3rd Year at LSU · 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray

State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

TIGERS TAKE PART IN COMPETE 4 CAUSE CLASSIC IN FRISCO; NEXT YEAR IN NEW ORLEANS

Saturday's game with SMU is under the banner of the Compete 4 Cause Classic and is part of a neutral-neutral set of games between the Tigers and the Mustangs. Saturday's game will take place in the Comerica Center in Frisco, Texas, the home of the G-League's Texas Legends. The Legends will be playing the NOLA Pelicans' G-League team, the Birmingham Squadron, in a 7:45 p.m. game Saturday in the same building.

Next year, the site of the Classic will shift to New Orleans as the teams will meet in either November or December in the Smoothie King Center.

There is also a community aspect to the game as once the Tigers arrive in town they will stop at the Boys and Girls Club of Frisco to visit with the youngsters there.

THE SMU SERIES

The teams have met five total times previously, but just once since 1965 and that was in the 2014 second round of the NIT at Moody Coliseum in Dallas. The Mustangs were an 80-67 winner.

SMU leads the series, 3-2. The teams played two home-and-away sets in 1962 through 1965 with LSU winning both home matchups in 1963 (66-62) and 1965 (91-88).

SMU UPDATE

The Mustangs won their first ever Atlantic Coast Conference game last Saturday, 63-51, over Virginia at Moody Coliseum. Kario Oquendo had 21 points to lead SMU. Samet Yigitoglu had 16 points and Matt Cross grabbed 10 rebounds for SMU. The Mustangs are now 8-2 on the season.

SMU has played one SEC team this season, losing to Mississippi State on Nov. 29, 84-79. The team won the Acrisure Holiday Invitational in Palm Springs with two victories

For the season, Boopie Miller leads SMU in scoring average at 14.9 points per game, while Chuck Harris averages 12.2, and Oquendo and Yigitoglu each are at 11.6 a game. SMU averages 85.0 points and surrenders just under 70 points a game.

SMU is under the direction of first-year coach Andy Enfield, who had previous stops at Florida Gulf Coast and USC.

LSU is 1-1 on neutral courts this year having split in the Greenbrier Tipoff, losing to Pittsburgh and scoring a 109-102 triple overtime victory over UCF back in November. Matt McMahon at LSU is 7-6 in neutral court games in his three years at LSU.

The Tigers on-court are 170-183 in its history in neutral court games.

THE 8-1 LSU START

The Tigers have started 8-1 or 9-0 now for the 25th time in program history and the 12th time in the last 40 seasons;

NOTES FROM THE WIN OVER FLORIDA GULF COAST

--LSU has now played and won three games in its last four against teams from Florida – UCF in triple overtime (Nov. 24), 109-102; Florida State (Dec. 3) 85-75 in the SEC/ACC Challenge; and most recently, FGCU (Feb. 8) 80-71 ... LSU's next home game is Dec. 17 against Stetson, which hails from Deland, Florida.

- --Corey Chest not only had his first double double as a college player against FGCU (12 pts-12 rebs), but it marked his third straight game with 10 or more rebounds. He is the first LSU player to have 10 or more rebounds in three straight games since Darius Days did it in 2022 at TCU (12), Ole Miss (13) and 11 at Vandy.
- --Daimion Collins had his first LSU start in the FGCU game (12/8) and he responded with 18 points on 8-of-13 shooting with a three-pointer, five rebounds and three blocks. He played 24 minutes in the game.
 - --Tigers shot 50 percent for the game (29-of-58) to go 4-0 this season when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 11-3 in the Matt McMahon era.
- --LSU used its third different lineup of the season with Jalen Reed now out with a torn ACL in his right knee. Collins replaced Reed in the opening five with Jordan Sears, Dji Bailey, Cam Carter and Collins.
 - --It was the second time this season that LSU had five players in double figures in a game.

TIGERS CONTINUING TO TAKE STEPS TO BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

The win over Kansas State, LSU's rallies against Charleston Southern and UCF, and the SEC/ACC Challenge win over Florida State has allowed LSU to take more steps toward having a better November-December record when the non-conference portion of the season ends at the end of December.

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the 2023-24 season where LSU stumbled too much, losing five times in the month of November and December, including some games when they were favored. So one of the goals of this team this year has been to not only get ready for league play, but to play better basketball in the first two months of the season.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

Now LSU which has survived one injury to Daimion Collins, will now have to survive the loss for the season of Jalen Reed. Collins has made the first step in that transition

and Noah Boyde is now cleared to play as well.

THREE POWER CONFERENCE WINS IN NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

LSU wins over Kansas State and UCF of the Big 12 and Florida State of the ACC, puts the 2024-25 LSU team in rarified air of wins by an LSU team against the so-called major conferences of the particular time (in this case, Big 10, Big 12, Big East, ACC) for example.

The last LSU team to beat three teams from the power conferences in November-December was the 2021-22 Tigers which defeated Penn State of the Big 10 and Wake Forest and Georgia Tech of the ACC.

The only LSU team in the last 20 years to record four non-conference wins in an entire season was the 2005-06 team which beat West Virginia of the Big East and then Texas A&M (Big 12), Duke (ACC) and Texas (Big 12) in the NCAA Tournament.

NET RANKINGS ARE OUT

The NCAA NET Rankings came for the first time on Monday with LSU starting in the No. 50 spot. As of Tuesday AM, the Tigers are No. 57 in the rankings. LSU has Quad 2 wins over Kansas State, UCF and Florida State. LSU is 0-1 against Quad 1 teams (Pittsburgh). LSU's next Quad 1 opportunity could come on the semi-neutral court in Frisco, Texas against SMU (Dec. 14).

1,000, THEN 2,000 POINT MARKS ON THE HORIZON FOR LSU IN 2024-25

In the 2022-23 season, LSU celebrated a 2,000-point career scorer when KJ Williams crossed the mark as part of his final season at LSU after a stellar part of his career at Murray State.

LSU in the 2024-25 season, is on the verge of having a 1,000-point career scorer before the turn of the calendar and then in the new year could watch a player top the 2,000-point career mark.

Cam Carter has posted 156 points in nine games in an LSU uniform, a 17.3 points per game average, and for his career stands at 942 points for his 106 games. He is 58 points short of the 1,000 mark. There are four games to be played before 2025 begins and he would need to average 14.5 points to get to a thousand by 2024's end.

Jordan Sears, who is averaging 15.2 points per game this season, and who has scored 137 points in his first nine games as a Tiger, stands at 1,811 points for his 130-game career. He needs to average just over 8.5 points a game to reach the mark by the start of the SEC Tournament.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

The early scoop on LSU was that it was going to try to transition fast and shoot the three-ball when possible.

Well, that hasn't exactly lived up to its tenor after nine games. LSU tries to get it going fast when it can control the boards, but has not shot the percentage it would like from distance, hitting 73-of-231 or 31.6 percent. Last Sunday, the Tigers looked like it would have a big day from the arc, hitting 6-of-14 from the arc (42.9 percent). But in the second half, the Tigers were just 2-of-13 from distance (15.4 percent). LSU finished 8-of-27 (29.6%).

It reversed a trend where LSU did hit double figures in two-of-the-previous four games, hitting 12 against UCF in the triple overtime game. The Tigers hit nine of those in the second half and overtime when they were 9-of-23 from distance after going 3-of-13 in the opening 20 minutes.

Against Northwestern State (11/30), the Tigers hit 10-of-27 (37.0 percent), including 7-of-14 in the second half.

LSU has now hit double digit three-pointers 20 times in the Matt McMahon era (3-0 this season) with a 10-10 overall mark.

The Tigers main three-point success has come from Jordan Sears and Cam Carter:

Jordan Sears – 26-of-65 – 40.0 percent (9th in the SEC) Cam Carter – 23-of-56 – 41.1 percent (7th in the SEC)

DEFENSIVELY FROM THE FIELD

The Tigers have 26 more made field goals than opponents, even though opponents have attempted 47 more shots. Opponents are 229-of-599 or 38.2 percent, which is third in the conference or 27th in the NCAA for FG defense as of Tuesday AM.

The Tigers are 6-0 when opponents shot under 40 percent this season and 20-4 in the Coach Matt McMahon era at LSU.

From three-point range the number is even better. LSU has made 16 more three-pointers than opponents so far and the opponents three-point percentage is 27.1 percent (57-of-210), which is also third in the conference and 15th in the NCAA.

FIRST HALF VERSUS SECOND HALF

Although reversed in last Sunday's game, there was a trend developing here early in the season in which LSU had trailed in the previous four games prior to the FGCU contest.

In fact, when LSU had a lead at the half against FGCU, it marked the first time the Tigers had a halftime lead at home since the first game of the season against ULM on Nov. 6.

LSU's 42-27 halftime lead snapped a streak of LSU trailing at home at halftime against Alabama State (Nov. 10), Charleston Southern (Nov. 19), Northwestern State (Nov. 29) and Florida State (Dec. 3). LSU would win all four games.

LSU also trailed by 20 in the first half, 15 at intermission, in the Greenbrier game against UCF (11/24) that LSU would come back to tie and force triple overtime before winning, 109-102.

Both Jordan Sears and Cam Carter are averaging 9.7 points in the second half, while Sears if 15-of-30 from three-point range in the final 20 minutes.

FREE THROWS

There have been ups and downs at the free throw line, but LSU, after going 14-of-16 against FGCU (12/8), for the season is 153-of-206 or 74.3 percent at the line. Opponents are 114-of-164 (69.5%). LSU has made 39 more free throws with 42 more attempts.

LSU's top five scorers (including Jalen Reed), have made 129-of-168 free throws:

Cam Carter - 37-of-43 (86.0%) Jordan Sears - 31-of-38 (81.6%) Vyctorius Miller - 24-of-31 (77.4%) Jalen Reed - 23-of-34 (67.6%) Dji Bailey - 14-of-22 (63.6%)

BLOCKS ARE BACK

LSU has nine players that have blocks through the first nine games this season. LSU averaged 3.8 blocks per game a year ago.

So far, LSU is at 50 blocks or 5.55 which is 14th in the NCAA as of Tuesday AM. Corey Chest with his five-block game against Northwestern State (11/29), is averaging 1.25 blocks with Daimion Collins, who has had seven combined blocks in the last two games, now averaging 2.0 a contest.

GOOD REBOUNDING NUMBERS

LSU is averaging 41.33 rebounds a game and that is fifth in the SEC and 30th in the NCAA ... LSU averages 28.44 defensive rebounds a game and that is third in the SEC and 35th in the NCAA.

Corey Chest leads LSU with an 8.1 rebounds per game average and that is fifth in the SEC.

VYCTORIUS MILLER CONTINUES STRONG EFFORTS

Vyctorius Miller has been a good asset for the LSU basketball team coming off the bench as starting with the third game he rolled off six consecutive double figure scoring games. That streak was stopped on Sunday when he scored eight against FGCU, but he was 3-of-6 from the field with three assists.

Miller started the season playing just 20 minutes combined in the first two games with three total points. Since then, Miller has played no less than 21 minutes in any game and has averaged 14 points over the last seven games.

For the season to date, he is hitting 34-of-74 field goals (45.9%) with nine treys and 24-of-31 at the free throw ine.

He has a 1.6 assist-to-turnover ratio early on with just one game with more turnovers than assists. Miller for the year is now averaging 11.2 points per game, 2.1 rebounds and 1.6 assists.

COREY CHEST HAS MADE STARTS COUNT

There were hints a year ago when he was having his redshirt season at LSU that Corey Chest was making some impressions, all good, in practice and in the weight room.

And, those impressions are now being seen on the basketball court as Chest has started the last four games for the Tigers.

That first impression came in the third game of the year at Kansas State (11/14) when he pulled down 13 rebounds off the bench in 21 minutes. This came one game after he didn't see the floor (Coach's Decision) as part of the rotation in the game against Alabama State (11/10).

But the redshirt freshman from New Orleans played a combined 42 minutes in the next two games and moved into the starting lineup in the triple-overtime win over UCF (11/24) at The Greenbrier. Chest played 27 minutes before fouling out, hitting 3-of-4 field goals with eight points, six boards, a block and three steals.

He played 30 minutes in his second start against Northwestern State (11/29), again hitting 3-of-4 field goals with five blocks and just missing a double double with nine points and 10 rebounds.

He also had double figure boards against Florida State (10, 12/3) and then followed up in the FGCU game (12/8) with his first college double double with 12 points and 12 rebounds.

Chest became the first LSU player to have double figure rebounds in three straight games since Darius Days had 12 at TCU, 13 vs. Ole Miss and 11 at Vandy in the 2022 season.

In his four starts, he is 14-of-17 from the field. For the season, he is averaging 6.5 points, 8.1 rebounds, 1.3 blocks and 1.0 steals a game.

Chest is a redshirt freshman from New Orleans. He played three years of high school at McMain in New Orleans before playing for national high school champion (2023) Link Academy in Branson, Missouri.

DAIMION COLLINS

His first season at LSU in 2023-24 ended abruptly when a dislocated shoulder early in non-conference play would lead to surgery.

He returned for the 2024-25 season, playing good minutes off the bench, including a double figure scoring performance against Kansas State (11/14) when he was 5-of-5 from the field and scored 12 points.

But in the first half of the Pittsburgh game at The Greenbrier (11/22), he fell awkwardly and dislocated his shoulder. This time the shoulder was quickly put back in place and he was able to return against Florida State (12/3) where he played 18 minutes.

Collins moved into the starting lineup against FGCU (12/08) and at the best scoring game of his career – at either Kentucky or LSU – with 18 points on 8-of-13 shooting that included his second career three-pointer.

He has also blocked seven shots in the last two games and for the season is averaging 6.7 points, 4.1 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game.

It was Collins first LSU start, although he did start one game each year at Kentucky in 2021-22 and 2022-23. Collins is listed as a junior as he did receive a medical redshirt for the six-game season before his injury in 2023-24.

PORTAL PLAYERS

The three LSU picked up in the transfer portal started for the Tigers in the first nine games and here are some of their totals:

Cam Carter (Kansas St.) – 17.3 ppg, 4.4 rpg, 2.0 apg, 1.44spg – 44.4 FG%, 41.1 3FG%, 86.0 FT% Jordan Sears (UT Martin) – 15.2 ppg, 4.2 rpg, 2.6 apg, 1.6 spg – 40.4 FG%, 40.0 3FG%, 81.6 FT% DJI Bailey (Richmond) – 9.7 ppg, 4.3 rpg, 3.1 apg, 1.6 spg – 56.5 FG%, 17.6 3FG%, 63.6 FT%

CAM CARTER 5 20-POINT GAMES

For the fifth time this season, the transfer from Kansas State was able to score 20 or more, with his fifth coming in LSU's game against Florida State (12/3). Carter hit 8-of-15 field goal attempts with two treys and seven drawn fouls led to an 8-of-9 night at the free throw line against the Seminoles. He also had eight boards, two assists and two steals

Carter's 20-point games this season:

ULM (11/6) – 21 points Ala. St. (11/10) – 21 points At Kansas St. (11/14) – 20 points Vs. UCF (11/24) – 20 points Florida St. (12/3) – 26 points.

Carter has 10 career 20-point games.

On his return to Manhattan, Kansas (11/14), where he played for two seasons, Carter gave LSU the lead for good with his first three-pointer of the night at 23-21 and as mentioned finished with 20 points.

In the triple overtime at The Greenbrier against UCF (11/24) he had 20 points with three treys, seven boards, two assists and three steals.

Carter has had eight double figure games this season and is on a current streak of five consecutive double figure scoring games.

Carter is averaging 17.3 points, 4.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists a game. He is shooting 41.1 percent from distance (23-of-56). Carter as of Tuesday AM, is ninth in the league in scoring average.

JORDAN SEARS

Jordan Sears has posted 18 three-pointers in the last four games combined with six treys against both UCF (11/24) and Northwestern State (11/29). Sears is 15-of-30 from distance in the second half (50.0 percent) this season.

Sears has seven double figures games so far this season, including the last four, with an LSU high of 25 against UCF with nine boards. He has four games of three treys or more, five games with at least five rebounds and two games with at least five assists.

Sears had 21 points against Florida State (12/3) with four treys, 5-of-6 at the free throw line, and six rebounds.

Sears is a fifth-year senior who played two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin. He is five games shy of 100 career college starts.

With a couple of games with six treys, Sears' career high for distance FGs is seven, at Lindenwood of Feb. 22, 2024 in a game Sears scored 37 points. Last season, Sears had 76 made three-pointers.

This season, Sears is averaging 15.2 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 1.6 steals per game.

DJI BAILEY

The grad transfer from the University of Richmond is shooting 56.5 percent overall, making 35-of-62 this season. He is a career 56.4 percent shooter in overall field goal percentage.

From inside the arc, Bailey is 32-of-45 (71.1 percent).

Bailey played 44 minutes against UCF, with his fourth double figure game this season of 14 in that game. He had five rebounds (all offensive) and six assists against the Knights (11/24).

Bailey is averaging 9.7 points, 4.3 rebounds, 3.1 assists and 1.6 steals per game.

CURTIS GIVENS AND ROBERT MILLER

First of all, the two freshmen have "III" at the end of their names. Givens, who hails from Memphis and came from national champion Montverde Academy in Florida, has had the better numbers through nine games, especially in the opener against ULM (11/6).

Against the Warhawks, Givens played 21 minutes off the bench and hit four treys with six rebounds, scoring 15 points.

Givens is averaging 3.3 points, 1.2 rebounds and 1.2 assists per game.

Miller started the first five games before coming off the bench in the last four games.

However, he has found a bit of a spot in the last two games, playing 15 minutes in each, making 4-of-6 field goals and scoring nine points with two blocks.

The Houston product from Pasadena (Texas) Memorial, has played an average of 12.3 minutes a game, averaging 2.0 points and 2.1 rebounds a game.

SEASON OPENER MARKED EIGHTH STRAIGHT YEAR A FRESHMAN STARTED FOR LSU

With Robert Miller III starting versus ULM (11/6), it marked the eighth straight year LSU started at least one freshman in the regular season opener.

NOAH BOYDE

The junior college transfer, who has been out since suffering an ACL tear in Dec. 2023 in junior college play, finally was cleared to practice late last week and was put in for about 90 seconds late in the win over FGCU

The product of Monchy, St. Lucia, Boyde played at McCook Community College in McCook, Nebraska. Over two seasons, McCook averaged 11.2 points and 8.5 rebounds while shooting 56. 2 percent from the floor.

JALEN REED SUFFERS ACL TEAR; SURGERY PUTS HIM OUT FOR SEASON

Things were going so well for Jalen Reed in the first seven games before the ACL injury early in the Florida State game (12/3) that sidelined him.

In the opening game against ULM (11/6) and in the two Greenbrier games, junior Jalen Reed had certainly found the formula for driving to the goal and making productive shots.

Against ULM, in 23 minutes, Reed hit 8-of-9 field goals and 8-of-8 at the free throw lines to get a career high of 24 points with eight rebounds and two blocks.

For his performance at the Greenbrier, Reed would earn All-Tournament honors averaging 17.5 points, 10.0 rebounds with four assists and three blocks. Reed in the two games would make 13-of-22 field goals (59.1 percent) with a trey. Reed against UCF (11/24), would play 48 minutes, make 7-of-12 field goals and 7-of-8 rebounds to finish with 21 points, 13 rebounds and four assists.

Reed was a case study of Coach Matt McMahon's player development program showing his improvement from his freshman to sophomore season and now from his sophomore to junior season.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain is in his third year at LSU. He has played in six games, averaging 1.8 points and 2.5 rebounds.

When Fountain came off the bench for the first time this season against ULM (11/6), the aggressive play that had been seen in his best LSU season of 2022-23 seemed to be back. Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals, one block.

Fountain returned to play in the Greenbrier Tipoff after missing two games and played 25 minutes in the two games with three points, on his first three pointer of the season.

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24.

OVERTIMES

With the triple overtime win over FAU (11/24) at the Greenbrier, LSU has played 97 overtime games in its history with 44 wins. LSU has played 14 overtimes that have gone multiple sessions. This was the fifth game of at least three overtimes. LSU's last three-overtime game prior to UCF was a 97-94 win over Alabama in Baton Rouge on Feb. 23, 2013. The complete list of games of three OTs or more:

Regarding points in overtime, the 39 points LSU scored in the three overtimes combined is the most by LSU in an overtime game. The previous high had been 33 points vs. Ohio State on Jan. 15, 2005 which LSU won, 113-101, in double overtime. It was also the most points scored by an opponent in OT (32) with the previous being the 27 by Alabama on Feb. 12, 1972 in the four OT game vs. Alabama.

THE LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State. Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton. Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

TIGERS SIGNED THREE FOUR-STARS IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

The LSU Tigers signed three four-star players for the 2025-26 season during the opening day of the signing period that occurred last Wednesday. Rivals as of Wednesday AM, had the class ranked No. 7 in their team rankings. Here are some numbers on the signees:

MATT GILHOOL - Elizabethtown, Pa. - William Penn Charter School (6-11 Forward)

Averaged 15 points, nine rebounds and two blocks a game for the school as a junior ... The lefthander attended the 2024 Pangos All-America Camp where he was one of the top scorers in the event, averaging 17.3 points per game ... The No. 2 player in the state of Pennsylvania, is ranked No. 65 in the Rivals Rankings and 73 in the On3sports.com composite rankings.

MAZI MOSLEY - Los Angeles, California (6-5 guard)

Advanced to the 2024 Top 100 camp where he averaged 11.3 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.3 assists per contest ... At Section 7 elite event in Glendale, Arizona, he averaged 22.8 points and 6.3 rebounds ... Ranked No. 40 by Rivals.com. Mosley, who played baseball for some 10 years before concentrating fully on basketball, is the nephew of longtime basketball icon, Magic Johnson.

JALEN REECE - Orlando, Florida - Oak Ridge High School (6-0 point guard)

Averaged 16 points, 4.3 rebounds and 3.5 steals in his junior season. Oak Ridge won 27 games last season. Proven to be a prolific ball handler and distributor, averaging eight assists this past year at Oak Ridge. In EYBL play he averaged 11.3 points and 4.4 assists a contest and led the Peach Jam event this past summer in steals ... Ranked 49 by Rivals, 60 by ESPN and No. 67 in 247sports composite.

LSU will have three more conference games at the Maravich Center prior to the start of SEC play beginning on Tuesday night when Stetson comes to town in a continuance of the Florida school homestand. The game will start at 8 p.m. and will be televised on the SEC Network. LSU will then play on Sunday, Dec. 22, at 2 p.m. against UNO and Sunday, Dec. 29 at 6 p.m. versus Mississippi Valley State to complete non-conference play.

LSU opens up the conference schedule against Vanderbilt on Jan. 4.
