in the top two at the SEC Championships on floor with her score of 9.950
- In her NCAA Championships debut, she recorded a floor score of 9.9625 in the semifinals to tie the highest score on the event by an LSU gymnast at the championships
- Finnegan finished the 2023 season with six All-America honors (1 UB, 1 BB, 2 FX, 2 AA) and enters her junior season with 15 career individual titles.
- This year, FInnegan has been a mainstay in the vault, beam and floor lineups for the Tigers in 2024.

 The junior is one of the top floor performers in the country as she has recorded two perfect scores on floor this year in back-to-back weeks against Auburn and Florida. She now owns six career perfect 10's with four on floor, one on vault and one on beam.

• In this week's rankings, Finnegan is the No. 5 floor performer in the country with her NQS of 9.955 on the event, marking her third straight week in the top-five.

- The all-arounder owns eight perfect scores across three events and a career-high 9.950 on bars
- · Johnson scored her fifth perfect on floor this year in a full circle moment against Kentucky, the same team and event that she got injured last year.

• The fifth-year senior owns 45 titles in her career with eight on vault, four on bars, five on beam, 18 on floor and 10 in the all-around.

- Johnson improved her NQS to 39.570 in the all-around to move her up to No. 14 in the rankings. The fifth-year senior has ranked amongst the top-25 gymnasts in the country for seven consecutive weeks. while also earning a spot at No. 13 in the floor rankings.

· Her season-high 39.675 performance in the all-around came in the Tigers meet against Arkansas.

• A native of Las Vegas, Nevada, McClain has contributed to the bars, beam and floor lineups this year.

#### Bryant, Drayton Earn Week One SEC Honors

• The LSU Gymnastics pair of senior Haleigh Bryant and freshman Amari Drayton took home the first SEC awards of the 2024 season, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.

• Bryant was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week while freshman Amari Drayton earned Co-Freshman of the Week honors for their performances in the Tigers season opener against No. 14 Ohio State on Friday night.

• A native of Cornelius, North Carolina, Bryant finished as the top all-around gymnast in the country after week one with her score of 39.675. She helped lift the Tigers to a 196.975-196.775 victory over the Buckeyes to secure the squad's first victory of 2024.

• The senior's night was highlighted by her front pike half vault that scored a 9.950, while also posting a 9.875 on bars and a 9.925 on beam and floor for the Tigers. Bryant won the vault and all-around titles on the night to move her career total to 62, which ties her at eighth for most career individual titles in LSU history. Her 24 career vault titles and 20 all-around titles also place her amongst the top-five gymnasts in school history.

• Drayton had an impressive night against the Buckeyes in her collegiate gymnastics debut as she scored a pair of 9.925's on vault and floor.

• The freshman out of Spring, Texas started the night off with a stuck yurchenko one and a half on vault before anchoring on floor, capturing second place on vault and a share of second place on floor in her first competition with the Tigers.

#### McClain Named SEC Specialist of the Week in Week Two

Freshman Konnor McClain was named the SEC Specialist of the Week for the first conference award of her career, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon.

The honor comes after McClain scored her first career perfect 10 on bars in only her second collegiate routine
on the event.

• The freshman's performance on Saturday helped lift the Tigers to a 49.650 in the last rotation, marking the program's highest recorded bars score on the road. LSU finished second at the Sprouts Collegiate Quad Meet, defeating No. 2 Utah and No. 12 UCLA.

 A native of Las Vegas, Nevada, McClain's perfect score earned her the event title at the meet, the first of her career. She currently sits amongst the top-20 bars performers in the nation after week two as she ranks No. 15 on the event.

#### Bryant Named SEC Gymnast of the Week For Second Time This Year

• Senior Haleigh Bryant continues to be one of the top performers in the country as she was named SEC Gymnast of the Week for the second time this year, announced by the league on Tuesday afternoon. She owns averages of 9.900+ on every event after three weeks of competition.

• Bryant helped lead her team to a 198.125 over No. 6 Kentucky on Friday night, marking the second highest score by any team in the country and the highest score by any SEC team so far this year.

• This past weekend against the Wildcats, Bryant posted scores of 9.900 or better on every event for the second week in a row.
