GAME NOTES

General

- 1. LSU is 1-2 all-time against USC after falling to USC, 27-20, in the Modelo Kickoff Classic in Las Vegas, Nev.
 - a. Sunday's contest marked LSU's first appearance in Las Vegas for a football game.
- 2. LSU is 91-35-5 in season openers following Sunday's loss to USC.
 - a. The Tigers have won 22 of their past 29 season openers.
- 3. Since 2010, LSU has played 10 of 15 season openers at a neutral site, and the Tigers own a 6-4 record in those games after Sunday's game vs. USC.
- 4. LSU played just the seventh Sunday game in program history when the Tigers and Trojans met on Sunday night. LSU is now 3-4 in Sunday games.
- a. LSU's history in Sunday games dates back to the program's first against Notre Dame on Dec. 28, 1997, a 27-9 win in the Independence Bowl.
- 5. Brian Kelly is 8-4 all-time against USC, with all 11 previous games before the 2024 matchup coming as head coach at Notre Dame.
- 6. The Tigers, who are 22-36-3 on ABC after the loss to USC.
 - a. LSU made their 61st appearance on the network.
- 7. LSU is 8-3 against non-conference opponents under Brian Kelly.
- 8. LSU is 11-16-2 all-time against current members of the Big Ten.
- 9. Six Tigers started for the first time in an LSU uniform, including C DJ Chester, WR CJ Daniels, WR Kyle Parker, S Jardin Gilbert, S Jordan Allen, and DT Gio Paez.
- 10. Nine true freshmen saw action for the first time in the season opener vs. USC. The list includes TE Trey'Dez Green, S Ju'Juan Johnson, PK Aeron Burrell, S Dashawn Spears, DT Ahmad Breaux, DE Kolaj Cobbins, DE Gabriel Reliford, CB PJ Woodland, CB Wallace Foster IV.
- 11. Four transfers saw playing time for the first time in an LSU jersey. The list includes AP/RS Zavion Thomas, S Austin Ausberry, CB Jyaire Brown, RB Ty'son Edwards.
- 12. CB JK Johnson, who joined the LSU program last season, earned playing time for the first time.
- 13. S Jardin Gilbert was charged with targeting in the 4Q and is ineligible for the first half of the Nicholls game.

Offense

- 1. Making his second career start, QB Garrett Nussmeier finished with 304 passing yards 2 TDs, and one INT.
- 2. With 7:04 remaining in the first half, WR Kyren Lacy scored the Tigers' first TD of the season on a 19-yard toss from QB Garrett Nussmeier and knotted the score at 7.
- 3. WR Aaron Anderson gave LSU the 17-13 lead on a 13-yard pass from QB Garrett Nussmeier with 3:42 left in the 3Q.
 - a. Anderson recorded his first collegiate TD on the go-ahead score.

Defense

- 1. DE Sai'vion Jones collected 2 sacks for eight yards, a career-high for the senior.
- 2. LB Harold Perkins Jr. collected 8 tackles, 1 solo and 0.5 tackles for loss as the leading tackler.
- 3. S Jordan Allen, S Major Burns, and LB Whit Weeks each collected 6 tackles and 3 solo tackles apiece.

Special Teams

- 1. PK Damian Ramos tied the ballgame 10-10 with 1:08 left in the first half on a 45-yard FG try.
 - a. Ramos improved to 21 of 24 on FG attempts within 45 yards
- 2. Ramos surpassed 200 career points scored with his PAT and first FG combined.
 - a. He came into the USC game with 198 total points scored and now sits at 206.
- 3. Ramos finished the game perfect on PATs (2-2)
- 4. P Peyton Todd punted for the first time in his LSU career during the 3Q. His kick traveled 40 yards.
- 5. Ramos tied the game again at 20 with 1:47 remaining in the game.
