3rd Year at LSU · 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season titles (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

THE MTE HISTORY

It's called the Multi-Team Event (MTE) these days. No telling what it was called in 1947 when LSU played in the Fort Worth Collegiate in Texas, the first multi-team event LSU played in. The Greenbrier Tipoff will be the 63rd time LSU has participated in an early season tournament. Last year, the Tigers took part in the Charleston Classic, losing to Dayton 70-67 in the opening round before defeating North Texas, 66-62 and then Wake Forest in overtime, 86-80. The last two-game event the Tigers took part in was the Emerald Coast Classic in Niceville, Florida, in 2021 when LSU defeated Penn State (68-63) in overtime and Wake Forest, 75-61. Those games coincidentally were broadcast on CBSSN. Speaking of CBSSN, the network has to be happy as the four teams come in with a combined record of 18-0.

SERIES HISTORY VS. THE GREENBRIER TEAMS

PITTSBURGH -- The teams are tied 2-2 in the overall series that dates back to the latest game played in a season in LSU history -- April 13, 1935. In a game that was played in Atlantic City, New Jersey, the best of the East (Pitt) met the best of the West (LSU) in a game billed as a "mythical" national championship which LSU won, 41-37. Harry Rabenhorst was the coach of that team that finished 14-1 and 11-0 in conference. The only game not played on a neutral site was in January 1969, when LSU with Pete Maravich won in the old "Cow Palace" on campus. **UCF** -- LSU and UCF have not played in basketball. **WISCONSIN** -- The Tigers are 0-4 versus Wisconsin and the last game came 25 seasons ago in Albuquerque when the Badgers were 61-48 winners over the Tigers in the NCAA Sweet 16. LSU Radio Network color analyst John Brady was the coach of that 2000 LSU team. Wisconsin also won games in 1953, 1954 and 1967.

PITTSBURGH UPDATE

Pittsburgh scored 93 points on Monday night, 54 in the second half in a 93-48 win over VMI as Pittsburgh ran its record to 5-0 on the season. The Panthers have wins over Radford, Murray State, Gardner Webb and an 86-62 win over West Virginia prior to Monday night.

Six players scored between 11 and 14 points for Pittsburgh in the victory. For the season, Ishmael Leggett averages 17.6 points a game, Damian Dunn 15.2, Jaland Lowe 13.6, Cameron Corhen 12.6 and Guillermo Diaz Graham is at 10.0 point a contest. Pittsburgh is averaging 88.2 points a game. Jeff Capel is in his seventh season as the head coach of Pittsburgh.

Freshman Vyctorius Miller had a second strong game with a team best 19 points on 9-of-14 shooting, while Jordan Sears had 15 points and Dji Bailey hit 5-of-6 field goals to finish with 11 ... RECAP: The Tigers broke open a tight game some eight minutes in with a couple of scoring runs, including 11 straight points that helped the Tigers to a 50-27 halftime advantage on the way to the opening night victory. Ten Tigers scored in the game with four in double figures as LSU shot over 50 percent from the floor and an impressive 17-of-19 from the free throw line. LSU made 10 three-pointers on 34 attempts. Defensively, LSU was good, shooting 38.7 percent (24-of-62) with just three three-point field goals. LSU had a 23-7 advantage in points from turnovers and 46 points in the paint.

Junior Jalen Reed had his best game as a Tiger scoring 24 points with eight rebounds, hitting 8-of-9 field goals and all eight free throws. Cam Carter had 21 points with four treys, while Curtis Givens III had 15 and Dji Bailey 15.

MORE NOTES FROM THE CHARLESTON SOUTHERN WIN

The rebounds in the game were tied at 42 each, the seventh time in the Matt McMahon era rebounds were even after 40 minutes. The Tigers are now 1-6 in those games.

The tie game after 30 minutes marked the fifth time LSU has been tied after 30 minutes of play in the McMahon era. LSU is now 1-4 in those games. LSU has shot 50 percent from the field in three of the four games this season, including against Charleston Southern. LSU has now shot 50 percent or better in 13 games in the McMahon era at LSU with a 10-3 record.

LSU has held the opponents below 40 percent and under 70 points in all four contests this season.

TIGERS CONTINUING TO TAKE STEPS TO BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

The win over Kansas State and LSU's rally against Charleston Southern allowed LSU to take more steps toward having a better November-December record when the non-conference portion of the season ends at the end of December.

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the 2023-24 season where LSU stumbled some, losing five times in the month of November and December, including some games when they were favored. So one of the goals of this team this year is to not only get ready for league play, but to play better basketball in the first two months of the season.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

VYCTORIUS MILLER WITH BACK-TO-BACK STRONG PERFORMANCES

Freshman Vyctorius Miller made it back-to-back double figure scoring games coming off the bench at Kansas State (11/14) and at home against Charleston Southern (11/19). Miller was 1-7 from the field and 1-6 from three-point range in the first two games but in the last two games, great numbers in some 45 minutes of play:

At K-State – 6-of-9 FGs, 2-4 3FGs, 1-2 FTs, 15 pts, 3 rebs, 2 asts
Charleston So. – 9-of-14 FGs, 1-3 FTs, 19 pts, 1 ast, 2 steals

For the season, Miller is averaging 9.3 points, 1.3 rebounds, 1.3 assists and has made 16-of-30 field goals.

COREY CHEST GETS POINTS AFTER DOMINATING ON BOARD

Corey Chest, a redshirt freshman from New Orleans, took advantage of Derek Fountain not being able to go at Kansas State (11/14) by grabbing 13 rebounds against the Wildcats. Message boards invoked names like Greg “Cookieman” Cook from the 1981 Final Four team and freshman Tyrus Thomas from the 2005-06 season as people who had similar rebound efforts.

Chest played 21 minutes and was +9 for the game. He played three years of high school before playing for Link Academy of Branson, Missouri, the national high school champions in 2023. He redshirted the 2023-24 season.

Against Charleston So. (11/19), Chest scored eight total points with six boards, two blocks and two steals. He had six second half points to help the Tigers rally.

SO 13 REBOUNDS AS A FRESHMAN AT LSU?

The 13 rebounds against Kansas State (11/14) was the first game for a Tiger freshman with 13 rebounds since Naz Reid versus Florida in the SEC Tournament had 14 boards on March 15, 2019.

That was one of three games Reid had 13 or more rebounds in the 2018-19 season. Emmitt Williams also had two games as a freshman of 13 rebounds that season.

Since the start of the 1988-89 season, Chest is the 13th freshman to have at least one rebound game of 13 or more for the Tigers.

The school record for rebounds happens to be by a freshman when Durand “Rudy” Macklin had a seemingly unbreakable mark of 32 rebounds against Tulane on Nov. 26, 1976. Macklin is the school's all-time career rebound leader, with 1,276.

AT THE NEUTRAL SITE

LSU was 2-3 at neutral sites last year and in Matt McMahon's first two years, the Tigers are 6-5. LSU's two neutral wins a year ago came in the Charleston Classic.

Overall, LSU on court has a record of 169-182 (48.1 percent) in neutral court contests.

SEASON OPENER MARKED EIGHTH STRAIGHT YEAR A FRESHMAN STARTED FOR LSU

With Robert Miller III starting versus ULM (11/6), it marked the eighth straight year LSU started at least one freshman in the regular season opener.

WILL WE SEE A 2,000 POINT SCORER FOR LSU; MAYBE 1,000 POINT MARK TO BE CROSSED?

In the 2022-23 season, LSU celebrated a 2,000-point career scorer when KJ Williams crossed the mark as part of his final season at LSU after a stellar part of his career at Murray State.

Now in the 2024-25 season, the potential of another 2,000-point career scorer is a possibility as Jordan Sears enters the week having passed the 1,700-point mark in the Kansas State game.

Sears, with two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin is now at 1,729 points. He would need to average just under 10 points a game to get the mark by the end of the season.

Speaking of point totals, Cam Carter with 71 points in the first four games has taken a big chunk of the total on his march to 1,000 career points. After four games at LSU, to go with a year at Mississippi State and two at Kansas State, is at 857 points entering the tournament.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

The early scoop on LSU was that it was going to try to transition fast and shoot the three-ball when possible.

Well, that hasn't exactly lived up to its tenor after four games. LSU tries to get it going fast when it can control the boards, but has not shot the percentage it would like from distance, hitting just 29-of-93 or 31.2 percent.

The caveat with that is that the Tigers have found that they can drive to the goal more than probably predicted by the pundits and is shooting 83-of-134 inside the arc (61.9 percent). That puts LSU in the top 25 in two-point field goal shooting.

However, opponents after four games are hitting just 19.7 percent from distance (15-of-76) which ranks first in the Southeastern Conference and second in the nation as of Wednesday morning.

LSU was in double figures from the arc nine times last year, making 256-of-717 (35.7 percent). Opponents made 19 more threes on 104 more attempts. LSU was 143-of-396 (36.1 percent) in SEC games.

FREE THROWS – WHAT HAPPENED?

There was a moment of question regarding LSU's free throw shooting when they made just 7-of-14 at the stripe in the first half of play against Alabama State (11/10). But in the second half and against Kansas State, the Tigers were 32-of-38 at the line in those 60 minutes of play.

But against Charleston Southern, it was just a so-so night with free tosses, making 8-of-12 in the first half and just 5-of-11 in the second half for a 13-of-23 night (56.5%).

Through four games, LSU is 69-of-94 or 73.4 percent, while opponents are 57-of-80 for 71.3 percent. LSU's top four scorers have attempted 70 of LSU's 94 free throws:

Cam Carter – 15-of-17 (88.2%)

Jordan Sears – 16-of-20 (80.0%)

Jalen Reed – 14-of-20 (70.0%)

Dji Bailey – 9-of-13 (69.2%)

The remaining LSU players are a combined 15-of-24 at the stripe.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain is in his third year at LSU, but his best season was his first after last year was plagued by injuries before and during the 2023-24 season. While his first two games showed what he did two years ago when he was healthy, his minor injury in the pregame prior to Kansas State (11/14) could have been problematic for LSU.

When Fountain came off the bench for the first time this season against ULM (11/6), the aggressive play that had been seen in the 2022-23 season seemed to be back. Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals and one block

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24.

Fountain, who played two years at Mississippi State before coming to LSU, did not have a good scoring game against Alabama State (11/10), but he was on the floor for 23 minutes, helping to move the issue in favor of the Tigers with six rebounds and a plus/minus total of +17.

PORTAL PLAYERS

The three LSU picked up in the transfer portal started for the Tigers in the first two games and here are some of their four-game totals:

Cam Carter (Kansas St.) – 71 pts, 14 rebs, 4 asts, 22-40 FGs (55.0%); 12-21 3FGs (57.1%), 15-17 FTs

Jordan Sears (UT Martin) – 55 pts, 16 rebs, 13 asts, 16-35 FGs (45.7%); 7-19 3FGs (36.8%), 16-20 FTs

DJI Bailey (Richmond) – 43 pts, 19 rebs, 10 asts 17-25 FGs (68.0%), 9-13 FTs (69.2%)

CAM CARTER GOT IT TO 20 IN RETURN TO MANHATTAN

After two 21-point games in Baton Rouge to open the LSU part of his career, the return proved not too big for the fourth-year player as he returned to a spot where the “Octagon of Doom” was his home court in Manhattan, Kansas.

Carter gave LSU the lead for good with his first three-pointer of the night at 23-21 and finished with 20 points, his third consecutive 20-point game for the Tigers.

He was on the verge of his third consecutive 21-point game, but after making his first 15 free throws, his miss late in the game of a free throw left him at 20 points. He was 6-of-11 from the field with three makes after back-to-back four three-pointers in his first two games.

Carter is averaging 17.8 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3 treys a game. He has had eight games of 20 or more in his career.

SEARS AND BAILEY

Jordan Sears and Dji Bailey’s numbers have been important at different times in the young season doing different things.

Sears has had the scoring run of three straight double figure games with 18 vs. Alabama State and 15 each at Kansas State and versus Charleston Southern. In the last two games he is 9-of-20 from the field and 5-of-11 from distance with 12 rebounds and eight assists.

He is averaging 13.8 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.3 assists.

Bailey has played over 30 minutes in each of the last three games, rebounding from a 4-point game against Kansas State to hit 5-of-6 field goals in scoring 11 points against Charleston Southern (11/19).

For the season he is 17-of-25 in field goals (68.0%) and 17-of-21 inside the arc. He is averaging 10.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.5 assists.

DAIMION COLLINS BACK HEALTHY

Daimion Collins was playing his best basketball of the season against North Florida early last season when he suffered a shoulder injury that required surgery.

Well, Collins may have been played one of his best LSU games against Kansas State (11/14) when he came off the bench to play 21.5 minutes, making all five field goal attempts (3 dunks) with two free throws scoring 12 points with three rebounds.

The season opener marked his return to the court and he played 17 minutes with two points, four rebounds and two blocks against ULM. Against Alabama State (11/10), he played 16 minutes with four points, three rebounds and again two blocks.

In fact in four games, he has already played more minutes (77-62), made as many field goals (10) and has more rebounds (17-13) than he did in the six games he played for the Tigers in 2023-24.

Collins had three blocks against Charleston Southern and had five points and seven rebounds in the contest.

CURTIS GIVENS AND ROBERT MILLER

First of all, the two freshmen have “III” at the end of their names. Givens, who hails from Memphis and came from national champion Montverde Academy in Florida, has had the better numbers through four games, especially in the opener against ULM (11/6).

Against the Warhawks, Givens played 21 minutes off the bench and hit four treys with six rebounds, scoring 15 points. He is averaging 12.6 minutes a game, 4.3 points, 1.8 assists

Miller as mentioned started the first four games and while the Houston product from Pasadena (Texas) Memorial, has not scored well early, he has played an average of 15.3 minutes a game,

BLOCKS GOING TO BE A NUMBER TO WATCH?

LSU last season averaged 3.78 blocks a game and the Tigers seem ready to see if they can't up that number a bit this year.

Seven different Tigers blocked shots in the first four games.

LSU is averaging 5.5 blocks a game so far this season. Opponents have just nine total blocks.

JALEN REED CAREER NIGHT IN OPENER

It was in Charleston last November in the opening round that Jalen Reed had his previous best scoring night of 16 points against Dayton.

But against ULM (11/6) in the season opener, Reed made 8-of-9 field goals and all eight free throw attempts to score 24 points.

Reed had eight rebounds and a career high eight field goals made. His eight free throws were also a career high.

While the scoring hasn't been as much since that opening game, the number eight has been good for Reed as he has had eight rebounds in three-of-the-four games this season, including Tuesday night against Charleston Southern.

Reed has now played 69 career games at LSU with 35 starts. Through four games he is averaging 10.3 points and is the team leader in rebounds at 6.8 a game.

FAMILIAR FACES JOIN LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State.

Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton.

Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

TIGERS SIGNED THREE FOUR-STAR IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

The LSU Tigers signed three four-star players for the 2025-26 season during the opening day of the signing period that occurred last Wednesday. Rivals as of Wednesday AM, had the class ranked No. 7 in their team rankings. Here are some numbers on the signees:

MATT GILHOOL – Elizabethtown, Pa. – William Penn Charter School (6-11 Forward)

Averaged 15 points, nine rebounds and two blocks a game for the school as a junior ... The lefthander attended the 2024 Pangos All-America Camp where he was one of the top scorers in the event, averaging 17.3 points per game ... The No. 2 player in the state of Pennsylvania, is ranked No. 65 in the Rivals Rankings and 73 in the On3sports.com composite rankings.

In his junior season, he shot 57 percent from the floor, 31 percent from distance and helped William Penn Charter to the championship of the Inter-AC in 2024, their first outright championship in 20 years. He was the Inter-AC MVP last season.
