3rd Year at LSU · 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season titles (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

SERIES VS. ALABAMA STATE

This will be the second time in as many years Alabama State and LSU have played each other with LSU winning a 74-56 decision on Dec. 13, 2023. While it was an 18-point win for LSU, the Tigers trailed 34-30 at intermission of the game.

ALABAMA STATE UPDATE

The Hornets opened the season on Monday in Las Vegas, dropping a 93-79 decision to UNLV. The Hornets (0-1) had four players score in double figures, led by Amarr Knox, who had 19 points, five assists, and two steals. TJ Madlock tacked on 14 points and four assists and Micah Octave helped with 13 points. ASU had 15 assists on 27 made baskets.
Tony Madlock is the ASU coach and he is in his third season as the head coach. He has served on staffs at Auburn and Ole Miss in his coaching career.

HATE TO MENTION THIS, BUT IT IS THE SECOND GAME

Remembering how this game went a year ago with ASU, it has to be brought up that LSU fell in the second game of non-conference play a year ago at home to Nicholls on a bucket in the final seconds by the Colonels.
One of the primary goals this year for Coach Matt McMahon is he wants the Tigers to play better in November and December. The Tigers lost five times in non-conference play before finishing strong at 9-9 in the SEC.

RECAP: The Tigers broke open a tight game some eight minutes in with a couple of scoring runs, including 11 straight points that helped the Tigers to a 50-27 halftime advantage on the way to the opening night victory. Ten Tigers scored in the game with four in double figures as LSU shot over 50 percent from the floor and an impressive 17-of-19 from the free throw line. LSU made 10 three-pointers on 34 attempts. Defensively, LSU was good, shooting 38.7 percent (24-of-62) with just three three-point field goals. LSU had a 23-7 advantage in points from turnovers and 46 points in the paint.

Junior Jalen Reed had his best game as a Tiger scoring 24 points with eight rebounds, hitting 8-of-9 field goals and all eight free throws. Cam Carter had 21 points with four treys, while Curtis Givens III had 15 and Dji Bailey 15.

MORE OPENING NIGHT NOTES

LSU played all 13 players that dressed in the opening contest with 10 playing 10 minutes or more. Ten players also scored during the opening night.

LSU had one of its better nights at the free throw line, making 17-of-19 attempts (89.5%), including 13-of-14 in the 50-point first half. In the fouls drawn department, Jalen Reed drew six fouls that let to 8-of-8 at the line.

The Tigers' starting lineup was a combined +126 in the plus-minus category which indicates how much was scored by his team while on the court versus how many points the team gave up at the same time. Robert Miller was +29, Cam Carter +28, Dji Bailey +27, Jalen Reed +23 and Jordan Sears +19.

TIGERS WANT BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the season where LSU stumbled some, losing five times in the month of November and December. So one of the goals of this team this year is to not only get ready for league play, but to play better basketball in the first two months of the season.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

OPENING NIGHTS

LSU is now 96-21 on opening nights, having won the last 11 opening games. The last loss was in November 2013 when the Tigers lost, 92-90, at UMass.

The Tigers last on-court home loss in the first game of the season dates back to 1986 when LSU lost to TCU in the opening round of the preseason NIT.

RETURNING NUMBERS

LSU returns an average of 35.3 points from a year ago (46.2 percent) of the team's 76.4 points per game average, while the returning rebound average is 42.8 percent (15.3 of 35.7).

TURNOVERS

The exhibition game did give hope about LSU's ability to possibly keep the turnovers down. Last season LSU averaged 13.1 turnovers a game.

LSU only had single digit turnovers once a year ago with eight in the home win over Vanderbilt (January 2024) and 10 on four other occasions.

The Tigers had 12 in the opening contest on Wednesday.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

The Tigers did not shoot a good percentage in the game against ULM (11/6), making 10-of-34, but for the 18th time in the Matt McMahon era, the Tigers were in double figures from the arc. LSU is 8-10 in those 18 games. LSU in the exhibition game against Loyola made 18 three-pointers which would have been a school record in a regular season game. The record bests:

LSU was in double figures from the arc nine times last year, making 256-of-717 (35.7 percent). Opponents made 19 more threes on 104 more attempts. LSU was 143-of-396 (36.1 percent) in SEC games.

There was a hint of what was possible last year when LSU had 14 makes against Mississippi Valley State and then against Lamar (Dec. 12, 2023), the Tigers had 38 attempts, the second most in school history:

FAMILIAR FACES JOIN LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State.

Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton.

Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

MARAVICH CENTER

LSU was 12-6 a year ago in the 53rd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. The Tigers are 339-49 in non-conference games in the building.

The building was originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation following the untimely death of the star LSU player. The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain is in his third year at LSU, but his best season was his first after last year was plagued by injuries before and during the season.

But when Fountain came off the bench for the first time, the aggressive play that had been seen in the 2022-23 season seemed to be back. Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals and one block.

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24.

PORTAL PLAYERS

All three players that LSU picked up in the transfer portal over the summer started for the Tigers in the opening game.

Cam Carter (Kansas State) – 31 minutes, 7-of-12 FGs, 4-of-8 3FGs, 3-3 FT, 21 pts, 4 rebs, 1 asts

Jordan Sears (UT Martin) – 14 minutes, 3-of-6 FGs, 1-of-3 3FGs, 7 pts, 1 reb.

DJI Bailey (Richmond) – 23 minutes, 6-of-7 FGs, 1-1 FTs, 13 pts, 6 rebs, 2 asts

TOTALS – 71 minutes, 16-30 FG, 10-18 3FG, 5-6 FT, 47 pts, 11 rebs, 10 asts

WHAT ARE THE ODDS FOR CAM CARTER?

When Cam Carter played on the Maravich Center court representing Kansas State on Dec. 9, 2023, he posted 21 points in the K-State victory.

His next game on the same court, representing LSU this past Wednesday, he posted 21 points, this time for the Tigers.

Those are two of the three times he has scored 21 points, T4 on his career scoring list. He has had six games of 20 or more points in his career.

DAIMION COLLINS BACK HEALTHY

Daimion Collins was playing his best basketball of the season against North Florida early last season when he suffered a shoulder injury that required surgery.

Wednesday officially marked his return to the court and he played 17 minutes with two points, four rebounds and two blocks.

It was his seventh official contest in the purple and gold. He averaged 4.3 points and 2.2 rebounds in six contests a season ago.

AND THE FIRST YEAR GUYS MADE THEIR MARK AS WELL

LSU had four players make their official debuts in the ULM game -- Robert Miller III, Vyctorius Miller, Curtis Givens III, Corey Chest.

The first three were freshman signees for the 2024-25 season, while Chest was signed prior to the 2023-24 season and was redshirted.

Robert Miller earned the start at forward, playing 23 minutes with two points, 1 rebound, three assists and no turnovers. Givens hit four treys and scored 15 points to go with six rebounds, while Vyctorius Miller played 13 minutes and had three points, two assists and two rebounds.

Chest, a New Orleans native, played his final prep season in 2022-23 at Link Academy in Branson, Missouri where the school won the prep national championship. He played three minutes and did not score.

BLOCKS GOING TO BE A NUMBER TO WATCH?

LSU last season averaged 3.78 blocks a game and the Tigers seem ready to see if they can't up that number a bit this year.

Five different Tigers blocked shots with both Jalen Reed and Daimion Collins each with two blocks each.

JALEN REED CAREER NIGHT

It was in Charleston last November in the opening round that Jalen Reed had his best scoring night of 16 points against Dayton.

Reed made 8-of-9 field goals and all eight free throw attempts to score 24 points.

Reed had eight rebounds and a career high eight field goals made. His eight free throws were also a career high.

Reed has now played 66 career games at LSU with 32 starts.

SEVEN FORMER TIGERS STARTED ON NBA ROSTERS

Seven former Tiger basketball players were on opening week rosters as the National Basketball Association began its 2024-25 season last week:

- Brooklyn Nets – Ben Simmons, Cam Thomas, Tandon Watford
- Houston Rockets – Tari Eason
- Minnesota Timberwolves – Naz Reid
- Portland Trail Blazers – Duop Reath
- Toronto Raptors – Garrett Temple

Reid is one of the most popular players in Minnesota is coming off a season in which he was named the NBA Sixth Man of the Year. Reid was part of the Tigers 2019 Sweet 16 NCAA Tournament team at LSU.

Temple is the veteran of the group and has been a mentor to many of the young Raptors. He is in his 15th season in the league after playing in the Final Four as a freshman in 2006 and winning an SEC regular season title for LSU in his final year of 2009. As of Saturday, he had appeared in 745 NBA games and needs only 14 appearances to pass Brandon Bass for third place in total appearances among LSU NBA stars (748).

Thomas had a breakout season a year ago for the Nets, averaging 22.5 points and 2.9 assists in 66 games. Last year he became the youngest player in NBA history to score 40 points in three straight games. He opened with 36 points on Wednesday night.

Joining him on the NETS are Watford and 2016 National Freshman of the Year Ben Simmons

Watford is in his fourth season in the NBA, joining the Nets last year. Simmons, who has struggled with injuries but seems to be fully recovered from back surgery. This is his seventh year to play in the league.

Eason looks to return from an injury that shortened his season in 2023-24. The 17th pick in the 2022 NBA Draft played a full 82 games in the 2022-23 seasons.

Reath had a different path to the NBA after completing his playing time at LSU in 2018. Reath played overseas before joining the Trail Blazers 2023 Summer League team. He eventually signed a two-way deal with Portland and debuted on Nov. 12, 2023. In February 2024, Portland converted his two-way deal to a standard contract.

FIRST ROAD TRIP OF SEASON TAKES CAM CARTER BACK TO KANSAS STATE

LSU and Kansas State will meet for the third straight season on Thursday night at 8 p.m. in Manhattan, Kansas. The game at Bramlage Coliseum is part of a men-women doubleheader with K-State women's team hosting Creighton at 5:30 p.m. The LSU game will be streamed on ESPN+ and broadcast on the affiliates of the LSU Sports Radio Network.

The Tigers return to take on Charleston Southern on Nov. 19 in the next home appearance after Sunday at the Maravich Center.
