3rd Year at LSU · 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season titles (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

SERIES VS. KANSAS STATE

This will mark the third consecutive year that LSU and Kansas State have played basketball, starting with a neutral site game in 2022 and the home-and-home series in 2023 and 2024.

The Wildcats have won both of the first two meetings -- 61-59 in the finals of 2022 Cayman Islands Classic; and, last season (12/9/23), 75-60, in Baton Rouge.

The Cayman Islands Classic game had its share of drama as K-State scored late to take the lead and LSU after several timeouts, had 4.7 seconds to go the length of the court to tie the game. LSU was able to score just before the horn sounded, but upon video review the clock did not start on time, disallowing the LSU basket.

KANSAS STATE UPDATE

Kansas State has also won its first two games this season, 89-65 over New Orleans and 77-64 over Cleveland State. In its game against Cleveland State on Saturday, the Wildcats shot 57.8 percent from the field (26-of-45), including 14-of-22 (63.6%) in the second half. K-State was 10-of-19 from three-point range (52.6 percent).

Kansas State was outrebounded in the game, 31-25, with Cleveland State having an 18-7 edge in offensive boards. Kansas State had 19 turnovers and 12 steals, scoring 24 points off turnovers.

Jerome Tang is in his third season as the head coach at Kansas State.

RECAP: For the second consecutive year, LSU found itself trailing after 20 minutes -- this time by six points, 32-26 ... The Tigers fought back to take a one-point lead early in the second half, only to have Alabama State push the Hornets lead to 10 points, 48-38, with 12:38 in the game ... LSU then went on a 26-5 run over the next eight minutes of play to take control of the game, 64-53, with 4:12 to play. After making just eight first half field goals and 7-of-14 at the free throw line in the first half, the Tigers shot 59.1 percent in the final 20 minutes (13-of-22), including 4-of-7 three-point FGs. LSU was also 18-of-20 at the stripe in the second half ... Alabama State was 20-of-60 from the field, but 1-of-20 from the arc. The Hornets out rebounded LSU, 38-33 and 15-6 on the offensive glass.

For the second straight game as a Tiger, Cam Carter hit four three-pointers and had 21 points ... A total of 18 came in the second half ... Jordan Sears had 18 points and five assists, while Dji Bailey had 15 points, 7 rebounds. The trio combined for a plus/minus total of +53 (Sears +22, Bailey +16, Carter +15).

RECAP: The Tigers broke open a tight game some eight minutes in with a couple of scoring runs, including 11 straight points that helped the Tigers to a 50-27 halftime advantage on the way to the opening night victory. Ten Tigers scored in the game with four in double figures as LSU shot over 50 percent from the floor and an impressive 17-of-19 from the free throw line. LSU made 10 three-pointers on 34 attempts. Defensively, LSU was good, shooting 38.7 percent (24-of-62) with just three three-point field goals. LSU had a 23-7 advantage in points from turnovers and 46 points in the paint.

Junior Jalen Reed had his best game as a Tiger scoring 24 points with eight rebounds, hitting 8-of-9 field goals and all eight free throws. Cam Carter had 21 points with four treys, while Curtis Givens III had 15 and Dji Bailey 15.

MORE NOTES FROM SUNDAY’S WIN

Alabama State’s struggled from the arc (1-of-20, 5.0 percent) was the first time an LSU opponent posted a shooting percentage less than 10 since Dec. 21, 2013 when UAB was 1-of-16 from distance (6.3 percent).

LSU’s win after trailing at halftime marked the ninth time in 36 games of the Matt McMahon era that LSU has come back to win. LSU’s win after trailing after 30 minutes mark the fourth time in 28 games that LSU has won.

Alabama State had 10 steals in the game and it was the first time in the Matt McMahon era that the Tigers have won in eight tries when the opponent has had at least 10 steals.

In one of those strange stats, because of Alabama State’s poor 1-of-20 shooting from the arc, it has put LSU second in the nation in three-point field goal defense at 11.8 percent. First happens to be Iowa State at 8.3 percent.

TIGERS WANT BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

LSU tries to take a step forward in this game to have a better November-December record when the 2025 portion of the season rolls around.

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the season where LSU stumbled some, losing five times in the month of November and December, including some games when they were favored. So one of the goals of this team this year is to not only get ready for league play, but to play better basketball in the first two months of the season.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

TRYING TO WORK ON THE ROAD MARK

LSU was 3-7 on the road a year ago, with road wins at Texas A&M, No. 11 South Carolina and at Vanderbilt. Overall the Tigers are 3-16 in the Matt McMahon era on opponents’ home court.

LSU’s last non-conference win on an opponent’s court was in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge on Jan. 25, 2020 when LSU won in Austin against Texas, 69-67.

RETURNING NUMBERS

LSU returns an average of 35.3 points from a year ago (46.2 percent) of the team’s 76.4 points per game average, while the returning rebound average if 42.8 percent (15.3 of 35.7).

TURNOVERS

The exhibition game did give hope about LSU's ability to possibly keep the turnovers down with nine. Last season LSU averaged 13.1 turnovers a game

LSU only had single digit turnovers once a year ago with eight in the home win over Vanderbilt (January 2024) and 10 on four other occasions.

The Tigers had 12 in the opening contest and 15 in the game Sunday against Alabama State (11/10). Half of the eight turnovers in the first half came in the first five minutes of the game.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

The scouting report is that LSU will shoot threes when possible, and while some Tigers have had great success, the team percentage of 31.5 is not as good as it could be. LSU was in double figures against ULM (11/6), making 10-of-34.

It was the 18th time in the Matt McMahon era that the Tigers had 10 or more treys in a game. LSU is 8-10 in those 18 games.

Against Alabama State, the Tigers shot a respectable 35.0 percent (7-of-20), including 4-of-7 in the second half. That number was low as LSU went to the inside game scoring down low and getting fouled and going to the line.

LSU was in double figures from the arc nine times last year, making 256-of-717 (35.7 percent). Opponents made 19 more threes on 104 more attempts. LSU was 143-of-396 (36.1 percent) in SEC games.

Through two games, Cam Carter is 8-of-13 from the arc (61.5 percent) with four makes each game. The freshman, Curtis Givens III, is 4-of-11 through the first two contests (36.4 percent). Those two have made 12 of the team's 17 makes. The remainder of team is 5-of-30.

FREE THROWS – NOT SO GOOD HALF; THEN NO PROBLEM

LSU's free throw shooting woes in the first half against Alabama State (11/10) were pretty well evident when the Tigers went just 7-of-14 at the stripe. Then in the second half, the Tigers drove to the goal and the Tigers were fouled and made 18-of-20 in the final 20 minutes. LSU finished 25-of-34 for a respectable 73.5 percent.

For the season in two games, LSU is 42-of-53 or 79.2 percent. LSU has made 13 more free throws than opponents on 14 more attempts. LSU has made three more free throws than opponents have attempted.

Cam Carter is 10-of-10 from the line, Jalen Reed 10-of-12, Dji Bailey 8-of-11 and Jordan Sears 9-of-11. Those four players are a combined 37-of-44 at the line. The rest of the team is 5-of-9.

FAMILIAR FACES JOIN LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State.

Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton.

Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain is in his third year at LSU, but his best season was his first after last year was plagued by injuries before and during the season.

But when Fountain came off the bench for the first time this season against ULM (11/6), the aggressive play that had been seen in the 2022-23 season seemed to be back. Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals and one block

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24.

Fountain, who played two years at Mississippi State before coming to LSU, did not have a good scoring game against Alabama State (11/10), but he was on the floor for 23 minutes, helping to move the issue in favor of the Tigers with six rebounds and a plus/minus total of +17.

FOUNTAIN PART OF BEST GROUP ON FLOOR AT RIGHT TIME

It was the combination of Fountain, Jordan Sears, Dji Bailey, Cam Carter and Daimion Collins that was on the court from the 7:50 mark to the 4:53 mark of the second half when the Tigers outscored Alabama State, 13-2, to take firm control of the game.

Over the course of the entire game, that quintet was on the floor for 5:51 and outscored Alabama State, 21-8 with five rebounds, no turnovers and two assists.

PORTAL PLAYERS

The three LSU picked up in the transfer portal started for the Tigers in the first two games and here are some of their highlights:

CAM CARTER PLAYING 21 AT THE MARAVICH CENTER

When Cam Carter played on the Maravich Center court representing Kansas State on Dec. 9, 2023, he posted 21 points in the K-State victory.

His next game on the same court, representing LSU in the season opener last week, he posted 21 points.

Then after a sluggish scoring first half on Sunday against Alabama State, Carter scored 18 second half points to finish again with 21 points for a third time on the PMAC court.

He has had seven games of 20 or more in his career and four times he has now scored 21 points in his career.

SEARS AND BAILEY

Jordan Sears and Dji Bailey against Alabama State had nine combined assists Sunday, but more importantly when LSU had 15 turnovers, the pair combined for just two in almost 66 minutes of play.

In two games, the pair has 11 total assists and four combined of LSU's 27 turnovers.

DAIMION COLLINS BACK HEALTHY

Daimion Collins was playing his best basketball of the season against North Florida early last season when he suffered a shoulder injury that required surgery.

The season opener marked his return to the court and he played 17 minutes with two points, four rebounds and two blocks against ULM. Against Alabama State (11/10), he played 16 minutes with four points, three rebounds and again two blocks. He is also at +12 and +11 in the first two games of the season in the plus/minus category.

Sunday was his eighth official contest in the purple and gold. He averaged 4.3 points and 2.2 rebounds in six contests a season ago.

CURTIS GIVENS AND ROBERT MILLER

First of all, the two freshmen have "III" at the end of their names. Givens, who hails from Memphis and came from national champion Montverde Academy in Florida, has had the better numbers through two games, especially in the opener against ULM (11/6).

Against the Warhawks, Givens played 21 minutes off the bench and hit four treys with six rebounds, scoring 15 points.

Miller as mentioned started both games and while the Houston product from Pasadena (Texas) Memorial, has not scored well early, he has played 36 minutes with five assists and three blocks.

BLOCKS GOING TO BE A NUMBER TO WATCH?

LSU last season averaged 3.78 blocks a game and the Tigers seem ready to see if they can't up that number a bit this year.

Five different Tigers blocked shots with both Jalen Reed and Daimion Collins each with two blocks each for a total of seven.

Four LSU players had blocks in the Alabama State with Miller and Collins getting two apiece.

JALEN REED CAREER NIGHT IN OPENER

It was in Charleston last November in the opening round that Jalen Reed had his best scoring night of 16 points against Dayton.

Reed made 8-of-9 field goals and all eight free throw attempts to score 24 points.

Reed had eight rebounds and a career high eight field goals made. His eight free throws were also a career high.

Reed has now played 67 career games at LSU with 33 starts. Through two games he is averaging 15.0 points and 5.5 rebounds.

he was named the NBA Sixth Man of the Year. Reid was part of the Tigers 2019 Sweet 16 NCAA Tournament team at LSU.

Temple is the veteran of the group and has been a mentor to many of the young Raptors. He is in his 15th season in the league after playing in the Final Four as a freshman in 2006 and winning an SEC regular season title for LSU in his final year of 2009. He has appeared in 745 NBA games and needs only 14 appearances to pass Brandon Bass for third place in total appearances among LSU NBA stars (758).

Thomas had a breakout season a year ago for the Nets, averaging 22.5 points and 2.9 assists in 66 games. Last year he became the youngest player in NBA history to score 40 points in three straight games. He opened with 36 points on Wednesday night.

Joining him on the NETS are Watford and 2016 National Freshman of the Year Ben Simmons

Watford is in his fourth season in the NBA, joining the Nets last year. Simmons, who has struggled with injuries but seems to be fully recovered from back surgery. This is his seventh year to play in the league.

Eason looks to return from an injury that shortened his season in 2023-24. The 17th pick in the 2022 NBA Draft played a full 82 games in the 2022-23 seasons.

Reath had a different path to the NBA after completing his playing time at LSU in 2018. Reath played overseas before joining the Trail Blazers 2023 Summer League team. He eventually signed a two-way deal with Portland and debuted on Nov. 12, 2023. In February 2024, Portland converted his two-way deal to a standard contract.

LSU RETURNS HOME TO BEGIN GREENBRIER TIPOFF WEEK

The Tigers are appearing in the Greenbrier Tipoff event at the famed resort in White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia. Play begins next week on Tuesday, Nov. 19, when LSU hosts one of the teams from the other bracket of the event, Charleston Southern, at 7 p.m. at the Maravich Center.

LSU then goes to the Greenbrier on Wednesday, Nov. 20 and on Nov. 22 will face Pittsburgh in the semifinals. In the final round of games on Nov. 24, the Tigers will face either UCF or Wisconsin.

LSU's game with Charleston Southern will be streamed on SECN+, while the two West Virginia games will be aired on the CBS Sports Network.

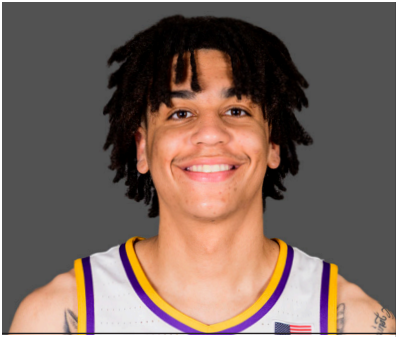
