3rd Year at LSU • 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season titles (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

THE UNO SERIES

The Privateers and the Tigers have met 13 previous times since 1977 with LSU holding a 13-4 advantage. The teams last played in 2019 with LSU getting a 90-54 win. The Tigers have won 9-of-the-12 games played in the Maravich Center.
UNO's last win in the series came in the Lakefront Arena in 2001 when UNO won 60-59. UNO has won in the Maravich Center in 1977, 1983 and 1986.

UNO UPDATE

This will be the second of three SEC opponents for the Privateers in a four-game span as UNO faced Texas Thursday night and after playing LSU, will have a game with Vanderbilt on Dec. 30.
UNO lost at Texas on Thursday, 98-62. Dae Dae Hunter had 16 points, Jah Short 15, James White 14 and MJ Thomas 11. White averages 18.6 points a game and Short 12.0.
Stacy Hollowell, who led Loyola of New Orleans to the NAIA Championship in 2022, is in his first year as the head coach at UNO. He served eight years at Loyola before joining Kermit Davis' staff at Ole Miss for the 2002-23 season, then serving with Johnny Jones at Texas Southern before getting the head coaching job back in New Orleans.

A MILESTONE NUMBER GAME AT THE MARAVICH CENTER

The Tigers are 7-0 this year at home and riding a nine-game home winning streak dating back to the final two home games of the 2023-24 season.
LSU is now 346-49 in non-conference home games in the building. Overall, LSU is 634-215 and this will be the 850th men's college basketball game in the building since the first game on Jan. 3, 1972.
The building was originally known as the LSU Assembly Center from its opening in late 1971 until August 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation following the untimely death of the star LSU player. The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

GAME 11 -- LSU 99, STETSON 53 I December 17, 2024 I Pete Maravich Assemlby Center I Baton Rouge, Louisiana

RECAP: The Tigers scored the first 17 points to open the game, holding Stetson scoreless for the first 9:49 of the game and allowed just 10 first-half points in building a 47-10 halftime advantage. Stetson made just 4-of-31 shots (12.9%) in the opening 20 minutes, while LSU was 16-of-32 from the field ... Tigers led by as much as 49 in the final 90 seconds of the game and shot 53.8 percent for the night (35-of-65) with 14-of-31 three-pointers (45.2%) and 15-of-18 from the free throw line (83.3%) ... LSU had a 48-23 advantage on the glass and 42-18 in points in the paint. LSU had assists on 66% of the buckets (23 assists/35 makes).

Five players were in double figures for LSU with Cam Carter and Vyctorius Miller each getting 16 points. Miller hit four treys. Dji Bailey had 14 points, Corey Chest 13 and Curtis Givens 12 ... For Chest it was his second double double of the season and his fifth consecutive game with double figure rebounds.

RECAP: It was a game of two halves as LSU held SMU to 33.3 percent from the floor in the first 20 minutes with only four turnovers as the Tigers built a 33-27 halftime advantage ... But in the second half, SMU forced 13 turnovers and used easy opportunities to shoot 70 percent through the first 12 minutes of the second half. The Mustangs ran off 14 points and turned a two-point deficit into a 12-point advantage ... LSU also went some six-plus minutes without a field goal during that stretch ... The Tigers cut the lead to four and then three in the final two minutes but couldn't get any closer.

Jordan Sears led LSU with 21 points, four assists and four steals, while Dji Bailey had 13 points and Cam Carter had 11 points, six assists, three steals. LSU shot 42.6 percent from the field (23-of-54) with four treys.

RECAP: The Florida home portion of the LSU schedule continued with Florida Gulf Coast coming to town ... The Eagles jumped out to a 4-0 lead, but LSU scored the next 10 points and never trailed again ... LSU would lead by 15, 42-27, at the half and by as much as 22 points with 6:15 to play ... FGCU hit some three-pointers and took advantage of some LSU mistakes to cut the game down to nine at the end ... LSU shot 50 percent from the field (29-of-58) with eight treys and 14-of-16 at the free throw line.

All five LSU starters scored in double figures with Daimion Collins, in his first LSU start, getting 18 points, while Jordan Sears and Cam Carter had 13 each. Corey Chest had his first college double with 12 points-12 rebounds, and Dji Bailey added 11 points. Cam Carter had 5 assists and Collins 3 blocks.

GAME 8 -- LSU 85, FLORIDA STATE 75 I December 3, 2024 I Pete Maravich Assembly Center I Baton Rouge, Louisiana

RECAP: LSU, down three at the half, scored 53 second half points and shot 57 percent from the field as it won its SEC/ACC Challenge game against Florida State. The win was No. 9 for the SEC, clinching the series for the league ... Florida State led by as much as seven in the first half before the Tigers were able to cut it to 35-32 at halftime. The Tigers scored the first eight points of the second half in a 99 second period to take the lead for good. LSU made 16-of-28 field goals in the second half (57.1%) with six three-pointers and 15-of-22 at the line.

LSU finished the game at 45.2 percent (28-of-62) with nine three-pointers, while FSU made just 38.9 percent (28-72) with six treys. Cam Carter led LSU with 26 points, while Jordan Sears had 21 and Vyctorius Miller posted 15 points. For the third game this year, Corey Chest grabbed double figure rebounds with 10.

GAME 7 -- LSU 77, NORTHWESTERN STATE 53 I November 29, 2024 I Pete Maravich Assembly Center I Baton Rouge, Louisiana

RECAP: For the fourth time this season, the Tigers were behind at the half, but came out in the second half and quickly took care of the situation to get a 24-point win over the Demons. LSU was down one, 26-25, after 25 minutes. LSU scored the first five points of the half, then gave up a three-pointer to Northwestern State. But the Tigers responded with a 17-0 run to take complete control of the game. LSU shot 53.1 percent in the second half (17-of-32) and 7-of-14 three-pointers with 11 makes in 12 attempts at the free throw line. LSU would shoot 44.8 percent for the game (26-of-58) with 10 made threes. The Tigers held the Demons to 31.3 percent from the field (21-of-67). The Tigers scored 52 second half points.

Jordan Sears hit six treys for the second straight game in getting 18 points with Cam Carter adding 15 and Jalen Reed and Vyctorius Miller 11 each. Corey Chest had nine point, 10 rebounds and five blocks.

COREY CHEST MAKING REBOUND NUMBER HISTORY

Corey Chest surpassed one mark of Ben Simmons on Tuesday night when he recorded his fifth consecutive double figure rebound game against Stetson (12/17). He had 10 in that contest and passed the mark of four straight set by Ben Simmons in 2016 in the February-March portion of the season.
air when it comes to double digit rebound games at LSU.
The Chest numbers on the boards the last five games:

Now, he will try to continue that streak in a potential march toward Ben Simmons' other streak he had during that 2015-2016 year of seven games in the non-conference portion of the schedule in November-December 2016.
Chest is now fourth in the league in rebound average at 8.60, one of six in the league averaging 8.00 rebounds or more. He is 41st in the NCAA rankings.

TIGERS HAVE TWO GAMES TO GO FOR BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

The Tigers have a game this afternoon and next Sunday that will hopefully complete the first goal of the 2024-25 season – to have a better November-December record coming out of non-conference play.

LSU has taken the steps to improve on last year's November-December, a point of emphasis for LSU as this season began.

The win over Kansas State, LSU's rallies against Charleston Southern and UCF, and the SEC/ACC Challenge win over Florida State has allowed LSU to take some of those steps.

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the 2023-24 season where LSU stumbled too much, losing five times in the month of November and December, including some games when they were favored.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

Now LSU which has survived one injury to Daimion Collins (who has returned), now is working through a rotation after the loss for the season of Jalen Reed. Also, junior college transfer Noah Boyde has been cleared and has made two brief appearances as he continues to get ramped up for play.

THREE POWER CONFERENCE WINS IN NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

LSU wins over Kansas State and UCF of the Big 12 and Florida State of the ACC, puts the 2024-25 LSU team in rarified air of wins by an LSU team against the so-called major conferences of the particular time (in this case, Big 10, Big 12, Big East, ACC) for example.

The last LSU team to beat three teams from the power conferences in November-December was the 2021-22 Tigers which defeated Penn State of the Big 10 and Wake Forest and Georgia Tech of the ACC.

The only LSU team in the last 20 years to record four non-conference wins in an entire season was the 2005-06 team which beat West Virginia of the Big East and then Texas A&M (Big 12), Duke (ACC) and Texas (Big 12) in the NCAA Tournament.

AND OMG WHAT IS UP WITH THE SEC

Entering play on Thursday, only one SEC team has lost more than two games and 10 teams had just one loss. Three of the four remaining undefeated teams are in the league (Florida, Oklahoma, Tennessee).

SEC teams have won 88.6 percent (155-20) of their games entering Thursday play. SEC teams are 58-17 against teams from the ACC, Big 12, Big East and Big Ten. The SEC's 19 regular-season, non-conference Top 25 wins are six more than any other league has ever had in a season (per former ESPN researcher Jared Berson).

Also, the SEC won the second SEC/ACC Challenge, just as a reminder, with a 14-2 mark, including LSU's 85-75 win over Florida State.

And, if that's not enough, ESPN's Joe Lunardi's most recent bracketology had an almost seemingly unbelievable 13 teams in the bracket with two teams, including LSU, in its next four out category.

1,000, THEN 2,000 POINT MARKS ON THE HORIZON FOR LSU IN 2024-25

In the 2022-23 season, LSU celebrated a 2,000-point career scorer when KJ Williams crossed the mark as part of his final season at LSU after a stellar part of his career at Murray State.

LSU in the 2024-25 season, is on the verge of having a 1,000-point career scorer before the turn of the calendar and then in the new year could watch a player top the 2,000-point career mark.

And, now we are getting close to the first milestone.

Cam Carter has scored 183 points to date, a 16.6 average. For his 108-game college career, Carter has now scored 969 points, just 31 points shy of 1,000 for his career.

Jordan Sears, who is averaging 15.0 points per game this season, and who has scored 165 points in his first 11 games as a Tiger, stands at 1,839 points for his 132-game career. He needs to average just over 8.5 points a game to reach the mark by the start of the SEC Tournament.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

LSU found its three-point range against Stetson, hitting 14 treys which is:

- 1) The most made this season by LSU**
- 2) The fourth time in double figures this season**
- 3) T4 most made in the Maravich Center in its years of operation**
- 4) T5 overall in most three-pointers made**

For the season (after making 14-of-31), the Tigers are at 32.9 percent (91-of-277). LSU raised its NCAA ranking 63 spots to 215th after the Stetson game. LSU has now made 20 more three-pointers than opponents on 26 more attempts.

LSU's three-point defense has been good allowing just 71 makes in 251 attempts or 28.3 percent. That is 26th in the NCAA.

LSU has now hit double digit three-pointers 21 times in the Matt McMahon era (4-0 this season) with a 11-10 overall mark.

The Tigers main three-point success has come from Jordan Sears and Cam Carter (The pair has 55 of LSU's 91 three-pointers):

Cam Carter – 26-of-62 – 41.9 percent

Jordan Sears – 29-of-76 – 38.2 percent

Vyctorius Miller hit 4-of-6 three-pointers in the game and raised his season percentage to 31.0, up 60 points from the percentage entering the game.

DEFENSIVELY FROM THE FIELD

The Tigers have 39 more made field goals than opponents, even though opponents have attempted 46 more shots. Opponents are 274-of-717 percent (38.2 percent), which is second in the conference for FG defense and 18th in the NCAA.

The Tigers are 7-0 when opponents shot under 40 percent this season and 21-4 in the Coach Matt McMahon era at LSU.

FREE THROWS

There have been ups and downs at the free throw line, but LSU, after going 14-of-18 against SMU (12/14) and 15-of-18 against Stetson (12/17), so the free throw percentage is back up to over 75 percent (75.2%) for the season (182-of-242) and third best in the league.

Opponents are 137-of-199 (68.8%). LSU has made 45 more free throws with 43 more attempts.

LSU's top five scorers (including Jalen Reed), have made 152-of-195 (77.9%) free throws:

BLOCKS ARE BACK

LSU has nine players that have blocks through the first 11 games this season. LSU averaged 3.8 blocks per game a year ago.

So far, LSU is at 60 blocks or 5.45 which is third in the SEC and 17th in the NCAA as of Thursday.
Damion Collins, who has had 11 blocks in the last four games combined, is averaging 2.0 blocks per game.
Corey Chest, who had a five-block game against Northwestern State (11/29), is averaging 1.1 blocks. Freshman big Robert Miller III is getting his blocks going, now at 0.91 a game.

VYCTORIUS MILLER CONTINUES STRONG EFFORTS

Vyctorius Miller has been a good asset for the LSU basketball team coming off the bench as starting with the third game he rolled off six consecutive double figure scoring games. That streak was stopped on against FGCU (12/8).

Miller had struggled from the arc the last four games, hitting just 3-of-15 attempts, but he showed the form seen earlier in the season against Stetson (12/17), when he hit 4-of-6 from distance. It was his second game of three or more treys this season.

Against the Hatters, he finished with 16 points on 5-of-8 overall shooting.
Miller started the season playing just 20 minutes combined in the first two games with three total points. Since then, Miller has played no less than 20 minutes in eight-of-the-last-nine games and has bests of 19 points against Charleston Southern (11/19) and another 16-point game versus UCF (11/24).

For the season to date, he is hitting 40-of-86 field goals (46.5%) with 13 treys and 26-of-33 at the free throw line.

Miller for the year is now averaging 10.8 points per game, 2.3 rebounds and 1.5 assists.

COREY CHEST HAS MADE STARTS COUNT

There were hints a year ago when he was having his redshirt season at LSU that Corey Chest was making some impressions, all good, in practice and in the weight room.

And, those impressions are now being seen on the basketball court as Chest has started the last five games for the Tigers.

That first impression came in the third game of the year at Kansas State (11/14) when he pulled down 13 rebounds off the bench in 21 minutes. This came one game after he didn't see the floor (Coach's Decision) as part of the rotation in the game against Alabama State (11/10).

But the redshirt freshman from New Orleans played a combined 42 minutes in the next two games and moved into the starting lineup in the triple-overtime win over UCF (11/24) at The Greenbrier. Chest played 27 minutes before fouling out, hitting 3-of-4 field goals with eight points, six boards, a block and three steals.

Since moving into the starting lineup, Chest's scoring average has gone from 4.8 to 7.1, his rebound average from 6.6 to 8.6 and he is 23-of-34 from the field.

As documented earlier, Chest has become the first LSU player with five straight double figure rebound games since 2016.

For the season, he is averaging 7.1 points, 8.6 rebounds, 1.1 blocks and 1.0 steals a game.

Chest in New Orleans played three years of high school at McMain before playing for national high school champion (2023) Link Academy in Branson, Missouri.

DAIMION COLLINS

His first season at LSU in 2023-24 ended abruptly when a dislocated shoulder early in non-conference play would lead to surgery.

He returned for the 2024-25 season, playing good minutes off the bench, including a double figure scoring performance against Kansas State (11/14) when he was 5-of-5 from the field and scored 12 points.

But in the first half of the Pittsburgh game at The Greenbrier (11/22), he fell awkwardly and dislocated his shoulder. This time the shoulder was quickly put back in place and he was able to return against Florida State (12/3) where he played 18 minutes.

Collins moved into the starting lineup against FGCU (12/08) and at the best scoring game of his career – at either Kentucky or LSU – with 18 points on 8-of-13 shooting that included his second career three-pointer.

In his three starts he has played 76 minutes, made 16-of-25 field goals, grabbed 17 boards with seven blocks and 36 points.

For the season, he is averaging 7.2 points, 4.6 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game. In his three starts he has seen his scoring average raise from 4.8 to 7.2 points a game.

The FGCU game was Collins first LSU start, although he did start one game each year at Kentucky in 2021-22 and 2022-23. Collins is listed as a junior as he did receive a medical redshirt for the six-game season before his injury in 2023-24.

CAM CARTER 5 20-POINT GAMES

For the fifth time this season, the transfer from Kansas State was able to score 20 or more, with his fifth coming in LSU's game against Florida State (12/3). Carter hit 8-of-15 field goal attempts with two treys and seven drawn fouls led to an 8-of-9 night at the free throw line against the Seminoles. He also had eight boards, two assists and two steals.

On his return to Manhattan, Kansas (11/14), where he played for two seasons, Carter gave LSU the lead for good with his first three-pointer of the night at 23-21 and as mentioned finished with 20 points.

In the triple overtime at The Greenbrier against UCF (11/24) he had 20 points with three treys, seven boards, two assists and three steals.

Carter has had 10 double figure games this season and is on a current streak of seven consecutive double figure scoring games.

Against SMU, he handed out six assists (14 in the last three games).

Carter is averaging 16.6 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists a game. He is shooting 41.9 percent from distance (26-of-62).

JORDAN SEARS

Jordan Sears has made a team high 29 three-pointers with six each against UCF (11/24) and Northwestern State (11/29).

Sears found his scoring touch in the mid-range and at the free throw line against SMU (12/14), hitting 7-of-13 field goals with one trey and 6-of-7 free throws. He scored 21 points, his third 20-point game in the last six starts.

He has eight double figure scoring games for the year, including the last five-of-the-last-six.

Sears had 21 points against Florida State (12/3) with four treys, 5-of-6 at the free throw line, and six rebounds.

Sears is a fifth-year senior who played two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin. He is three games shy of 100 career college starts.

With a couple of games with six treys, Sears' career high for distance FGs is seven, at Lindenwood of Feb. 22, 2024 in a game Sears scored 37 points. Last season, Sears had 76 made three-pointers.

This season, Sears is averaging 15.0 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 1.6 steals per game.

DJI BAILEY

The grad transfer from the University of Richmond is shooting 55.8 percent overall, making 43-of-77 this season. He is a career 56.5 percent shooter in overall field goal percentage.

From inside the arc, Bailey is 37-of-53 (69.8 percent).

He has seven double figure scoring games, including the Stetson game (12/17) where he had 14 points, his third straight game in double figures. He also had 14 in the win over UCF (11/24).

Bailey is averaging 10.4 points, 4.4 rebounds, 3.1 assists and 1.5 steals per game.

CURTIS GIVENS AND ROBERT MILLER

First of all, the two freshmen have "III" at the end of their names. Givens, who hails from Memphis and came from national champion Montverde Academy in Florida, has had the better numbers through 10 games, especially in the opener against ULM (11/6).

Against the Warhawks, Givens played 21 minutes off the bench and hit four treys with six rebounds, scoring 15 points.

Givens had 12 points against Stetson (12/17), hitting three three-pointers in the contest.

Givens is averaging 3.8 points, 1.3 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game.

Miller started the first five games before coming off the bench in the last six games.

He has scored 19 points in the last five games combined, making 7-of-11 from the field (including his first college trey against Stetson) with 11 rebounds.

The Houston product from Pasadena (Texas) Memorial, has played an average of 12.3 minutes a game, averaging 2.3 points and 1.9 rebounds a game.

SEASON OPENER MARKED EIGHTH STRAIGHT YEAR A FRESHMAN STARTED FOR LSU

With Robert Miller III starting versus ULM (11/6), it marked the eighth straight year LSU started at least one freshman in the regular season opener.

NOAH BOYDE

The junior college transfer, who has been out since suffering an ACL tear in Dec. 2023 in junior college play, finally was cleared to practice late last week and was put in for about 90 seconds late in the win over FGCU (12/8).

He made his second appearance against Stetson (12/14), playing 2:37. He had his first field goal as a Tiger.

The product of Monchy, St. Lucia, Boyde played at McCook Community College in McCook, Nebraska.

Over two seasons, McCook averaged 11.2 points and 8.5 rebounds while shooting 56.2 percent from the floor.

He is cleared for full activity on the practice floor and is available to play.

JALEN REED SUFFERS ACL TEAR; SURGERY PUTS HIM OUT FOR SEASON

Things were going so well for Jalen Reed in the first seven games before the ACL injury early in the Florida State game (12/3) that sidelined him.

In the opening game against ULM (11/6) and in the two Greenbrier games, junior Jalen Reed had certainly found the formula for driving to the goal and making productive shots.

Against ULM, in 23 minutes, Reed hit 8-of-9 field goals and 8-of-8 at the free throw lines to get a career high of 24 points with eight rebounds and two blocks.

For his performance at the Greenbrier, Reed would earn All-Tournament honors averaging 17.5 points, 10.0 rebounds with four assists and three blocks. Reed in the two games would make 13-of-22 field goals (59.1 percent) with a trey. Reed against UCF (11/24), would play 48 minutes, make 7-of-12 field goals and 7-of-8 rebounds

to finish with 21 points, 13 rebounds and four assists.

Reed was a case study of Coach Matt McMahon's player development program showing his improvement from his freshman to sophomore season and now from his sophomore to junior season.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

It was a nice return to the floor for Derek Fountain against Stetson (12/17) after not appearing in a couple of games after playing six minutes against Florida State (12/3).

Fountain played 20 minutes against the Hatters, hitting both field goal attempts, with six rebounds and three assists with no turnovers.

He has played now in seven games, averaging 2.1 points and 3.0 rebounds.

When Fountain came off the bench for the first time this season against ULM (11/6), the aggressive play that had been seen in his best LSU season of 2022-23 seemed to be back. Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals, one block.

Fountain returned to play in the Greenbrier Tipoff after missing two games (injury) and played 25 minutes in the two games with three points, on his first three pointer of the season.

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24.

OVERTIMES

With the triple overtime win over FAU (11/24) at the Greenbrier, LSU has played 97 overtime games in its history with 44 wins. LSU has played 14 overtimes that have gone multiple sessions. This was the fifth game of at least three overtimes. LSU's last three-overtime game prior to UCF was a 97-94 win over Alabama in Baton Rouge on Feb. 23, 2013. The complete list of games of three OTs or more:

Regarding points in overtime, the 39 points LSU scored in the three overtimes combined is the most by LSU in an overtime game. The previous high had been 33 points vs. Ohio State on Jan. 15, 2005 which LSU won, 113-101, in double overtime. It was also the most points scored by an opponent in OT (32) with the previous being the 27 by Alabama on Feb. 12, 1972 in the four OT game vs. Alabama.

THE LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State. Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton. Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

MAZI MOSLEY – Los Angeles, California (6-5 guard)

Advanced to 2024 Top 100 camp where he averaged 11.3 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.3 assists ... At Section 7 elite event in Glendale, Arizona, averaged 22.8 points and 6.3 rebounds ... Ranked 40 by Rivals.com. Mosley, who played baseball for some 10 years before concentrating fully on hoops, is the nephew of Magic Johnson.

JALEN REECE – Orlando, Florida – Oak Ridge High School (6-0 point guard)

Averaged 16 points, 4.3 rebounds and 3.5 steals ... Oak Ridge won 27 games last season. Prolific ball handler and distributor, averaging eight assists at Oak Ridge. In EYBL play he averaged 11.3 points and 4.4 assists and led the Peach Jam this past summer in steals ... Ranked 49 by Rivals, 60 by ESPN and No. 67 in 247sports composite.

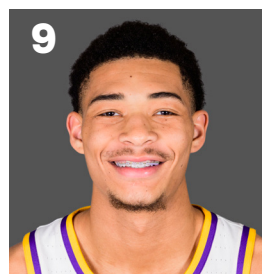
