3rd Year at LSU · 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

### Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season titles (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

### PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

SERIES VS. CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

This will be the first year that LSU and Charleston Southern have competed in basketball. The school is part of the Big South Conference. LSU is presently 6-1 against Big South Conference teams in its history.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN UPDATE

Charleston Southern lost both games in the River Division of the Greenbrier Tipoff over the weekend, losing to UTRGV, 86-76, on Friday and VMI, 80-69, on Saturday. On Friday, the Buccaneers were led by Daylen Berry with 18 points, while Taje' Kelly 16 and RJ Johnson 14. Charleston Southern was 27-of-56 from the field (48.2%) with seven treys and 15-of-24 from the free throw line. In the loss on Saturday, Reis Jones was 9-of-9 from the field with 14 rebounds for the Buccaneers to score 21 points, while RJ Johnson had 15 points and Taje' Kelly had 10. Charleston Southern again made 27 field goals (27-62, 43.5%) with seven treys and 8-of-19 at the charity stripe. Saah Nimley is in his second season as head coach at his alma mater after being named head coach late in November during the 2023-24 season. A 2015 CSU graduate, Nimley is the Bucs' all-time assists leader and third-leading scorer. The Lawrenceville, Ga., native remains the only player in Big South Conference history with over 1,800 points and 500 assists.

IT IS GREENBRIER TIPOFF WEEK

Tonight's game begins Greenbrier Tipoff Week for LSU as one of the four teams from the River Division will visit each of the four teams in the Mountain Division (LSU, Pittsburgh, UCF, Wisconsin). LSU will travel to America's Resort on Wednesday after practice and practice at the game site, Colonial Hall on Thursday before facing Pittsburgh on Friday at 1:30 p.m. CT (2:30 p.m. ET). LSU will play either UCF or Wisconsin in the final round game on Sunday, Nov. 24.

**RECAP:** The Tigers score their first non-conference road win since the 2020 SEC/Big 12 Challenge when the Tigers won at Austin versus Texas. It was also LSU's first win in its first non-conference road game of the season since a win at No. 13 West Virginia early in the 2005-06 season ... The Tigers took the lead at 23-21 with 9:10 to play in the first half on a Cam Carter three-pointer that started a 7-0 run ... LSU, which built a 17-point first half lead (43-26, 2:04 first half), never let Kansas State get closer than nine points on one occasion in the second half.

LSU shot an even 50 percent (27-54) with eight treys and 14-of-18 from the line. LSU held its third straight opponent to less than 40 percent (23-61, 37.7 percent) with five treys. LSU dominated the boards (43-25) with 16 second chance points off 11 offensive boards. Carter had his third 20-point game with 20, while Jordan Sears and Vyctorius Miller each had 15 and Daimion Collins 12 ... Corey Chest had 13 rebounds for the Tigers.

### GAME 2 -- LSU 74, Alabama State 61 | November 10, 2024 | Pete Maravich Assembly Center | Baton Rouge, Louisiana

**RECAP:** For the second consecutive year against Alabama St, LSU found itself trailing after 20 minutes, 32-26 ... The Tigers fought back to take a one-point lead early in the second half, only to have Alabama State push the Hornets lead to 10 points, 48-38, with 12:38 in the game ... LSU then went on a 26-5 run over the next eight minutes of play to take control of the game. The Tigers shot 59.1 percent in the final 20 minutes (13-of-22), including 4-of-7 three-point FGs. LSU was also 18-of-20 at the stripe in the second half ... Alabama State was 20-of-60 from the field, but 1-of-20 from the arc.

### GAME 1 -- LSU 95, ULM 60 | October 29, 2024 | Pete Maravich Assembly Center | Baton Rouge, Louisiana

**RECAP:** The Tigers broke open a tight game some eight minutes in with a couple of scoring runs, including 11 straight points that helped the Tigers to a 50-27 halftime advantage on the way to the opening night victory. Ten Tigers scored in the game with four in double figures as LSU shot over 50 percent from the floor and an impressive 17-of-19 from the free throw line. LSU made 10 three-pointers on 34 attempts. Defensively, LSU was good, shooting 38.7 percent (24-of-62) with just three three-point field goals. LSU had a 23-7 advantage in points from turnovers and 46 points in the paint.

Junior Jalen Reed had his best game as a Tiger scoring 24 points with eight rebounds, hitting 8-of-9 field goals and all eight free throws. Cam Carter had 21 points with four treys, while Curtis Givens III had 15 and Dji Bailey 15.

## MORE NOTES FROM THE KANSAS STATE WIN

LSU win over Kansas State was the first time LSU won its opening road game of the year since LSU defeated No. 13 West Virginia in Morgantown in the early part of the 2005-06 season. LSU's last non-conference road win came in the old SEC/Big 12 Challenge in January 2020 when the Tigers knocked off Texas in Austin.

Cam Carter opened with three consecutive 20-point games, the first time an LSU player has had three consecutive 20-point games since KJ Williams scored 35 against Vandy, 29 at Ole Miss and 24 versus Missouri between Feb. 22 and March 1, 2023.

LSU led for 31:22 of the game and never trailed after taking the lead 23-21 on a Carter three-pointer.

Vyctorius Miller had his first double figure game of the season, scoring 15 points on 6-of-9 field goals.

All nine players that saw the floor against Kansas State had plus numbers on the plus/minus category as posted by the NCAA Genius Stat Program.

LSU had nine different players out on the floor starting from the 8:54 mark of the first half to the 1:07 mark. Carter played the entire time with the others in the roster getting time as LSU outscored Kansas State, 20-5.

## TIGERS TAKE FIRST STEP TO BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

The win over Kansas State allowed LSU to take a first step toward having a better November-December record when the non-conference portion of the season ends at the end of December.

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the 2023-24 season where LSU stumbled some, losing five times in the month of November and December, including some games when they were favored. So one of the goals of this team this year is to not only get ready for league play, but to play better basketball in the first two months of the season.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

## COREY CHEST DOMINATES ON THE BOARD

Corey Chest, a redshirt freshman from New Orleans, took advantage of Derek Fountain not being able to go at Kansas State (11/14) by grabbing 13 rebounds against the Wildcats. Message boards invoked names like Greg "Cookiemann" Cook from the 1981 Final Four team and freshman Tyrus Thomas from the 2005-06 season as people who had similar rebound efforts.

Chest played 21 minutes and was +9 for the game. He played three years of high school before playing for Link Academy of Branson, Missouri, the national high school champions in 2023. He redshirted the 2023-24 season.

## SO 13 REBOUNDS AS A FRESHMAN AT LSU?

It was the first game for a Tiger freshman with 13 rebounds since Naz Reid versus Florida in the SEC Tournament had 14 boards on March 15, 2019.

That was one of three games Reid had 13 or more rebounds in the 2018-19 season. Emmitt Williams also had two games as a freshman of 13 rebounds that season.

Since the start of the 1988-89 season, Chest is the 13th freshman to have at least one rebound game of 13 or more for the Tigers:

The school record for rebounds happens to be by a freshman when Durand "Rudy" Macklin had a seemingly unbreakable mark of 32 rebounds against Tulane on Nov. 26, 1976. Macklin is the school's all-time career rebound leader, with 1,276.

#### **MARAVICH CENTER**

LSU was 12-6 a year ago in the 53rd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. With two wins this year, the Tigers are 341-49 in non-conference games in the building.

The building was originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation following the untimely death of the star LSU player. The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

#### **SEASON OPENER MARKED EIGHTH STRAIGHT YEAR A FRESHMAN STARTED FOR LSU**

With Robert Miller III starting versus ULM (11/6), it marked the eighth straight year LSU started at least one freshman in the regular season opener.

#### **WILL WE SEE A 2,000 POINT SCORER FOR LSU; MAYBE 1,000 POINT MARK TO BE CROSSED?**

In the 2022-23 season, LSU celebrated a 2,000-point career scorer when KJ Williams crossed the mark as part of his final season at LSU after a stellar part of his career at Murray State.

Now in the 2024-25 season, the potential of another 2,000-point career scorer is a possibility as Jordan Sears enters the week having passed the 1,700-point mark in the Kansas State game.

Sears, with two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin is now at 1,714 points. He would need to average just under 10 points a game to get the mark by the end of the season.

Speaking of point totals, Cam Carter with 61 points in the first three games has taken a big chunk of the total on his march to 1,000 career points. After three games at LSU, to go with a year at Mississippi State and two at Kansas State, is at 848 points entering the week.

#### **THREE-POINT SHOOTING**

The scouting report is that LSU will shoot threes when possible, and while some Tigers have had great success, the team percentage of 32.5 is not as good as it could be. LSU was in double figures against ULM (11/6), making 10-of-34.

It was the 18th time in the Matt McMahon era that the Tigers had 10 or more treys in a game. LSU is 8-10 in those 18 games.

Against Alabama State, the Tigers shot a respectable 35.0 percent (7-of-20), including 4-of-7 in the second half. That number was low as LSU went to the inside game scoring down low and getting fouled and going to the line.

The Tigers shot consistently 33.3 percent in both halves against Kansas State making 5-of-15 in the first half and 3-of-9 in the second half.

LSU was in double figures from the arc nine times last year, making 256-of-717 (35.7 percent). Opponents made 19 more threes on 104 more attempts. LSU was 143-of-396 (36.1 percent) in SEC games.

Through three games, the Tigers have made 25-of-78 for 32.1 percent. LSU opponents are 9-of-55 through the first three games (16.4%) including no makes in the last four minutes of any game. LSU is first in the nation and fourth in the NCAA in three-point defense.

#### **FREE THROWS – SO FAR SO GOOD**

After a so-so first half against Alabama State (11/10) when the Tigers were just 7-of-14 at the charity stripe, in the last 60 minutes of play, LSU is 32-of-38 at the line (18-of-20 in second half versus Alabama State and 14-of-18 at Kansas State).

Through three games, LSU is 56-of-71 at the free throw line (78.9%). LSU is first in the SEC and 33rd in the country in percentage at 78.9 percent. LSU's 18.7 makes per game is 47th in the nation.

Opponents are 43-of-59 at the free throw line (72.9%)

LSU's top four scorers have attempted 56 of LSU's 71 free throws:

#### **VYCTORIUS MILLER**

The freshman had his coming out party in one of the tougher places to play on the road at Kansas State. Miller played 21 minutes, hit 6-of-9 field goals, including 2-of-4 treys with a free throw to go with three rebounds and two assists.

The freshman from Los Angeles, has averaged 14 minutes in his first three games and is 7-of-16 (43.8%) and is averaging 6.0 points per game.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain is in his third year at LSU, but his best season was his first after last year was plagued by injuries before and during the season. While his first two games showed what he did two years ago when he was healthy, his minor injury in the pregame Thursday could have been problematic for LSU.

When Fountain came off the bench for the first time this season against ULM (11/6), the aggressive play that had been seen in the 2022-23 season seemed to be back. Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals and one block

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24.

Fountain, who played two years at Mississippi State before coming to LSU, did not have a good scoring game against Alabama State (11/10), but he was on the floor for 23 minutes, helping to move the issue in favor of the Tigers with six rebounds and a plus/minus total of +17.

CAM CARTER GOT IT TO 20 IN RETURN TO MANHATTAN

After two 21-point games in Baton Rouge to open the LSU part of his career, the return proved not too big for the fourth-year player as he returned to a spot where the “Octagon of Doom” was his home court in Manhattan, Kansas.

Carter gave LSU the lead for good with his first three-pointer of the night at 23-21 and finished with 20 points, his third consecutive 20-point game for the Tigers.

He was on the verge of his third consecutive 21-point game, but after making his first 15 free throws, his miss late in the game of a free throw left him at 20 points. He was 6-of-11 from the field with three makes after back-to-back four three-pointers in his first two games.

Carter is averaging 20.7 points per game, 3.7 rebounds and 1.3 assists and 1.0 blocks. He has had eight games of 20 or more in his career.

SEARS AND BAILEY

Jordan Sears and Dji Bailey against Alabama State had nine combined assists Sunday, but more importantly when LSU had 15 turnovers, the pair combined for just two in almost 66 minutes of play.

Against Kansas State, Sears had 15 points, five assists and seven rebounds, while Bailey had three assists and three rebounds to go with four points. Bailey had just one turnover.

In the three games, the pair has 19 assists, 27 rebounds.

DAIMION COLLINS BACK HEALTHY

Daimion Collins was playing his best basketball of the season against North Florida early last season when he suffered a shoulder injury that required surgery.

Well, Collins may have been played one of his best LSU games against Kansas State (11/14) when he came off the bench to play 21.5 minutes, making all five field goal attempts (3 dunks) with two free throws scoring 12 points with three rebounds.

The season opener marked his return to the court and he played 17 minutes with two points, four rebounds and two blocks against ULM. Against Alabama State (11/10), he played 16 minutes with four points, three rebounds and again two blocks.

Thursday was his ninth official contest in the purple and gold. So far this season, he is averaging 6.0 points, 3.3 rebounds and 1.3 blocks.

CURTIS GIVENS AND ROBERT MILLER

First of all, the two freshmen have “III” at the end of their names. Givens, who hails from Memphis and came from national champion Montverde Academy in Florida, has had the better numbers through two games, especially in the opener against ULM (11/6).

Against the Warhawks, Givens played 21 minutes off the bench and hit four treys with six rebounds, scoring 15 points. Given is averaging 5.0 points per game, 2.3 rebounds and 2.3 assists.

Miller as mentioned started the first three games and while the Houston product from Pasadena (Texas) Memorial, has not scored well early, he has played 43 minutes with six assists and three blocks.

BLOCKS GOING TO BE A NUMBER TO WATCH?

LSU last season averaged 3.78 blocks a game and the Tigers seem ready to see if they can’t up that number a bit this year.

Seven different Tigers blocked shots in the first three games.

LSU is averaging five blocks a game so far this season. Opponents have just five total blocks.

Reed had eight rebounds and a career high eight field goals made. His eight free throws were also a career high.

Reed has now played 68 career games at LSU with 34 starts. Through three games he is averaging 11.7 points and is second on the team at 6.3 rebounds a game.

## FAMILIAR FACES JOIN LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State.

Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton.

Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

## TIGERS SIGNED THREE FOUR-STARS IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

The LSU Tigers signed three four-star players for the 2025-26 season during the opening day of the signing period that occurred last Wednesday. Rivals as of Saturday night had the class ranked No. 6 in their team rankings. Here are some numbers on the signees:

### MATT GILHOOL – Elizabethtown, Pa. – William Penn Charter School (6-11 Forward)

Averaged 15 points, nine rebounds and two blocks a game for the school as a junior ... The lefthander attended the 2024 Pangos All-America Camp where he was one of the top scorers in the event, averaging 17.3 points per game ... The No. 2 player in the state of Pennsylvania, is ranked No. 65 in the Rivals Rankings and 73 in the On3sports.com composite rankings.

In his junior season, he shot 57 percent from the floor, 31 percent from distance and helped William Penn Charter to the championship of the Inter-AC in 2024, their first outright championship in 20 years. He was the Inter-AC MVP last season.

### MAZI MOSLEY – Los Angeles, California (6-5 guard)
