3rd Year at LSU · 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season titles (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

THE NORTHWESTERN STATE SERIES

This will be the 30th time that LSU and Northwestern State will meet in basketball and the second straight years the teams have faced off. Last year on Dec. 29, 2023, the Tigers won, 96-55.
Since the teams resumed playing in 1989, the Tigers have won 13 straight games in the series.
Overall, LSU leads the series, 22-7, which actually began in 1915 in Natchitoches with LSU winning a 24-23 decision. Northwestern State's last win was in 1956 in Shreveport at the Louisiana Invitational.
LSU leads the series, 17-4 in games played in Baton Rouge.

NORTHWESTERN STATE UPDATE

The Demons are 2-4 and coming off a Sunday 71-58 win over North Alabama in the City of Lights Multi-Team Event that was held at Natchitoches' Prather Coliseum. Chris Mubiru led the Demons with 13 points, while Jerald Colonel and Landyn Jumawan had 13 points each. Love Bettis added 10. The Demons hit 62.1 percent of their second half field goals, making 18-of-29. It marked the second straight game the Demons have shot over 60 percent in the second half.
In between a win over John Melvin, the Demons dropped two-point decisions to Rice (77-75) and to ULM (65-63).
Rick Cabrera is in his second year as the head coach of the Demons.

OVERTIMES

LSU has played 97 overtime games in its history with 44 wins. LSU has played 14 overtimes that have gone multiple sessions. This is the fifth game of at least three overtimes, the fourth of three overtimes. LSU's last three-overtime game prior to Sunday was a 97-94 win over Alabama in Baton Rouge on Feb. 23, 2013. Regarding points in overtime, the 39 points LSU scored in the three overtimes combined is the most by LSU in an overtime game. The previous high had been 33 points vs. Ohio State on Jan. 15, 2005 which LSU won, 113-101, in double overtime. It was also the most points scored by an opponent in OT (32) with the previous being the 27 by Alabama on Feb. 12, 1972 in the four OT game vs. Alabama. This was the second 3OT game in Division I thus far this season (Nov. 16, Missouri State 111, Tulsa 106).

NOTES FROM THE GREENBRIER TIPOFF AND THE WIN OVER UCF

- Jalen Reed was named to the Greenbrier Tipoff All-Tournament team for his play, including his second career double double against UCF.
- The 20-point deficit that LSU came back from marked the fourth win for the Tigers when trailing by 20+ since 1967. The last time came at Holiday Hoopsgiving in Atlanta when LSU defeated Wake Forest, 72-70, on Dec. 10, 2022. Since the start of the 1980-81 season, Sunday marked the 14th time LSU has been down double figures at halftime and came back to win. It was the first since Nov. 18, 2014 when LSU came from 12 down at the half to beat Texas Tech, 69-64, in overtime.
- The win marked just the fifth time in 34 games in the Matt McMahon era, but the second time this season, that LSU has come back to win when trailing after 30 minutes of play. LSU is now 4-32 when coming back to win after trailing after 35 minutes.
- The 109 points is the most scored by LSU since scoring 109 against Northwestern State on Dec. 8, 2019.
- Cam Carter played 51 minutes against UCF. The last two players to top 50 minutes in a game were Johnny O'Bryant III (51) and Charles Carmouche (54) in the three OT game versus Alabama in 2013.
- LSU finished with 56 rebounds. The last time LSU had more than 50 rebounds was against McNeese on Nov. 18, 2021.
- After shooting just 25 percent in the first half (8-of-30) from the field, the Tigers were 30-of-56 over the remaining 35 minutes of play (53.6 percent) against UCF (11/24).
- LSU is now 106-8 when scoring 100 points in a game and 17-10 when both teams score over 100 points.
- The last time the Tigers had three players scoring 20 or more points in a game was at Florida on Jan. 2, 2021 in an 83-79 LSU loss. In the LSU-Florida game, Cam Thomas had 28, Trendon Watford 21 and Javonte Smart 20.

TIGERS CONTINUING TO TAKE STEPS TO BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

The win over Kansas State, LSU's rally against Charleston Southern and UCF allowed LSU to take more steps toward having a better November-December record when the non-conference portion of the season ends at the end of December.

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the 2023-24 season where LSU stumbled some, losing five times in the month of November and December, including some games when they were favored. So one of the goals of this team this year is to not only get ready for league play, but to play better basketball in the first two months of the season.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

VYCTORIUS MILLER CONTINUES STRONG EFFORTS; 4 STRAIGHT IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Freshman Vyctorius Miller has really turned into a contributor with four consecutive games of 14 points or more. After playing just 20 minutes in the first two games combined, Miller has now played no less than 21 minutes in the last four games and averaged 16.0 points per game in that span:

At K-State – 6-of-9 FGs, 2-4 3FGs, 1-2 FTs, 15 pts, 3 rebs, 2 asts

Charleston So. – 9-of-14 FGs, 1-3 FTs, 19 pts, 1 ast, 2 steals

Vs. Pittsburgh – 3-6 FGs, 2-3 3FGs, 6-7 FTs, 14 pts, 1 steal

Vs. UCF – 6-13 FGs, 1-5 3FGs, 3-4 FTs, 16 pts, 1 ast, 1 steal

Miller for the year is now averaging 11.2 points per game, 1.5 rebounds and 1.2 assists.

COREY CHEST GETS FIRST START AT GREENBRIER AND MAKES IT COUNT

Corey Chest bumped up to the starting lineup for the UCF game at The Greenbrier (11/24) and responded with a solid eight points, six rebounds (4 offensive) three steals and a block before fouling out after 27 minutes of play.

Chest didn't get on the floor in the second game of the season, but since then has become an integral part of the LSU team, especially on the boards.

He grabbed 13 rebounds against Kansas State in the win in Manhattan, the 13th LSU freshman to grab at least 13 rebounds in a game. He has had 8 pts-6 rebs, 6 pts-8 rebs, and 8 pts-6 rebs in each of the last three games. He is 11-of-18 from the field in the last four games for the Tigers.

He is averaging 5.4 points and 6.6 rebounds.

Chest is a redshirt freshman from New Orleans. He played three years of high school at McMain in New Orleans before playing for national high school champion (2023) Link Academy in Branson, Missouri.

AT THE NEUTRAL SITE

LSU is now 1-1 on the neutral court and Matt McMahon is 7-6 in neutral court games.

Overall, LSU on court has a record of 170-183 (48.1 percent) in neutral court contests.

MARAVICH ASSEMBLY CENTER

LSU was 12-6 a year ago in the 53rd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. With three wins this year, the Tigers are 342-49 in non-conference games in the building.

The building was originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation following the untimely death of the star LSU player. The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

2,000, 1,000 POINT MARKS POSSIBLE FOR TIGERS IN 2024-25

In the 2022-23 season, LSU celebrated a 2,000-point career scorer when K.J Williams crossed the mark as part of his final season at LSU after a stellar part of his career at Murray State.

Now in the 2024-25 season, the potential of another 2,000-point career scorer is a possibility as Jordan Sears enters the week at 1,759 points, with a 13.9 career scoring average for 127 games.

Sears, with two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin, would need to average just under 10 points a game to get the mark by the end of the season.

Speaking of point totals, Cam Carter with 102 points in the first six games has taken a big chunk of the total on his march to 1,000 career points. The senior is now at 888 points in 103 career games.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

The early scoop on LSU was that it was going to try to transition fast and shoot the three-ball when possible.

Well, that hasn't exactly lived up to its tenor after six games. LSU tries to get it going fast when it can control the boards, but has not shot the percentage it would like from distance, hitting just 46-of-150 or 30.7 percent.

LSU did hit double figures for the second time this season, hitting 12 against UCF in the triple overtime game. LSU hit nine of those in the second half and overtime when they were 9-of-23 from distance after going 3-of-13 in the opening 20 minutes.

LSU has now hit double digit three-pointers 19 times in the Matt McMahon era (2-0 this season) with a 9-10 overall mark.

Cam Carter leads the team in percentage at 41.7 percent (15-of-36), while Jordan Sears, who hit six in the UCF game, is 14-of-38 (36.8 percent).

With those two a combined 29-of-74, the remainder of the Tiger squad so far is 17-of-76 (22.4 percent).

Defensively, the Tigers are still allowing just 23.9 percent from three-point range (32-of-134). As of Tuesday, the Tigers are ranked second in the conference behind Kentucky (22.4%) and seventh in the NCAA statistics.

INSIDE THE ARC

LSU, according to Team Rankings, is getting 51 percent of its points inside the arc, compared to 48.6 percent a year ago.

The Tigers are shooting 56.3 percent inside the arc, compared to 51.4 percent a year ago.

LSU missed 10 layups and dunks in the first half of the game against UCF (11/24), but finished the game 21-of-38 overall. LSU is 44-of-66 on layups and dunks this season.

FREE THROWS – WHAT HAPPENED?

There was a moment of question regarding LSU's free throw shooting when they made just 7-of-14 at the stripe in the first half of play against Alabama State (11/10). But in the second half and against Kansas State, the Tigers were 32-of-38 at the line in those 60 minutes of play.

Versus Charleston Southern (11/19), it was just a so-so night with free tosses, making 8-of-12 in the first half and just 5-of-11 in the second half for a 13-of-23 night (56.5%).

In the two Greenbrier Tipoff games, the Tigers made 35-of-49 free throws or 71.4 percent.

LSU's top five scorers have attempted 120-of-143 free throws this season with 87 makes:

Cam Carter – 25-of-30 (83.3%)

Jordan Sears – 19-of-25 (76.0%)

Jalen Reed – 22-of-32 (68.8%)

Vyctorius Miller – 11-of-16 (68.8%)

Dji Bailey – 10-of-17 (58.8%)

The remaining LSU players are a combined 17-of-23 at the line.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain is in his third year at LSU, but his best season was his first after last year was plagued by injuries before and during the 2023-24 season. While his first two games showed what he did two years ago when he was healthy, his minor injury in the pregame prior to Kansas State (11/14) could have been problematic for LSU.

When Fountain came off the bench for the first time this season against ULM (11/6), the aggressive play that had been seen in the 2022-23 season seemed to be back.

Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals and one block.

Fountain returned to play after missing two games against Pittsburgh and played 25 minutes in the two games with three points, on his first three pointer of the season.

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24.

Fountain, who played two years at Mississippi State before coming to LSU, did not have a good scoring game against Alabama State (11/10), but he was on the floor for 23 minutes, helping to move the issue in favor of the Tigers with six rebounds and a plus/minus total of +17.

PORTAL PLAYERS

The three LSU picked up in the transfer portal started for the Tigers in the first six games and here are some of their totals:

CAM CARTER GOT IT TO 20 AGAIN AT GREENBRIER

For the fourth time this season, the transfer from Kansas State was able to score 20 or more, this time in the Tigers' last game against UCF (11/24). Carter had 17 points in the second half and overtime against the Knights as he finished with 20 points, hitting three treys with seven rebounds, two assists and three steals.

Carter has four 20-point games this season:

Vs. ULM (11/6) – 21 points
Vs. Ala. St. (11/10) – 21 points
At Kansas St. (11/14) – 20 points
Vs. UCF (11/24) – 20 points

Carter has nine career 20-point games.

On his return to Manhattan, Kansas, where he played for two seasons, Carter gave LSU the lead for good with his first three-pointer of the night at 23-21 and as mentioned finished with 20 points.

Carter is averaging 17.0 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.3 assists a game. He is shooting 41.7 percent from distance (15-of-36).

SEARS AND BAILEY

Jordan Sears and Dji Bailey's numbers have been important at different times in the young season doing different things.

Sears first and second half shooting and scoring has been night and day in the early going. The fifth-year senior has hit just 20 percent of his field goal attempts in the first half, averaging 2.3 points in the opening 20 minutes, while in the second half he is 52.9 percent with nine treys and a team best 9.7 average in the second half.

Sears has four double figure games, topped by his 25 against UCF (11/24) when he hit six total three-pointers, including back-to-back treys that helped fuel LSU's second half comeback.

The six equaled the most by a Tiger since a year ago when Mike Williams hit six treys in an early season contest.

Sears also had nine rebounds and three assists in the game against UCF.

He is averaging 14.2 points, 4.2 rebounds and 3.0 assists.

Bailey played 44 minutes against UCF, with his fourth double figure game this season of 14 in that game. He had five rebounds (all offensive) and six assists against the Knights (11/24).

Bailey is averaging 10.5 points, 4.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists.

CURTIS GIVENS AND ROBERT MILLER

First of all, the two freshmen have "III" at the end of their names. Givens, who hails from Memphis and came from national champion Montverde Academy in Florida, has had the better numbers through six games, especially in the opener against ULM (11/6).

Against the Warhawks, Givens played 21 minutes off the bench and hit four treys with six rebounds, scoring 15 points.

Givens played eight minutes against UCF (11/24) but hit 2-of-3 field goals, including a trey and finished with five points in the Tigers win. He is averaging 4.0 points, 1.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists.

Miller started the first five games before coming off the bench in the last game. The Houston product from Pasadena (Texas) Memorial, has played an average of 12.7 minutes a game, averaging 1.0 points and 1.7 rebounds a game.

SEASON OPENER MARKED EIGHTH STRAIGHT YEAR A FRESHMAN STARTED FOR LSU

With Robert Miller III starting versus ULM (11/6), it marked the eighth straight year LSU started at least one freshman in the regular season opener.

JALEN REED CAREER NIGHT IN OPENER; CAREER DOUBLE AGAINST UCF

In the opening game against ULM (11/6) and in the two Greenbrier games, junior Jalen Reed has certainly found the formula for driving to the goal and making productive shots.

Against ULM, in 23 minutes, Reed hit 8-of-9 field goals and 8-of-8 at the free throw lines to get a career high of 24 points with eight rebounds and two blocks.

For his performance at the Greenbrier, Reed would earn All-Tournament honors averaging 17.5 points, 10.0 rebounds with four assists and three blocks. Reed in the two games would make 13-of-22 field goals (59.1 percent) with a trey.

Reed against UCF (11/24), would play 48 minutes, make 7-of-12 field goals and 7-of-8 rebounds to finish with 21

FAMILIAR FACES JOIN LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State.

Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton.

Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

TIGERS SIGNED THREE FOUR-STAR IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

The LSU Tigers signed three four-star players for the 2025-26 season during the opening day of the signing period that occurred last Wednesday. Rivals as of Wednesday AM, had the class ranked No. 7 in their team rankings. Here are some numbers on the signees:

MATT GILHOOL – Elizabethtown, Pa. – William Penn Charter School (6-11 Forward)

Averaged 15 points, nine rebounds and two blocks a game for the school as a junior ... The lefthander attended the 2024 Pangos All-America Camp where he was one of the top scorers in the event, averaging 17.3 points per game ... The No. 2 player in the state of Pennsylvania, is ranked No. 65 in the Rivals Rankings and 73 in the On3sports.com composite rankings.

In his junior season, he shot 57 percent from the floor, 31 percent from distance and helped William Penn Charter to the championship of the Inter-AC in 2024, their first outright championship in 20 years. He was the Inter-AC MVP last season.
