3rd Year at LSU · 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season titles (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

SEC WINS BIG IN CHALLENGE; LSU GETS CLINCHING NINTH POINT

The game Tuesday night between LSU and Florida State lasted two hours and 27 minutes and that was late enough to make the LSU win over the Seminoles the ninth win needed to clinch the SEC/ACC Challenge for the Southeastern Conference.

Overall in the 16 games, the SEC won 14 to get their first win in the series after the two leagues tied a year ago. LSU is now 5-6 overall in Challenge games with the Big East, Big 12 and ACC over the years.

THE FLORIDA GULF COAST SERIES

LSU and Florida Gulf Coast will be playing basketball for the first time on Sunday. It is the second of what will be three straight home games LSU will play against schools from the state of Florida -- Florida State (Dec. 3), Florida Gulf Coast (Dec. 8) and Stetson (Dec. 17).

FLORIDA GULF COAST UPDATE

Furman defeated Florida Gulf Coast on Wednesday night in Fort Myers by a score of 76-73. FGCU built a 44-33 halftime lead, but Furman came back to score 43 second half points to get the win. Florida Gulf Coast shot 29-of-55 from the field (52 percent) with six treys. Furman posted an 18-8 advantage in points off turnovers and had a 34-26 advantage in rebounds.

Zavian McLean led FGCU in the contest with 19 points, Jevin Muniz had 16 points, Dallion Johnson 11 and Rahmir Barno 10.

Johnson leads FGCU with a 13.1 points per game average, with McLean at 11.1 a game.

FGCU is now 3-6 and has won three-of-the-last-five games after starting 0-4 on the season.

The Eagles of the ASun Conference, are coached by Pat Chambers in his third season. He was previously head coach at Boston University and Penn State.

THE 7-1 LSU START

The Tigers have won seven-of-the-first-eight games now for the 35th time in program history and the 14th time in the last 40 seasons:

NOTES FROM THE WIN OVER FLORIDA STATE

- LSU again found itself trailing at intermission and then put the offense in high gear, scoring 53 second-half points while shooting 57.1 percent from the field (16-of-28).
- Cam Carter and Jordan Sears combined for 47 points, 14 rebounds, 3 assists, 14-of-31 from the field and 6-of-16 from three-point range.
- Carter who leads the team in fouls drawn through eight games, drew seven fouls and was 8-of-9 at the line.
- Vyctorius Miller had his sixth consecutive double figure scoring game with 15 points.
- Daimion Collins returned after a shoulder injury suffered in the Pittsburgh game on Nov. 22. He missed two full games and returned to play 18 minutes with four points, three rebounds and four blocks.
- Corey Chest had his third double figure rebound game of the season with 10 boards.

TIGERS CONTINUING TO TAKE STEPS TO BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

The win over Kansas State, LSU's rally against Charleston Southern and UCF, and now the SEC/ACC Challenge win over Florida State has allowed LSU to take more steps toward having a better November-December record when the non-conference portion of the season ends at the end of December.

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the 2023-24 season where LSU stumbled some, losing five times in the month of November and December, including some games when they were favored. So one of the goals of this team this year is to not only get ready for league play, but to play better basketball in the first two months of the season.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

Now LSU which has survived one injury to Daimion Collins, will now have to survive the loss for the season of Jalen Reed.

THREE POWER CONFERENCE WINS IN NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

LSU wins over Kansas State and UCF of the Big 12 and Florida State of the ACC, puts the 2024-25 LSU team in rarified air of wins by an LSU team against the so-called major conferences of that particular time (in this case, Big 10, Big 12, Big East, ACC) for example.

The last LSU team to beat three teams from the power conferences in November-December was the 2021-22 Tigers which defeated Penn State of the Big 10 and Wake Forest and Georgia Tech of the ACC.

The only LSU team in the last 20 years to record four non-conference wins in an entire season was the 2005-06 team which beat West Virginia of the Big East and then Texas A&M (Big 12), Duke (ACC) and Texas (Big 12) in the NCAA Tournament.

FIRST NET RANKINGS COME OUT

The NCAA NET Rankings came for the first time on Monday with LSU starting in the No. 50 spot. As of Thursday AM, the Tigers are No. 55 in the rankings. LSU has Quad 2 wins over Kansas State, UCF and Florida State. LSU is 0-1 against Quad 1 teams (Pittsburgh). LSU's next Quad 1 opportunity could come on the semi-neutral court in Frisco, Texas against SMU (Dec. 14).

MARAVICH ASSEMBLY CENTER

LSU was 12-6 a year ago in the 53rd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. LSU is 5-0 this year on the Maravich court and the Tigers are 344-49 in non-conference games in the building.

The building was originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation following the untimely death of the star LSU player. The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

2,000, 1,000 POINT MARKS POSSIBLE FOR TIGERS IN 2024-25

In the 2022-23 season, LSU celebrated a 2,000-point career scorer when K.J Williams crossed the mark as part of his final season at LSU after a stellar part of his career at Murray State.

Now in the 2024-25 season, the potential of another 2,000-point career scorer is a possibility as Jordan Sears enters Sunday with 1,798 points, with a 13.9 career scoring average for 129 games.

Sears, with two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin, would need to average just under 10 points a game to get the mark by the end of the season.

Speaking of point totals, Cam Carter with 143 points in the first eight games has taken a big chunk of the total on his march to 1,000 career points. The senior is now at 929 points in 105 career games. With his current average of 17.9 and 71 points needed, there is every chance he could get to 1,000 by the end of the month.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

The early scoop on LSU was that it was going to try to transition fast and shoot the three-ball when possible.

Well, that hasn't exactly lived up to its tenor after seven games. LSU tries to get it going fast when it can control the boards, but has not shot the percentage it would like from distance, hitting 65-of-204 or 31.9 percent.

However, LSU did hit double figures in two-of-the-last three games, hitting 12 against UCF in the triple overtime game. The Tigers hit nine of those in the second half and overtime when they were 9-of-23 from distance after going 3-of-13 in the opening 20 minutes.

Against Northwestern State (11/30), the Tigers hit 10-of-27 (37.0 percent), including 7-of-14 in the second half.

LSU has now hit double digit three-pointers 20 times in the Matt McMahon era (3-0 this season) with a 10-10 overall mark.

The Tigers are on the uptick from the arc, hitting 31-of-90 (34.4 percent) in the last three games.

Jordan Sears, who has made 16 three-pointers in the last three games, leads the team in percentage at 40.7 percent (24-of-59), while Cam Carter is 20-of-50 (40.0%). These two are a combined 44-of-109 from the arc.

Defensively, the Tigers are allowing just 25.7 percent from three-point range (46-of-179). As of Thursday AM, the Tigers are ranked first in the conference in three-point percentage defense and 10th in the NCAA statistics.

DEFENSIVELY FROM THE FIELD

The Tigers have 25 more made field goals than opponents, even though opponents have attempted 39 more shots. Opponents are 201-of-533 or 37.7 percent, which is 27th in the NCAA for FG defense as of Thursday AM.

The Tigers are 6-0 when opponents shot under 40 percent this season and 20-4 in the Coach Matt McMahon era at LSU.

FIRST HALF VERSUS SECOND HALF

There is a trend that seems to be developing here early in the season as LSU has trailed at the half in its last four home games – Alabama State (Nov. 10), Charleston Southern (Nov. 19), Northwestern State (Nov. 29), Florida State (Dec. 3). LSU would win all games.

LSU also trailed by 20 in the first half, 15 at intermission in the Greenbrier game against UCF (11/24) that LSU would come back to tie and force triple overtime before winning, 109-102.

In the first half of games, LSU is averaging just less than a point more than opponents – 32.3-31.5 and are outrebounded 20.8-20.3. The Tigers shoot 38.1 percent overall and 24.8 percent from three-point range. Jalen Reed was the team's leading first half scorer at 6.3 points with Cam Carter at 5.9 points and Dji Bailey 4.3.

In the second half of games (not counting the overtime periods), LSU averaged 44.9 points compared to 34.3 for opponents and has almost a three-board advantage, 19.5-16.4. The Tigers are shooting 52.4 percent in the last 20 minutes of regulation (120-229) and 39.3 percent from distance (35-89). Opponents are shooting 39.4 percent overall and 22.8 percent in the second half. Carter averages 10.6 points in the second half, Jordan Sears 10.3 and Vyctorius Miller 7.0 a game.

FREE THROWS

There have been ups and downs at the free throw line, but LSU for the season is 73.2 percent at the line, making 139-of-190 attempts. Opponents are 110-of-159 (69.2%).

LSU's top five scorers have made 117-of-139 makes:

Cam Carter – 35-of-41 (85.4%)

Jordan Sears – 24-of-31 (77.4%)

Jalen Reed – 23-of-34 (67.6%)

Vyctorius Miller – 22-of-29 (75.9%)

BLOCKS ARE BACK

LSU has nine players that have blocks through the first eight games this season. LSU averaged 3.8 blocks per game a year ago.

So far, LSU is at 5.5:0 blocks per game which is 20th in the NCAA entering play on Thursday. Corey Chest with his five-block game against Northwestern State (11/29), is averaging 1.29 blocks with Daimion Collins, who had four blocks against Florida State, averaging 1.83 a contest.

GOOD REBOUNDING NUMBERS

The Tigers in the games to date, are averaging 42.0 rebounds a game, compared to 38.5 for opponents. LSU's rebound average is ranked 21st in the NCAA as of Thursday AM.

VYCTORIUS MILLER CONTINUES STRONG EFFORTS; 6 STRAIGHT IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Freshman Vyctorius Miller has really turned into a contributor with six consecutive games in double figures. After playing just 20 minutes in the first two games combined, Miller has now played no less than 21 minutes in the last six games, including 30 minutes against Florida State (12/3).

For the season, he is hitting 31-of-68 field goals (45.6%) with nine treys and 22-of-29 at the free throw line.

Miller for the year is now averaging 11.6 points per game, 2.1 rebounds and 1.38 assists.

COREY CHEST HAS MADE STARTS COUNT

Corey Chest made his first impression in the third game of the year at Kansas State (11/14) when he pulled down 13 rebounds off the bench in 21 minutes. This came one game after he didn't see the floor (Coach's Decision) as part of the rotation in the game against Alabama State (11/10).

But the redshirt freshman from New Orleans played a combined 42 minutes in the next two games and moved into the starting lineup in the triple-overtime win over UCF (11/24) at The Greenbrier. Chest played 27 minutes before fouling out, hitting 3-of-4 field goals with eight points, six boards, a block and three steals.

He played 30 minutes in his second start against Northwestern State (11/29), again hitting 3-of-4 field goals with five blocks and just missing a double double with nine points and 10 rebounds.

He again had double figure rebounds against Florida State (12/3), pulling down 10 rebounds.

Chest became the first LSU player with double figure rebounds in consecutive games since KJ Williams in Dec. 2022.

In his three starts, he is 8-of-10 from the field. For the season, he is averaging 5.7 points, 7.8 rebounds, 1.29 blocks and 1.0 steals a game.

Chest is a redshirt freshman from New Orleans. He played three years of high school at McMain in New Orleans before playing for national high school champion (2023) Link Academy in Branson, Missouri.

PORTAL PLAYERS

The three LSU picked up in the transfer portal started for the Tigers in the first eight games and here are some of their totals:

CAM CARTER 5 20-POINT GAMES

For the fifth time this season, the transfer from Kansas State was able to score 20 or more, with his fifth coming in LSU's last game against Florida State (12/3). Carter hit 8-of-15 field goal attempts with two treys and seven drawn fouls led to an 8-of-9 night at the free throw line against the Seminoles. He also had eight boards, two assists and two steals.

Carter's 20-point games this season:

ULM (11/6) – 21 points

Ala. St. (11/10) – 21 points

At Kansas St. (11/14) – 20 points

Vs. UCF (11/24) – 20 points

Florida St. (12/3) – 26 points.

Carter has 10 career 20-point games.

On his return to Manhattan, Kansas (11/14), where he played for two seasons, Carter gave LSU the lead for good with his first three-pointer of the night at 23-21 and as mentioned finished with 20 points.

In the triple over at The Greenbrier against UCF (11/24) he had 20 points with three treys, seven boards, two assists and three steals.

Carter is averaging 17.9 points, 4.5 rebounds and 1.6 assists a game. He is shooting 40.0 percent from distance (20-of-50). Carter as of Thursday AM, is eighth in the league in scoring average.

JORDAN SEARS

Jordan Sears has posted 16 three-pointers in the last three games combined with six treys against both UCF (11/24) and Northwestern State (11/29). Sears is 14-of-27 from distance in the second half (51.9 percent) this season.

Sears has six double figures games so far this season with an LSU high of 25 against UCF with nine boards. He has four games of three treys or more, five games with at least five rebounds and two games with at least five assists.

Sears had 21 points against Florida State (12/3) with four treys, 5-of-6 at the free throw line, and six rebounds.

Sears is a fifth-year senior who played two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin. He is six games shy of 100 career college starts.

With a couple of games with six treys, Sears' career high for distance FGs is seven, at Lindenwood of Feb. 22, 2024 in a game Sears scored 37 points. Last season, Sears had 76 made three-pointers.

This season, Sears is averaging 15.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.4 steals per game.

DJI BAILEY

The grad transfer from the University of Richmond is shooting 56.4 percent overall, making 31-of-55 this season. He is a career 56.4 percent shooter in overall field goal percentage.

From inside the arc, Bailey is 30-of-42 (71.4 percent).

Bailey played 44 minutes against UCF, with his fourth double figure game this season of 14 in that game. He had five rebounds (all offensive) and six assists against the Knights (11/24).

Bailey is averaging 9.5 points, 4.4 rebounds, 3.1 assists and 1.5 steals per game.

CURTIS GIVENS AND ROBERT MILLER

First of all, the two freshmen have "III" at the end of their names. Givens, who hails from Memphis and came from national champion Montverde Academy in Florida, has had the better numbers through eight games, especially in the opener against ULM (11/6).

Against the Warhawks, Givens played 21 minutes off the bench and hit four treys with six rebounds, scoring 15 points.

Givens is averaging 3.6 points, 1.4 rebounds and 1.2 assists per game.

Miller started the first five games before coming off the bench in the last three games. Miller had his best effort scoring in the first eight games against Florida State as he came in for 15 minutes, hit both field goal attempts for five points, four rebounds (three offensive) and a block.

The Houston product from Pasadena (Texas) Memorial, has played an average of 12.0 minutes a game, averaging 1.8 points and 2.0 rebounds a game.

SEASON OPENER MARKED EIGHTH STRAIGHT YEAR A FRESHMAN STARTED FOR LSU

With Robert Miller III starting versus ULM (11/6), it marked the eighth straight year LSU started at least one freshman in the regular season opener.

JALEN REED CAREER NIGHT IN OPENER; CAREER DOUBLE AGAINST UCF

Things were going so well for Jalen Reed in the first seven games before the ACL injury early in the Florida State game (12/3) that has sidelined him.

In the opening game against ULM (11/6) and in the two Greenbrier games, junior Jalen Reed has certainly found the formula for driving to the goal and making productive shots.

Against ULM, in 23 minutes, Reed hit 8-of-9 field goals and 8-of-8 at the free throw lines to get a career high of 24 points with eight rebounds and two blocks.

For his performance at the Greenbrier, Reed would earn All-Tournament honors averaging 17.5 points, 10.0 rebounds with four assists and three blocks. Reed in the two games would make 13-of-22 field goals (59.1 percent) with a trey.

Reed against UCF (11/24), would play 48 minutes, make 7-of-12 field goals and 7-of-8 rebounds to finish with 21 points, 13 rebounds and four assists.

Reed was a case study of Coach Matt McMahon's player development program showing his improvement from his freshman to sophomore season and now from his sophomore to junior season.

Reed has played 73 career games at LSU with 39 starts.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain is in his third year at LSU, but his best season was his first after last year was plagued by injuries before and during the 2023-24 season. While his first two games showed what he did two years ago when he was healthy, his minor injury in the pregame prior to Kansas State (11/14) could have been problematic for LSU.

When Fountain came off the bench for the first time this season against ULM (11/6), the aggressive play that had been seen in the 2022-23 season seemed to be back. Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals and one block.

Fountain returned to play in the Greenbrier Tipoff after missing two games and played 25 minutes in the two games with three points, on his first three pointer of the season.

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24. In 2024-25, he is averaging 1.8 points and 2.5 rebounds.

Fountain, who played two years at Mississippi State before coming to LSU, did not have a good scoring game against Alabama State (11/10), but he was on the floor for 23 minutes, helping to move the issue in favor of the Tigers with six rebounds and a plus/minus total of +17.

OVERTIMES

With the triple overtime win over FAU (11/24) at the Greenbrier, LSU has played 97 overtime games in its history with 44 wins. LSU has played 14 overtimes that have gone multiple sessions. This was the fifth game of at least three overtimes. LSU's last three-overtime game prior to Sunday was a 97-94 win over Alabama in Baton Rouge on Feb. 23, 2013. Regarding points in overtime, the 39 points LSU scored in the three overtimes combined is the most by LSU in an overtime game. The previous high had been 33 points vs. Ohio State on Jan. 15, 2005 which LSU won, 113-101, in double overtime. It was also the most points scored by an opponent in OT (32) with the previous being the 27 by Alabama on Feb. 12, 1972 in the four OT game vs. Alabama.

FAMILIAR FACES JOIN LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State.

Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton.

Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

TIGERS SIGNED THREE FOUR-STAR IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

The LSU Tigers signed three four-star players for the 2025-26 season during the opening day of the signing period that occurred last Wednesday. Rivals as of Wednesday AM, had the class ranked No. 7 in their team rankings. Here are some numbers on the signees:

MATT GILHOOL – Elizabethtown, Pa. – William Penn Charter School (6-11 Forward)

Averaged 15 points, nine rebounds and two blocks a game for the school as a junior ... The lefthander attended the 2024 Pangos All-America Camp where he was one of the top scorers in the event, averaging 17.3 points per game ... The No. 2 player in the state of Pennsylvania, is ranked No. 65 in the Rivals Rankings and 73 in the On3sports.com composite rankings.

In his junior season, he shot 57 percent from the floor, 31 percent from distance and helped William Penn Charter to the championship of the Inter-AC in 2024, their first outright championship in 20 years. He was the Inter-AC MVP last season.

MAZI MOSLEY – Los Angeles, California (6-5 guard)

Advanced to the 2024 Top 100 camp where he averaged 11.3 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.3 assists per contest ... At Section 7 elite event in Glendale, Arizona, he averaged 22.8 points and 6.3 rebounds ... Ranked No. 40 by Rivals.com

Mosley, who played baseball for some 10 years before concentrating fully on basketball, is the nephew of longtime basketball icon, Magic Johnson.

JALEN REECE – Orlando, Florida – Oak Ridge High School (6-0 point guard)

Averaged 16 points, 4.3 rebounds and 3.5 steals in his junior season. Oak Ridge won 27 games last season.

Proven to be a prolific ball handler and distributor, averaging eight assists this past year at Oak Ridge. In EYBL play he averaged 11.3 points and 4.4 assists a contest and led the Peach Jam event this past summer in steals ... Ranked 49 by Rivals, 60 by ESPN and No. 67 in the 247sports composite listings.
