3rd Year at LSU · 10th Year as a Head Coach

Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

**Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.**

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

Now after two seasons as head coach at LSU and the improvement shown by the team from year one to year two, the foundation has been laid for further improvement by the Tigers and through the second season in 2023-24, all five of those core values were seen time and time again.

Through long hours of work in the classroom, in the video room, and practice, the hard work and unselfishness was seen. The toughness and accountability were there in when times got tough; and, yes, when LSU defeated back-to-back nationally-ranked teams in the final seconds, there was that joy that all LSU fans could enjoy.

The team learned and played under those five principles and laid a foundation for the LSU Basketball program to move forward on in 2024-25.

As the LSU Basketball program under Coach McMahon enters its third season, the team will mix three top 65 high school recruits, along with a handful of transfers into the mix with another step in the progress of the McMahon program – player development.

Player development is stressed a lot in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program and that was never more evident than the development of Tyrell Ward and Jalen Reed from their freshman to sophomore years. Most importantly, after another summer and fall of player development, they will be back for their third season with the program.

That bodes well for players like sophomore Mike Williams and the return of Derek Fountain and Daimion Collins who both battled injuries during different points of the 2023-24 campaign.

This past season, as LSU continued to improve, including a seven-win rise in the Southeastern Conference, finishing with a 9-9 record and a post-season tournament appearance in the NIT, the culture of the LSU program and the success that it can have in the future were on full display.

The Tigers won 5-of-their-last-7 regular season conference games starting back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in Baton Rouge.

Against the Gamecocks, it was two Jordan Wright free throws with less than five seconds to play that were the game winners after the Tigers rallied from 10 down with eight minutes

to play.

At home against Kentucky, Wright's first shot attempt was blocked. He got the rebound and tossed it to Ward who beat the buzzer for the winning score.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3).

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season titles (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

## PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season.

A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

LET'S TALK CHALLENGES

This will be LSU's 11th game in one of the challenge series that the SEC has been involved in since 2007. The Tigers were 2-1 in the SEC/Big East Challenge which ran from 2007-2012, starting with just four games involving two doubleheaders at semi-neutral sites for each league. LSU had wins over Rutgers and Seton Hall.  
The SEC/Big 12 Challenge series ran from 2014-23 with 10 of the then 14 SEC schools competing each year and LSU was 2-4 in those games with wins at Texas and at West Virginia.  
Last season, in the opening year of the SEC/ACC Challenge, the Tigers lost at Syracuse.  
Overall, the Tigers are 4-6 in Challenge games over the years.

SEC/ACC EVENT

This will be the second SEC/ACC challenge and the men's event last year ended in a 7-7 tie. Winners for the SEC included: Arkansas, Auburn, UGA, UK, Mizzou, Ole Miss and South Carolina. The ACC winners: BC, Clemson, Ga. Tech, North Carolina, Syracuse, Virginia and Wake Forest.

THE FLORIDA STATE SERIES

The Tigers and the Seminoles have met six previous times with each side winning on three occasions. The last meeting was in Orlando at the Disney hosted event in 2018, with Florida State winning, 79-76, in overtime.  
This will actually be the first meeting on one of the team's home floors since a game in Baton Rouge on Dec. 1, 1959 as the teams met in 1967, 2004 and 2018 on neutral floors. The 1967 game was held in Milwaukee, the 2004 game was part of the then Sugar Bowl Classic at the Smoothie King Center in New Orleans, and, as mentioned the 2018 game was in Orlando.  
LSU has won both previous meetings in Baton Rouge in 1957 and 1959.



FLORIDA STATE UPDATE

The Seminoles have won their last four games since a Nov. 15 loss to Florida in Tallahassee. FSU has wins over Hofstra, Temple, UMass and most recently, Western Carolina, 91-57. In that game, Daquan Davis led Florida State with 19 points, while Jamie Watkins added 14 and Malique Ewin 12. Florida State made 31-of-54 in the game (57.4%) with nine treys.

Watkins leads Florida State at 17.3 points per game with Ewin averaging 10.5 points. Florida State is averaging 79.1 points a game, giving up 64.0.

The veteran head coach of the Seminoles is Leonard Hamilton, who had previous head coaching stints with Oklahoma State, Miami and the Washington Wizards before getting the Florida State job prior to the 2002-03 season.

**RECAP:** For the fourth time this season, the Tigers were behind at the half, but came out in the second half and quickly took care of the situation to get a 24-point win over the Demons. LSU was down one, 26-25, after 25 minutes. LSU scored the first five points of the half, then gave up a three-pointer to Northwestern State. But the Tigers responded with a 17-0 run to take complete control of the game. LSU shot 53.1 percent in the second half (17-of-32) and 7-of-14 three-pointers with 11 makes in 12 attempts at the free throw line. LSU would shoot 44.8 percent for the game (26-of-58) with 10 made threes. The Tigers held the Demons to 31.3 percent from the field (21-of-67). The Tigers scored 52 second half points.

Jordan Sears hit six treys for the second straight game in getting 18 points with Cam Carter adding 15 and Jalen Reed and Vycorius Miller 11 each. Corey Chest had nine point, 10 rebounds and five blocks.

The Tigers cut it to 15 at halftime, but UCF had two second half leads of 17 points before the Tigers made a successful rally, tying the game at 70-70 on two Cam Carter free throws with 22 seconds left ... The Tigers shot 50.0 percent in the second half, hitting 15-of-30 with five treys ... The teams traded leads in the first two overtimes but no decision was rendered ... In the third five-minute session, the Tigers scored the first five points and the closest UCF got was two, 98-96, with two minutes to play ... LSU outscored UCF, 16-9, in the final five minutes.

**RECAP:** For the second straight home game, LSU has to rally from a halftime deficit, this time down five at the break to Charleston Southern ... LSU still trailed by two, 58-56, with 9:39 to play before LSU went on a 14-0 to take a 70-58 lead with 3:43 to play in the game. Charleston Southern cut the margin to five with 2:21 to play but the Tigers were able to get home from there and hold the Buccaneers to just one point the rest of the way.

Freshman Vycorius Miller had a second strong game with a team best 19 points on 9-of-14 shooting, while Jordan Sears had 15 points and Dji Bailey hit 5-of-6 field goals to finish with 11 ... LSU shot 62.5 percent in the second half (20-of-32) and finished the game at 50.8 percent (30-of-59) ... Rebounds were tied but CSU had a 21-10 advantage in second chance points with 18 offensive rebounds.

GAME 3 -- LSU 76, Kansas State 65 | November 14, 2024 | Bramlage Coliseum | Baton Rouge, Louisiana

**RECAP:** The Tigers score their first non-conference road win since the 2020 SEC/Big 12 Challenge when the Tigers won at Austin versus Texas. It was also LSU's first win in its first non-conference road game of the season since a win at No. 13 West Virginia early in the 2005-06 season ... The Tigers took the lead at 23-21 with 9:10 to play in the first half on a Cam Carter three-pointer that started a 7-0 run ... LSU, which built a 17-point first half lead (43-26, 2:04 first half), never let Kansas State get closer than nine points on one occasion in the second half.

LSU shot an even 50 percent (27-54) with eight treys and 14-of-18 from the line. LSU held its third straight opponent to less than 40 percent (23-61, 37.7 percent) with five treys. LSU dominated the boards (43-25) with 16 second chance points off 11 offensive boards. Carter had his third 20-point game with 20, while Jordan Sears and Vycorius Miller each had 15 and Daimion Collins 12 ... Corey Chest had 13 rebounds for the Tigers.

NOTES FROM THE WIN OVER NORTHWESTERN STATE

--The 24-point win marked the third-largest margin of victory in a game which LSU trailed at halftime since the 1964-65 season. The top three:

**36-point win -- 12/30/01 -- John Brady's 2001-02 Tigers trailed Nicholls, 25-22, won 71-35**

**25-point win -- 11/12/21 -- LSU trailed Texas State, 37-32, won 84-59**

**24-point win -- 11/29/24 --LSU trailed Northwestern State, 26-25, won 77-53**

--Vycorius Miller's 11 points marked his fifth consecutive double figure scoring game.

-- Corey Chest blocked five shots, the most by an LSU player since Kavell Bigby-Williams blocked five at Ole Miss on Jan. 15, 2019.

-- Corey Chest's 10 rebounds against Northwestern State marked his second double figure rebound game of the season.

-- Jordan Sears hit six three-pointers two games in a row for the Tigers against UCF and Northwestern State. Last year, Mike Williams hit six three-pointers in the game against the same opponent, Northwestern State.

-- In the second half, when LSU scored 52 points, LSU scored on 23-of-34 possessions in the final 20 minutes while Northwestern State scored on 12-of-33 second half possessions.

OVERTIMES

With the triple overtime win over FAU (11/24) at the Greenbrier, LSU has played 97 overtime games in its history with 44 wins. LSU has played 14 overtimes that have gone multiple sessions. This was the fifth game of at least three overtimes. LSU's last three-overtime game prior to Sunday was a 97-94 win over Alabama in Baton Rouge on Feb. 23, 2013. The complete list of games of three OTs or more:

- Feb. 12, 1972 – 4 OT – Alabama 103, LSU 99
- Nov. 25, 2024 – 3 OT – LSU 109, UCF 102
- Feb. 23, 2013 – 3 OT – LSU 97, Alabama 94

- Feb. 29, 1960 – 3 OT – Furman 56, LSU 55

Regarding points in overtime, the 39 points LSU scored in the three overtimes combined is the most by LSU in an overtime game. The previous high had been 33 points vs. Ohio State on Jan. 15, 2005 which LSU won, 113-101, in double overtime. It was also the most points scored by an opponent in OT (32) with the previous being the 27 by Alabama on Feb. 12, 1972 in the four OT game vs. Alabama.

TIGERS CONTINUING TO TAKE STEPS TO BETTER NOVEMBER-DECEMBER

The win over Kansas State, LSU's rally against Charleston Southern and UCF allowed LSU to take more steps toward having a better November-December record when the non-conference portion of the season ends at the end of December.

LSU finished strong last season to get to 9-9 in the SEC games, but it was in the first 13 games of the 2023-24 season where LSU stumbled some, losing five times in the month of November and December, including some games when they were favored. So one of the goals of this team this year is to not only get ready for league play, but to play better basketball in the first two months of the season.

LSU had two losses in the Maravich Center a year ago in the first two months, to Nicholls (68-66) and to Kansas State (75-60).

VYCTORIUS MILLER CONTINUES STRONG EFFORTS; 5 STRAIGHT IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Freshman Vyctorius Miller has really turned into a contributor with five consecutive games in double figures. After playing just 20 minutes in the first two games combined, Miller has now played no less than 21 minutes in the last five games and averaged 15.0 points per game in that span:

- At K-State – 6-of-9 FGs, 2-4 3FGs, 1-2 FTs, 15 pts, 3 rebs, 2 asts
- Charleston So. – 9-of-14 FGs, 1-3 FTs, 19 pts, 1 ast, 2 steals
- Vs. Pittsburgh – 3-6 FGs, 2-3 3FGs, 6-7 FTs, 14 pts, 1 steal
- Vs. UCF – 6-13 FGs, 1-5 3FGs, 3-4 FTs, 16 pts, 1 ast, 1 steal
- N'western St. – 2-7 FGs, 0-3 3FGs, 7-7 FTs, 11 pts, 5 rebs, 1 steal

Miller for the year is now averaging 11.1 points per game, 2.0 rebounds and 1.3 assists. Miller is shooting 27-of-56 at the field (48.2 percent) and 18-of-23 at the free throw line including 16-of-18 the last three games.

COREY CHEST MAKES FIRST TWO STARTS COUNT

Corey Chest made his first impression in the third game of the year at Kansas State (11/14) when he pulled down 13 rebounds off the bench in 21 minutes. This came one game after he didn't see the floor (Coach's Decision) as part of the rotation in the game against Alabama State (11/10).

But the redshirt freshman from New Orleans played a combined 42 minutes in the next two games and moved into the starting lineup in the triple-overtime win over UCF (11/24) at The Greenbrier. Chest played 27 minutes before fouling out, hitting 3-of-4 field goals with eight points, six boards, a block and three steals.

He played 30 minutes in his second start against Northwestern State (11/29), again hitting 3-of-4 field goals with five blocks and just missing a double double with nine points and 10 rebounds.

In his two starts, he is 6-of-8 from the field, 5-of-6 from the line. For the season, he is averaging 6.0 points, 7.2 rebounds, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 steals a game.

Chest is a redshirt freshman from New Orleans. He played three years of high school at McMain in New Orleans before playing for national high school champion (2023) Link Academy in Branson, Missouri.

MARAVICH ASSEMBLY CENTER

LSU was 12-6 a year ago in the 53rd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. With four wins in as many games this year, the Tigers are 343-49 in non-conference games in the building.

The building was originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation following the untimely death of the star LSU player. The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

2,000, 1,000 POINT MARKS POSSIBLE FOR TIGERS IN 2024-25

In the 2022-23 season, LSU celebrated a 2,000-point career scorer when KJ Williams crossed the mark as part of his final season at LSU after a stellar part of his career at Murray State.

Now in the 2024-25 season, the potential of another 2,000-point career scorer is a possibility as Jordan Sears enters the week at 1,777 points, with a 13.9 career scoring average for 128 games.

Sears, with two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin, would need to average just under 10 points a game to get the mark by the end of the season.

Speaking of point totals, Cam Carter with 117 points in the first seven games has taken a big chunk of the total on his march to 1,000 career points. The senior is now at 903 points in 104 career games.

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

The early scoop on LSU was that it was going to try to transition fast and shoot the three-ball when possible.

Well, that hasn't exactly lived up to its tenor after seven games. LSU tries to get it going fast when it can control the boards, but has not shot the percentage it would like from distance, hitting just 56-of-177 or 31.6 percent.

However, LSU did hit double figures in both of the last two games, hitting 12 against UCF in the triple overtime game. LSU The Tigers hit nine of those in the second half and overtime when they were 9-of-23 from distance after going 3-of-13 in the opening 20 minutes.

Against Northwestern State (11/30), the Tigers hit 10-of-27 (37.0 percent), including 7-of-14 in the second half.

LSU has now hit double digit three-pointers 20 times in the Matt McMahon era (3-0 this season) with a 10-10 overall mark.

Cam Carter leads the team in percentage at 40.9 percent (18-of-44), while Jordan Sears, who hit six in the last two games, is 20-of-49 (40.8 percent).

With those two a combined 38-of-93, the remainder of the Tiger squad so far is 18-of-84 (21.4 percent).

Defensively, the Tigers are still allowing just 25.0 percent from three-point range (40-of-160). As of Sunday, the Tigers are ranked second in the conference in three-point percentage defense and ninth in the NCAA statistics.

INSIDE THE ARC

LSU, according to Team Rankings, is shooting 55.7 percent inside the arc, compared to 51.4 percent a year ago.

LSU missed 10 layups and dunks in the first half of the game against UCF (11/24), but finished the game 21-of-38 overall. LSU was 13-of-22 in dunks and layups against Northwestern State and 109-180 for the season (60.5%).

DEFENSIVELY FROM THE FIELD

The Tigers have 25 more made field goals than opponents, even though opponents have attempted 29 more shots. Opponents are 173-of-461 or 37.5 percent, which is 28th in the NCAA for FG defense.

The Tigers are 5-0 when opponents shot under 40 percent this season and 19-4 in the Coach Matt McMahon era at LSU.

FIRST HALF BLUES

There is a trend that seems to be developing here early in the season as LSU has trailed at the half in its last three home games – Alabama State (Nov. 10), Charleston Southern (Nov. 19), Northwestern State (Nov. 29). LSU would win all games.

LSU also trailed by 20 in the first half, 15 at intermission in the Greenbrier game against UCF (11/24) that LSU would come back to tie and force triple overtime before winning, 109-102.

In the first half of games, LSU is averaging just more than a point more than opponents – 32.2-31.0 and are outrebounded 20.4-19.9. The Tigers shoot 38.5 percent overall and 25.3 percent from three-point range. Jalen Reed is the team's leading first half scorer at 6.9 points with Cam Carter at 5.3 points and Vycorius Miller 4.4.

In the second half of games (not counting the overtime periods), LSU averaged 43.7 points compared to 33.4 for opponents and has almost a four-board advantage, 19.4-15.6. The Tigers are shooting 51.7 percent in the last 20 minutes of regulation and 38.2 percent from distance. Carter averages 9.9 points in the second half, Jordan Sears 9.6 and Vycorius Miller 6.1 a game.

FREE THROWS – WHAT HAPPENED?

There was a moment of question regarding LSU's free throw shooting when they made just 7-of-14 at the stripe in the first half of play against Alabama State (11/10). But in the second half and against Kansas State, the Tigers were 32-of-38 at the line in those 60 minutes of play.

Versus Charleston Southern (11/19), it was just a so-so night with free tosses, making 8-of-12 in the first half and just 5-of-11 in the second half for a 13-of-23 night (56.5%).

In the two Greenbrier Tipoff games, the Tigers made 35-of-49 free throws or 71.4 percent. Then against UCF (11/29), the Tigers went 11-of-12 in the 52-point second half when the Tigers rallied to win.

LSU's top five scorers have made 98 free throws and had 132-of-LSU's 161 attempts:

- Cam Carter – 27-of-32 (84.4%)
- Jordan Sears – 19-of-25 (76.0%)
- Jalen Reed – 23-of-34 (67.6%)
- Vycorius Miller – 18-of-23 (68.8%)
- Dji Bailey – 11-of-18 (61.1%)

The remaining LSU players are a combined 21-of-29 at the line.  
As a team, LSU is 73.9 percent at the line. LSU opponents are 97-of-137 (70.8 percent).

BLOCKS ARE BACK

LSU has eight players that have blocks through the first seven games this season. LSU averaged 3.8 blocks per game a year ago.

So far, LSU is at 5.14 blocks per game which is 32nd in the NCAA entering play on Sunday. Corey Chest with his five-block game on Friday, is averaging 1.5 blocks with Daimion Collins at 1.4 blocks and Jalen Reed at 1.14 a game.

GOOD REBOUNDING NUMBERS

The Tigers in the games to date, are averaging 41.9 rebounds a game, compared to 37.6 for opponents. LSU's 29.0 defensive rebound average is 28th in the NCAA, while the total rebound average is ranked 27th in the NCAA.

PORTAL PLAYERS

The three LSU picked up in the transfer portal started for the Tigers in the first seven games and here are some of their totals:

- Cam Carter (Kansas St.) – 16.7 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 1.6 apg, 1.1 spg – 42.9% FG, 40.9% 3 FG, 84.4% FT.
- Jordan Sears (UT Martin) – 14.7 ppg, 4.3 rpg, 2.9 apg, 1.6 spg – 42.7% FG, 40.8% 3FG, 76.0% FT
- DJl Bailey (Richmond) – 9.7 ppg, 4.3 rpg, 3.1 apg, 1.3 spg – 59.6% FG, 61.1% FT

CAM CARTER 4 20-POINT GAMES; STRONG SECOND HALF LAST TWO GAMES

For the fourth time this season, the transfer from Kansas State was able to score 20 or more, with his fourth coming in the Tigers' game against UCF (11/24). Carter had 17 points in the second half and overtime against the Knights as he finished with 20 points, hitting three treys with seven rebounds, two assists and three steals. Carter has four 20-point games this season:

- Vs. ULM (11/6) – 21 points
- Vs. Ala. St. (11/10) – 21 points
- At Kansas St. (11/14) – 20 points
- Vs. UCF (11/24) – 20 points

Carter has nine career 20-point games.  
On his return to Manhattan, Kansas (11/14), where he played for two seasons, Carter gave LSU the lead for good with his first three-pointer of the night at 23-21 and as mentioned finished with 20 points.  
Carter is averaging 16.7 points, 4.0 rebounds and 1.6 assists a game. He is shooting 40.9 percent from distance (18-of-44).

JORDAN SEARS

Jordan Sears has posted 12 three-pointers in each of the last two games with six treys against both UCF (11/24) and Northwestern State (11/29). Sears is 12-of-23 from distance in the second half (52.2 percent).  
Sears has five double figures games so far this season with an LSU high of 25 against UCF with nine boards. He has three games of three treys or more, four games with at least five rebounds and two games with at least five assists.  
Sears is a fifth-year senior who played two years at Gardner Webb and two years at Tennessee Martin. He is seven games shy of 100 career college starts.  
With a couple of games with six treys, Sears' career high for distance FGs is seven, at Lindenwood of Feb. 22, 2024 in a game Sears scored 37 points. Last season, Sears had 76 made three-pointers.  
This season, Sears is averaging 14.7 points, 4.3 rebounds, 2.9 assists and 1.6 steals per game.

### DJI BAILEY

The grad transfer from the University of Richmond is shooting 59.6 percent overall, making 28-of-47 this season. He is a career 56.9 percent shooter in overall field goal percentage.

From inside the arc, Bailey is 27-of-37 (72.9 percent). That is T50 in the Team Rankings for two-point field goal percentage in the NCAA.

Bailey played 44 minutes against UCF, with his fourth double figure game this season of 14 in that game. He had five rebounds (all offensive) and six assists against the Knights (11/24).

Bailey is averaging 9.7 points, 4.3 rebounds, 3.1 assists and 1.3 steals per game.

### CURTIS GIVENS AND ROBERT MILLER

First of all, the two freshmen have "III" at the end of their names. Givens, who hails from Memphis and came from national champion Montverde Academy in Florida, has had the better numbers through seven games, especially in the opener against ULM (11/6).

Against the Warhawks, Givens played 21 minutes off the bench and hit four treys with six rebounds, scoring 15 points.

Givens is averaging 4.1 points, 1.6 rebounds and 1.4 assists per game.

Miller started the first five games before coming off the bench in the last two games. The Houston product from Pasadena (Texas) Memorial, has played an average of 11.6 minutes a game, averaging 1.3 points and 1.7 rebounds a game.

### SEASON OPENER MARKED EIGHTH STRAIGHT YEAR A FRESHMAN STARTED FOR LSU

With Robert Miller III starting versus ULM (11/6), it marked the eighth straight year LSU started at least one freshman in the regular season opener.

### JALEN REED CAREER NIGHT IN OPENER; CAREER DOUBLE AGAINST UCF

In the opening game against ULM (11/6) and in the two Greenbrier games, junior Jalen Reed has certainly found the formula for driving to the goal and making productive shots.

Against ULM, in 23 minutes, Reed hit 8-of-9 field goals and 8-of-8 at the free throw lines to get a career high of 24 points with eight rebounds and two blocks.

For his performance at the Greenbrier, Reed would earn All-Tournament honors averaging 17.5 points, 10.0 rebounds with four assists and three blocks. Reed in the two games would make 13-of-22 field goals (59.1 percent) with a trey.

Reed against UCF (11/24), would play 48 minutes, make 7-of-12 field goals and 7-of-8 rebounds to finish with 21 points, 13 rebounds and four assists.

Reed had his first career double double in the 2023 SEC/ACC Challenge game against Syracuse.

Reed is kind of used as the poster board of Coach Matt McMahon's player development program showing his improvement from his freshman to sophomore season and now from his sophomore to junior season.

Reed played 33 games as a freshman with 11 starts, averaging 3.7 points and 3.2 rebounds. As a sophomore he started 20 of 32 games averaging 7.9 points and 4.1 rebounds. He upped his shooting percentage from 39.8 percent as a freshman to 51.6 percent as a sophomore.

Now with seven starts, he is averaging 12.4 points, 7.4 rebounds, shooting 59.6 percent from the floor.

Reed's 7.4 rebound average is ranked T7 in the SEC as of Tuesday.

Reed has now played 72 career games at LSU with 38 starts.

### DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain is in his third year at LSU, but his best season was his first after last year was plagued by injuries before and during the 2023-24 season. While his first two games showed what he did two years ago when he was healthy, his minor injury in the pregame prior to Kansas State (11/14) could have been problematic for LSU.

When Fountain came off the bench for the first time this season against ULM (11/6), the aggressive play that had been seen in the 2022-23 season seemed to be back. Fountain had four rebounds in his first couple of minutes in the game and he finished in 13 minutes with six points, seven rebounds with 2-of-3 from the field and 2-of-3 from the line. He also had two steals and one block.

Fountain returned to play in the Greenbrier Tipoff after missing two games and played 25 minutes in the two games with three points, on his first three pointer of the season.

Fountain averaged 8.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in the 2022-23 season and 5.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 2023-24. In 2024-25, he is averaging 2.2 points and 3.0 rebounds.

Fountain, who played two years at Mississippi State before coming to LSU, did not have a good scoring game against Alabama State (11/10), but he was on the floor for 23 minutes, helping to move the issue in favor of the Tigers with six rebounds and a plus/minus total of +17.

### FAMILIAR FACES JOIN LSU COACHING STAFF

The LSU coaching staff is back at full strength for 2024-25 after Cody Toppert left before the start of the season to take on the Washington Wizards G-League team head coaching job and Ronnie Hamilton left after the season to join the staff at Louisville.

Joining the Tigers for his second time on the LSU coaching staff as associate head coach is David Patrick, who has served twice as a head coach in his tenure, including the last two seasons as the head coach at Sacramento State.

Known as a top-flight recruiter, Patrick was on the coaching staff of Johnny Jones at LSU from 2012-16.

Also returning as assistant coach is former Tiger player Jalen Courtney-Williams. Courtney-Williams joins the Tigers after three years as a member of the coaching staff at Creighton.

Courtney-Williams played in 61 games at LSU in three seasons (2010-11, '11-12, '12-13) before transferring to Morehead State, where after sitting out a transfer season, played for MSU in 2014-15.

That pair joins returning assistants Casey Long, Tim Kaine and Ronrico White. Jeff Moore remains the director of recruiting and fan favorite Tasmin Mitchell is in his eighth season on the coaching staff as Special



Assistant to Head Coach Tasmin Mitchell.

TIGERS SIGNED THREE FOUR-STARS IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

The LSU Tigers signed three four-star players for the 2025-26 season during the opening day of the signing period that occurred last Wednesday. Rivals as of Wednesday AM, had the class ranked No. 7 in their team rankings. Here are some numbers on the signees:

MATT GILHOOL – Elizabethtown, Pa. – William Penn Charter School (6-11 Forward)

Averaged 15 points, nine rebounds and two blocks a game for the school as a junior ... The lefthander attended the 2024 Pangos All-America Camp where he was one of the top scorers in the event, averaging 17.3 points per game ... The No. 2 player in the state of Pennsylvania, is ranked No. 65 in the Rivals Rankings and 73 in the On3sports.com composite rankings.

In his junior season, he shot 57 percent from the floor, 31 percent from distance and helped William Penn Charter to the championship of the Inter-AC in 2024, their first outright championship in 20 years. He was the Inter-AC MVP last season.

MAZI MOSLEY – Los Angeles, California (6-5 guard)
